EAGLES

» THE GAME

The Delaware State women's basketball team (3-3) will look for its third consecutive victory of the season Saturday afternoon (2 p.m.) against MEAC foe Coppin State (3-4), in what will be the conference opener for both squads.

» THE OPPONENT

The Eagles enter Saturday's contest dropping three out of their last four games with losses to Robert Morris, No. 18 North Carolina and West Virginia. Coppin State's lone win during this stretch came against Virginia Union at home, 71-69.

Spearheading the Eagles' offensive attack is forward **Kyra Coleman** averaging 14.6 points per game on 40 percent (37-of-93) shooting. Also, averaging double figures in the scoring column is guard **Ashle Craig** (11.6 ppg), while leading the team in steals (23). Down low, forward **Larissa Carter** leads the team in rebounding (6.7 rpg), to go along with averaging 12 points per contest.

» THE COACH

Derek Brown is in his 13th season at the helm. Throughout his tenure, Brown has been named MEAC Coach of the Year twice (2004-05, 2005-06), while leading the Lady Eagles to three NCAA Tournament appearances (2005, 2006, 2008).

» THE SERIES

DSU is 25-33 all-time against the Eagles. Last season, the two squads met once with the Lady Hornets losing at home, 73-68. In that game, Delaware State's **Tierra Hawkins** led all scorers with 19 points (5-of-12), while **Kyra Coleman** poured in a team-high 12 points (4-of-8) for the Eagles.

A WIN WOULD MEAN...

» The Hornets would be 3-0 at home for the first time since the 2003-04 season.

» DSU would be a game over .500 since beating Wilmington to start the 2011-12 season.

» The Lady Hornets would snap a two-game losing skid to Coppin State.

LAST TIME OUT...

The Lady Hornets erased a 10-point deficit with under two minutes to play in regulation to come away with a thrilling 90-83 overtime win at home over the George Mason Patriots this past Wednesday.

Despite scoring eight points on 1-of-6 (.166) shooting in the first half, forward **Tierra Hawkins** finished the night with a game-high 29 points (10-of-21) and 14 rebounds to secure her third double-double of the season. Hawkins also went a perfect 9-for-9 from the free throw line, to go along with two blocks.

Guard/Forward **Deanna Harmon**, meanwhile, recorded her first double-double of the season with 14 points (6-of-13) and 10 rebounds while playing a game-high 43 minutes.

Additionally, guard **Raven Bankston** chipped in with 18 points (6-of-15), whereas forward **Tylinn Carter** finished with a career-high 10 points (3-of-5), along with four rebounds, three steals and two blocks.

As a team, DSU shook off its dismal 29 percent (9-of-31) shooting in the first half and shot 51 percent (17-of-33) in the second stanza, while finishing

the contest shooting 79 percent (27-of-34) from the line.

AT THIS POINT LAST SEASON...

Delaware State was 2-4 overall and 1-1 in MEAC action, coming off a 54-40 loss at home to Howard.

COMING UP NEXT...

The Lady Hornets will face powerhouse No. 8 Maryland on the road next Saturday (7 p.m.), in what will be the first of a season-long three-game road swing for DSU.

SCRAPPY HORNETS

Through six games on the defensive end, the Lady Hornets are forcing 22 turnovers per game (132 total), which is good for a +2.5 turnover margin.

Steals wise, they have 10 more (64-54) than their opponents with four players in double figures, led by guard/forward **Deanna Harmon** (13).

FEAR THE HAWK

After earning Second Team All-MEAC honors last season, junior **Tierra Hawkins** has picked up where she left off.

So far in 2013-14, the Clinton, Md. native, not only leads the MEAC and Lady Hornets in scoring (25.3 ppg), but she sits eighth in the nation. Additionally, Hawkins leads the Lady Hornets in rebounds (10.5 rpg) and double-doubles (3). In her last four games, she has also topped 25 points or more.

In DSU's 86-73 win at home over Wilmington (Nov. 20), Hawkins tied what was then a career-high 30

points and matched a career-high in rebounds (15). Also, in this game, she tallied 1,000 career points to become the 15th player in team history to reach this milestone.

Coming into Saturday's matchup against Coppin State, she needs 18 points to pass **Kim Taylor** (1987-92) to place 10th on DSU's all-time scoring list. Currently, Hawkins' career point total stands 1,120.

RAVEN CONTINUING HOT START, RAINE DONE FOR THE SEASON

After scoring a career-high 28 points on 10-for-21 (.476) shooting in the Lady Hornets' 87-71 loss at Albany (Nov. 24), guard **Raven Bankston** added to her hot start this season.

In addition to scoring in double figures each contest, she is second on the team in scoring (18.7 ppg) and first in three-pointers made (6). From the line, Rav. Bankston is second on the team at 75 percent (24-of-32).

In DSU's season opening loss at Old Dominion, she totaled 18 points (8-of-12), five rebounds and a steal, along with going 2-for-3 (.666) from beyond the arc. With these efforts, she earned MEAC Rookie of the Week honors.

As for her twin sister, **Raine**, her season abruptly ended with a knee injury suffered in practice in preparation for DSU's game against George Mason (Dec.4).

In five starts, she averaged 7.6 points, 3.6 assists (second most on the team), 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game.

Coming out of high school, both ranked among the top 20 high school players in Michigan and helped lead John Glenn High School to city and district championships as seniors.

In a game during their high school careers, they combined for 75 points.

ALL BY HERSELF

Standing as the lone senior on the roster, guard/forward **Deanna Harmon** is averaging 12 points, 7.3 rebounds and a team leading 2.2 steals per contest. In addition, she is 27-for-42 (.643) from the field and 18-of-24 (.750) from the free throw line.

Career wise, she sits eighth (225) on DSU's all-time assist list.

"FLOOR" GENERAL WASHINGTON

Starting every game this season, guard **Jade Washington** leads the team in assists at 4.8 per contest, 29 total. Her highest output of the season occurred in DSU's 90-83 overtime win at home against George Mason (Dec. 4) as she finished with eight.

Last season, she led the Lady Hornets in the assist department at 3.5 assists per game, which was good for fourth in the MEAC.

HAWKINS GARNERS MEAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

On Nov. 25, forward **Tierra Hawkins** was named MEAC Player of the Week for the first time in her stellar career as a Hornet.

In games against Wilmington and Albany, Hawkins averaged 29.5 points, shooting 66-percent from the field (25-of-38), with 10.0 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 2.0 steals.

RAV. BANKSTON NAMED MEAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

On Nov. 11, freshman **Raven Bankston** was named MEAC Rookie of the Week after totaling 18 (8-of-12) points, five rebounds and a steal in DSU's season opening loss at Old Dominion.

The freshman out of Detroit, Mich. also went 2-for-3 (.666) from beyond the arc to lead the Lady Hornets.

With this feat, Bankston is the first Hornet to earn this recognition since **Tierra Hawkins** garnered the award three times during the 2011-12 season, as she went on to be named MEAC Rookie of the Year.

HORNETS PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN THE MEAC

The Delaware State Lady Hornets were picked to finish 10th (254 points) in the MEAC Preseason Standings.

Holding down the top spot was defending regular season and conference tournament champions, Hampton (658), who received 20 first-place votes. Additionally, Hampton's **Alyssa Bennett** was named Co-MEAC Preseason Player of the Year, along with FAMU's **Jasmine Grace**.

Picked to finish second, meanwhile, was North Carolina A&T (599 points), followed by Coppin State (457 points), Florida A&M (429 points), Howard (318 points), Morgan State (314 points), South Carolina State (303 points),

Rounding out the rest of the preseason predicted order of finish were Norfolk State (238 points), Savannah State (118 points) and North Carolina Central (80 points).

RETURNERS

Along with **Tierra Hawkins** and **Deanna Harmon**, DSU's floor general last season, point guard **Jade Washington**, returns for the Lady Hornets. Washington was tops on the club with 108 assists to rank fourth in the MEAC (3.5 apg) last season. In addition, she recorded a team-high 54 steals in her first season in a Hornet uniform after coming over from Arizona Western.

Rounding out the rest of the Hornets' returning players are sophomore **N'Kayah Kersey** and junior **Coreenah Redden**.

Appearing in 31 games last season, including 10 starts, Kersey will provide depth at the guard position, while Redden will do the same after playing in 26 games in 2012-13.

FRESH FACES

Delaware State's newcomers include standout twin sisters **Raven** and **Raine Bankston** out of Detroit, Mich. Also, in the backcourt, is the addition of sharpshooter **Diamond Williams** out of Newark, N.J.

Forwards **Tylinn Carter** and **Mi'Queara Lewis**, meanwhile, will look to make solid contributions in their first seasons in a Hornet uniform. Hailing from San Diego, Calif., by way

of Serra High School, Carter averaged 14.1 points and 4.1 assists per game to help lead her squad to the Eastern League championship last season.

In the case of Lewis, she averaged 12 points and 10 rebounds per game, to go along with shooting 85 percent from the line. As a senior at Digital Harbor High School (Baltimore, Md.), she led her team to a Division I title.

In addition, walk-on freshman **Kareena Pitts** will compete for playing time down on the block.

TOUGH ROAD AHEAD

The 2013-14 schedule for the Lady Hornets will be a tough one, headlined by five NCAA Tournament teams from last season in Vanderbilt, Albany, No. 8 Maryland, West Virginia and defending regular season and conference tournament MEAC champions, Hampton.

Second Season at DSU | Record: 13-24 (6-10 MEAC)

A new era began on Thursday, May 31, 2012 for the Delaware State University women's basketball team as President **Harry L. Williams** introduced **Tamika L. Louis**, a former championship junior college head coach and Division I assistant coach, as the new head coach.

In her first season, the Lady Hornets finished 10-21 overall, including 6-10 in MEAC action to earn the ninth seed in the conference tournament. Nevertheless, DSU took down the eighth-seeded Bethune-Cookman Wildcats in the opening round, 55-44, to snap a five-year MEAC tournament skid.

Meanwhile, forward **Tierra Hawkins** was able to garner Second Team All-MEAC honors by leading the Lady Hornets in scoring (17.1 ppg) and rebounding (7.4 rpg).

Louis arrived at Delaware State with 14 years of coaching and recruiting experience on the NCAA Division I, Junior College and high school levels. Before accepting the position at DSU, she served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2011-12 season at George Washington University in Washington, D.C.

"As the Lady Hornets' head coach, I will be a servant-leader and hope that my energy, dedication and work ethic will be infectious to the young ladies on the team."

Louis added: "We will establish a winning culture here with an expectation to excel in the classroom and on the court, resulting in MEAC championships. Just as important, we will develop future leaders who, upon graduation, will make an immediate impact in our global society and positively represent DSU"

From 2009-11, Louis was an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for St. John's University, where she was in charge of organizing all recruiting initiatives, game scouting, overseeing player academic progress and off-court mentoring. Additionally, she was responsible for the development of the Red Storm guards, including Second Team All-Big East and Freshman All-American Shennicka Smith.

Prior to her time at SJU, Louis served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Illinois from 2007-09 where she was instrumental in signing the No. 2 and No. 3 ranked players in the 2009 class in the country, according to ESPN Hoop Girl and Blue Star rankings, in All-Americans Destiny Williams and Karisma Penn.

From 2002-05, she was the head women's basketball coach at Mott Community College in Flint, Mich., where she led her squad to a 58-33 overall record during her tenure. The 2004-05 squad boasted a 16-0 conference record and was 27-7 overall en route to a NJCAA Region XII championship and bid to the NJCAA Tournament. For her efforts during this stellar season, Louis was named the Michigan Community College Athletic Association and Region XII Coach of the Year.
