### TERRIERS

### » THE GAME

Coming off a season-long three-game road swing, the Delaware State women's basketball team (3-7, 0-1 MEAC) returns to Memorial Hall for the first time since Dec. 7 to take on the St. Francis Brooklyn Terriers (8-2), looking to end a four-game losing skid.

### » THE OPPONENT

The Lady Terriers enter Sunday afternoon's contest on a four-game winning streak, while their two losses on the season occurred against St. John's and Miami. As a team, St. Francis Brooklyn is holding its opponents to 58 points per game, including 37 percent shooting from the floor and 27 percent from beyond the arc.

On the offensive end, the Lady Terriers have three players averaging double figures in the scoring column, led by guard **Eilidh Simpson** (13.4 ppg). In addition to leading the squad in scoring, Simpson is shooting 51 percent (20-of-39) from three-point range and was recently named Co-NEC Player of the Week. Forward **Jaymee Veney**, meanwhile, is averaging 12.2 points per game and leading the squad in rebounding (6.7 rpg), whereas forward **Sarah Benedetti** is totaling 11.7 points per contest off the bench.

### » THE COACH

**John Thurston** is in his second season with the St. Francis Brooklyn women's basketball program. Last season, Thurston led the Lady Terriers to an 11-19 overall record, including an 8-10 output in conference play.

### » THE SERIES

DSU is 3-2 all-time against the Terriers. The last meeting between these two programs occurred last season with the Lady Hornets falling on the road, 69-50.

**A WIN WOULD MEAN...**

» The Lady Hornets would snap their longest losing streak of the season.  
 » DSU's home record would be 3-1.  
 » The Hornets' first win over St. Francis Brooklyn since Dec. 22, 2010 with DSU pulling out a 62-42 win on the road.  
 » Delaware State would be 4-7 for the first since the 2002-03 season.

**LAST TIME OUT...**

The Lady Hornets fell 62-47 to Marshall to complete their three-game road trip.

Returning after missing the previous two games due to a shoulder injury was leading scorer (21.5 ppg) and rebounder (9.9 rpg) **Tierra Hawkins**, who finished the game with 11 points (4-of-14) and a team-high 13 rebounds for her fourth double-double of the season.

DSU's **Raven Bankston**, on the other hand, led the team in scoring with 21 points, despite a tough 8-for-24 (.333), including a 2-for-9 (.333) performance from beyond the arc. She also committed a game-high seven turnovers and pulled down five rebounds.

At game's end, the Lady Hornets shot its second lowest field goal percentage of the season at 28 percent (17-of-60). In addition to forcing 22 DSU turnovers, the Thundering Herd scored 20 points off those miscues. Delaware State did, however, win the battle boards at 42-37.

**BOTH ENDS SLIPPING**

In the first seven games of the season, the Lady Hornets scored at least 65 points and averaged 77 points per contest on 42 percent shooting. Also during this stretch, Delaware State forced 23 turnovers per game, including 11 steals, and averaged 23 points off those miscues.

However, the Lady Hornets have seen both their offensive and defensive production decline of late.

In the last three games, DSU has been held under 50 points and averaged 46 points per game on shooting 28 percent from the field, including 20 percent from three-point range. Additionally, opponents are forcing 22 turnovers per game, including 11 steals, while DSU is giving up 88 points on 49 percent shooting from the floor.

**HOME COOKIN' ON THE MENU**

DSU's contest against St. Francis will begin a stretch of playing four out of its next five games at home.

After traveling to Howard on Jan. 2, the Lady Hornets will have a three-game homestand with matchups against NJIT (Jan. 7), Hampton (Jan. 11) and Norfolk State (Jan. 13).

In three home games this season, Delaware State is 2-1 and averaging 84 points per game on 40 percent shooting, while forcing 26 turnovers and 12 steals per contest on the defensive end.

**ROAD WOES**

In seven road games this season, DSU is 1-6 and being outscored 84-60. Offensively, the Lady Hornets

are shooting 37 percent from field, including 22 percent from beyond the arc, while also dishing out 74 assists, compared to 131 by their oppositions.

On the defensive end, opposing squads are shooting 47 percent, along with owning the rebounding advantage at 312-235.

### MOVING UP THE CAREER LIST

Despite DSU's recent loss to Marshall, two players moved up on DSU's all-time career list in two categories.

With her 11 points, junior **Tierra Hawkins** is now 10th all-time on DSU's scoring list with 1,142 career points.

Senior **Deanna Harmon**, meanwhile, now sits in a two-way tie with **Alfreda Jefferson** (1994-96) for fifth all-time in career assists (229).

### AT THIS POINT LAST SEASON...

The Lady Hornets were 2-8 overall and 1-1 MEAC action, coming off a 69-61 loss at Towson.

### COMING UP NEXT...

DSU will head to Washington, D.C. to face MEAC foe Howard on Jan. 2 (5 p.m.).

### HAWKINS DOESN'T MISS A BEAT

After missing the last two games due to a shoulder injury, junior **Tierra Hawkins** tallied a team-leading fourth double-double of the season in DSU's loss at Marshall.

So far in 2013-14, the Clinton, Md. native, leads Lady Hornets in scoring (21.5 ppg), which is good for third in the MEAC and 24th in the nation. Additionally, Hawkins leads the Lady Hornets in rebounds (9.9 rpg).

In DSU's 86-73 win at home over Wilmington (Nov. 20), Hawkins tied what was then a career-high 30 points and matched a career-high in rebounds (15). Also, in this game, she tallied 1,000 career points to become the 15th player in team history to reach this milestone.

On Nov. 25, she was named MEAC Player of the Week for the first time in her stellar career as a Hornet.

In games against Wilmington and Albany, Hawkins averaged 29.5 points, shooting 66-percent from the field (25-of-38), with 10.0 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 2.0 steals.

**ALL BY HERSELF**

Standing as the lone senior, guard/forward **Deanna Harmon** is averaging 11.6 points, 6.6 rebounds and a team-leading 1.8 steals per contest. In addition, her team leading 55 percent (41-of-74) is second in the conference. From the line, the Owings Mills, Md. native, is shooting a team-best 83 percent (34-of-41).

**"FLOOR" GENERAL WASHINGTON**

Starting every game this season, guard **Jade Washington** leads the team in assists at 3.9 per contest, 39 total. Her highest output of the season occurred in DSU's 90-83 overtime win at home against George Mason (Dec. 4) as she finished with a career-high eight.

Washington is also sits second on the team in steals at 1.7 per contest, 17 total.

Last season, she led the Lady Hornets in the assist department at 3.5 assists per game, which was good for fourth in the MEAC.

**BANKSTON TALLIES THIRD MEAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK HONOR**

On Dec. 16, in what was for the second straight week and for the third time this season, guard **Raven Bankston** was named MEAC Rookie of the Week, after her 22-point and six-rebound

performance at No. 8 Maryland.

With this feat, she is the first Hornet to garner this award three times in a season since forward **Tierra Hawkins** did it during the 2011-12 season, as she went on to win MEAC Rookie of the Year.

The previous week, in DSU's thrilling 90-83 overtime victory at home over George Mason, Bankston was one of four players to score in double figures as she poured in 18 points (6-of-15).

Earlier, despite the Lady Hornets' 80-75 loss at home to Coppin State (Dec. 7), the Detroit, Mich. native, scored a team-high 21 points (7-of-21), including a 5-for-6 (.833) output from the charity stripe.

Earlier in the season on Nov. 11, Bankston earned the award, after totaling 18 points (8-of-12), including 2-for-3 (.666) beyond the arc, five rebounds and a steal in DSU's season opening loss at Old Dominion.

**RAVEN CONTINUING HOT START, RAINE DONE FOR THE SEASON**

Starting every game this season, guard **Raven Bankston** has continued a strong pace since the start of the 2013-14 campagin.

In addition to scoring in double figures each contest, she is second on the team and fourth in the MEAC in scoring (19.0 ppg). She also first in three-pointers made (8) on the squad.

As for her twin sister, **Raine**, her season abruptly ended with a knee injury suffered in practice in preparation for DSU's game against George Mason (Dec.4). In five starts, she averaged 7.6 points, 3.6 assists (second most on the team), 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game.

Coming out of high school, both ranked among the top 20 high school players in Michigan and helped lead John Glenn High School to city and district championships as seniors.

In a game during their high school careers, they combined for 75 points.

### **HORNETS PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN THE MEAC**

The Delaware State Lady Hornets were picked to finish 10th (254 points) in the MEAC Preseason Standings.

Holding down the top spot was defending regular season and conference tournament champions, Hampton (658), who received 20 first-place votes. Additionally, Hampton's **Alyssa Bennett** was named Co-MEAC Preseason Player of the Year, along with FAMU's **Jasmine Grace**.

Picked to finish second, meanwhile, was North Carolina A&T (599 points), followed by Coppin State (457 points), Florida A&M (429 points), Howard (318 points), Morgan State (314 points), South Carolina State (303 points), Bethune-Cookman (302 points) and UMES (257 points).

Rounding out the rest of the preseason predicted order of finish were Norfolk State (238 points), Savannah State (118 points) and North Carolina Central (80 points).

### **RETURNERS**

Along with **Tierra Hawkins** and **Deanna Harmon**, DSU's floor general last season, point guard **Jade Washington**, returns for the Lady Hornets. Washington was tops on the club with 108 assists to rank fourth in the MEAC (3.5 apg) last season. In addition, she recorded a team-high 54 steals in her first season in a Hornet uniform after coming over from Arizona Western.

Rounding out the rest of the Hornets' returning players are sophomore **N'Kayah Kersey** and junior **Coreenah Redden**.

Appearing in 31 games last season, including 10 starts, Kersey will provide depth at the guard position, while Redden will do the same after playing in 26 games in 2012-13.

### **FRESH FACES**

Delaware State's newcomers include standout twin sisters **Raven** and **Raine Bankston** out of Detroit, Mich.

Also, in the backcourt, is the addition of sharpshooter **Diamond Williams** out of Newark, N.J.

Forwards **Tylinn Carter** and **Mi'Queara Lewis**, meanwhile, will look to make solid contributions in their first seasons in a Hornet uniform.

Hailing from San Diego, Calif., by way of Serra High School, Carter averaged 14.1 points and 4.1 assists per game to help lead her squad to the Eastern League championship last season.

In the case of Lewis, she averaged 12 points and 10 rebounds per game, to go along with shooting 85 percent

from the line. As a senior at Digital Harbor High School (Baltimore, Md.), she led her team to a Division I title.

In addition, walk-on freshman **Kareena Pitts** will compete for playing time down on the block.

### **TOUGH ROAD AHEAD**

The 2013-14 schedule for the Lady Hornets will be a tough one, headlined by five NCAA Tournament teams from last season in Vanderbilt, Albany, No. 8 Maryland, West Virginia and defending regular season and conference tournament MEAC champions, Hampton.

## Second Season at DSU | Record: 13-28 (6-11 MEAC)

A new era began on Thursday, May 31, 2012 for the Delaware State University women's basketball team as President **Harry L. Williams** introduced **Tamika L. Louis**, a former championship junior college head coach and Division I assistant coach, as the new head coach.

In her first season, the Lady Hornets finished 10-21 overall, including 6-10 in MEAC action to earn the ninth seed in the conference tournament. Nevertheless, DSU took down the eighth-seeded Bethune-Cookman Wildcats in the opening round, 55-44, to snap a five-year MEAC tournament skid.

Meanwhile, forward **Tierra Hawkins** was able to garner Second Team All-MEAC honors by leading the Lady Hornets in scoring (17.1 ppg) and rebounding (7.4 rpg).

Louis arrived at Delaware State with 14 years of coaching and recruiting experience on the NCAA Division I, Junior College and high school levels. Before accepting the position at DSU, she served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2011-12 season at George Washington University in Washington, D.C.

"As the Lady Hornets' head coach, I will be a servant-leader and hope that my energy, dedication and work ethic will be infectious to the young ladies on the team."

Louis added: "We will establish a winning culture here with an expectation to excel in the classroom and on the court, resulting in MEAC championships. Just as important, we will develop future leaders who, upon graduation, will make an immediate impact in our global society and positively represent DSU"

From 2009-11, Louis was an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for St. John's University, where she was in charge of organizing all recruiting initiatives, game scouting, overseeing player academic progress and off-court mentoring. Additionally, she was responsible for the development of the Red Storm guards, including Second Team All-Big East and Freshman All-American Shennicka Smith.

Prior to her time at SJU, Louis served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Illinois from 2007-09 where she was instrumental in signing the No. 2 and No. 3 ranked players in the 2009 class in the country, according to ESPN Hoop Girl and Blue Star rankings, in All-Americans Destiny Williams and Karisma Penn.

From 2002-05, she was the head women's basketball coach at Mott Community College in Flint, Mich., where she led her squad to a 58-33 overall record during her tenure. The 2004-05 squad boasted a 16-0 conference record and was 27-7 overall en route to a NJCAA Region XII championship and bid to the NJCAA Tournament. For her efforts during this stellar season, Louis was named the Michigan Community College Athletic Association and Region XII Coach of the Year.
