OPENING TIP

* Drexel is 6-4 on the season, coming off a 38-point victory over La Salle University on Tuesday, 69-31. It came as the second fewest points ever allowed by the Dragons as they moved to 4-0 against Atlantic 10 opponents and 3-0 against city foes this season.

* Senior Bailey Greenberg leads the team in scoring, averaging 20.6 points per game. She also leads the conference and ranks 13th in the country. * The Dragons have had three-straight

20-win seasons for the first time in program history. Last year, DU advanced to its second-straight CAA championship game (third in the last four years) and earned a bid to the WNIT, its 10th postseason appearance in the last 11 years.

* Drexel returns 1880 of its 1985 points scored last year when the Dragons went 24-9, 14-4 CAA.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

Penn is off to a 7-1 start on the year including a 4-0 record at The Palestra. The Quakers last played on Saturday, Dec. 7, pouring on 81 points to defeat Stetson by 40 points. #45 Kayla Padilla led the team with 24 points including 9-of-12 from the field and 6-of-7 from deep. For her performance, she earned Big 5, Ivy League and U.S. Basketball Writers Association weekly honors. As a team, Penn shot 30-of-70 with 14 made three-pointers.

Penn is averaging 72.0 points per game and defeating opponents by an average margin of 24.0 points, holding those foes to 48.0 points per game.

In addition to Padilla (19.8), #33 Phoebe Sterba (11.1) and #31 Eleah Parker (10.4) are also averaging double figures.

This comes as the fourth and final city opponent that Drexel will face in its nonconference slate. The Dragons are currently 3-0 with wins against Saint Joseph's, Villanova and most recently, La Salle.

Last season, Penn went 24-7 and advanced to the second round of the WNIT.

Head Coach Mike McLaughlin (Holy Family, '91) is in the midst of his 25th season and his 11th leading Penn. He has an overall record of 593-178 including a 186-117 mark with the Quakers.

THE SERIES

Drexel leads the all-time series against Penn, 13-8, though the Quakers have won the last two meetings.

The Dragons and Quakers met last season at the DAC on School Day in front of 1,625 fans with the Quakers taking the 55-39 affair on Dec. 21, 2018.

Drexel's last win over Penn came exactly five years ago on Dec. 20, 2014 with the Dragons winning 67-58 at home.

The teams first met back on Dec. 30, 1983 with the Dragons claiming the 78-58 victory.

HEAD COACH // DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 / 17th Season / Career Record: 312-208

* In her 17th season as the head coach of Drexel's women's basketball team, Denise Dillon has become one of the most respected coaches in collegiate women's basketball, elevating the program to new heights and maintaining an enviable consistency and high level

of play.

The winningest head coach in program history, Dillon has led the Dragons to 10 postseason appearances. Those include the Dragons' first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season, and a WNIT championship in 2012-13.

Most recently, Dillon guided the Dragons to a 24-9 record in 2018-

19, culminating with a second place finish in the CAA and a WNIT bid. Following on the heels of a 22-win season in 2016-17 and a 27-8 mark in 2017-18, Dillon's Dragons have won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons for the first time in program history. Late in the 2018-19 campaign, Dillon became the first Drexel basketball coach to win 300 career games at the school. That year, the team also led the nation in scoring defense, allowing 50.5 points/game. * Drexel has boasted a winning record in 11 of the last 12 seasons. In 2012-13, her team won a school-record 28 games on its way to a 28-10 record and the WNIT title. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling

Green, Auburn, Florida and Utah on its way to the title. Drexel had never defeated an SEC or Pac-12 team until the 2013 WNIT.

* The first breakthrough season for Dillon and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders and a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a then-program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion Old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the

* During her tenure Dillon has helped guide the careers of 25 All-Conference selections, six Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, three CAA Rookies of the Year, two CAA Players of the Year, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scoring in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft. Most recently, Dillon mentored the CAA Player of the Year Bailey Greenberg in 2018-19. Additionally, Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009. She also earned the V Foundation Comeback Award and the Honda Inspiration Award.

* Dillon came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped Dillon to become interim head coach and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball. That season she turned a 10-18 team into a 19-10 squad that earned its first opening-round bye in the CAA Tournament.

* Before coming to Drexel, Dillon boasted a remarkable playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense similar to the one now run by Drexel, Dillon scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds. She was an All-Rookie selection and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. Her playing career earned her enshrinement in the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2004, the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012, and the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2013. She was also inducted into the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame in 2018.
