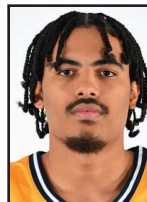

HEAD COACH ZACH SPIKER

Ithaca '00 · Ninth Season at Drexel

Zach Spiker is in his ninth season as Drexel's Head Coach. Spiker, the 2023-24 Philadelphia Big 5 Coach of the Year, and his staff have rebuilt the Dragons' roster over the last few years and in 2021 saw their hard work pay off. Drexel won its first-ever CAA Championship and earned a bid to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 25 years.

Last year, Drexel had one of its best seasons since joining the CAA. The Dragons won 20 games for the first time in more than a decade and for only the 11th time in school history. Spiker's squad earned a two-seed in the CAA Championships after a 13-5 regular season record. The Dragons won seven straight games to start CAA play, their best start since joining the league. Spiker's team played well in the DAC, winning 13 straight games and going 9-0 in

conference games. The Dragons have now posted three consecutive winning seasons and have now won 10 or more CAA games in three straight years, the first time that has happened at Drexel in more than a decade.

Prior to the 2023-24 season, the Dragons became part of the fabled Philadelphia Big 5. After suffering narrow losses in their first two Big 5 games, the Dragons defeated No. 18 Villanova in front of a crowd of 15,215 at Wells Fargo Center. It was Drexel's first win against a top 25 team since 2010 and only the fifth win against a nationally-ranked team in Drexel's Division I history. It was also only the second time in school history the Dragons defeated Villanova.

In 2022-23, Drexel finished 17-15 overall and advanced to the CAA quarterfinals. The Dragons went 10-8 in CAA play, including a come from behind win against Charleston, a team receiving votes nationally, at the DAC for the second consecutive year. Amari Williams picked up the second of his three straight CAA Defensive Player of the Year awards. He is the only player in league history to accomplish that feat.

The 2020-21 season was an unforgettable year. Games were canceled on numerous occasions by the pandemic, but the Dragons stayed discipline the entire year. The Dragons played just five home games due to other teams testing protocols, but that didn't deter them from their ultimate goal. Drexel knocked off James Madison in the final regular season game to earn the CAA's sixth-seed. The Dragons then returned to Harrisonburg for the Championships and proceeded to beat Charleston, Northeastern and Elon to win their first CAA title. Spiker's team shot a blistering 58 percent from long-range during the tournament as DU advanced to the Indianapolis Bubble for their first appearance in March Madness since 1996. Camren Wynter was named the CAA's Most Outstanding Player, while Zach Walton and James Butler were named to the All-Tournament team. The Dragons had their magical run end at the hands of Illinois in the NCAA Tournament.

The Dragons followed that season up with a 15-14 mark during the 2021-22 campaign. Spiker's squad finished the year with a 10-8 record in the CAA, the most conference wins by a Drexel team in 10 years. The Dragons were 5-4 in league road games. Spiker's team became just the second Drexel men's basketball team to finish above .500 in back-to-back seasons in the last 17 years. Wynter was a First Team All-CAA pick, while Williams was named the CAA's Defensive Player of the Year and a Third Team selection. Matey Juric became just the second Drexel men's basketball player to earn the CAA's prestigious Dean Ehlers Award.

Spiker was named the 26th head coach in Drexel history on March 25, 2016 and just the sixth since the school became a Division I member. In his six previous seasons at the school, Spiker has had 10 All-CAA selections. Two of his recruits have been named to the CAA All-Rookie Team including Wynter who was named the 2019 CAA Rookie of the Year. In his time at DU, the Dragons have had two players lead the league in 3-pt. percentage and Butler led the CAA in both rebounding and field-goal percentage.

During the 2019-20 season, the Dragons picked up their first in-season tournament victory in 17 years by winning the Boardwalk Battle in Atlantic City, N.J. Those were two of Drexel's seven non-conference wins, the most for the school in six years. In addition, Drexel won 10 games at the Daskalakis Athletic Center, marking the first time the team won 10 or more games at the DAC since the 2011-12 team won 15.

Spiker picked up his first victory at Drexel against Hartford in his first game at the DAC on Nov. 18, 2016. The Dragons have had some memorable wins in his time in University City. Drexel knocked off Houston, an NCAA Tournament team, at the Paradise Jam in 2017. Spiker's team made national headlines as it rallied from a 34-point deficit to defeat Delaware at the DAC on Feb. 22, 2018. That marked the biggest come-from-behind win in NCAA history.

The Dragons increased their CAA win total for the second straight year and averaged 75.8 points per game in 2018-19, their highest average since joining the league. Drexel picked up a 79-78 win at Charleston, which snapped the Cougars' 22-game home winning streak, the second longest in the nation at that time. Drexel finished the year with 237 treys, the third-highest total in school history. Spiker's first team holds the school record with 256 3-pointers.

Spiker came to the Dragons from Army West Point, where he spent seven seasons as the head coach of the Black Knights. He led Army West Point to its most wins in more than 30 years in his final season. Spiker won 102 games during his time at West Point, which is tied with Bob Knight for second all-time at the Academy. In his final season, Spiker led the Black Knights to a 19-14 record and earned Army's first postseason appearance since another Hall of Famer, Mike Krzyzewski, led them to the NIT in 1978. He is the only coach in Army history to win 15 or more games in four consecutive seasons, a mark the program has not achieved — even under multiple coaches — since 1920-24.

Spiker was selected as the 2016 Skip Prosser Man of the Year. He was named the 2013 Patriot League Coach of the Year award and was a finalist for the Hugh Durham Award, presented annually to the nation's top mid-major coach. Spiker was one of only seven coaches in the country to receive at least one vote for the Associated Press National Coach of the Year. urnament in 1978. PRESENTING SPONSOR

International Brotherhood of Electrical Worker's Local 98 is the presenting sponsor of the 2024-25 Drexel Men's Basketball season. IBEW Local 98 is a proud supporter of Drexel Athletics and Drexel University for the fifth-straight season.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

The CAA preseason pollsters picked the Dragons to finish 11th this season, despite the fact the Dragons finished 13-5 in the CAA a year ago. Towson received 10 of the 14 first-place votes and was picked to earn its first CAA title. The College of Charleston, last year's champion, was picked to finish second, while UNCW was picked to finish third.

AGAINST THE BLUE HENS

The Blue Hens lead the all-time series, 85-84. The series dates back to the 1911-12 season. This will be the last time the Blue Hens come to the DAC as a member of the Coastal Athletic Association. The Dragons have won the last four

meetings and the last five during the regular season. Delaware's last win came during the 2022 CAA Championship in Washington, D.C.

ABOUT DELAWARE

The Blue Hens come into the game with an 11-9 record and an 4-3 mark in league play after a 93-68 loss on Thursday at Hofstra. Delaware is led by John Camden. The transfer from Virginia Tech is averaging 17.7 points and is shooting .442 from deep. All five of Delaware's starters average in double figures. The Blue Hens entered Thursday's game leading the CAA in field goal percentage and 3-point percentage.

THE PHILADELPHIA BIG 5

The Dragons became a member of the storied Philadelphia Big 5 in April of 2023. Drexel joined La Salle, Penn, Saint Joseph's, Temple and Villanova as members of the Big 5, which was formed in 1955.

The teams are in two pods of three. This season, like last year, the Dragons were in a pod with Temple and La Salle. Each team played a home and a road game in the pod before playing in a triple header at Wells Fargo Center. Drexel finished 1-2 in the Big 5 this year after defeating Penn, 60-47, in the first game of the tripleheader. The Dragons lost at home to La Salle and at Temple. Last season, the Dragons picked up their first-ever Big 5 win at Wells Fargo with a 57-55 win vs. No. 18 Villanova, the first DU win vs. Villanova since the 2007 team upset the 'Cats.

AT THE DAC

Drexel has been a tough team to face at the DAC over the last few years. The Dragons are off to a slow start this year at home with a 3-4 record. Last year, the Dragons were 13-1 at home and won 15 straight at the DAC before losing to La Salle on Nov. 16. In 2022-23, they posted a 12-3 mark at the DAC, including an 8-1 record in CAA play. The Dragons have had a winning record at the DAC in seven straight seasons. Spiker has a 72-49 mark at the DAC.

ROAD WINS

With the victory at Stony Brook, the Dragons picked up their sixth road win of the season. The six wins are tied for the most road wins the Dragons have had in a season under Spiker. Last years team had six on its way to 20 wins overall. The 2021-22 team also had six road wins. Drexel's six road wins are tied for fourth in the nation as of Jan. 19. UC Irvine leads the

nation with eight road wins.

LAST TOP 25 VICTORY

On Dec. 2, 2023 the Dragons knocked off No. 18 Villanova at Wells Fargo Center, 57-55. Amari Williams had 12 points and five blocked shots, including the game-winner in the closing seconds, as Drexel defeated a top 25 team for the first time in 13 years (Louisville, '10). Drexel had lost five straight to nationally ranked teams. The win was just the fifth all-time against a nationally-ranked team and the second in 20 games against the Wildcats.

WINNING SEASONS

Last year the Dragons finished with a 20-12 record. It gave the team its fourth straight winning season under Spiker. Before last season, *the last time that happened at Drexel was 27 years ago, when the 1996-97 team went 22-9 to secure its sixth straight season above .500.* Drexel was 17-15 in 2023-24 and 15-14 in 2021-22. During the Covid-19 shortened year, Drexel was 12-8 and won the CAA. If you take out the Covid-19 season, Spiker's team has evened or improved its win total in each year. In CAA play, the Dragons have now won 10 games or more in three straight seasons, the first time they accomplished that feat since the 2011-12 season.

PLAYERS IN THE PROS

Since 2000-01, the Dragons have had more than 30 players sign professional contracts. Damion Lee is a member of the Phoenix Suns. Other players who have played over the last few years include Luke House, Samme Givens, Tramaine Isabell, Melik Martin, Dartaye Ruffin, Chaz Crawford, Frank Elegar, Zach Walton and Trevor John.

LOCAL PRODUCTS

The Dragons have made an increased emphasis on recruiting Philadelphia-area student athletes. This year's team has three players who played locally in high school. Horace Simmons attended La Salle High School. Cole Hargrove played at Methacton, while freshman Josh Reed attended Archbishop Wood.

DOES EXPERIENCE MATTER?

The Dragons were picked to finish 11th in the CAA after losing so many players. The new roster is ranked 346th in the NCAA in Division I experience and last in the CAA with .71 years of experience.

SUCCESS IN THE NON-CONFERENCE

The Dragons finished the non-conference part of their schedule with an 8-5 record this season. The eight non-league wins are the most a Spiker coached team has had in a season. The last time Drexel won eight non-conference games came back during the 2013-14 season. In addition, Drexel was 4-1 in true non-conference road games this season.

NEWCOMERS

The Dragons' roster has seven new faces this year, but four of those have previous experience playing college basketball. Junior Victor Panov played at Daytona State last season after attending Cal State Fullerton. Point guard Jason "Deuce" Drake started at Butler Community College last year. He also played Division I basketball previously at Cleveland State. Sophomore Kevon Vanderhorst attended Brunswick Community College in 2023-24, the same school that produced former Dragon Leon Spencer. Villiam Garcia Adsten transferred to Drexel after playing last season at Pacific.

FIRST YEAR FRESHMEN

Drexel has three true freshmen on the 2024-25 roster. Josh Reed was an All-Catholic League performer at Archbishop Wood. Clem Edomwonyin continues the English pipeline. The 6-foot-9 forward follows in the footsteps of Mate Okros and Amari Williams. The third freshman is Ralph Akuta, who spent last season at Hargrave Military Academy, which is the same school that former DU standout Chaz Crawford attended.

QUITE THE DEBUT

Horace Simmons, Jr, who redshirted last year, had an unforgettable debut. The Archbishop Wood grad poured in 24 points and was 8-for-9 from long distance. The 24 points were the most in a debut since Brian Holden scored 29 points. Holden was a transfer from Boston University. No other freshman has scored that many in his debut since at least 1980.

BLOCK PARTY

Despite losing Amari Williams, who is fifth on Drexel's career blocked shots list, the Dragons are still rejecting shots at a high level. Drexel is averaging 4.4 blocks per game. The Dragons blocked nine shots in their victory against Colgate on Nov. 9. That was the most for a Drexel team in a single game since the Dragons blocked 11 JMU shots in their 2018 CAA Tournament victory against the Dukes. Cole Hargrove led the way with four against Colgate, while Shane Blakeney had three. Drexel matched that total of nine blocks at N.C. A&T. Hargrove had four in that game and averages a team-high 1.6 blocks per game.

IN THE COMMUNITY

Drexel has been very active over the last few years in the West Philadelphia community. The team organized a coat drive that has turned into an annual event. Members of the team were once again part of the Vidas Field Day held on Oct. 28. The event brought 200 children from a nearby local elementary school in for a field day which included games and lunch with members of SAAC and different Drexel teams.

On Martin Luther King, Jr. Day the last two seasons,

the team, along with more than 300 other volunteers through Drexel, participated in a day of service. It was part of Community Clean-Up Days in West Philadelphia.

Head coach Zach Spiker has been involved since he arrived on campus. He was named the 2021 Lindy Center for Civic Engagement Award winner. He was given the Staff Award for Campus and Community Engagement by the Lindy Center and became the only Drexel coach to win the award. It goes to one staff member each year that exhibits the tenets of good campus or community partnership in their efforts regardless of their university role. Spiker has been a vocal supporter and helped raise funds for the creation of the Center for Black Culture.

MILESTONE VICTORIES

The Dragons first-ever Big 5 win against Villanova was also the 200th career coaching victory for Zach Spiker. He won his first 102 games at Army. In late December, Spiker picked up another milestone. Drexel's win against Penn State Greater Allegheny was the 100th as the head coach of the Dragons.

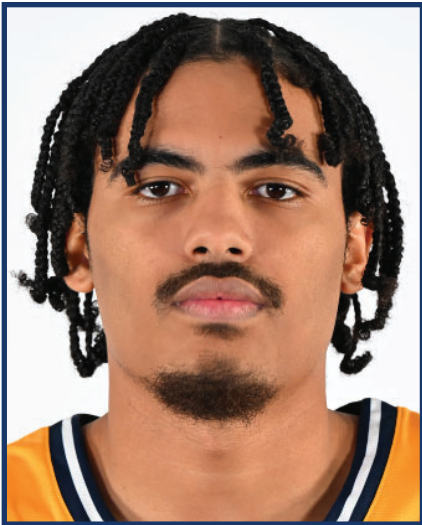
