OPENING TIP

* Drexel is 10-1 in CAA games and in first place at the top of the conference standings. DU recently defeated Hofstra and Northeastern on the road last weekend. The Dragons are now 17-6 on the year and riding a season-best 10-game winning streak.

* Senior Bailey Greenberg is averaging a team-best 18.2 points per game overall and 15.3 points in CAA contests.

* The Dragons have had three-straight 20-win seasons for the first time in program history. Last year, DU advanced to its second-straight CAA championship game (third in the last four years) and earned a bid to the WNIT, its 10th postseason appearance in the last 11 years.

HEAD COACH // DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 / 17th Season / Career Record: 323-210

* In her 17th season as the head coach of Drexel's women's basketball team, Denise Dillon has become one of the most respected coaches in collegiate women's basketball, elevating the program to new heights and maintaining an enviable consistency and high level of play.

* The winningest head coach in program history, Dillon has led the Dragons to 10 postseason appearances. Those include the Dragons' first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season, and a WNIT championship in 2012-13.

* Most recently, Dillon guided the Dragons to a 24-9 record in 2018-19, culminating with a second place finish in the CAA and a WNIT bid. Following on the heels of a 22-win season in 2016-17 and a 27-8 mark in 2017-18, Dillon's Dragons have won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons for the first time in program history. Late in the 2018-19 campaign, Dillon became the first Drexel basketball coach to win 300 career games at the school. That year, the team also led the nation in scoring defense, allowing 50.5 points/game. * Drexel has boasted a winning record in 11 of the last 12 seasons. In 2012-13, her team won a school-record 28 games on its way to a 28-10 record and the WNIT title. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling Green, Auburn, Florida and Utah on its way to the title. Drexel had never defeated an SEC or Pac-12 team until the 2013 WNIT.

* The first breakthrough season for Dillon and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders and a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a then-program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion Old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the school's first CAA title.

* During her tenure Dillon has helped guide the careers of 25 All-Conference selections, six Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, three CAA Rookies of the Year, two CAA Players of the Year, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scorer in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft. Most recently, Dillon mentored the CAA Player of the Year Bailey Greenberg in 2018-19. Additionally, Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009. She also earned the V Foundation Comeback Award and the Honda Inspiration Award.

* Dillon came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped Dillon to become interim head coach and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball. That season she turned a 10-18 team into a 19-10 squad that earned its first opening-round bye in the CAA Tournament.

* Before coming to Drexel, Dillon boasted a remarkable playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense similar to the one now run by Drexel, Dillon scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds. She was an All-Rookie selection and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. Her playing career earned her enshrinement in the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2004, the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012, and the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2013. She was also inducted into the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame in 2018.

LAST TIME OUT

- * Drexel (17-6, 10-1 CAA) defeated the Northeastern University Huskies (10-12, 6-5 CAA) on Sunday afternoon by a final of 67-51 from the Cabot Center in Boston, Mass.
- * The win came as Drexel's 10th-straight victory as the team improved to 10-1 in league play.
- * Senior Bailey Greenberg recorded her 10th career double-double behind game highs of 14 points and 10 rebounds.
- * Greenberg also moved into 5th place on Drexel's all-time scoring list and now has 1,647 career points.
- * Sophomore Keishana Washington tied for a game-high 14 points behind 4-of-5 from three-point range and 2-of-2 at the line.
- * Sophomore Kate Connolly gave the Dragons a major boost in the first half, going 4-of-4 from beyond the arc to tie her career high of 12 points in the opening period.
- * Senior Mariah Leonard was a perfect 4-of-4 from the field for eight points. Fellow senior Niki Metzel also contributed six points.
- * The Dragons finished with 10 three-pointers on the day to tie their season high as a team.
- * Drexel connected on 9-of-12 three-pointers in the first half, including four from Connolly, three from Washington and one from each Hannah Nihill and Maura Hendrixson. DU held a 41-22 at the halftime and led by as many as 21 in the first half.
- * Drexel's largest lead of 23 came with 58 seconds left in the third quarter, 54-31.

NATIONAL WATCH

- * Bailey Greenberg is averaging 18.2 points/game, good for 39th in the nation.
- * Drexel is allowing just 55.3 points/game to opponents, the 16th lowest figure in the nation; 14 of the team's 17 wins have come when allowing under 60 points.
- * Keishana Washington was named the USBWA National Player of the Week following her 27-point effort off the bench against JMU behind 10-of-13 shooting including 6-of-8 from deep with zero turnovers in 24 minutes played.

PRESSING THE ISSUE

- * Drexel has been able to limit turnovers to just 13.0 miscues per game while forcing opponents to cough it up 19.13 times per contest.
- * Over half of those opponent turnovers come via Drexel steals with the Dragons picking their foes pockets 10.0 times per game, tops in the CAA.
- * Drexel has at least 11 steals in 11 games this year with a season-high of 15 at UNCW.
- * 10 Dragons have at least 10 steals including six with at least 20: Aubree Brown (38), Bailey Greenberg (35), Hannah Nihill (32), Keishana Washington (26), Mariah Leonard (21) and Niki Metzel (20). In a single game this year, Maura Hendrixson had a single-game high 5 steals at No. 18/20 DePaul.

SHARING THE ROCK

- * Drexel has 379 assists and 16.5 assists per game through 23 games to rank 1st in the CAA.
- * Senior Aubree Brown is responsible for a team- and-CAA-best 115 of those dimes, dishing out the rock 5.0 times per game. Her assist average is first in the CAA and 33rd in the nation.
- * Together with the turnover numbers, Drexel has the 17th best assist-to-turnover ratio in the nation at 1.26, also tops

in the conference.

HEADING TO THE FOURTH

- * All but two of the Dragons' wins have come if they held the lead after three quarters of action.
- * Drexel is 15-0 when taking a lead in the fourth quarter.
- * The Dragons have only trailed for 58 seconds in the fourth quarter after entering with a lead.

MILESTONE WATCH

- * Senior Bailey Greenberg ranks 6th on the school's scoring list (1,647). Kamile Nacickaite (2008-12) is in 4th with 1,649, Katrina Martin (2000-05) is in 3rd with 1,651 and Michelle Maslowski (1998-02) is in 2nd with 1,900.
- * Seniors Aubree Brown and Bailey Greenberg have played in 90 wins, a program record.
- * As a DI program, the Dragons have 595 wins.

- * Senior Bailey Greenberg recently attended the 116th annual Philadelphia Sports Writers Association Banquet on Monday, Jan. 20 in Cherry Hill, N.J. Greenberg was invited an honoree and recognized for her achievements.

PHILLY CATHOLIC ALL-DECADE TEAM

- * Drexel recently had three players named to the Philadelphia Sports Digest's Philadelphia Catholic League All-Decade Team for girls' high school basketball.
- * PSD chose the top 10 players from 2010-19 which included current Dragons senior Bailey Greenberg (Archbishop Wood '16) and junior Hannah Nihill (Cardinal O'Hara '17) along with former Drexel star Sarah Curran (Archbishop Carroll '13, Drexel 2013-17).

* Bailey Greenberg became the second Dragon ever to win the CAA Player of the Year award in 2018-19 (Gabriela Marginean, 2008-09).
* She finished the league third in scoring at 17.2. The only Dragon ever to pace the CAA in that category (Michelle Maslowski, 18.8 ppg in 2001-02, the program's first season in the CAA).
* Greenberg led the CAA in scoring during conference play at 18.6 points per game. She was the third Dragon to lead the CAA in scoring during league action (Maslowski, 18.6 ppg in 2001-02; Gabriela Marginean, 19.9 ppg in 2007-08).

300-GAME WINNER

* Drexel head coach Denise Dillon won her 300th game with Drexel's 76-45 win over Northeastern on Feb. 17, 2019.
* Already the winningest coach in Drexel women's basketball history, Dillon became the fourth CAA head coach to reach the milestone, joining Wendy Larry (493 at ODU), Kenny Brooks (337 at JMU) and Tina Martin (330 at Delaware).
* She has more head coaching victories than any coach in Drexel athletics history except for Hall of Fame wrestling coach Jack Childs (421 from 1976-2011).
* She became the fourth coach ever to win 200 in CAA play (regular season and tournament) with a 68-45 win on Mar. 3, 2019 against Elon (Larry, 353 at ODU; Brooks, 220 at JMU; Martin, 217 at Delaware).
* Dillon is a three-time CAA Coach of the Year (2005, 2009, 2018), one of four coaches to earn the award at least three times (Larry, 8 times; Sheila Moorman JMU, 5 times; Brooks, 4 times).

SISTER, SISTER

* There are 22 sets of sisters on DI WBB rosters in 2019-20.
* Ana (senior) and Maria (freshman) represent one pair on the Drexel squad.

PRESEASON PICKS

* The Dragons were picked to finish second in the CAA by

the preseason coaches poll. Drexel got one first-place votes and collected a total of 70 points, 11 behind first-place JMU.

* Bailey Greenberg was selected as a Preseason First Team All-CAA pick. The reigning CAA Player of the Year was a First Team pick following the 2018-19 campaign, a Second Team choice after the 2017-18 season, and an All-Rookie Team member following the 2016-17 year.

* Niki Metzel was tabbed as 2019-20 Preseason Honorable Mention All-CAA choice.

2018-19 SEASON RECAP

* The Dragons won six straight after a season-opening loss to Quinnipiac. That streak included the TD Bank Classic championship at Vermont over Thanksgiving weekend.
* Drexel dropped its first two conference games to Towson and JMU at home, then rattled off the third-longest winning streak in program history (12 games) to gain control of what would become the No. 2 seed.
* The Dragons went 12-2 on the road, including winning their first 11, part of what was for more than a month the longest road winning streak in the nation.
* Drexel's 22 regular season wins were second-most all-time in program history, behind 24 in 2017-18
* Then junior Bailey Greenberg was named the CAA Player of the Year.

COMING IN 2023

* The Colonial Athletic Association announced on Oct. 29, 2019 that Drexel University's John A. Daskalakis Athletic Center was chosen as the host venue for the 2023 Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) Women's Basketball Championship.
* It marks the second time (2018) the CAA will be playing the conference tournament in Philadelphia.
- The league also announced hosts James Madison (2021), Towson (2022) and William & Mary (2024).
* This year's CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held in Elon, N.C. at the Schar Center from March 11-14, 2020.

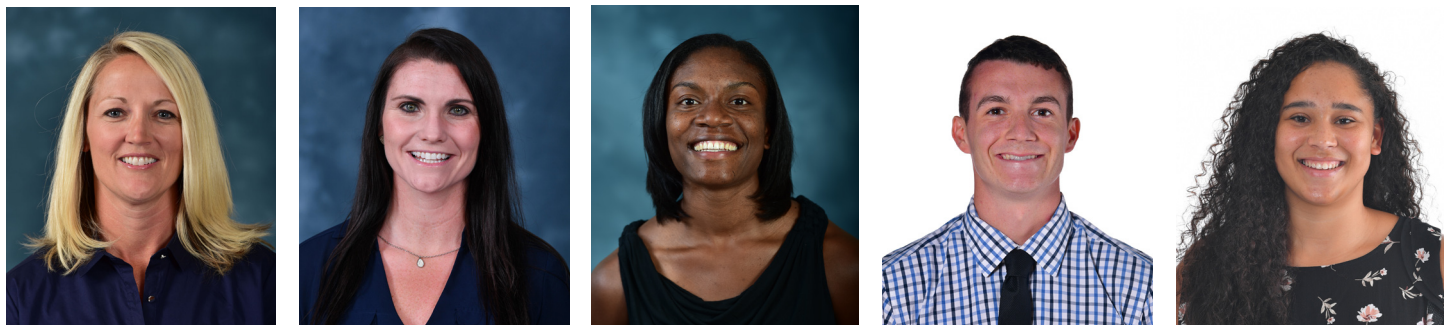
