DREXEL TO HOST CAA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

The defending CAA women's basketball champions, Drexel University was announced on Tuesday, November 30 as the host of the 2022 Colonial Athletic Association Women's Basketball Championship presented by Primis by a vote of the conference's athletics directors.

As announced on January 21, the event will take place March 10-13.

It will be the second time that the conference has conducted its showcase women's basketball event at the Daskalakis Athletic Center in Philadelphia, Pa. The facility also played host to the championship in 2018.

The Dragons won the CAA tournament last year, defeating Delaware in the 2021 title game to earn its first NCAA Tournament berth since 2009. DU has had consistent women's basketball success for more than a decade, reaching postseason play in all but one season since 2009.

The CAA is considered one of the top mid-major women's basketball conferences in the nation. Five different schools have captured the conference championship since 2013.

WELCOME ABOARD!

On Tuesday, January 25, the CAA announced that Hampton, Monmouth, and Stony Brook accepted invi-

tations to join the conference in 2022-23. The addition of the schools brings the total number of schools in the league to 12 for next year.

LAST TIME OUT

Hannah Nihill tied a career-high with five three-pointers as the Dragons defeated James Madison 64-61 on Wednesday night.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Nihill led all scorers with 18 points, adding three assists and three rebounds. She also contributed on the defensive end with four steals, her fifth consecutive game with three or more swipes.
- **Keishana Washington** tallied 17 in the contest and had six assists.
- **Tessa Brugler** kept the Dragons in the game early on, ending up with 13 points and a team-high seven rebounds.
- Off the bench, **Maura Hendrixson** led Drexel with seven assists.
- As a team, Drexel posted 23 assists. It is the third time this season DU recorded 23 helpers in a game, the highest total for a CAA team against a Division I opponent in 2021-22.

HOW IT HAPPENED

Unlike the first three quarters, Drexel came out of the gates hot to start the fourth, connecting on its first three shots of the period and taking its first lead since the first quarter while forcing a JMU timeout.

Neither team backed down as there were five lead changes in the last 8:44. The final flip came with ex-

actly one minute remaining as Washington made her only three of the night, pushing Drexel up 63-61.

Both teams scored early and often with each squad hitting on 7-of-15 shots in the first quarter. The only difference in the frame was JMU making the only free throws as the Dukes led 18-16 after 10 minutes. Brugler was big for the Dragons in the period, scoring eight, all on the mid-range jumper.

Defense prevailed to open the second as neither team scored until the 7:05 mark. James Madison was the first to break the ice and opened a 31-20 lead with 2:16 remaining before Drexel battled back, scoring the final eight points in the quarter, pulling back to 31-28 at the break.

The third quarter started the same as the first two, with JMU getting the early jump, using an 8-0 run in just more than two minutes to lead 39-28. Drexel closed in as the period went on with the help of a trio of treys from Nihill in the frame, cutting the advantage to 48-47 with 40 seconds left on a pair of Washington free throws. The Dukes finished with the closing four points of the frame to take a five-point lead.

SCOUTING REPORT

Delaware enters play 18-5 overall with a 12-1 mark in the CAA following a 71-58 win against Hofstra on February 13. The Blue Hens have not lost since falling to Drexel on January 23 and their eight game winning streak is tied for the ninth longest in NCAA Division I.

Leading the offense for Delaware is Jasmine Dickey who tops the CAA and is third nationally at 25.5 points per game. A volume shooter, Dickey leads the nation in field goal attempts per game at 22.45 and is second in total field goal attempts with 494. She gets to the line a lot as well with 145 tries at the charity stripe and makes her attempts, hitting 81.9 percent. Not to be outdone is Ty Battle who averages a double-double with 13.0 points and a conference best 10.9 rebounds per game. Tyi Skinner is another scoring option at 14.0 a game. She also tops UD in assists with 78.

One thing the Blue Hens do exceptionally well is collect their own misses, ranking third in the country with 16.8 offensive rebounds per game. On the down side, they will put their opponents on the line as teams are averaging 16.8 free throws per game.

Natasha Adair is in her fifth season at Delaware with a record of 89-55 at UD and 161-140 in 10 seasons overall as a collegiate head coach. She has guided her Blue Hens teams to the WNIT twice in 2018 and 2021 and has had only two season below .500 as a head coach.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Sunday is the 88th all-time meeting between Delaware and Drexel at the Division I level, with the Blue Hens holding a 48-39 series lead. The 87 games are the most for either school against any opponent. The

Dragons had won 11 in a row against UD before the Blue Hens took both regular season games last season. Drexel got the final say, however, coming from behind to win the CAA title game last season, 63-52, claiming the conference championship and a trip to the NCAA Tournament. Washington led DU with 30 points in the contest. Drexel won the most recent game between the squads, a 70-62 victory at the DAC on January 23.

TWO DECADES IN THE MAKING

Brugler earned some major honors for her work in the classroom and on the court, being named a First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District performer. She is the first women's basketball player to earn Academic All-District honors since Michelle Maslowski in 2002 and is just the fourth overall in program history to earn the award. HISTORICAL NIGHT (PART I)

Nihill tied the Dragons career appearances record in style on Wednesday, playing all 40 minutes and tying a career-high with five treys. By stepping on the court on Sunday, she will break the record for games played with Drexel, currently held by **Meghan Creighton** who played from from 2012-17. As the schedule currently stands, the CAA mark is also in her sights. Based on available information, Nikki Newman played in the most games while in the conference, appearing 147 times for James Madison from 2009-14. Nihill is on target to play in her 148th game in Drexel's quarterfinal game of the CAA Tournament.

HISTORICAL NIGHT (PART II)

The win against the Dukes was the 20th of the season for DU. It is the fifth consecutive full season where the Dragons have won 20 or more games and the 10th overall in program history. **Amy Mallon** also became

the quickest head coach in Drexel history to win 20 games in a season, accomplishing the mark in her second year. **Lil Haas** needed five years to get to a 20-win season and **Denise Dillon** did it in six.

COMEBACK KIDS

The past three weeks have tested the Dragons' mettle as DU has faced three different double-digit deficits, winning twice and tying the score in the third. Starting with Elon on January 28, Drexel came back from down 35-25 with 2:33 left in the second quarter to win 72-60. Wednesday versus James Madison, DU rallied from a 39-28 deficit with 7:49 to go in the third, pulling out a 64-61 victory. Those game sandwiched a game against Charleston on February 6 where the Dragons trailed 55-31 with 2:18 remaining in the third before tying the score at 66-66 with 1:23 to go.

CASHING IN ON MISTAKES

For a team as defensive-minded as DU is, it may come as a surprise that Drexel is ninth out of 10 teams in the CAA in forcing turnovers, causing opponents to give the ball up 15.0 times per game. The Dragons excel, however, at making teams pay for giving the ball up, posting 15.7 points per game off turnovers. That average of 1.05 points scored per opponent turnover is second in the CAA, only trailing Towson, who sits at 1.10.

WILL YOU BE MY VALENTINE?

Coming off the bench, Valentine provided a spark for Drexel against Northeastern with a career-high 13 rebounds in just 17 minutes of action. It was her second double-digit game this season as she pulled in 10 caroms against Longwood. Overall, the sophomore from Odenton, Md. has 54 boards in 218 minutes of action, an average of 9.9 rebounds per 40 minutes. Despite averaging less than 11 minutes per game, she is third on the Dragons with 22 offensive boards.

BACK TO HER OLD HABITS

Throughout her career, Nihill has averaged 2.01 steals per game, so it was a bit under her numbers when she came away with 25 swipes in the first 18 games of the year. The last five contests, however, she has reminded teams in the CAA why she is the reigning Defensive Player of the Year with 22 steals. That this is happening

in February really shouldn't come as a surprise. In her career, Nihill has 143 takeaways in 52 career games in February and March, an average of 2.75 per contest and has 29 of her 50 career games with three or more steals in those months.

FINISHING WHAT YOU START

DU led by eight at the break at Northeastern on February 13, on its way to a 61-46 victory, improving to 16-0 this season in games where it leads at halftime. As impressive as that is on its own, Drexel has not lost a game it led at halftime since a 53-49 setback at Penn on December 20, 2019, a string of 39 consecutive games.

ANYWHERE, ANYTIME

Drexel is 8-0 in true road games this season. DU is one of only two teams in Division I to be undefeated on the road, joining Florida Gulf Coast (7-0).

BEST BEGINNINGS

The Dragons continue to build off the success of their CAA Championship last year, putting together the best start in program history at 20-3. The 2016-17 team was 12-3 before falling in its 15th contest of the season. Drexel's .870 winning percentage is ninth in the nation through Wednesday's games.

40 IS THE NEW 30

Washington took full advantage of the overtime periods against William & Mary, scoring 18 points in the 10 extra minutes of game time, resulting in the first 40-point effort of her career. It was the second 40+ point game in the CAA this season at the time and is the 10th highest total this season nationally. It is also the first 40-point game for a Dragon since 2010, just the fourth in the Division I era of the program, and the first for a player not named **Gabriela Marginean** who accomplished the feat three times including a team record, 47-point explosion against Northeastern on February 22, 2009.

UP NEXT

The Dragons return to the DAC for their final two regular season home games and looks to solidify playoff seeding, starting with William & Mary on Friday, February 25. Tipoff is scheduled for 7:00 p.m.

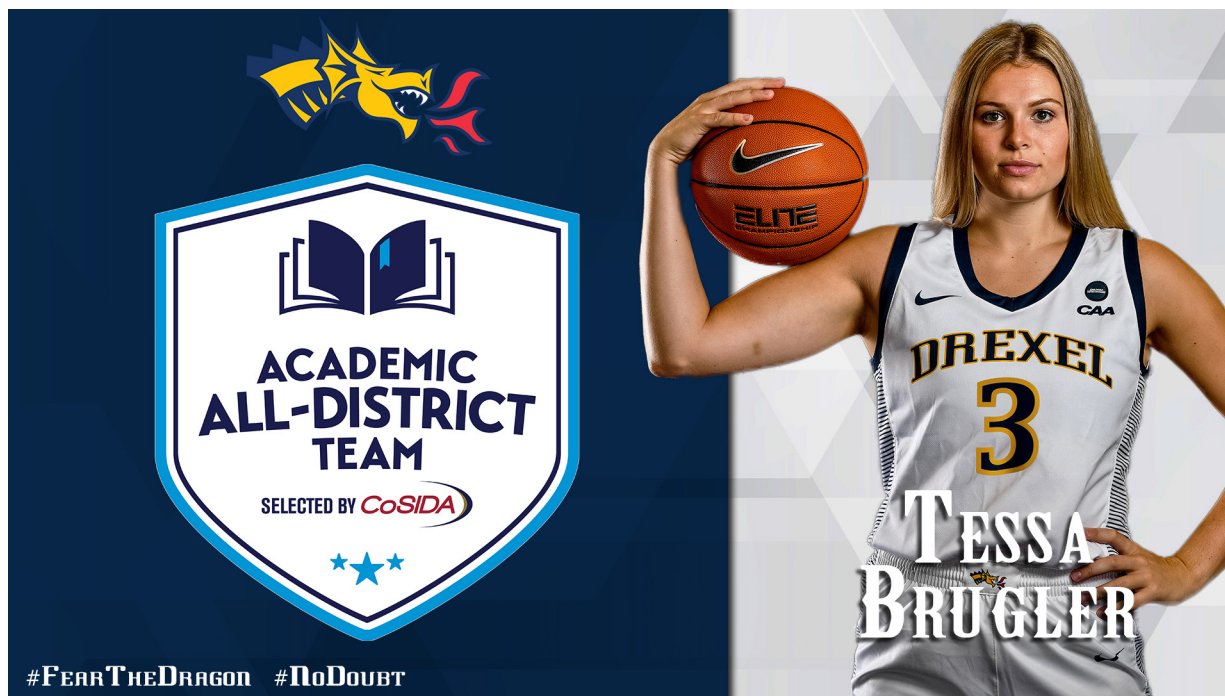

BRUGLER NAMED CoSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

GREENWOOD, Ind. – Tessa Brugler of the Drexel University women's basketball team has been named a First Team CoSIDA Academic All-District performer as announced by the College Sports Information Directors Association on Thursday afternoon and voted on by the organization's membership.

Brugler is the first women's basketball player to earn Academic All-District honors since Michelle Maslowski in 2002 and is just the fourth overall in program history to earn the award.

First Team Academic All-District honorees advance to the CoSIDA Academic All-America ballot. First, Second and Third Team Academic All-America honorees will be announced in mid-March.

A graduate student from Nazareth, Pa., Brugler has a 3.83 GPA while earning her master's degree in sports business. On the court, she has started all 23 games for the Colonial Athletic Association leading Dragons, averaging 14.0 points per game and is fifth in the conference with 8.6 rebounds a contest. She also ranks third in the CAA with 1.3 blocks per game and her 30 blocks this season are the most for a Drexel player since the 2015-16 season.

To be eligible, student-athletes must have an academic standing of a sophomore or higher and have a 3.30 GPA at their current institution. They must also be a starter or key contributor to their team and have appeared in at least 50 percent of the team's games.



Amy Mallon, a fixture on Drexel's bench as an assistant and then associate head coach for 16 seasons, was named the sixth head coach in the Division I history of Drexel women's basketball on Friday, March 27, 2020.

In her first season as head coach of the Dragons, Mallon made a statement right from the start. Drexel competed to a 14-9 record in 2020-21 and made an improbable run to the CAA Championship. Mallon led the program to its first CAA title since the 2009 season and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament. With the standout victory over No. 1 seeded Delaware in the CAA Finals, Mallon became the first rookie head coach in more than 35 years to accomplish the feat. Mallon's success in her inaugural season earned her All-Philly Co-Coach of the Year and a spot as a finalist for Spalding Maggie Dixon NCAA DI Rookie Coach of the Year, awarded to an NCAA DI head coach who demonstrated on-court success and enriched the lives of those around them. In addition to her own accolades, Mallon also mentored standout guard duo, Hannah Nihill and Keishana Washington. Nihill became the program's first ever CAA Defensive Player of the Year while Washington was named the CAA Tournament's Most Outstanding Player after producing back-to-back 30+ point performances to propel the Dragons to victory. After punching their ticket to San Antonio, Drexel entered the tournament as the 14th seed and drew No. 3 Georgia in the first round. Despite leading for most of the first half, the Dragons saw a late comeback by the Bulldogs to end their unforgettable season.

Mallon joined the Dragons in 2004 as an assistant coach before becoming the associate head coach in 2007. Charged with forging Drexel's defense, Mallon

galvanized DU into a formidable defensive adversary for opponents, pushing the Dragons to become one of the best defensive programs in the country.

Mallon played a significant part in seven 20-win campaigns during her time as a Drexel coach including five in the last six seasons. Drexel went 23-7 in 2019-20, capping off the conference schedule with a 16-2 record to claim the No. 1 seed in the Colonial Athletic Association Championships and a share of the conference's regular-season title. At one point during the CAA slate, the Dragons put together a 13-game winning streak, the third longest in program history.

Drexel has won three regular-season CAA titles with Mallon on the bench. Prior to this season, DU previously earned a share of the regular-season championship in 2017-18 and the outright title in 2008-09. The Dragons have made 10 postseason trips in the last 11 seasons including a 2009 NCAA Tournament appearance and

nine WNIT bids with a WNIT Championship in 2013.

Mallon came to Drexel in 2004 after coaching stints at Saint Joseph's University and Villanova University as a coach and assistant athletics director at Episcopal Academy in Merion, Pa. Mallon also enjoyed success as a professional, playing in the now defunct American Basketball League and in Luxembourg. Mallon also suited up for the Irish National Team during the 2001 European Championships. Her playing career has earned her numerous accolades including a 2002 induction into the Philadelphia Big 5 Hall of Fame and enshrinement in the halls of fame of Howard County Maryland and Mt. Hebron High School in Ellicott City, Md.

Her start in coaching came in 1994 when she took an assistant coaching position at Division III Rosemont College. After one season with the Ramblers, Mallon joined Villanova's coaching staff and helped guide the Wildcats to a 21-8 record and a Big 5 Championship in



the 1995-96 season. She returned to her alma mater, Saint Joseph's, the following season and, as an assistant coach, helped bring the Hawks both Atlantic-10 and Big 5 titles after finishing with a 26-5 mark.

Mallon continued to produce championship teams as a coach when she took over as head coach at the prestigious Episcopal Academy in Merion, Pa. In addition to serving as head coach of the girls' basketball and softball teams, Mallon also took on responsibilities as the assistant director of athletics. In her fifth season at the helm of the women's basketball team, Mallon led Episcopal to a 17-6 record, one of its best finishes ever, and a trip to the Inter-Ac Championship game.

In her playing days, Mallon was one of the CAA's all-time greats. She helped lead the Richmond Spiders to back-to-back conference championships in 1990 and 1991 and was named to All-Conference teams in both seasons and also made the CAA All-Defensive team in 1991. Mallon helped lead the Spiders to three consecutive postseason appearances, including two NCAA bids, and a 72-18 record during her three seasons with the team. Her experience as a member of one of the last teams to defeat Old Dominion in a conference tournament, proved to be a rallying point for the 2009 Drexel

women's basketball team when the Dragons upended the Lady Monarchs in the semifinals of the CAA Tournament, ending what had been a 17-year reign by ODU in conference tournament play. The 1990 Richmond women's basketball team was recently inducted into the University of Richmond Athletics Hall of Fame in 2019 as a team of distinction.

Mallon transferred to Saint Joseph's for her senior season in 1992-93 and put together one of the best single seasons in the history of Philadelphia Big 5 women's basketball, leading to her induction into the Big 5 Hall of Fame in 2002. Mallon led the Hawks to a 21-8 record, a Big 5 Championship and was named the league's Player of the Year after averaging a double-double for the season. She was also an All-Atlantic 10 First Team selection, a member of the Academic All-District Team and an Honorable Mention All-American.

After graduating from Saint Joseph's with a bachelor's degree in sociology, a master's in health education and 1,384 career points on the basketball court, Mallon played professionally in Luxembourg for the DBBL's Résidence de Walferdang franchise. When the American Basketball League was born, Mallon returned to Philadelphia to play for the city's franchise, the Rage.

In addition to her on-court expertise, Mallon has played a pivotal role in the growth of the Drexel program internationally. Her recruiting efforts have helped to bring top-level talent to Drexel from around the globe. She was integral in the recruitment and coaching of Gabriela Marginean, a Romanian-native who was the 2009 CAA Player of the Year, a three-time First Team All-CAA selection, the league's Rookie of the Year in 2006-07 and the first Drexel player to be drafted in the WNBA. In addition, her efforts have also helped to procure players hailing from Belgium, Canada, Czech Republic, England, Ivory Coast, Lithuania, Slovakia, Spain and Sweden.

Mallon has had her finger on the pulse of collegiate women's basketball for over two decades, playing as a Nike-sponsored athlete and working as a representative and consultant for the company from 1997-2001. She has been an ambassador for the game since her playing days, speaking at schools and clinics throughout the nation since 1993. Her passion for the game continues to inspire new generations of student-athletes to strive for success.

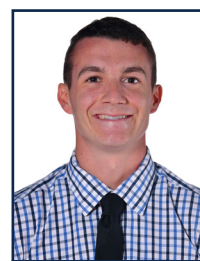
