OPENING TIP

* Drexel is 4-3 on the season after going 1-1 at the 26th Annual Hawk Classic over the Thanksgiving weekend. The Dragons fell in a close and tough neutral-site game to Buffalo on Saturday, 63-59, before closing the classic with a 62-52 win over the host Saint Joseph's on Sunday.

* Senior Bailey Greenberg ranks eighth in the country and first in the conference, averaging 22.0 points per game. * The Dragons have had three-straight 20-win seasons for the first time in program history. Last year, DU advanced to its second-straight CAA championship game (third in the last four years) and earned a bid to the WNIT, its 10th postseason appearance in the last 11 years.

* Drexel returns 1880 of its 1985 points scored last year when the Dragons went 24-9, 14-4 CAA.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

Villanova is 3-3 on the year and last played a week and a half ago in a 63-58 road win at the University of Georgia. VU Head Coach Harry Perretta, in the midst of his 42nd season with the Wildcats, announced that the 2019-20 season would be his final as a coach.

After an 0-3 start with losses to George Washington, James Madison and American, the Wildcats have won their last three affairs over Fordham, Manhattan and Georgia.

Madison Siegrist (19.2) and Mary Gedaka (16.3) lead the team in scoring. Siegrist, a freshman from Poughkeepsie, N.Y., was recently named the BIG EAST Rookie of the Week for the second time while Gedaka, a senior from Mullica Hill, N.J., was the Philadelphia Big 5 Player of the Week.

Villanova went 19-13 a season ago, falling in the first round of the BIG EAST Tournament before earning a WNIT postseason bid.

THE SERIES

This comes as the seventh overall meeting between Drexel and Villanova.

VU leads the all-time series, 5-1.

Drexel picked up its only victory back on Nov. 26, 2010 in a 56-50 win.

The two teams last met in the Postseason WNIT on March 19, 2017 with the Wildcats edging out a 56-51 victory.

HEAD COACH // DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 / 17th Season / Career Record: 310-207

* In her 17th season as the head coach of Drexel's women's basketball team, Denise Dillon has become one of the most respected coaches in collegiate women's basketball, elevating the program to new heights and maintaining an enviable consistency and high level

of play.

The winningest head coach in program history, Dillon has led the Dragons to 10 postseason appearances. Those include the Dragons' first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season, and a WNIT championship in 2012-13.

Most recently, Dillon guided the Dragons to a 24-9 record in 2018-

19, culminating with a second place finish in the CAA and a WNIT bid. Following on the heels of a 22-win season in 2016-17 and a 27-8 mark in 2017-18, Dillon's Dragons have won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons for the first time in program history. Late in the 2018-19 campaign, Dillon became the first Drexel basketball coach to win 300 career games at the school. That year, the team also led the nation in scoring defense, allowing 50.5 points/game. * Drexel has boasted a winning record in 11 of the last 12 seasons. In 2012-13, her team won a school-record 28 games on its way to a 28-10 record and the WNIT title. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling

28-10 record and the WNIT title. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling Green, Auburn, Florida and Utah on its way to the title. Drexel had never defeated an SEC or Pac-12 team until the 2013 WNIT. * The first breakthrough season for Dillon and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders and a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a then-program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion Old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the

* School's first CAA title.

* During her tenure Dillon has helped guide the careers of 25 All-Conference selections, six Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, three CAA Rookies of the Year, two CAA Players of the Year, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scoring in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft. Most recently, Dillon mentored the CAA Player of the Year Bailey Greenberg in 2018-19. Additionally, Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009. She also earned the V Foundation Comeback Award and the Honda Inspiration Award.

* Dillon came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped Dillon to become interim head coach and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball. That season she turned a 10-18 team into a 19-10 squad that earned its first opening-round bye in the CAA Tournament.

* Before coming to Drexel, Dillon boasted a remarkable playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense similar to the one now run by Drexel, Dillon scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds. She was an All-Rookie selection and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. Her playing career earned her enshrinement in the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2004, the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012, and the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2013. She was also inducted into the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame in 2018.

The Dragons led for 38:08 minutes in the contest, though the Hawks were able to get back into the game late after Drexel went up by as many as 21 points.

* The win came as the Dragons' fourth-straight over the Hawks.

* Senior Bailey Greenberg moved into 12th place on the Drexel career scoring list with her fourth point of the afternoon, coming with 5:19 left in the first quarter. Greenberg finished with a game-high 24 points on 10-of-17 shooting including 3-of-6 from threepoint range. It came as her third game with at least 10 field goals on the season.

* Following her career performance on Saturday, senior Mariah Leonard made her first collegiate start on Sunday against Saint Joseph's. She scored nine points with two rebounds, a steal and took two charges.

* Junior Hannah Nihill also scored nine points on 3-of-5 from the floor with two three-pointers and three assists.

* She finished the league third in scoring at 17.2. The only Dragon ever to pace the CAA in that category (Michelle Maslowski, 18.8 ppg in 2001-02, the pro-

gram's first season in the CAA).

- * Greenberg led the CAA in scoring during conference play at 18.6 points per game. She was the third Dragon to lead the CAA in scoring during league action (Maslowski, 18.6 ppg in 2001-02; Gabriela Marginean, 19.9 ppg in 2007-08).
- * She was the Dragons' leading scorer in 25 of 33 games and reached double figures 29 times.
- * She was named the CAA Player of the Week four times (Nov. 26, Jan. 28, Feb. 4, Feb. 25), tying Gabriela Marginean (2008-09) for a program record number of Player of the Week awards in a single season.
- * She shot at least 50.0 percent or better from the floor in eight-straight games from Jan. 25 through Feb. 22 and her .524 percentage in conference play was second in the league.
- * She had double-doubles against Quinnipiac (17 pts, 10 boards), Richmond (11 pts, 10 boards), William & Mary (24 pts, 11 boards), UNCW (14 pts, 10 boards) and Northeastern (15 pts, 15 boards).
- * She was named the TD Bank Classic MVP after a then-career best 22 points in the championship game against Vermont.
- * Greenberg has 10 20+ point games last year, five of which matched or set career highs at the time. Those 10 games are the most for a Dragon since Hollie Mershon had 17 in 2012-13.
- * Her 26 points at Northeastern on Jan. 18, a career high at the time, included a buzzer-beating gamewinner.

- * Drexel head coach Denise Dillon won her 300th game with Drexel's 76-45 win over Northeastern on Feb. 17, 2019.
- * Already the winningest coach in Drexel women's basketball history, Dillon became the fourth CAA head coach to reach the milestone, joining Wendy Larry (493 at ODU), Kenny Brooks (337 at JMU) and Tina Martin (330 at Delaware).
- * She has more head coaching victories than any coach in Drexel athletics history except for Hall of Fame wrestling coach Jack Childs (421 from 1976-2011).
- * She became the fourth coach ever to win 200 in CAA play (regular season and tournament) with a 68-45 win on Mar. 3, 2019 against Elon (Larry, 353 at

ODU; Brooks, 220 at JMU; Martin, 217 at Delaware). * Dillon is a three-time CAA Coach of the Year (2005, 2009, 2018), one of four coaches to earn the award at least three times (Larry, 8 times; Sheila Moorman JMU, 5 times; Brooks, 4 times).

PHILLY CATHOLIC PIPELINE

- * This year's Drexel team features four players who graduated from schools in the Philadelphia Catholic League (PCL). Aubree Brown and Bailey Greenberg are graduates Archbishop Wood and Hannah Nihill and Maura Hendrixson graduated from Cardinal O'Hara.
- * Three of the four (Greenberg, Nihill and Hendrixson) won PCL championships in high school. Brown won a pair of state titles at Archbishop Wood.
- * Kate Connolly also played at Archbishop Wood before graduating from Souderton Area.

- * This year's CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held in Elon, N.C. at the Schar Center from March 11-14, 2020.


