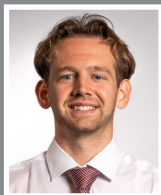

THE OPPONENTS

ABOUT CONCORDIA-ST. PAUL

- Concordia-St. Paul was picked to finish fourth in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference's preseason poll and is receiving votes in the NABC's Preseason Division II Coaches Poll.
- Last season, the Golden Bears logged the best season in program history, finishing 22-9 with a 16-6 mark in Northern Sun play to claim their first-ever NSIC regular-season title.
- CSP went on to secure an at-large bid to the NCAA Central Regional, where they defeated Minot State in the quarterfinals before falling to host Washburn in the semifinals.
- Head coach Matt Fletcher was named NSIC Coach of the Year.
- The Golden Bears enter the week a perfect 3-0 on the season following victories over Nebraska-Kearney, Fort Hayes State and Winona State.
- CSP is averaging 86.7 points per contest and shooting .478 from the floor as a team, including a blistering .458 from beyond the arc.
- Ben Kopetzki leads the offense with his 24.7 ppg average; the junior guard is shooting .468 from the field and .957 (22-of-23) from the foul line.

HEAD COACH MATT FLETCHER

- Fletcher brings a 123-118 overall head coaching record into Tuesday's tournament opener.
- In his sixth season at the helm for Concordia, he has compiled a 47-85 mark as the Golden Bears bench boss.
- A graduate of Southwest Minnesota State, Fletcher set school records for three-point field goals and free-throw percentage during his collegiate playing career.
- Prior to taking over in St. Paul, Fletcher put together a 76-33 record as head coach at NCAA D-III Bethany Lutheran, where he helped the Vikings to a 52-12 mark in the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference (UMAC), including a pair of conference tournament titles and NCAA appearances.

ABOUT CENTRAL MISSOURI

- Central Missouri entered the 2025-26 campaign as the third-winningest program in NCAA Division II with 1,778 victories, having won two national titles (1984 & 2014) and four championships (1937 & 1938 NAIB) overall.
- UCM returns four players from last year's 15-15 squad, including MIAA Freshman of the Year Kyran Tilley, as well as sophomore guard Jake Fritz, junior forward Noah Martin and sophomore forward Kyree Polk.
- The Mules bring a 4-2 season record into Tuesday's action, including wins over No. 10 Colorado School of Mines, New Mexico Highlands, Sioux Falls and GLVC member Upper Iowa.
- As a team, UCM is averaging 79.7 points, while allowing 79.2 points per outing through its first six games.
- The Mules are shooting .487 as a team, led by Lazerek Houston's .506 mark and 21.3 ppg average.
- Tilley (15.5 ppg) and Jevon Hill (14.2 ppg) give the Mules a trio of double-figure scorers.

HEAD COACH ADAM BOHAC

- Adam Bohac enters his third season as head coach on the heels of a 15-15 campaign a year ago.
- He led the Mules to a 9-10 season mark in the MIAA, highlighted by a pair of all-conference selections, including Kyran Tilley as the league's Freshman of the Year.
- Prior to his arrival at UCM, Bohac served as head coach at Southern Nazarene for 15 seasons, compiling a 312-146 record.

ABOUT DRURY

- DU is coming off back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 2019-21 after going 14-13 a year ago and 15-13 in 2023-24.
- The Panthers are off to their first 4-0 start in six years, paced by an offense that features four double-figure scorers, led by junior guard **Zach Howell** (16.5 ppg/5.8 rpg/4.0 apg) and sophomore guard **Colin Hardrick** (16.3 ppg/8.0 rpg/2.8 apg).
- Howell is DU's leading returning scorer, while Hardrick earned GLVC All-Freshman and All-Defensive team honors last winter after averaging 10.2 points, 6.7 boards and 2.0 steals per outing.
- Drury also benefits from the return of junior guard **Luke Stubbs**, who missed all but three games a year ago due to injury, as well as senior forward **Aladji Gassama** and senior guard **Ethan Whatley**.
- Several talented newcomers have contributed significantly in their first two weeks as Panthers: junior transfer **Avante Nichols** has averaged 10.3 points and 6.0 boards per outing, while fellow transfer **Isaiah Otyaluk** has chipped in with 9.7 points per outing; freshman **KeShaun Thomas** (15.0 ppg/5.5 rpg) has been a dominant force in the paint, scoring in double-figures in all four games, including his first double-double as a Panther Saturday vs. Ozark Christian with 16 points and 10 rebounds.

HEAD COACH CHRIS FOSTER

- Now in his fifth season as head coach of the Panthers, **Chris Foster** brings a 52-61 record as DU's mentor.
- The Ironton, Mo., native has compiled a 169-141 overall record in his 12 seasons as a collegiate head coach -- all at the NCAA Division II level within the Great Lakes Valley Conference.
- Prior to accepting the Drury head position, Foster spent three seasons at McKendree, leading the Bearcats to a 34-40 mark, including the program's first winning campaign at the D-II level.
- Foster, a UNI graduate, began his head coaching career with a successful four-year stint at Truman State, where he led the Bulldogs to 20-win seasons each year.

DRURY BASKETBALL LUNCHEONS

- Drury will also host seven **Basketball Luncheons** inside Plaster Gallery/The Lair, located in the O'Reilly Family Event Center.
- The luncheons will feature both DU head coaches, as well as select members of the Panthers and Lady Panthers squads.
- The cost of each 11:30 a.m., luncheon is \$13, with the first gathering slated for Monday, Nov. 10, and additional luncheons scheduled subsequently on Nov. 24, Dec. 8, Jan. 12, Jan. 26, Feb. 9 and Feb. 23.



NOTEWORTHY

OFF AND RUNNING

- Drury has won its first four games for the first time since 2019-20, thanks in large part to a balanced and consistent offensive attack that has averaged 84.8 points per game.
- DU picked up wins in its first two games at the GLVC/G-MAC Conference Challenge (Nov. 14-15), marking the third time in four years under head coach **Chris Foster** the Panthers have accomplished the feat.
- The Panthers have enjoyed balanced contributions from up and down its roster, highlighted by a combined total of 15 different double-digit scoring performances through four games.
- Additionally, seven different newcomers combined to score 162 points in the four games, led by freshman **KeShaun Thomas's** 15.0 ppg average.

PANTHERS CENTURY CLUB

- Drury topped the century mark in scoring with last Wednesday's 108-68 win over Ecclesia, marking the first time the Panthers have done so since a 106-point effort vs. University of the Ozarks on Dec. 5, 2023.
- DU's 108 points marked its best offensive output since a 118-74 win over Missouri S&T on Jan. 13, 2018.
- The victory also marked the third 100+ point total for the Panthers under **Chris Foster**.

ROLLING IN NOVEMBER

- The Panthers improved to 4-0 with Saturday's win over Ozark Christian; DU's last 4-0 start came in 2019-20, when it won its first seven contests en route to a 20-9 season.
- DU has started 4-0 a total of nine times as a Division II program (since 1994).
- The Panthers have started 5-0 on seven occasions since becoming a full D-II member, most recently in 2019-20.
- DU's 4-0 start has continued a recent string of success in the season's first month, with the Panthers going a combined 13-3 in November since the start of the 2023-24 season.
- Since becoming a full member at the Division II level in 1994, Drury has compiled a 113-52 record in the month of November.

GLVC GAINS

- Drury has produced positive gains in the Great Lakes Valley Conference regular season over the past two seasons, including a nine-win league season a year ago that gave the Panthers their top GLVC total in four years.
- The Panthers have increased their conference win total in each of the last two seasons, improving from a 5-15 slate and a 12th place finish in 2022-23 to a 10th-place showing and an 8-12 record in 2023-24 to last year's 9-11 mark and ninth-place effort.
- Overall, the Panthers have won a total of 29 games with their back-to-back winning seasons, marking their best two-year stretch since 2019-20 and 2020-21 (31-19).

ROOKIE NO MORE

- Drury sophomore guard **Colin Hardrick** will look to make an even bigger splash in his second year on the court for the Panthers, despite a standout rookie campaign that netted the Milwaukee native GLVC All-Freshman and All-Defensive Team honors.
- Hardrick led the GLVC in steals (2.0 spg), while pacing the Panthers in rebounding (6.7 rpg) and assists (2.7 apg), in addition to scoring at a 10.2 ppg clip.
- The Milwaukee native picked up right where he left off in DU's season-opening trip to Illinois, logging 21 points and seven rebounds

in the opening game, before posting a 14-point, 15-rebound double-double against Thomas More in game two.

- With his average of 8.0 boards per outing, Hardrick is tied for fourth among all GLVC rebounders.

A FINE HOW-ELL DO YOU DO

- The other multi-faceted half of Drury's potent 1-2 punch, junior guard/forward **Zach Howell**, also turned in a memorable debut season in Scarlet and Gray last winter.
- Like Hardrick, Howell hit the ground running in the first two weeks of the new season, bringing a team-leading 16.5 ppg average into Tuesday's game.
- Howell tallied a season-best 21-point performance vs. Ecclesia (Nov. 19), then added a game-high 19 points in Saturday's win over Ozark Christian, going 5-of-9 from three-point range.
- So far in 2025-26, Howell ranks among the GLVC leaders in scoring, assists (4.0), steals (2.8), three-point field goals made (12) and three-point shooting percentage (.444).
- Last season the Springfield native averaged 13.2 points and 4.6 rebounds per outing following his return home after competing for two seasons at Division-I Milwaukee.
- Howell was not only the Panthers' top long-distance threat with his team-best 72 3-point field goal makes, but also DU's No. 2 rebounder to go along with the fourth-best steal (23) total on the club.

NEW PANTHERS PROVIDE A LIFT

- Drury's talented eight-man 2025 recruiting class has made an immediate impact for the Panthers over the first four games.
- Most notably, junior guard **Avante Nichols** has been a stalwart on both ends of the floor for the Panthers, scoring in double figures in three of DU's four games, while shooting a GLVC-best .769 from the floor; Nichols also leads the Panthers with eight dunks and has pulled down an average of 6.0 rebounds per game.
- Freshman forward **KeShaun Thomas** has asserted himself early in the season as well, starting his DU career with four straight double-digit point totals in the Panthers four wins; on Saturday, the Quincy, Ill., native logged his first double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds vs. Ozark Christian.
- Finally, the freshman duo of **Isaiah Otyaluk** and **Kevin Sargeant** have each turned in memorable contributions over the first two weeks of their Drury careers; Otyaluk scored 19 points on 7-of-10 shooting vs. Ecclesia (Nov. 19), while Sargeant is averaging 5.0 rebounds, 1.3 steals and 1.3 blocks to date.

DU TABBED FIFTH IN GLVC PRESEASON POLL

- Drury was tabbed fifth in the GLVC 2025-26 Men's Basketball Preseason Coaches' Poll.
- Drury received 121 points in the poll, finishing behind preseason favorite Missouri S&T (196) -- which received 14 first-place votes -- as well as Lincoln (174), UMSL (161) and Rockhurst (141). Rounding out the poll was Indianapolis (115), Lewis (114), McKendree (109), Illinois Springfield (97), William Jewell (96), Upper Iowa (78), Truman State (69), Quincy (51), Maryville (33) and Southwest Baptist (20).
- The Panthers are coming off a 14-13 season under Foster, who enters his fifth year as Drury's head coach. DU returns six letterwinners, including a pair of starters in junior **Zach Howell** and sophomore **Colin Hardrick**.

Chris Foster begins his fifth season at the helm of the Drury men's program and his 12th year overall as a collegiate head coach in 2025-26. Foster's rebuilding efforts at Drury have taken root over the past two seasons, as the Panthers posted their second consecutive winning season in 2024-25.

DU's growth over the past two winters has been evident on the court, as four different Panthers have earned All-Great Lakes Valley Conference honors, including sophomore guard **Colin Hardrick**. One of the conference's top all-around talents, Hardrick led the GLVC in steals while averaging 10.2 points and ranking among the league's top 10 players in rebounding to earn All-Freshman and All-Defensive Team honors.

The Panthers' 14-win season last year followed a breakthrough 2023-24 campaign that saw Drury post a 15-13 record, marking a six-game improvement from the previous year. The Panthers featured All-Great Lakes Valley Conference selection Logan Applegate, while Brock Wakefield was named to the All-Defensive team, and Juok Riak was selected for the All-Freshman squad.

Foster was named Drury's head coach on March 23, 2021, and arrived from McKendree, where he led the fellow GLVC program for three years. In 2020-21, he guided the Bearcats to their best finish ever in the GLVC as McKendree went 10-8 in the conference and ended the year in fourth place overall. The previous season, Foster put together the program's first-ever above .500 season at the NCAA-II level as the Bearcats went 15-13 and 10-10 in the conference.

Before his stint at McKendree, he was the head coach at Truman State, also a GLVC member, where he not only turned the Bulldogs around, but also laid the foundation for a program that has been one the best in Division II, as Truman advanced to the Elite Eight and was ranked as high as No. 2 in the nation in 2021.

Foster spent four seasons as Truman State's head coach putting together a record of 83-40. His team reached the NCAA-II tournament in 2017 and 2018, and their 2017 trip was their first national tourney berth in 11 years. While at Truman State, Foster recruited and signed four-time All-GLVC selection Brodrick Thomas, who reached the NBA with the Boston Celtics, Cleveland Cavaliers, and Houston Rockets.

Foster is the 20th head coach in Drury's 118-year history as a men's basketball program, and he is only the eighth man to fill the role since 1965.

Prior to becoming head coach at Truman State, Foster was the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for the Bulldogs.

Originally from Ironton, Mo., Foster played college basketball for Northern Iowa, was an All-Freshman selection in the Missouri Valley Conference, and scored more than 1,000 points in his collegiate career. He was a part of NCAA tournament teams in 2004 and 2005, and currently ranks 44th on Northern Iowa's all-time scoring list.

Foster stayed at UNI to serve as a graduate assistant, then transitioned to director of basketball operations for the Panthers. After coaching at the high school level, he returned to his alma mater to rejoin the coaching staff as video coordinator in 2011.

Foster is 169-141 in 12 seasons as a collegiate head coach. His 2018 Truman State squad was the GLVC's co-West Division champion, and three of his teams have won the conference's Sportsmanship Award.

He and his wife, Kylie, have three children – son Jase, and daughters Avery and Riley.



NEW LOOK STAFF FOR 2025-26

- Drury's bench will have a bit of a different look this winter with the addition of two new assistant coaches for the upcoming season.
- Foster turned to a familiar face to fill one of those spots, hiring former DU assistant **Sam Briscoe** in May.
- Briscoe returns to the program after serving as an assistant under Foster in 2021-22 and two years as a graduate assistant for Steve Hesser from 2019-21.
- Briscoe will replace assistant Marc Sonnen, who resigned for an assistant coaching position at his alma mater, UNI.
- For the last three years, Briscoe has been a head coach at the high school level in the St. Louis area and, for the last two seasons, led the prestigious Christian Brothers College (CBC) program.
- The Panthers also welcomed former Iowa State staffer **Brian Pearson** to Springfield over the summer to fill the final assistant post on his bench.
- Pearson arrives at Drury after spending the past four seasons with the Iowa State men's program, where he contributed to four NCAA Tournament appearances and two trips to the Sweet 16 under head coach T.J. Otzelberger.
- During his tenure in Ames, the Cyclones amassed 95 wins, and Pearson played a role in the development of eight All-Big 12 selections.

AT HOME IN THE O'

The **O'Reilly Family Event Center** is home to the Drury University Athletics offices and serves as the home venue for men's and women's basketball and volleyball.

The arena, built in 2010 for \$13.5 million, was rated as the top NCAA Division II facility in the continental United States and the second-best building in the division by HERO Sports.

The O' features six luxury suites, the Plaster Gallery banquet room, and a seating capacity of 2,850 for basketball games. It can hold 3,160 for a seated floor concert and up to 3,592 for a general admission standing concert. Acts that have performed in The O' include Jax, Willie Nelson and Merle Haggard, Incubus, Dierks Bentley, Florida Georgia Line, Rob Zombie, Korn, Trevor Noah, Avett Brothers, The Pointer Sisters, Jack's Mannequin, Chicago, Kelly Clarkson, Bryan Adams, Sheryl Crow, Lynyrd Skynyrd, REO/Slyx/Ted Nugent, and many more.

Fans have been greeted with a rich tradition of success inside The O'. The arena has hosted six NCAA-II Midwest Regional Tournaments, five of which resulted in regional championships. Drury basketball programs have combined for 21 National Tournament appearances, 11 Conference Championships, and a pair of dominant home records — 176-43 for the Panthers and an incredible 193-21 for the Lady Panthers. The O' has been the site of some of Drury's most historic moments, including the men's 2013 NCAA-II National Championship and the Lady Panthers' undefeated 32-0 season in 2020.
