» THE GAME

The Delaware State women's basketball team (4-9, 0-2 MEAC) will continue its three-game homestand Saturday afternoon (2 p.m.) against the four-time defending MEAC Tournament champion, Hampton Pirates (11-4, 2-0 MEAC). So far this season, the Lady Pirates boast the best overall and conference record amongst teams in the MEAC.

» THE OPPONENT

Coming in, the Lady Pirates have won six out of their last seven games. During this stretch, HU's notable wins have come against MEAC foes Florida A&M and Bethune-Cookman, along with double digit victories over Kansas State and Virginia Tech.

Hampton has three players averaging double figures in the scoring column, led by freshman guard **Malia Tate-DeFreitas** (18.1 ppg), who has been named MEAC Rookie of the Week three times. Meanwhile, Co-MEAC Preseason Player of the Year, **Alyssa Bennett** (16.7 ppg) leads HU in rebounding (9.1 rpg), as she's been named MEAC Player of the Week twice this season. Guard **Nicole Hampton** (14 ppg) leads the team in assists (82), steals (35) and blocks (29), as she's garnered both MEAC and Defensive Player of the Week honors once in 2013-14.

» THE COACH

In his fifth season at the helm, **David Six** is 110-34 overall, including 60-6 in conference action. Last season, Six led the Pirates to a 16-0 record in MEAC play, while the squad recorded a school-best Division I-record 28 wins on their way to clinching their fourth consecutive automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

» THE SERIES

DSU is 12-31 all-time against Hampton. Last year, the Lady Hornets went 0-3 against HU, while the Pirates ended DSU's season with a 63-28 victory in the second round of the MEAC Tournament.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR?

» Big Three Battle

The trio of **Tierra Hawkins** (22.5 ppg), **Raven Bankston** (18.8 ppg) and **Deanna Harmon** (11.5 ppg) makes up 79 percent of DSU's scoring, while Hampton's **Malia Tate-DeFreitas** (18.1 ppg), **Alyssa Bennett** (16.7 ppg) and **Nicole Hampton** (14 ppg) account for 73 percent of their squad's scoring.

» Top Freshmen Clash

DSU's **Raven Bankston** and Hampton's **Malia Tate-DeFreitas** both have been named MEAC Rookie of the Week three times, whereas Bankston sits fourth (18.8 ppg) in the conference in scoring and Tate-DeFreitas (18.1 ppg) ranks fifth.

FAMILIAR FACE

When the Lady Hornets face Hampton Saturday, a former DSU women's basketball standout will be in attendance. Currently in her fifth season with HU as an assistant coach, **Barbara Burgess** (1984-88) sits second on DSU's all-time scoring list with 1,807 points. In addition, she was inducted to the Delaware State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

LAST TIME OUT...

The Lady Hornets erased a 10-point halftime deficit Tuesday at home to defeat the NJIT Highlanders in overtime, 75-72. With this victory, DSU

snapped a six-game losing skid.

At game's end, three DSU players scored in double figures, led by guard **Raven Bankston** 26 points (8-of-17) with 19 coming in the second half. Bankston also went 2-for-2 from beyond the arc, to go along two assists, two rebounds and two steals. From the free throw line, the Detroit, Mich. native, set career-highs in free throws made (8) and attempted (12).

Forward **Tierra Hawkins**, meanwhile, poured in 23 points (9-of-19), grabbed three rebounds and totaled a game-high two blocks, whereas guard/forward **Deanna Harmon** finished with 11 points (5-of-13), eight rebounds and a game-high four steals. Off the bench, forward Tylinn Carter turned in a solid all-around performance with a team-high nine rebounds, a game-high four steals, four points (2-of-4), one assist and one block.

For the game, the Lady Hornets shot 45 percent (29-of-64) and forced 24 turnovers, despite being out-rebounded, 41-35.

HAWKINS NAMED MEAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK FOR THE SECOND TIME

Monday, junior **Tierra Hawkins** was named MEAC Player of the Week for the second time this season, DSU's 70-64 loss at MEAC foe Howard this past Tuesday, after totaling a game-high 26 points (10-of-18) and a career-high 16 rebounds for her sixth double-double of the season.

She also went a perfect 6-for-6 from the free throw, and added two assists, one steal and one block while playing all 40 minutes against HU.

On Nov. 25, she was named MEAC Player of the Week for the first time after averaging 29.5 points, shooting 66-percent from the field (25-of-38), with 10.0 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 2.0 steals in games against Wilmington and Albany.

HOME COOKIN' ON THE MENU

The Lady Hornets' contest against NJIT will began a stretch of three straight home games. In five games at Memorial Hall, Delaware State is 3-2 and averaging 76 points per game on 40 percent shooting, while forcing 24 turnovers and 12 steals per contest on the defensive end.

A SIGN OF THINGS TO COME?

In the first six games, the Lady Hornets were 3-3, scored at least 65 points and averaged 77 points per contest on 42 percent shooting. Also, during this stretch, DSU forced 23 turnovers per game, including 11 steals, and averaged 23 points off those miscues.

The next six games, DSU went winless and averaged 55 points per game on shooting 34 percent shooting from the field, including 17 percent from three-point range. Additionally, opponents forced 21 turnovers per

game, including nine steals, while DSU gave up 80 points on 45 percent.

However, in DSU's recent overtime 75-72 victory against NJIT, it shot 45 percent (29-of-64) and forced 24 turnovers, despite being out-rebounded, 41-35.

MOVING UP THE CAREER LIST

With her performance against NJIT, senior Deanna Harmon is now fourth (239) on DSU's all-time career assists list.

AT THIS POINT LAST SEASON...

Delaware State was 3-10 and 0-2 MEAC, coming off 84-83 overtime victory at Houston Baptist.

So far in 2013-14, the Clinton, Md. native, leads the Lady Hornets in scoring (22.5 ppg), which is second in the MEAC and 13th in the nation. Additionally, Hawkins leads the Lady Hornets in rebounds (10.0 rpg), which is good for second in the MEAC. With these numbers, she is one of nine players in the country to average 20+ points and 10+ rebounds per game.

In DSU's 86-73 win at home over Wilmington (Nov. 20), Hawkins tallied 30 points to eclipse 1,000 career points to become the 15th player in Hornets history to reach this milestone.

BANKSTON LOOKING TO BUILD

Despite sitting second (18.8 ppg) on the team and fourth in the MEAC in scoring, guard **Raven Bankston's** 26-point output against NJIT on 8-for-17 (.470) shooting, including 8-for-12 (.666) from the charity strip and 2-for-2 from three-point range was her best game in nearly a month.

The previous six games, Bankston averaged 18 points per game on just 32 percent (41-of-130), including 14 percent (4-of-29) from long distance and 69 percent (20-of-29) from the free throw line. Assist wise, she totaled eight (1.3 apg), compared to 22 turnovers. Defensively, she has four steals and one block.

ALL BY HERSELF

Standing as the lone senior, guard/forward **Deanna Harmon** is averaging 11.5 points, 7.3 rebounds and a team-leading 2.4 steals per contest. In addition, her team leading 54 percent (53-of-99) is tops in the conference. From the line, the Owings Mills, Md. native, is shooting

76 percent (44-of-58).

"FLOOR" GENERAL WASHINGTON

Starting every game this season, guard **Jade Washington** leads the team in assists at 3.8 per contest, 50 total. Her highest output of the season occurred in DSU's 90-83 overtime win at home against George Mason (Dec. 4) as she finished with a career-high eight.

Washington is also sits second on the team in steals at 1.7 per contest, 22 total.

Last season, she led the Lady Hornets in the assist department at 3.5 assists per game, which was good for fourth in the MEAC.

BANKSTON TALLIES THIRD MEAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK HONOR

On Dec. 16, in what was for the second straight week and for the third time this season, guard **Raven Bankston** was named MEAC Rookie of the Week, after her 22-point and six-rebound performance at No. 8 Maryland.

With this feat, she is the first Hornet to garner this award three times in a season since forward **Tierra Hawkins** did it during the 2011-12 season, as she went on to win MEAC Rookie of the Year.

The previous week, in DSU's thrilling 90-83 overtime victory at home over George Mason, Bankston was one of four players to score in double figures as she poured in 18 points (6-of-15).

Earlier, despite the Lady Hornets' 80-75 loss at home to Coppin State (Dec. 7), the Detroit, Mich. native,

scored a team-high 21 points (7-of-21), including a 5-for-6 (.833) output from the charity stripe.

Earlier in the season on Nov. 11, Bankston earned the award, after totaling 18 points (8-of-12), including 2-for-3 (.666) beyond the arc, five rebounds and a steal in DSU's season opening loss at Old Dominion.

BACKCOURT TAKES A HIT, RAINE DONE FOR THE SEASON

Guard **Raine Bankston's**, twin sister of **Raven Bankston**, season abruptly ended with a knee injury suffered in practice in preparation for DSU's game against George Mason (Dec.4). In five starts, she averaged 7.6 points, 3.6 assists (second most on the team), 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game. Coming out of high school, both ranked among the top 20 high school players in Michigan and helped lead John Glenn High School to city and district championships as seniors.

In a game during their high school careers, they combined for 75 points.

HORNETS PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN THE MEAC

The Delaware State Lady Hornets were picked to finish 10th (254 points) in the MEAC Preseason Standings.

Holding down the top spot was defending regular season and conference tournament champions, Hampton (658), who received 20 first-place votes. Additionally, Hampton's **Alyssa Bennett** was named Co-MEAC Preseason Player of the Year, along with FAMU's **Jasmine Grace**.

Picked to finish second, meanwhile, was North Carolina A&T (599 points), followed by Coppin State (457 points),

Florida A&M (429 points), Howard (318 points), Morgan State (314 points), South Carolina State (303 points), Bethune-Cookman (302 points) and UMES (257 points).

Rounding out the rest of the preseason predicted order of finish were Norfolk State (238 points), Savannah State (118 points) and North Carolina Central (80 points).

RETURNERS

Along with **Tierra Hawkins** and **Deanna Harmon**, DSU's floor general last season, point guard **Jade Washington**, returns for the Lady Hornets. Washington was tops on the club with 108 assists to rank fourth in the MEAC (3.5 apg) last season. In addition, she recorded a team-high 54 steals in her first season in a Hornet uniform after coming over from Arizona Western.

Rounding out the rest of the Hornets' returning players are sophomore **N'Kayah Kersey** and junior **Coreenah Redden**.

Appearing in 31 games last season, including 10 starts, Kersey will provide depth at the guard position, while Redden will do the same after playing in 26 games in 2012-13.

FRESH FACES

Delaware State's newcomers include standout twin sisters **Raven** and **Raine Bankston** out of Detroit, Mich.

Also, in the backcourt, is the addition of sharpshooter **Diamond Williams** out of Newark, N.J.

Forwards **Tylinn Carter** and **Mi'Queara Lewis**, meanwhile, will look to make solid contributions in their first seasons

in a Hornet uniform.

Hailing from San Diego, Calif., by way of Serra High School, Carter averaged 14.1 points and 4.1 assists per game to help lead her squad to the Eastern League championship last season.

In the case of Lewis, she averaged 12 points and 10 rebounds per game, to go along with shooting 85 percent from the line. As a senior at Digital Harbor High School (Baltimore, Md.), she led her team to a Division I title.

In addition, walk-on freshman **Kareena Pitts** will compete for playing time down on the block.

TOUGH ROAD AHEAD

The 2013-14 schedule for the Lady Hornets will be a tough one, headlined by five NCAA Tournament teams from last season in Vanderbilt, Albany, No. 8 Maryland, West Virginia and defending regular season and conference tournament MEAC champions, Hampton.

Second Season at DSU | Record: 14-30 (6-12 MEAC)

A new era began on Thursday, May 31, 2012 for the Delaware State University women's basketball team as President **Harry L. Williams** introduced **Tamika L. Louis**, a former championship junior college head coach and Division I assistant coach, as the new head coach.

In her first season, the Lady Hornets finished 10-21 overall, including 6-10 in MEAC action to earn the ninth seed in the conference tournament. Nevertheless, DSU took down the eighth-seeded Bethune-Cookman Wildcats in the opening round, 55-44, to snap a five-year MEAC tournament skid.

Meanwhile, forward **Tierra Hawkins** was able to garner Second Team All-MEAC honors by leading the Lady Hornets in scoring (17.1 ppg) and rebounding (7.4 rpg).

Louis arrived at Delaware State with 14 years of coaching and recruiting experience on the NCAA Division I, Junior College and high school levels. Before accepting the position at DSU, she served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2011-12 season at George Washington University in Washington, D.C.

"As the Lady Hornets' head coach, I will be a servant-leader and hope that my energy, dedication and work ethic will be infectious to the young ladies on the team."

Louis added: "We will establish a winning culture here with an expectation to excel in the classroom and on the court, resulting in MEAC championships. Just as important, we will develop future leaders who, upon graduation, will make an immediate impact in our global society and positively represent DSU."

From 2009-11, Louis was an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for St. John's University, where she was in charge of organizing all recruiting initiatives, game scouting, overseeing player academic progress and of-court mentoring. Additionally, she was responsible for the development of the Red Storm guards, including Second Team All-Big East and Freshman All-American Shenniekia Smith.

Prior to her time at SJU, Louis served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Illinois from 2007-09 where she was instrumental in signing the No. 2 and No. 3 ranked players in the 2009 class in the country, according to ESPN Hoop Girl and Blue Star rankings, in All-Americans Destiny Williams and Karisma Penn.

From 2002-05, she was the head women's basketball coach at Mott Community College in Flint, Mich., where she led her squad to a 58-33 overall record during her tenure. The 2004-05 squad boasted a 16-0 conference record and was 27-7 overall en route to a NJCAA Region XII championship and bid to the NJCAA Tournament. For her efforts during this stellar season, Louis was named the Michigan Community College Athletic Association and Region XII Coach of the Year.

Before joining the collegiate coaching ranks, Louis had stints as an assistant and associate basketball coach at Central High School in Fresno, Calif., Rhodes High School in Cleveland, Ohio and Cuyahoga Community College in Cleveland, Ohio.

After playing her freshman year (1993-94) at West Virginia University, Louis transferred to Fresno State, where she was the starting point guard and captain from 1995-98. She earned her Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts Degrees in communications from Fresno State University.
