OPENING TIP

* Drexel is 13-1 in CAA games and in first place at the top of the CAA standings.
* The Dragons are now 20-6 on the year and riding a season-best 13-game winning streak, the third-longest winning streak in program history.
* DU's last six victories have all been by double-digit margins.
* Drexel is coming off a 2-0 weekend against W&M and Elon as sophomore Keishana Washington was named the CAA Honorable Mention Player of the Week.
* Senior Bailey Greenberg is averaging a team-best 17.7 points per game overall and 14.9 points in CAA contests.
* The Dragons have recorded fourth-straight 20-win seasons for the first time in program history.
* Last year, DU advanced to its second-straight CAA championship game (third in the last four years) and earned a bid to the WNIT, its 10th postseason appearance in the last 11 years.

HEAD COACH // DENISE DILLON

Villanova '96 / 17th Season / Career Record: 326-210

* In her 17th season as the head coach of Drexel's women's basketball team, Denise Dillon has become one of the most respected coaches in collegiate women's basketball, elevating the program to new heights and maintaining an enviable consistency and high level of play.

* The winningest head coach in program history, Dillon has led the Dragons to 10 postseason appearances. Those include the Dragons' first CAA Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the 2008-09 season, and a WNIT championship in 2012-13.

* Most recently, Dillon guided the Dragons to a 24-9 record in 2018-19, culminating with a second place finish in the CAA and a WNIT bid. Following on the heels of a 22-win season in 2016-17 and a 27-8 mark in 2017-18, Dillon's Dragons have won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons for the first time in program history. Late in the 2018-19 campaign, Dillon became the first Drexel basketball coach to win 300 career games at the school. That year, the team also led the nation in scoring defense, allowing 50.5 points/game. * Drexel has boasted a winning record in 11 of the last 12 seasons. In 2012-13, her team won a school-record 28 games on its way to a 28-10 record and the WNIT title. Drexel beat Iona, Harvard, Bowling Green, Auburn, Florida and Utah on its way to the title. Drexel had never defeated an SEC or Pac-12 team until the 2013 WNIT.

* The first breakthrough season for Dillon and her Dragons came in 2008-09. Led by a core of veteran senior leaders and a talented junior in Gabriela Marginean, the Dragons played their way to the 2009 regular-season championship, a then-program record 24 wins and the top seed in the CAA Tournament. There, Drexel did what many thought was impossible: knocking off 17-time defending champion Old Dominion and ending the Lady Monarchs' NCAA-best 50-game conference tournament winning streak. The Dragons went on to defeat James Madison on its home court to bring home the school's first CAA title.

* During her tenure Dillon has helped guide the careers of 25 All-Conference selections, six Dean Ehlers Leadership Award recipients, three CAA Rookies of the Year, two CAA Players of the Year, the program's first AP All-American, the leading scorer in Philadelphia women's basketball history and the first Drexel women's player to be selected in the WNBA Draft. Most recently, Dillon mentored the CAA Player of the Year Bailey Greenberg in 2018-19. Additionally, Nicole Hester ('09) was the recipient of the John Randolph Inspiration Award and the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Award in 2009. She also earned the V Foundation Comeback Award and the Honda Inspiration Award.

* Dillon came to Drexel in 2001 as an assistant coach in charge of recruiting and player development. In 2003, Director of Athletics Dr. Eric Zillmer tapped Dillon to become interim head coach and by the 2004-05 season she received full appointment as the head coach of Drexel women's basketball. That season she turned a 10-18 team into a 19-10 squad that earned its first opening-round bye in the CAA Tournament.

* Before coming to Drexel, Dillon boasted a remarkable playing career at Villanova under the tutelage of coaching legend Harry Perretta. Playing in an offense similar to the one now run by Drexel, Dillon scored 1,355 points and pulled down 677 rebounds. She was an All-Rookie selection and a three-time All-Big 5 and All-Big East pick. Her playing career earned her enshrinement in the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2004, the Delaware County Athletics Hall of Fame in 2012, and the Villanova Varsity Club Hall of Fame in 2013. She was also inducted into the Cardinal O'Hara High School Hall of Fame in 2018.

DRAGON BITES

LAST TIME OUT

* Drexel (20-6, 13-1 CAA) dispatched the Elon University Phoenix on Sunday, Feb. 23 by a final of 66-47 from the Daskalakis Athletic Center in Philadelphia.

* Drexel's 20th win of 2019-20 gives the Dragons their fourth-straight 20-win season. The program now has nine 20-win campaigns including seven under head coach Denise Dillon. DU has had at least 20 wins in five of the last six seasons.

* 13 consecutive wins is the third longest winning streak in program history. Drexel won 16-straight games on two prior occasions, including 11 years ago under head coach Denise Dillon (Jan. 22, 2009 to March 15, 2009).

* Drexel used 11-0 runs in each the first and second quarters to own a 21-point edge at halftime, 34-13. It marked the third time in the last five games that DU held its opponent to 13 points or under at halftime following 11 points to each Hofstra (Feb. 7) and Delaware (Feb. 16).

* The Dragons held their largest lead of the game with 1:20 to play in the third quarter, up by 32 with the score 53-21.

* Drexel's last six wins have all been by double-digit margins.

* Three Dragons finished in double figures: Washington (16), Leonard (15) and Greenberg (10).

WINNING STREAKS

* DU is currently on a 13-game winning streak. It marks the fourth double-digit streak in program history with three of those coming under head coach Denise Dillon.

* The program has had nine streaks of eight games or more with five of those coming under Dillon's watch.

DE-FENSE!

* The Dragons have held their opponents to under 15 points in a half 5 times this season including 4 times in the first half. DU has allowed under 13 points in the first half to its opponent 3 times in the last 5 games.

* Drexel is allowing just 54.8 points/game to opponents, the 17th lowest figure in the nation; 16 of the team's 20 wins have come when allowing under 60 points.

NATIONAL WATCH

* Keishana Washington was named the USBWA National Player of the Week following her 27-point effort off the bench against JMU behind 10-of-13 shooting including 6-of-8 from deep with zero turnovers in 24 minutes played.

* Bailey Greenberg is averaging 17.7 points/game, good for 56th in the nation.

PRESSING THE ISSUE

* Drexel has been able to limit turnovers to just 13.0 miscues (26th in nation) per game while forcing opponents to cough it up 19.31 (37th in nation) times per contest.

* Half of those opponent turnovers come via Drexel steals with the Dragons picking their foes pockets 10.1 times per game, tops in the CAA.

* Drexel has at least 11 steals in 12 games this year with a season-high of 15 at UNCW and vs. Elon.

* 10 Dragons have at least 10 steals including six with at least 20: Aubree Brown (44), Bailey Greenberg (40), Hannah Nihill (40), Keishana Washington (29), Mariah Leonard (25) and Niki Metzel (22). In a single game this year, Maura Hendrixson had a single-game high 5 steals at No. 18/20 DePaul.

SHARING THE ROCK

* Drexel is averaging 16.5 assists per game to rank 2nd in the CAA and 25th in the nation.

* Senior Aubree Brown is responsible for a team- and-CAA-best 129 of those dimes, dishing out the rock 5.0 times per game. Her assist average is second in the CAA and 36th in the nation.

* Together with the turnover numbers, Drexel has the 16th best assist-to-turnover ratio in the nation at 1.27, also tops in the conference.

HEADING TO THE FOURTH

* All but two of the Dragons' wins have come if they held the lead after three quarters of action.

300-GAME WINNER

- * Drexel head coach Denise Dillon won her 300th game with Drexel's 76-45 win over Northeastern on Feb. 17,

2019.

- * Already the winningest coach in Drexel women's basketball history, Dillon became the fourth CAA head coach to reach the milestone, joining Wendy Larry (493 at ODU), Kenny Brooks (337 at JMU) and Tina Martin (330 at Delaware).
- * She has more head coaching victories than any coach in Drexel athletics history except for Hall of Fame wrestling coach Jack Childs (421 from 1976-2011).
- * She became the fourth coach ever to win 200 in CAA play (regular season and tournament) with a 68-45 win on Mar. 3, 2019 against Elon (Larry, 353 at ODU; Brooks, 220 at JMU; Martin, 217 at Delaware).
- * Dillon is a three-time CAA Coach of the Year (2005, 2009, 2018), one of four coaches to earn the award at least three times (Larry, 8 times; Sheila Moorman JMU, 5 times; Brooks, 4 times).

PRESEASON PICKS

- * The Dragons were picked to finish second in the CAA by the preseason coaches poll. Drexel got one first-place votes and collected a total of 70 points, 11 behind first-place JMU.
- * Bailey Greenberg was selected as a Preseason First Team All-CAA pick. The reigning CAA Player of the Year was a First Team pick following the 2018-19 campaign, a Second Team choice after the 2017-18 season, and an All-Rookie Team member following the 2016-17 year.
- * Niki Metzel was tabbed as 2019-20 Preseason Honorable Mention All-CAA choice.

- * The Dragons won six straight after a season-opening loss to Quinnipiac. That streak included the TD Bank Classic championship at Vermont over Thanksgiving weekend.

- * The Colonial Athletic Association announced on Oct. 29, 2019 that Drexel University's John A. Daskalakis Athletic Center was chosen as the host venue for the 2023 Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) Women's Basketball Championship.
- * It marks the second time (2018) the CAA will be playing the conference tournament in Philadelphia.
- The league also announced hosts James Madison (2021), Towson (2022) and William & Mary (2024).
- * This year's CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held in Elon, N.C. at the Schar Center from March 11-14, 2020.

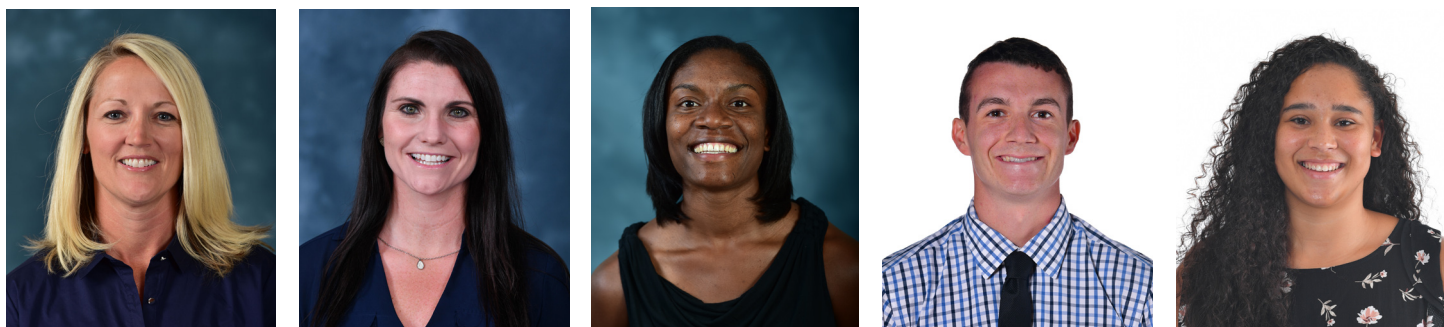
