### OPENING TIP

\* Drexel went 7-5 as the Dragons finished off nonconference play against Maine on Monday in Philadelphia with a 70-57 win.

Senior Bailey Greenberg leads the team in scoring, averaging 20.9 points per game after a career-high 32 points against Maine. She also leads the conference and ranks 12th in the country. She sits in 10th place on Drexel's alltime scoring list.

\* The Dragons have had three-straight 20-win seasons for the first time in program history. Last year, DU advanced to its second-straight CAA championship game (third in the last four years) and earned a bid to the WNIT, its 10th postseason appearance in the last 11 years.

\* Drexel returns 1880 of its 1985 points scored last year when the Dragons went 24-9, 14-4 CAA.

### HEAD COACH // DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 / 17th Season / Career Record: 313-209

\* In her 17th season as the head coach of Drexel's women's basketball team, Denise Dillon has become one of the most respected coaches in collegiate women's basketball, elevating the program to new heights and maintaining an enviable consistency and high level

of play.

The winningest head coach in program history, Dillon has led the Dragons to 10 postseason appearances. Those include the Dragons' first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season, and a WNIT championship in 2012-13.

Most recently, Dillon guided the Dragons to a 24-9 record in 2018-

19, culminating with a second place finish in the CAA and a WNIT bid. Following on the heels of a 22-win season in 2016-17 and a 27-8 mark in 2017-18, Dillon's Dragons have won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons for the first time in program history. Late in the 2018-19 campaign, Dillon became the first Drexel basketball coach to win 300 career games at the school. That year, the team also led the nation in scoring defense, allowing 50.5 points/game. \* Drexel has boasted a winning record in 11 of the last 12 seasons. In 2012-13, her team won a school-record 28 games on its way to a 28-10 record and the WNIT title. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling

Green, Auburn, Florida and Utah on its way to the title. Drexel had never defeated an SEC or Pac-12 team until the 2013 WNIT.

\* The first breakthrough season for Dillon and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders and a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a then-program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion Old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the

\* During her tenure Dillon has helped guide the careers of 25 All-Conference selections, six Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, three CAA Rookies of the Year, two CAA Players of the Year, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scoring in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft. Most recently, Dillon mentored the CAA Player of the Year Bailey Greenberg in 2018-19. Additionally, Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009. She also earned the V Foundation Comeback Award and the Honda Inspiration Award.

\* Dillon came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped Dillon to become interim head coach and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball. That season she turned a 10-18 team into a 19-10 squad that earned its first opening-round bye in the CAA Tournament.

\* Before coming to Drexel, Dillon boasted a remarkable playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense similar to the one now run by Drexel, Dillon scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds. She was an All-Rookie selection and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. Her playing career earned her enshrinement in the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2004, the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012, and the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2013. She was also inducted into the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame in 2018. Fame in 2018.

### DRAGON BITES

### LAST TIME OUT

\* Drexel (7-5) closed out nonconference play with a 70-57 home win over the University of Maine Black Bears (4-10) on Monday night from the Daskalakis Athletic Center in Philadelphia, Pa.

\* Senior Bailey Greenberg established a new career high with 32 points. It came as her third 30-point game this season as she finished 13-of-20 from the floor including 2-of-3 from deep and 4-of-5 from the line on Monday.

\* Greenberg moved into 10th place on Drexel's alltime scoring list with her eighth point of the night, which came with 3:26 left in the first quarter.

\* Trailing midway through the second quarter, Drexel took a three-point lead at halftime and then used a 13-2 third-quarter run to stretch its lead to double figures.

\* The Black Bears, playing with just seven players, chipped back and got the deficit down to four in the fourth quarter before Greenberg and the Dragons pushed it back up to double digits for the home win. \* The Dragons dominated the paint, scoring a season-best 48 points inside the key.

\* Senior Aubree Brown dished out a game-high seven

\* Senior Ana Ferariu grabbed a season-high and teambest seven rebounds in the win.

\* Greenberg (32) was the only Dragon to finish in double digits while junior Hannah Nihill (8), sophomore Kate Connolly (7) and sophomore Keishana Washington (6) all contributed points with at least three field goals each.

\* In total, nine Dragons scored points on the night and 13 saw action on the floor.

#### POSITIVE SPECALITY STATS

\* Drexel has a positive margin overall in its 12 contests this year in specality scoring stats inclduing +50 in points in the paint (340-290), +84 points off turnovers (226-142), +49 in second-chance points (138-89)), +17 in fastbreak points (788-71) and +60 in bench scoring (206-142).

#### NATIONAL WATCH

\* Bailey Greenberg is averaging 20.9 points/game, good for 12th in the nation.

\*The senior also ranks in the top-20 individually in field goals made (8th with 98), field goal attempts (15th with 207) and total points (16th with 251).

\* Aubree Brown is 39th in assists/game (5.0), 40th in assists (60) and 43rd in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.22).

#### PRESSING THE ISSUE

\* Drexel has been able to limit turnovers to just 13.0 miscues per game while forcing opponents to cough it up 19.2 times per contest.

\* Over half of those opponent turnovers come via Drexel steals with the Dragons picking their foes pockets 10.4 times per game.

\* Drexel has at least 11 steals in seven games this

year with a season-high of 14 twice (La Salle & Richmond).

\* Eight Dragons have at least 10 steals led by Aubree Brown (18) and Hannah Nihill (17). In a single game this year, Maura Hendrixson had 5 steals at No. 18/20 DePaul.

#### SHARING THE ROCK

\* Drexel has 195 assists through 12 games to lead the CAA. Its 16.3 assists per game rank second in the conference.

\* Senior Aubree Brown is responsible for 60 of those 195 dimes, dishing out the rock 5.0 times per game. Her assist figure is first in the CAA and 39th in the nation.

\* Together with the turnover numbers, Drexel has the 23rd best assist-to-turnover ratio in the nation at 1.25, also tops in the conference.

#### **JUST PLAY THREE**

\* All of the Dragons' wins have come if they held the lead after three quarters of action.

\* Drexel is 7-0 when taking a lead in the fourth quarter.




