***The Match-Up - DSU vs. SHU***

The Hornets are out to stop a four game losing streak, while the Pirates are trying to regroup after a setback to N.C. State.

***Last Time Out ...***

Cold shooting was definitely a major problem that the Delaware State Hornets could not overcome, falling 65-33 to the Musketeers of Xavier University. The Hornets shot 26.1% from the floor for the game while the Musketeers finished the evening shooting 49%.

***Series Against Seton Hall...***

This is the first meeting between the Hornets and the Pirates. The Pirates have a 9-0 record against MEAC opponents.

***Last Time Out for the Pirates...***

SHU dropped a 79-73 game to N.C. State last Thursday at the Prudential Center.

***Next Match-Up...***

The Hornets will still be on the road, but will have a 12 day break before their second conference game facing the Bulldogs of S.C. State on January 12th....

***From the Hornets Nest***

The men’s basketball team has been picked to finish second in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference behind Hampton University. The pre-season pick was made by the league’s head coaches and sports information directors. The Hornets collected 13 first place votes along with Hampton.

**Greg Jackson** is the second coach in DSU history to win over 100 games as head coach. Bennie George (1949-71) won 201 games during his DSU tenure....

***Douse & Smith Are In***

Sophomores Kris Douse and Melvin Smith saw action for the first time this season when the Hornets took on Cal. Douse a 6’6, 210 guard from Brampton, Ontario is a transfer from the University of Nebraska and also played at Laurinburg Institute where he was an all-star at Five Star camp. Smith is a 6’1, 170 guard from Burlington, NJ who scored 1,300 points and averaged 19 points per game at Burlington Township. Both players became eligible after the first semester.

**DSU Head Coach Greg Jackson** (St. Paul's 80)  
**Record at DSU:** 121-104(Eighth year); **career:** 284-181 (17<sup>th</sup> year) Including this season



Jackson was selected as the 2005-06 MEAC Coach-of-the-Year after leading the Hornets to their second straight MEAC regular season title. The team also set school records for overall wins (21), regular season wins (18) and MEAC wins (16). The 2005-06 Hornets also won the first post-season game in school history by defeating Northern Arizona 58-54 in the opening round of the National Invitation

Tournament. Jackson was also selected as the 2005 Coach-of-the-Year by the *Delaware Sportswriters and Broadcasters Association*. In 2004-05, Jackson led the Hornets to the first MEAC regular season and tournament titles in team history. The conference championship earned DSU its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Jackson acquitted himself quite well against legendary Duke coach **Mike Krzyzewski** in the Hornets' 57-46 loss to the Blue Devils in the NCAA Tournament. The Hornets have finished in at least a tie for second place in the final MEAC regular season standings in each of his six seasons. Jackson has a 77-31 record in MEAC regular season games (.713). Delaware State was 30-78 in the four years prior to his arrival. He inherited a team that was 6-22 the previous season. Before accepting the Delaware State post, Jackson spent 16 years at Division II North Carolina Central University, the last nine as head coach. While at NCCU, Jackson never had a losing season, and led the team to a 163-75 overall record. He guided the Eagles to five Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA) division titles, and three trips to the NCAA playoffs. He also earned three CIAA Coach-of-the-Year awards. Jackson was a North Carolina Central assistant coach when the team won the NCAA Division II national title in 1989. As a player at St. Paul's (Va.), he was a three-time All-CIAA selection. During his junior year, he led all collegiate players in scoring, averaging 30.5 points per game.

**MEAC dominance**

Delaware State has enjoyed a great deal of success in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference in the **Greg Jackson** era. After last season the Hornets are 87-33 in MEAC regular season games under Jackson (.725).

Delaware State has won 40 of its last 46 games against MEAC opponents, including 32 in the regular season, dating back to the 2004-05 campaign. The Hornets have a combined record of 41-8 in MEAC regular season games the last three years. Delaware State has posted at least 11 MEAC wins in each of Jackson's six seasons. Prior to Jackson's arrival in 2000, the Hornets had eight straight non-winning seasons in MEAC play.

**MEAC Leaders**

**Roy Bright** was leading the MEAC in scoring with a 19.3 point per game average before the last game, but his season low of two points dropped him to a 17.6 average...

Freshman point guard **Trevor Welcher** has started his collegiate career with impressive assist numbers dishing out 4.3 a game. He is leading the MEAC in assists and turnover margin....

**National Categories**

The Hornets are ranked ninth in the country in personal fouls per game, 24th in team free throw percentage and 58th in turnovers per game....

**Road warriors**

The Hornets have spent a great deal of time packing and unpacking this season. Delaware State has played eight of the their first ten games on the road. Including the final two games of their 2007 half of the schedule, the Hornets have had 10 straight road games. As usual DSU has not back down from tough competition, seeing action against opponents from the SEC, Pac-10, Atlantic 10 and the Big East....The Hornets next two conference games will also be in hostile territory, returning home for the first time since the Round Ball Classic (Nov. 9-10) on January 19th against Norfolk State....

**Shooting Drought**

The Hornets have been battle tested with their non-conference schedule and in three games their shooting from the floor really

hurt their chances. Their season low was against Arizona State when they shot 20% from the floor. Against Xavier they shot 26% and against Georgia it was 28%. In the Georgia game the Hornets had opportunities because of the defensive effort losing to the Bulldogs by nine (47-58).

**Foreign-born Hornets**

The 2007-08 Hornets roster includes three players born outside of the United States. Sophomore forward **Mark D'Agostino** (Dag-ah-stee-noo) is from Montreal, Canada, **Andre Topic** (Tah-pik) is from Zagreb, Croatia and Nebraska transfer **Kris Douse** (rhymes with house) is from Toronto, Canada....

**Post-season quest**

The Hornets are hoping the 2007-08 campaign ends in a fourth-straight trip to a national post-season tournament. Last season the Hornets were denied the opportunity to the big dance, when Florida A&M won at the buzzer in the MEAC championship game and they made their second consecutive trip to the NIT. West Virginia won in the first round 74-50. In 2006 the Hornets were 1-1 in the National Invitation Tournament, defeating Northern Arizona (58-54) before falling to Louisville (71-54). Three seasons ago, Delaware State made their first post-season appearance in team history. The 16<sup>th</sup> seeded Hornets put up a good fight before falling to top-seed Duke 57-46 in the first round of the 2005 NCAA Tournament in Charlotte, NC. Delaware State trailed 12-3 before going on a 13-1 run to open up a 16-13 lead with 11:49 left in the first half. The game was tied at 20, 22 and 28 before Duke rallied to lead 35-28 at the half. The Hornets held Duke's **J.J. Redick** to a season-low seven points on one-of-seven shooting from the field.

**HORNETS On TV**

DSU will appear on national television twice this season during conference action. On February 9th at home in Dover, the Hornets will host Hampton on ESPN2 and on February 18th ESPNU will televised the N.C. Carolina A&T match-up from Greensboro, NC....

The Delaware State men's basketball team is off to a good start in its bid for a fourth straight Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) regular season title.
