- Drexel is coming off a 74-63 win over Davidson in the first round of the Pre-season WNIT.

- 72 of Drexel's 74 points came from starters with freshman AJ Davis scoring the lone two off the bench for her first collegiate points in the third quarter.

- Senior Bailey Greenberg tied her career high in both games this year with 31 points against each Quinnipiac and Davidson. She also set single-game school records for makes and attempts at the free-throw line at Quinnipiac, going 19-for-21.

- Drexel returns 1880 of its 1985 points scored last year when the Dragons went 24-9, 14-4 CAA for their third-straight 20-win season.

## HEAD COACH // DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 / 17th Season / Career Record: 308-204

\* Entering her 17th season as the head coach of Drexel's women's basketball team, Denise Dillon has become one of the most respected coaches in collegiate women's basketball, elevating the program to new heights and maintaining an enviable consistency and high level of play.

\* The winningest head coach in program history, Dillon has led the Dragons to 10 postseason appearances. Those include the Dragons' first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season, and a WNIT championship in 2012-13.

\* Most recently, Dillon guided the Dragons to a 24-9 record in 2018-19, culminating with a second place finish in the CAA and a WNIT bid. Following on the heels of a 22-win season in 2016-17 and a 27-8 mark in 2017-18, Dillon's Dragons have won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons for the first time in program history. Late in the 2018-19 campaign, Dillon became the first Drexel basketball coach to win 300 career games at the school. That year, the team also led the nation in scoring defense, allowing 50.5 points/game. \* Drexel has boasted a winning record in 11 of the last 12 seasons. In 2012-13, her team won a school-record 28 games on its way to a 28-10 record and the WNIT title. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling Green, Auburn, Florida and Utah on its way to the title. Drexel had never defeated an SEC or Pac-12 team until the 2013 WNIT.

\* The first breakthrough season for Dillon and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders and a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a then-program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion Old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the school's first CAA title.

\* During her tenure Dillon has helped guide the careers of 25 All-Conference selections, six Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, three CAA Rookies of the Year, two CAA Players of the Year, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scoring in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft. Most recently, Dillon mentored the CAA Player of the Year Bailey Greenberg in 2018-19. Additionally, Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009. She also earned the V Foundation Comeback Award and the Honda Inspiration Award.

\* Dillon came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped Dillon to become interim head coach and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball. That season she turned a 10-18 team into a 19-10 squad that earned its first opening-round bye in the CAA Tournament.

\* Before coming to Drexel, Dillon boasted a remarkable playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense similar to the one now run by Drexel, Dillon scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds. She was an All-Rookie selection and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. Her playing career earned her enshrinement in the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2004, the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012, and the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2013. She was also inducted into the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame in 2018.

## LAST TIME OUT

- Drexel won its second-straight game to begin the 2019-20 campaign in the Dragons' home opener over the Davidson Wildcats in the first round of the Pre-season WNIT, 74-63
- Senior Bailey Greenberg matched her career high for the second time in two games to begin the season. Greenberg put up 31 points against Davidson behind 12-of-24 from the floor and 5-of-9 from beyond the arc. Her five made treys also came as a career high.
- With 31 points, Greenberg now has 1,290 for her career as she passed Jasmina Rosseel (2007-11; 1,272) on the all-time scoring list for 13th place.
- Sophomore Keishana Washington scored 18 points in the win on Saturday to go along with four assists.
- Senior Niki Metzler was the third Dragon in double figures with 10 points on 3-of-5 from the floor and 4-of-6 from the foul line. She also tied for a team-high six rebounds.
- Junior Hannah Nihill finished with eight points, seven assists and six rebounds while senior Aubree Brown had five points, five assists and two blocks.

## 2018-19 SEASON RECAP

- The Dragons won six straight after a season-opening loss to Quinnipiac. That streak included the TD Bank Classic championship at Vermont over Thanksgiving weekend.
- Drexel dropped its first two conference games to Towson and JMU at home, then rattled off the third-longest winning streak in program history (12 games) to gain control of what would become the No. 2 seed.
- The Dragons went 12-2 on the road, including winning their first 11, part of what was for more than a month the longest road winning streak in the nation.
- Drexel's 22 regular season wins were second-most all-time in program history, behind 24 in 2017-18
- Then junior Bailey Greenberg was named the CAA Player of the Year

## NO. 1 DEFENSE RETURNS

- The Dragons boasted the top scoring defense in the nation for most of the season last year, allowing just 50.5 points per game.
- Drexel did not allowed more than 60 points in regulation all regular season, and held teams under 50 in 17 of its 24 wins.
- The Dragons were the only team in the nation to allow fewer than 51 points per game.
- The Dragons allowed opponents to shoot just 24.5 percent from long range, also tops nationally.

## 2018-19 ALL-CONFERENCE

- Bailey Greenberg / As a junior, Greenberg became the second Drexel player to be named the CAA Player of the Year. She also earned a trip to the All-CAA First Team and CAA All-Defensive Team.
- Keishana Washington / After playing in 31 of 33 games with starts in 30 of them, Washington was named to the CAA All-Rookie Team. She averaged 7.4 points per game and scored double figures in the last

eight of 12 games of 2018-19.

## POLLING FAVORABLY

- Drexel opened the 2019-20 season ranked No. 10 in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25
- Drexel ranked in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 all season in 2018-19, finishing at No. 16.
- The Dragons were ranked as high as No. 7 before falling to Wright State. That was the Dragons' highest ranking ever in the poll.

## RETURNING TALENT

- Drexel returns 1880 of its 1985 total points scored last season, accounting for 95% of the offense.
- The grouping of Brown, Greenberg, Metzler, Nihill and Washington started 27 of 33 games a year ago.

## ROAD WARRIORS

- The Dragons won their first 12 road games during the 2018-19 regular season, establishing a new program record for road wins in a campaign.
- The Dragons' 14-game road winning streak, which extended from Feb. 11, 2018 until Mar. 7, 2019, became the longest in the nation on Feb. 3, 2019 and was four games longer than the next-longest streak when it came to an end.
- Drexel's 12 road victories last season broke a record of 10 road wins set in 2011-12 and matched in 2012-13 and 2017-18.
- Before last season, Drexel had never even won its first five road games in a given season. It won its first 11 last year.
- The last time Drexel was even 4-0 on the road came in its first season as a Division I program, 1982-83.
- Drexel handed UNCW its only home loss of the season. The Seahawks finished the regular season 13-1 at home.
- The Dragons' only two road losses came at James Madison, where the Dukes went 14-0 at home during the regular season, and to Harvard in the WNIT.

- The Dragons' 22 victories during the 2018-19 regular season were the second-most in program history behind 2017-18's 24.  
- Meghan Creighton holds the Drexel program record, having played in 88 victories. Current juniors Aubree Brown and Bailey Greenberg have now played in 75 victories.

### BALLER BAILEY

- Bailey Greenberg became the second Dragon ever to win the CAA Player of the Year award (Gabriela Marginean, 2008-09).  
- She finished the league third in scoring at 17.2. The only Dragon ever to pace the CAA in that category (Michelle Maslowski, 18.8 ppg in 2001-02, the program's first season in the CAA).  
- Greenberg led the CAA in scoring during conference play at 18.6 points per game. She was the third Dragon to lead the CAA in scoring during league action (Maslowski, 18.6 ppg in 2001-02; Gabriela Marginean, 19.9 ppg in 2007-08).  
- She was the Dragons' leading scorer in 25 of 33 games and reached double figures 29 times.  
- She was named the CAA Player of the Week four times (Nov. 26, Jan. 28, Feb. 4, Feb. 25), tying Gabriela Marginean (2008-09) for a program record number of Player of the Week awards in a single season.  
- She shot at least 50.0 percent or better from the floor in eight-straight games from Jan. 25 through Feb. 22 and her .524 percentage in conference play was second in the league.  
- She had double-doubles against Quinnipiac (17 pts, 10 boards), Richmond (11 pts, 10 boards), William & Mary (24 pts, 11 boards), UNCW (14 pts, 10 boards) and Northeastern (15 pts, 15 boards).

- She was named the TD Bank Classic MVP after a then-career best 22 points in the championship game against Vermont.  
- Greenberg has 10 20+ point games last year, five of which matched or set career highs at the time. Those 10 games are the most for a Dragon since Hollie Mer-shon had 17 in 2012-13.  
- Her 26 points at Northeastern on Jan. 18, a career high at the time, included a buzzer-beating game-winner.  
- She was 13-for-15 for a new career high 31 on Jan. 27 vs. UNCW, the first Dragon in nearly two years to score 30 or more; matched twice already in 2019-20  
- She was the fourth player in program history to be named to a postseason All-CAA team after each of her first three seasons, joining Catherine Scanlon (2003, 04, 05, Gabriela Marginean (2007, 08, 09) and Sarah Curran (2013, 14, 15).

### 300-GAME WINNER

- Drexel head coach Denise Dillon won her 300th game with Drexel's 76-45 win over Northeastern on Feb. 17.  
- Already the winningest coach in Drexel women's basketball history, Dillon became the fourth CAA head coach to reach the milestone, joining Wendy Larry (493 at ODU), Kenny Brooks (337 at JMU) and Tina Martin (330 at Delaware).  
- She has more head coaching victories than any coach in Drexel athletics history except for Hall of Fame wrestling coach Jack Childs (421 from 1976-2011).  
- She became the fourth coach ever to win 200 in CAA play (regular season and tournament) with a 68-45 win on Mar. 3 against Elon (Larry, 353 at ODU; Brooks, 220 at JMU; Martin, 217 at Delaware).  
- Dillon is a three-time CAA Coach of the Year (2005, 2009, 2018), one of four coaches to earn the award at least three times (Larry, 8 times; Sheila Moorman JMU, 5 times; Brooks, 4 times).

### PHILLY CATHOLIC PIPELINE

- This year's Drexel team features four players who graduated from schools in the Philadelphia Catholic League (PCL). Aubree Brown and Bailey Greenberg are graduates Archbishop Wood and Hannah Nihill and Maura Hendrixson graduated from Cardinal O'Hara.  
- Three of the four (Greenberg, Nihill and Hendrixson) won PCL championships in high school. Brown won a pair of state titles at Archbishop Wood.  
- Kate Connolly also played at Archbishop Wood before graduating from Souderton Area.  
- The Dragons have had at least three PCL graduates every year since 2012-13, and at least one in each of Denise Dillon's 17 seasons.  
- Dillon herself is a PCL graduate and a member of the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame, inducted 2018.  
- Coordinator of Basketball Operations Mike Halbiger (Archbishop Ryan) and athletic trainer Kerri DiPietro (Archbishop Carroll) are also PCL products.

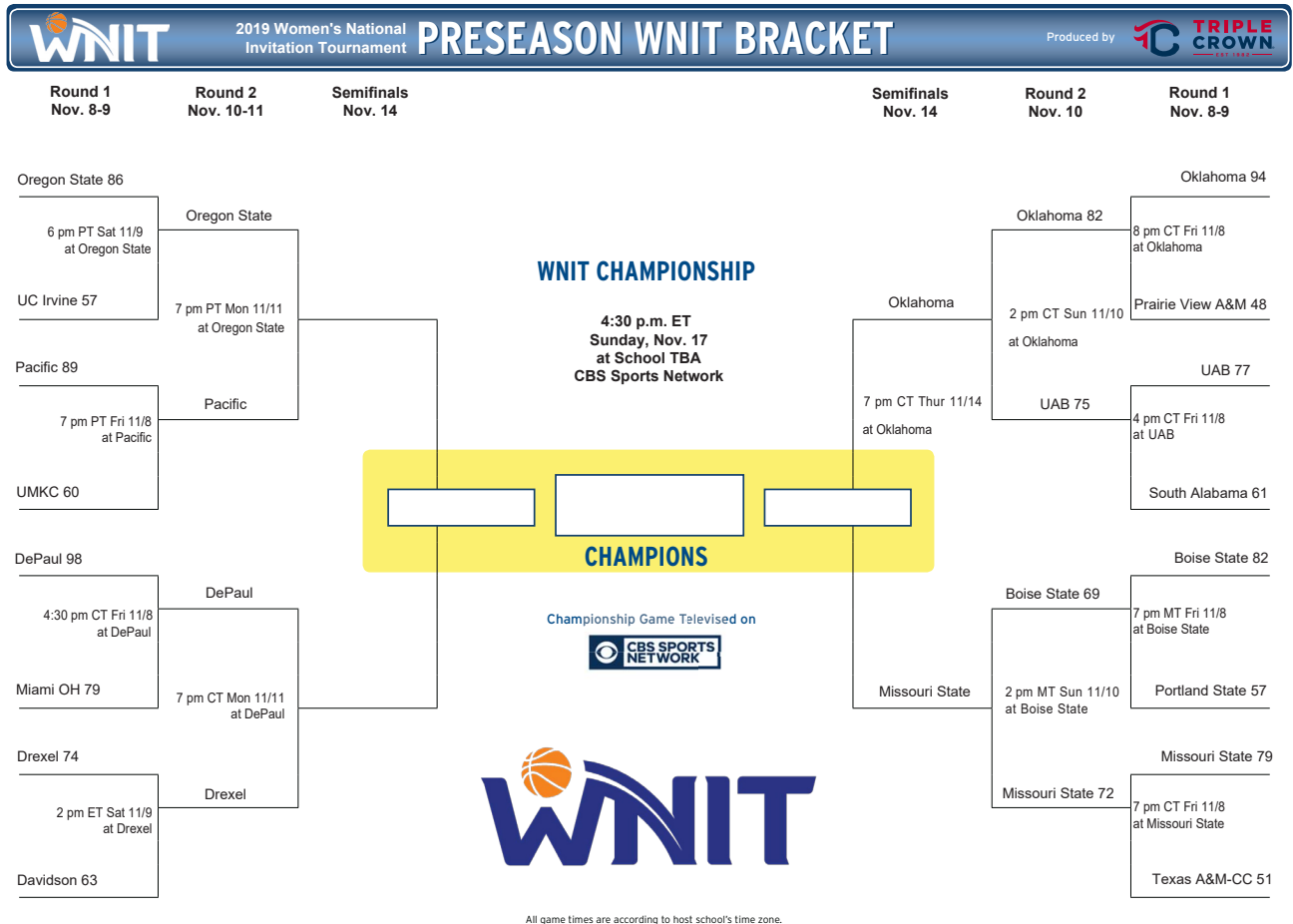
