MOUNTAINEERS

» THE GAME

The Delaware State women's basketball team (3-5, 0-1 MEAC) will look to avoid losing three consecutive games for the first time this season when it takes on Big 12 foe West Virginia (8-1) in what will be the second contest of a season-long three-game road swing.

» THE OPPONENT

After dropping its season opener to Ohio State, 70-61, WVU has ripped off eight-straight wins, with six of those victories by at least 20 points.

The Mountaineers have four players averaging 10 points or more per contest, led by guard **Christal Caldwell** (14.7 ppg). Also, in the backcourt, **Bria Holmes** is averaging 13.4 points per game, to go along with a team-high 11 steals, whereas guard **Taylor Palmer** (13.1 ppg) leads the team from beyond the arc at 33 percent (19-of-58). On the block, center **Asya Bussie** (13 ppg) is averaging a team-high 7.8 rebounds per game and leading WVU in blocks (17).

» THE COACH

In his 13th season at the helm, **Mike Carey's** resume features two Big East Coach of the Year honors and six NCAA Tournament appearances, including a current streak of four-straight. In addition, Carey holds the highest winning percentage by any coach in WVU history with an overall record of 252-142 (.639).

» THE SERIES

Delaware State is 1-2 all-time against West Virginia. In their last meeting, the Mountaineers came away with a 66-31 victory at home in the first game of the 2010-11 season. DSU's lone win of the series occurred in 2003 at home in overtime, 59-56.

A WIN WOULD MEAN...

LAST TIME OUT...

The Lady Hornets fell 93-44 to No. 8 Maryland on the road this past Saturday. DSU's offense struggled as MU's defense held the Lady Hornets to 24 percent (15-of-62) shooting. Despite the tough night, guard **Raven Bankston** finished with a game-high 22 points as the only player who scored in double figures for DSU. Bankston also totaled six rebounds, one steal and one assist.

BANKSTON TALLIES BACK-TO-BACK MEAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK HONORS, THIRD OVERALL

For the second straight week and for the third time this season, guard **Raven Bankston** was named MEAC Rookie of the Week, after her 22-point and six-rebound performance at No. 8 Maryland.

With this feat, she is the first Hornet to garner this award three times in a season since forward **Tierra Hawkins** did it during the 2011-12 season, as she went on to win MEAC Rookie of the Year.

Last week, in DSU's thrilling 90-83 overtime victory at home over George Mason, Bankston was one of four players to score in double figures as she poured in 18 points

(6-of-15).

Later in the week, despite the Lady Hornets' 80-75 loss at home to Coppin State, the Detroit, Mich. native, scored a team-high 21 points (7-of-21), including a 5-for-6 (.833) output from the charity stripe.

Earlier in the season on Nov. 11, Bankston earned the award, after totaling 18 points (8-of-12), including 2-for-3 (.666) beyond the arc, five rebounds and a steal in DSU's season opening loss at Old Dominion.

MOVING UP THE CAREER LIST

Despite DSU's recent loss to the Terps, forward **Deanna Harmon** tallied two assists to move into sixth (228) on DSU's all-time career assists list.

AT THIS POINT LAST SEASON...

The Lady Hornets were 2-6 overall and 1-1 in MEAC action, coming off a 79-57 loss at home to Albany.

COMING UP NEXT...

DSU will concluded its three-game road trip against Marshall this Saturday at 12 p.m.

SCRAPPY HORNETS

On the defense end, the Lady Hornets are forcing 21.6 turnovers per game (173 total), which is good for a +3.1 turnover margin.

Steals wise, they have 10 more (78-68) than their opponents with four players in double figures, led by **Jade Washington** and **Deanna**

FEAR THE HAWK

After earning Second Team All-
 MEAC honors last season, junior
Tierra Hawkins has picked up
 where she left off.

So far in 2013-14, the Clinton, Md.
 native, not only leads the MEAC
 and Lady Hornets in scoring (23.0
 ppg), but she sits 16th in the nation.
 Additionally, Hawkins leads the
 Lady Hornets in rebounds (9.4 rpg)
 and double-doubles (3).

In DSU's 86-73 win at home over
 Wilmington (Nov. 20), Hawkins tied
 what was then a career-high 30
 points and matched a career-high
 in rebounds (15). Also, in this game,
 she tallied 1,000 career points to
 become the 15th player in team
 history to reach this milestone.

Currently, she needs nine points to
 pass **Kim Taylor** (1987-92) to place
 10th on DSU's all-time scoring list.
 Currently, Hawkins' career point
 total stands 1,129.

Unfortunately, after injuring her
 shoulder in the first half against
 Coppin State (Dec. 7), she missed
 her first game ever as a Hornet in
 DSU's loss at No. 8 Maryland (Dec.
 14).

RAVEN CONTINUING HOT START, RAINE DONE FOR THE SEASON

After earning MEAC Rookie of the
 Week honors for the third time this
 season, guard **Raven Bankston**
 added to her hot start this season.

In addition to scoring in double
 figures each contest, she is second
 on the team and fourth in the
 MEAC in scoring (19.4 ppg). She
 also first in three-pointers made (8)
 on the squad.

As for her twin sister, **Raine**, her
 season abruptly ended with a
 knee injury suffered in practice in
 preparation for DSU's game against
 George Mason (Dec.4).

In five starts, she averaged 7.6 points, 3.6 assists (second most on the team), 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game.

Coming out of high school, both ranked among the top 20 high school players in Michigan and helped lead John Glenn High School to city and district championships as seniors.

In a game during their high school careers, they combined for 75 points.

ALL BY HERSELF

Standing as the lone senior, guard/forward **Deanna Harmon** is averaging 12.4 points, 6.9 rebounds and a team leading 2.0 steals per contest. In addition, her team leading 58 percent (36-of-62) is also tops in the conference. From the line, the Owings Mills, Md. native, is 27-of-34 (.794).

"FLOOR" GENERAL WASHINGTON

Starting every game this season, guard **Jade Washington** leads the team in assists at 4.1 per contest, 33 total. Her highest output of the season occurred in DSU's 90-83 overtime win at home against George Mason (Dec. 4) as she finished with eight.

Last season, she led the Lady Hornets in the assist department at 3.5 assists per game, which was good for fourth in the MEAC. Washington is also leading the team in steals at 2.0 per contest, 16 total.

HAWKINS GARNERS MEAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

HONORS

On Nov. 25, forward **Tierra Hawkins** was named MEAC Player of the Week for the first time in her stellar career as a Hornet.

In games against Wilmington and Albany, Hawkins averaged 29.5 points, shooting 66-percent from the field (25-of-38), with 10.0 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 2.0 steals.

HORNETS PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN THE MEAC

The Delaware State Lady Hornets were picked to finish 10th (254 points) in the MEAC Preseason Standings.

Holding down the top spot was defending regular season and conference tournament champions, Hampton (658), who received 20 first-place votes. Additionally, Hampton's **Alyssa Bennett** was named Co-MEAC Preseason Player of the Year, along with FAMU's **Jasmine Grace**.

Picked to finish second, meanwhile, was North Carolina A&T (599 points), followed by Coppin State (457 points), Florida A&M (429 points), Howard (318 points), Morgan State (314 points), South Carolina State (303 points), Bethune-Cookman (302 points) and UMES (257 points).

Rounding out the rest of the preseason predicted order of finish were Norfolk State (238 points), Savannah State (118 points) and North Carolina Central (80 points).

RETURNERS

Along with **Tierra Hawkins** and **Deanna Harmon**, DSU's floor general last season, point guard **Jade Washington**, returns for the Lady Hornets. Washington was tops on the club with 108 assists to rank fourth in the MEAC (3.5 apg) last season. In addition, she recorded a team-high 54 steals in her first season in a Hornet uniform after coming over from Arizona Western. Rounding out the rest of the Hornets' returning players are sophomore **N'Kayah Kersey** and junior **Coreenah Redden**.

Appearing in 31 games last season, including 10 starts, Kersey will provide depth at the guard position, while Redden will do the same after playing in 26 games in 2012-13.

FRESH FACES

Delaware State's newcomers include standout twin sisters **Raven** and **Raine Bankston** out of Detroit, Mich.

Also, in the backcourt, is the addition of sharpshooter **Diamond Williams** out of Newark, N.J.

Forwards **Tylinn Carter** and **Mi'Queara Lewis**, meanwhile, will look to make solid contributions in their first seasons in a Hornet uniform.

Hailing from San Diego, Calif., by way of Serra High School, Carter averaged 14.1 points and 4.1 assists per game to help lead her squad to the Eastern League championship last season.

In the case of Lewis, she averaged 12 points and 10 rebounds per game, to go along with shooting 85 percent from the line. As a senior at Digital Harbor High School (Baltimore, Md.), she led her team to a Division I title.

In addition, walk-on freshman **Kareena Pitts** will compete for playing time down on the block.

TOUGH ROAD AHEAD

The 2013-14 schedule for the Lady Hornets will be a tough one, headlined by five NCAA Tournament teams from last season in Vanderbilt, Albany, No. 8 Maryland, West Virginia and defending regular season and conference tournament MEAC champions, Hampton.

Second Season at DSU | Record: 13-26 (6-11 MEAC)

A new era began on Thursday, May 31, 2012 for the Delaware State University women's basketball team as President **Harry L. Williams** introduced **Tamika L. Louis**, a former championship junior college head coach and Division I assistant coach, as the new head coach.

In her first season, the Lady Hornets finished 10-21 overall, including 6-10 in MEAC action to earn the ninth seed in the conference tournament. Nevertheless, DSU took down the eighth-seeded Bethune-Cookman Wildcats in the opening round, 55-44, to snap a five-year MEAC tournament skid.

Meanwhile, forward **Tierra Hawkins** was able to garner Second Team All-MEAC honors by leading the Lady Hornets in scoring (17.1 ppg) and rebounding (7.4 rpg).

Louis arrived at Delaware State with 14 years of coaching and recruiting experience on the NCAA Division I, Junior College and high school levels. Before accepting the position at DSU, she served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2011-12 season at George Washington University in Washington, D.C.

"As the Lady Hornets' head coach, I will be a servant-leader and hope that my energy, dedication and work ethic will be infectious to the young ladies on the team."

Louis added: "We will establish a winning culture here with an expectation to excel in the classroom and on the court, resulting in MEAC championships. Just as important, we will develop future leaders who, upon graduation, will make an immediate impact in our global society and positively represent DSU"

From 2009-11, Louis was an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for St. John's University, where she was in charge of organizing all recruiting initiatives, game scouting, overseeing player academic progress and off-court mentoring. Additionally, she was responsible for the development of the Red Storm guards, including Second Team All-Big East and Freshman All-American Shennicka Smith.

Prior to her time at SJU, Louis served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Illinois from 2007-09 where she was instrumental in signing the No. 2 and No. 3 ranked players in the 2009 class in the country, according to ESPN Hoop Girl and Blue Star rankings, in All-Americans Destiny Williams and Karisma Penn.

From 2002-05, she was the head women's basketball coach at Mott Community College in Flint, Mich., where she led her squad to a 58-33 overall record during her tenure. The 2004-05 squad boasted a 16-0 conference record and was 27-7 overall en route to a NJCAA Region XII championship and bid to the NJCAA Tournament. For her efforts during this stellar season, Louis was named the Michigan Community College Athletic Association and Region XII Coach of the Year.
