Panthers face division leading Truman State

Drury has a chance to move into a first place tie in the West Division of the Great Lakes Valley Conference as they face Truman State on the road Thursday.

The Panthers are 13-4 and 6-3 in the GLVC. Drury is one game behind division leading Truman State entering Thursday's game. The Panthers are coming off of back-to-back home wins with a 77-53 win over William Jewell on Jan. 19 and a 70-68 victory over Rockhurst last Saturday.

The Bulldogs are 15-4 and 7-2 in the GLVC. Truman State won their last two games and three of their last four. They defeated Missouri-St. Louis 86-82 in overtime in their last game on Saturday.

The two teams have only played 14 times during an all-time history that dates back to 1923. The Panthers lead the series 8-6 but lost last year's meeting at home, 82-72, at the O'Reilly Family Event Center on Jan. 20, 2016.

Panthers Notes

- Drury is playing just their fourth road game of the year (not counting an neutral-court game on Dec. 16. The Panthers are just 1-2 in their three road contests.
- The Panthers are shooting .516 from the floor, a total that is third best in the GLVC. Drury is second in the conference in field goal defense allowing a.427 percentage.
- John Williams ranks 3rd in the GLVC in steals with 2.0 per game.
- Drury has a 91-13 record at home since the opening of the O'Reilly Family Event Center in the 2010-11 season and head coach Steve Hesser is 161-23 on home court combining six seasons at Weiser Gym and the opening of the O'.

Truman State Notes

- Truman State has the second best scoring average in the conference putting up 87.9 points per game.
- The Bulldogs lead the GLVC in 3-point percentage at .443 and their 11.5 3's per game also leads the conference.
- Truman State has the top two three-point shooters in the conference in 3's made per game. Nathan Messer and Jake Velky both average 3.47 3's per game.
- Head coach Chris Foster is in his third season at Truman State. Foster played at Northern Iowa and was a Missouri Valley All-Freshman performer in 2002.

DU's last game: Two made free throws by John Williams with eight seconds left and a blocked shot by Tevin Foster on a three-point attempt at the buzzer helped Drury fight off Rockhurst for a 70-68 win in front of an Overflow the O' crowd of 3,017 at the O'Reilly Family Event Center on Saturday.

Drury improved to 13-4 and 6-3 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference while Rockhurst dropped to 10-7 and 4-5 in league play.

Rockhurst jumped out to an 8-2 lead before the Panthers responded to go up 33-30 at halftime.

Drury built a nine-point lead, 63-54, with 6:29 remaining before the Hawks mounted a rally. Rockhurst had a chance to tie or win the game with a three-pointer with 0.7 seconds left but Foster stripped the ball away from Rockhurst's Travis House as he squared up to shoot as time expired.

Williams led the Panthers with 17 points going 6 for 7 from the field and 5 for 5 from the free throw line. Foster added 11 points for Drury.

The Panthers shot 53 percent from the field going 27 for 51 while holding Rockhurst to 42 percent and 22 for 52 shooting. Drury had a 37-25 advantage on the boards.

Kaleb Warner led Rockhurst with a game-high 19 points.

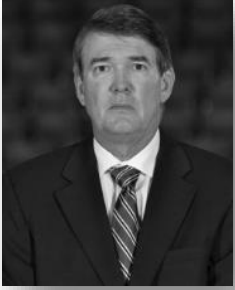

Head Coach – Steve Hesser



Steve Hesser has become one of the most successful and recognized names in NCAA Division II basketball nationwide as he completed his 12th season at the Panthers' helm in 2015-16. In a dozen years, his teams have advanced to the NCAA-II Tournament eight times, won two NCAA-II Regional championships, three Great Lakes Valley Conference championships and the 2013 NCAA-II national title with a 74-73 win over Metro State in Atlanta, Georgia.

The Panthers are the four-time defending champions in the GLVC West Division after going 19-8 and 14-4 in the conference last year. Drury has won or shared a GLVC West Division crown in seven of the Panthers' 11 years as a

league member with each of those titles coming under coach Hesser.

Hesser owns a career record of 276-100 (.741) and has the second most wins in Drury history trailing only A.L. Weiser's 316 victories that came in a 31-year span. Hesser's .741 winning percentage as a head coach is behind only Jerry Kirksey's mark of .943 that came in his lone season at the helm in 1978-79. Hesser is also among the top 10 active coaches in NCAA-II in wins and winning percentage.

The Panthers followed their 2013 NCAA-II national championship, capped by a thrilling 74-73 come-from-behind victory over Metro State., with a 28-4 season, another GLVC championship and their second straight trip to the NCAA-II Elite Eight in a year where they had graduated the best backcourt in program history.

Hesser came to Drury from Glendale High School in Springfield where he went 97-39 in five seasons. He was the head coach at Bartlesville High School, where his teams won state titles in 1989, 1991 and 1992 and twice earned state Coach of the Year honors. His Bartlesville teams also finished second in the state in 1988 and made the state quarterfinals in 1986 and 1990. He also coached the prep programs at Pauls Valley and Stillwater, leading the latter to four conference titles and two state tournament appearances in six seasons. His prep coaching record in Oklahoma was 262-142, including a 147-47 mark at Bartlesville.

He has been enshrined into the Oklahoma Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2007, the Bartlesville Sports Hall of Fame in 2011 and Missouri Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2014.

As a player, Hesser was a two-sport standout at Stillwater High, excelling in both basketball and football. He started his college playing career in both sports at New Mexico Military Academy before moving on to finish his college education, and playing days, at the University of Central Oklahoma.

His playing career ultimately cut short by a leg injury, Hesser finished his undergraduate degree work at Oklahoma State, then earned his master's degree in secondary education from Oklahoma in 1985.

Hesser and his wife, Patti, have one son; Tyler is a Drury graduate and former a student assistant basketball coach for the Panthers and is now an accountant in Springfield. Tyler and wife Stephanie have one child, three-year-old son Henry Thomas Hesser.
