OPENING TIP

* Drexel opened CAA play with a 73-59 loss at the College of Charleston on Friday to fall to 7-6 on the year and 0-1 in CAA play.
* The Dragons have a 16-game winning streak against UNCW.
* Senior Bailey Greenberg leads the team and CAA in scoring, averaging 20.7 points per game with a career-high 32 points on Dec. 30. She ranks 13th in the country.
* The Dragons have had three-straight 20-win seasons for the first time in program history. Last year, DU advanced to its second-straight CAA championship game (third in the last four years) and earned a bid to the WNIT, its 10th postseason appearance in the last 11 years.
* Drexel returns 1880 of its 1985 points scored last year when the Dragons went 24-9, 14-4 CAA.

HEAD COACH // DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 / 17th Season / Career Record: 313-210

* In her 17th season as the head coach of Drexel's women's basketball team, Denise Dillon has become one of the most respected coaches in collegiate women's basketball, elevating the program to new heights and maintaining an enviable consistency and high level of play.

* The winningest head coach in program history, Dillon has led the Dragons to 10 postseason appearances. Those include the Dragons' first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season, and a WNIT championship in 2012-13.

* Most recently, Dillon guided the Dragons to a 24-9 record in 2018-19, culminating with a second place finish in the CAA and a WNIT bid. Following on the heels of a 22-win season in 2016-17 and a 27-8 mark in 2017-18, Dillon's Dragons have won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons for the first time in program history. Late in the 2018-19 campaign, Dillon became the first Drexel basketball coach to win 300 career games at the school. That year, the team also led the nation in scoring defense, allowing 50.5 points/game. * Drexel has boasted a winning record in 11 of the last 12 seasons. In 2012-13, her team won a school-record 28 games on its way to a 28-10 record and the WNIT title. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling Green, Auburn, Florida and Utah on its way to the title. Drexel had never defeated an SEC or Pac-12 team until the 2013 WNIT.

* The first breakthrough season for Dillon and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders and a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a then-program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion Old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the school's first CAA title.

* During her tenure Dillon has helped guide the careers of 25 All-Conference selections, six Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, three CAA Rookies of the Year, two CAA Players of the Year, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scorer in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft. Most recently, Dillon mentored the CAA Player of the Year Bailey Greenberg in 2018-19. Additionally, Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009. She also earned the V Foundation Comeback Award and the Honda Inspiration Award.

* Dillon came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped Dillon to become interim head coach and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball. That season she turned a 10-18 team into a 19-10 squad that earned its first opening-round bye in the CAA Tournament.

* Before coming to Drexel, Dillon boasted a remarkable playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense similar to the one now run by Drexel, Dillon scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds. She was an All-Rookie selection and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. Her playing career earned her enshrinement in the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2004, the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012, and the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2013. She was also inducted into the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame in 2018.

LAST TIME OUT

- * Drexel (7-6, 0-1 CAA) dropped its Colonial Athletic Association opener to the College of Charleston Cougars (8-4, 1-0 CAA) to begin conference play on Friday evening from TD Arena in Charleston, S.C. by a final of 73-59.
- * The loss snapped a four-game winning streak against the Cougars.
- * Drexel held the lead for the final time late in the second quarter.
- * CoC used a pair of 8-0 runs in the third quarter to gain control of the game.
- * Senior Bailey Greenberg finished with a team-high 18 points and nine rebounds.
- * Senior Mariah Leonard finished with a career-high 14 points on 7-of-8 shooting. She also grabbed five rebounds, all on the offensive glass, and had four assists.
- * Senior Aubree Brown hit two three-pointers for six points, recorded five rebounds, dished out four assists and had a team-high two steals.
- * Junior Hannah Nihill had five points and a game-high six assists.
- * Sophomore Kate Connolly hit two treys and recorded eight points on the night.

STREAKING VS. UNCW

- * Drexel has won 16-straight matchups against the UNCW Seahawks including eight in a row in Wilmington, N.C.

POSITIVE SPECIALITY STATS

- * Drexel has a positive margin overall in its 12 contests this year in speciality scoring stats including +50 in points in the paint, +80 points off turnovers, +58 in second-chance points, +19 in fastbreak points and +58 in bench scoring.

NATIONAL WATCH

- * Bailey Greenberg is averaging 20.7 points/game, good for 13th in the nation.
- * The senior also ranks in the top-15 individually in field goals made (7th with 104), total points (11th with 269) and field goal attempts (12th with 223).
- * Aubree Brown is 37th in assists (4.9), 44th in assists/game (64) and 59th in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.06).

PRESSING THE ISSUE

- * Drexel has been able to limit turnovers to just 13.2 miscues per game while forcing opponents to cough it up 18.8 times per contest.
- * Over half of those opponent turnovers come via Drexel steals with the Dragons picking their foes pockets 10.1 times per game.
- * Drexel has at least 11 steals in seven games this year with a season-high of 14 twice (La Salle & Richmond).
- * Eight Dragons have at least 10 steals led by Aubree Brown (18) and Hannah Nihill (17). In a single game this year, Maura Hendrixson had 5 steals at No.

18/20 DePaul.

SHARING THE ROCK

- * Drexel has 213 assists through 13 games to lead the CAA. Its 16.4 assists per game rank second in the conference.
- * Senior Aubree Brown is responsible for 64 of those 213 dimes, dishing out the rock 4.9 times per game. Her assist figure is first in the CAA and 37th in the nation.
- * Together with the turnover numbers, Drexel has the 24th best assist-to-turnover ratio in the nation at 1.24, also tops in the conference.

HEADING TO THE FOURTH

- * All of the Dragons' wins have come if they held the lead after three quarters of action.
- * Drexel is 7-0 when taking a lead in the fourth quarter.
- * The Dragons have only trailed for 35 seconds in the fourth quarter after entering with a lead.

IN THE POLLS

- * Drexel opened the 2019-20 season ranked No. 10 in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 and now sits at No. 16
- * Drexel ranked in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 all season in 2018-19, finishing at No. 16.
- * The Dragons were ranked as high as No. 7 before falling to Wright State. That was the Dragons' highest ranking ever in the poll.

MILESTONE WATCH

- * Senior Bailey Greenberg ranks 10th on school scoring list (1,497) behind Debbie Lynn (1990-93 with 1,511) and Jen MacNeill (1994-96 and 1998 with 1,519). Needs 15 to overtake 9th place and 23 to break into the top 8.
- * Meghan Creighton holds the Drexel program record, having played in 88 victories. Current seniors Aubree Brown and Bailey Greenberg have now played in 80 victories.
- * As a DI program, the Dragons have 585 wins.

RETURNING TALENT

- * Drexel returns 1880 of its 1985 total points scored last season, accounting for 95% of the offense.
- * The grouping of Brown, Greenberg, Metzler, Nihill and Washington started 27 of 33 games a year ago.

300-GAME WINNER

* Drexel head coach Denise Dillon won her 300th game with Drexel's 76-45 win over Northeastern on Feb. 17, 2019.
* Already the winningest coach in Drexel women's basketball history, Dillon became the fourth CAA head coach to reach the milestone, joining Wendy

Larry (493 at ODU), Kenny Brooks (337 at JMU) and Tina Martin (330 at Delaware).

* She has more head coaching victories than any coach in Drexel athletics history except for Hall of Fame wrestling coach Jack Childs (421 from 1976-2011).
* She became the fourth coach ever to win 200 in CAA play (regular season and tournament) with a 68-45 win on Mar. 3, 2019 against Elon (Larry, 353 at ODU; Brooks, 220 at JMU; Martin, 217 at Delaware).
* Dillon is a three-time CAA Coach of the Year (2005, 2009, 2018), one of four coaches to earn the award at least three times (Larry, 8 times; Sheila Moorman JMU, 5 times; Brooks, 4 times).

PHILLY CATHOLIC PIPELINE

* This year's Drexel team features four players who graduated from schools in the Philadelphia Catholic League (PCL). Aubree Brown and Bailey Greenberg are graduates Archbishop Wood and Hannah Nihill and Maura Hendrixson graduated from Cardinal O'Hara.
* Three of the four (Greenberg, Nihill and Hendrixson) won PCL championships in high school. Brown won a pair of state titles at Archbishop Wood.
* Kate Connolly also played at Archbishop Wood before graduating from Souderton Area.
* The Dragons have had at least three PCL graduates every year since 2012-13, and at least one in each of Denise Dillon's 17 seasons.
* Dillon herself is a PCL graduate and a member of the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame, inducted 2018.
* Coordinator of Basketball Operations Mike Halbiger (Archbishop Ryan) and athletic trainer Kerri DiPietro (Archbishop Carroll) are also PCL products.

SISTER, SISTER

* There are 22 sets of sisters on DI WBB rosters in 2019-20.
* Ana (senior) and Maria (freshman) represent one pair on the Drexel squad.

PRESEASON PICKS

* The Dragons were picked to finish second in the CAA by the preseason coaches poll. Drexel got one first-place votes and collected a total of 70 points, 11 behind first-place JMU.
* Bailey Greenberg was selected as a Preseason First Team All-CAA pick. The reigning CAA Player of the Year was a First Team pick following the 2018-19 campaign, a Second Team choice after the 2017-18 season, and an All-Rookie Team member following the 2016-17 year.
* Niki Metzel was tabbed as 2019-20 Preseason Honorable Mention All-CAA choice.

2018-19 SEASON RECAP

* The Dragons won six straight after a season-opening loss to Quinnipiac. That streak included the TD Bank Classic championship at Vermont over Thanksgiving weekend.

DRAGON BITES

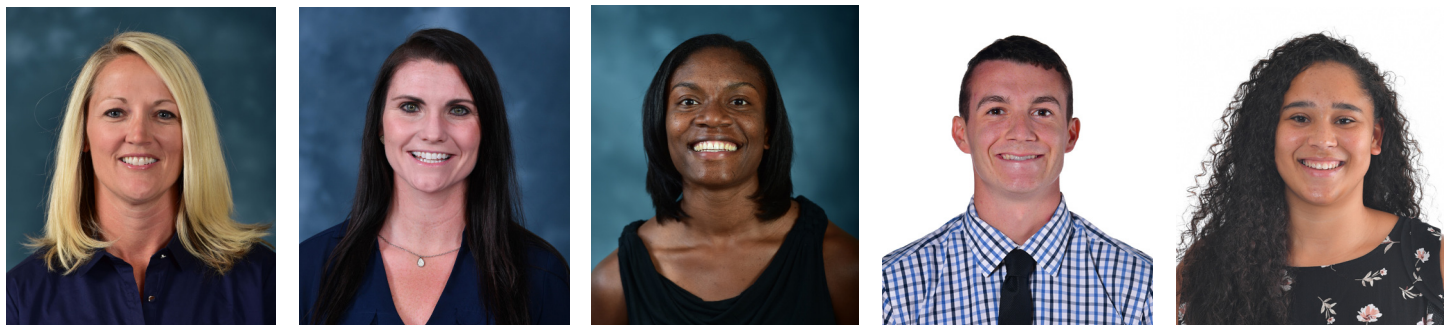
