## OPENING TIP

\* Drexel is 6-5 on the season, coming off a narrow loss to Penn about a week and a half ago. The loss moved DU to 3-1 against city teams on the year. Senior Bailey Greenberg leads the team in scoring, averaging 19.9 points per game. She also leads the conference and ranks 18th in the country. The senior ranks 12th in school history with 1,447 points and need seven to overtake 10th place.

\* The Dragons have had three-straight 20-win seasons for the first time in program history. Last year, DU advanced to its second-straight CAA championship game (third in the last four years) and earned a bid to the WNIT, its 10th postseason appearance in the last 11 years.

\* Drexel returns 1880 of its 1985 points scored last year when the Dragons went 24-9, 14-4 CAA.

## ABOUT THE OPPONENT

Maine is off to a slow 4-9 start, going 2-6 over their last eight after losing its leading scorer in late November. The Black Bears last played on Saturday, Dec. 21 in a 66-58 loss to CAA foe Northeastern in Bangor, Maine. The team shot 39.6% from the field and were led by three Black Bears in double figures including 14 from starters #3 Anne Simon and 11 from #5 Maeve Carroll while #4 Maddy McVicar scored a team-high 16 off the bench.

Maine's leading scorer Blanca Millan, averaging 18.2 points/game across six games, last played over a month ago on Nov. 29 when she suffered a lower body injury against Arizona State at the Gulf Coast Showcase.

#15 Dor Saar is the only other Black Bear averaging double figures at 10.6 points/game.

Last season, Maine went 25-8 and 15-1 in America East play as the squad lost in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Head Coach Amy Vachon (Maine, '00) is in the midst of her fourth season. She has an overall and school mark of 63-34.

## THE SERIES

Maine leads the all-time series against Drexel, 23-4, though the Dragons have won the last two meetings.

The Dragons and Black Bears last met on Dec. 29, 2008 with Drexel grabbing an 87-55 victory.

The two sides first met back on Dec. 28, 1983 with the Back Bears getting the 56-48 win.

## HEAD COACH // DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 / 17th Season / Career Record: 312-209

\* In her 17th season as the head coach of Drexel's women's basketball team, Denise Dillon has become one of the most respected coaches in collegiate women's basketball, elevating the program to new heights and maintaining an enviable consistency and high level

of play.

The winningest head coach in program history, Dillon has led the Dragons to 10 postseason appearances. Those include the Dragons' first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season, and a WNIT championship in 2012-13.

Most recently, Dillon guided the Dragons to a 24-9 record in 2018-

19, culminating with a second place finish in the CAA and a WNIT bid. Following on the heels of a 22-win season in 2016-17 and a 27-8 mark in 2017-18, Dillon's Dragons have won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons for the first time in program history. Late in the 2018-19 campaign, Dillon became the first Drexel basketball coach to win 300 career games at the school. That year, the team also led the nation in scoring defense, allowing 50.5 points/game. \* Drexel has boasted a winning record in 11 of the last 12 seasons. In 2012-13, her team won a school-record 28 games on its way to a 28-10 record and the WNIT title. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling

Green, Auburn, Florida and Utah on its way to the title. Drexel had never defeated an SEC or Pac-12 team until the 2013 WNIT.

\* The first breakthrough season for Dillon and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders and a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a then-program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion Old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the

\* During her tenure Dillon has helped guide the careers of 25 All-Conference selections, six Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, three CAA Rookies of the Year, two CAA Players of the Year, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scoring in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft. Most recently, Dillon mentored the CAA Player of the Year Bailey Greenberg in 2018-19. Additionally, Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009. She also earned the V Foundation Comeback Award and the Honda Inspiration Award.

\* Dillon came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped Dillon to become interim head coach and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball. That season she turned a 10-18 team into a 19-10 squad that earned its first opening-round bye in the CAA Tournament.

\* Before coming to Drexel, Dillon boasted a remarkable playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense similar to the one now run by Drexel, Dillon scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds. She was an All-Rookie selection and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. Her playing career earned her enshrinement in the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2004, the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012, and the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2013. She was also inducted into the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame in 2018.

- \* Senior Bailey Greenberg led the Dragons with 13 points on 6-of-14 shooting. She also grabbed eight boards and dished out three assists, both tying for team highs.
- \* Sophomore Kate Connolly had her second-straight strong game, putting up nine points with eight boards along with three assists. Five of her rebounds came on the offensive end.
- \* Sophomore Keishana Washington scored nine with four rebounds.
- \* Senior Mariah Leonard finished with eight points including six in the fourth quarter.
- \* Penn had four players in double figures including a game-high 17 from Kayla Padilla.
- \* A 17-2 run saw Drexel call three timeouts in the third quarter alone as the Quakers went up by 11 before the Dragons cut it down to five heading into the fourth quarter.

- \* Already the winningest coach in Drexel women's basketball history, Dillon became the fourth CAA head coach to reach the milestone, joining Wendy Larry (493 at ODU), Kenny Brooks (337 at JMU) and Tina Martin (330 at Delaware).
- \* She has more head coaching victories than any coach in Drexel athletics history except for Hall of Fame wrestling coach Jack Childs (421 from 1976-2011).

\* She became the fourth coach ever to win 200 in CAA play (regular season and tournament) with a 68-45 win on Mar. 3, 2019 against Elon (Larry, 353 at ODU; Brooks, 220 at JMU; Martin, 217 at Delaware). \* Dillon is a three-time CAA Coach of the Year (2005, 2009, 2018), one of four coaches to earn the award at least three times (Larry, 8 times; Sheila Moorman JMU, 5 times; Brooks, 4 times).

\* This year's Drexel team features four players who graduated from schools in the Philadelphia Catholic League (PCL). Aubree Brown and Bailey Greenberg are graduates Archbishop Wood and Hannah Nihill and Maura Hendrixson graduated from Cardinal O'Hara.

\* Three of the four (Greenberg, Nihill and Hendrixson) won PCL championships in high school. Brown won a pair of state titles at Archbishop Wood.


