# HEAD COACH // DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 / 17th Season / Career Record: 318-210

\* In her 17th season as the head coach of Drexel's women's basketball team, Denise Dillon has become one of the most respected coaches in collegiate women's basketball, elevating the program to new heights and maintaining an enviable consistency and high level

of play.

The winningest head coach in program history, Dillon has led the Dragons to 10 postseason appearances. Those include the Dragons' first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season, and a WNIT championship in 2012-13.

Most recently, Dillon guided the Dragons to a 24-9 record in 2018-

19, culminating with a second place finish in the CAA and a WNIT bid. Following on the heels of a 22-win season in 2016-17 and a 27-8 mark in 2017-18, Dillon's Dragons have won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons for the first time in program history. Late in the 2018-19 campaign, Dillon became the first Drexel basketball coach to win 300 career games at the school. That year, the team also led the nation in scoring defense, allowing 50.5 points/game. \* Drexel has boasted a winning record in 11 of the last 12 seasons. In 2012-13, her team won a school-record 28 games on its way to a 28-10 record and the WNIT title. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling

Green, Auburn, Florida and Utah on its way to the title. Drexel had never defeated an SEC or Pac-12 team until the 2013 WNIT.

\* The first breakthrough season for Dillon and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders and a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a then-program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the

\* During her tenure Dillon has helped guide the careers of 25 All-Conference selections, six Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, three CAA Rookies of the Year, two CAA Players of the Year, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scoring in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft. Most recently, Dillon mentored the CAA Player of the Year Bailey Greenberg in 2018-19. Additionally, Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009. She also earned the V Foundation Comeback Award and the Honda Inspiration Award.

\* Dillon came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped Dillon to become interim head coach and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball. That season she turned a 10-18 team into a 19-10 squad that earned its first opening-round bye in the CAA Tournament.

\* Before coming to Drexel, Dillon boasted a remarkable playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense similar to the one now run by Drexel, Dillon scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds. She was an All-Rookie selection and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. Her playing career earned her enshrinement in the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2004, the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012, and the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2013. She was also inducted into the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame in 2018.

## DRAGON BITES

#### LAST TIME OUT

- \* Drexel (12-6, 5-1 CAA) pulled out an overtime win against the Elon University Phoenix (9-9, 4-3 CAA) by a final of 55-53 from the Schar Center, the site of the 2020 CAA Championships, in Elon, N.C. on Friday evening.
- \* The win comes as the fifth-straight victory for the Dragons.
- \* After leading by an many as 12 in the first half, the second half proved to be a close affair with the game heading to overtime. 49-49.
- \* Sophomore Keishana Washington tied for a team-high 13 points with three three-pointers, three rebounds, two assists and a steal.
- \* Senior Bailey Greenberg also scored 13 points while going 7-of-8 from the free-throw line. She also tied for a teamhigh eight rebounds and had two steals and a block.
- \* Senior Mariah Leonard shot 5-of-9 for 11 points with three rebounds and a block.
- \* Senior Niki Metzel also grabbed eight rebounds while junior Hannah Nihill dished out a game-high six assists.
- \* The Dragons are 4-0 in overtime games this year.

#### POSITIVE +++ SPECALITY STATS

\* Drexel has a positive margin overall in its 18 contests this year in specality scoring stats inclduing +57 in points in the paint, +105 points off turnovers, +47 in second-chance points, +38 in fastbreak points and +107 in bench scoring.

#### NATIONAL WATCH

- \* Bailey Greenberg is averaging 19.3 points/game, good for 28th in the nation.
- \* The senior also ranks in the top-30 individually in field goals made (25th with 129).
- \*As a team, the Dragons rank 18th in turnover margin (6.39), 22nd in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.23), 34th in steals per game (10.6), 35th in turnovers per game (13.4) and 41st in scoring defense (57.6).

#### PRESSING THE ISSUE

- \* Drexel has been able to limit turnovers to just 13.4 miscues per game while forcing opponents to cough it up 19.8 times per contest.
- \* Over half of those opponent turnovers come via Drexel steals with the Dragons picking their foes pockets 10.6 times per game, tops in the CAA.
- \* Drexel has at least 11 steals in 10 games this year with a season-high of 15 at UNCW.
- \* 10 Dragons have at least 10 steals led by Aubree Brown (33), Bailey Greenberg (28) and Hannah Nihill (25). In a single game this year, Maura Hendrixson had 5 steals at No. 18/20 DePaul.

#### **SHARING THE ROCK**

- \* Drexel has 297 assists through 18 games rank 2nd in the CAA. Its 16.5 assists per game also rank second in the conference.
- \* Senior Aubree Brown is responsible for a team- and-CAA-best 87 of those dimes, dishing out the rock 4.8 times per game. Her assist average is second in the CAA and 54th in the nation.
- \* Together with the turnover numbers, Drexel has the 22nd best assist-to-turnover ratio in the nation at 1.23, also top in the conference.

#### HEADING TO THE FOURTH

- \* All but two of the Dragons' wins have come if they held the lead after three quarters of action.
- \* Drexel is 10-0 when taking a lead in the fourth quarter.
- \* The Dragons have only trailed for 58 seconds in the

fourth quarter after entering with a lead.

#### MILESTONE WATCH

- \* Senior Bailey Greenberg ranks 7th on the school's scoring list (1,576). Needs 24 to reach 1,600 career points, 25 to tie for 6th and 26 to overtake 6th.
- \* Meghan Creighton holds the Drexel program record, having played in 88 victories. Current seniors Aubree Brown and Bailey Greenberg have now played in 85 victories.

#### \* As a DI program, the Dragons have 590 wins.

#### **300-GAME WINNER**

- \* Drexel head coach Denise Dillon won her 300th game with Drexel's 76-45 win over Northeastern on Feb. 17, 2019.
- \* Already the winningest coach in Drexel women's basketball history, Dillon became the fourth CAA head coach to reach the milestone, joining Wendy Larry (493 at ODU), Kenny Brooks (337 at JMU) and Tina Martin (330 at Delaware).
- \* She has more head coaching victories than any coach in Drexel athletics history except for Hall of Fame wrestling coach Jack Childs (421 from 1976-2011).
- \* She became the fourth coach ever to win 200 in CAA play (regular season and tournament) with a 68-45 win on Mar. 3, 2019 against Elon (Larry, 353 at ODU; Brooks, 220 at JMU; Martin, 217 at Delaware).
- \* Dillon is a three-time CAA Coach of the Year (2005, 2009, 2018), one of four coaches to earn the award at least three times (Larry, 8 times; Sheila Moorman JMU, 5 times; Brooks, 4 times).

- \* There are 22 sets of sisters on DI WBB rosters in 2019-20. \* Ana (senior) and Maria (freshman) represent one pair on
- the Drexel squad.

#### PRESEASON PICKS

- \* The Dragons were picked to finish second in the CAA by the preseason coaches poll. Drexel got one first-place votes and collected a total of 70 points, 11 behind first-place JMU.
- \* Bailey Greenberg was selected as a Preseason First Team All-CAA pick. The reigning CAA Player of the Year was a First Team pick following the 2018-19 campaign, a Second Team choice after the 2017-18 season, and an All-Rookie

Team member following the 2016-17 year.

\* Niki Metzel was tabbed as 2019-20 Preseason Honorable Mention All-CAA choice.

#### 2018-19 SEASON RECAP

- \* The Dragons won six straight after a season-opening loss to Quinnipiac. That streak included the TD Bank Classic championship at Vermont over Thanksgiving weekend.
- \* Drexel dropped its first two conference games to Towson and JMU at home, then rattled off the third-longest winning streak in program history (12 games) to gain control of what would become the No. 2 seed.
- \* The Dragons went 12-2 on the road, including winning their first 11, part of what was for more than a month the longest road winning streak in the nation.
- \* Drexel's 22 regular season wins were second-most alltime in program history, behind 24 in 2017-18
- \* Then junior Bailey Greenberg was named the CAA Player of the Year.

#### **COMING IN 2023**

- \* The Colonial Athletic Association announced on Oct. 29, 2019 that Drexel University's John A. Daskalakis Athletic Center was chosen as the host venue for the 2023 Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) Women's Basketball Championship.
- \* It marks the second time (2018) the CAA will be playing the conference tournament in Philadelphia.
- The league also announced hosts James Madison (2021), Towson (2022) and William & Mary (2024).
- \* This year's CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held in Elon, N.C. at the Schar Center from March 11-14, 2020.
