Setting the Scene: The Spartans are looking win its third straight conference game of the season on Monday night as they take on Delaware State. Game time is at 5:30 p.m. at Memorial Hall in Dover, Del.

All-Time Series: Delaware State leads the series with NSU, 22-15. Last season the Spartans were 1-1 against the Lady Hornets. NSU won the first meeting on Feb. 9, 61-51 at Joseph Echols Hall, but dropped the second meeting, 58-48 at Memorial Hall on Feb. 23.

Last Time Out: Rae Corbo tallied 20 points and Rachel Gordon posted her sixth double-double of the season, finishing the game with 19 points and 16 rebounds, to lift Norfolk State past UMES 73-66 on Saturday afternoon at the W.P. Hytche Athletic Center.

The win moves NSU to 2-1 in MEAC play and 6-8 overall. The last time the Spartans started 2-1 in conference play was during the 2011-2012 season.

Gordon shot 50.0 percent (4-of-8) on the afternoon and was perfect from the free throw line shooting 11-of-11. She also tied her career-best of four blocks. Gordon now sits in sixth place all-time in career rebounding at NSU with 895 boards. She needs 11 more to tie Ann Theus for fifth place all-time.

Aside from Corbo and Gordon, junior Ebony Brown also posted double figures for the Spartans. Brown had 14 points and two assists.

The Spartans finished the game shooting 37.7 percent (23-of-61) from the field and only 18.2 percent (2-of-11) from 3-point range. NSU also shot 71.4 percent (25-of-35) from the charity strike. Another notable stat for the Spartans was that they outrebounded UMES 51-41 on the afternoon.

NSU had a great game defensively as they posted a season-high 10 blocks. Gordon led the defensive effort with four blocks while Leonard had two. Kieera Basey, Ebony Brown,

Jazamine Gray and Dominique Harper had one block each. Powell also had three steals and eleven rebounds.

Basey also tallied a team-high seven assists.

About DSU: The Delaware State women's basketball team (4-10, 0-3 MEAC) found themselves down early and often at home throughout Saturday's MEAC contest as the Hampton Pirates (12-4, 3-0 MEAC), led by guard Malia DeFreitas-Tate (29 points) and forward Alyssa Bennett (25 points), cruised to a 79-39 victory.

DSU turned in season-lows in points (39), field percentage (.203), field goals made (12) and assists (4). Raven Bankston led the Lady Hornets in scoring with 17 points (6-of-24), while Tiera Hawkins was held to just nine points (3-of-14) and nine rebounds before fouling out.

Hawkins leads the Lady Hornets in scoring and rebounding, averaging 21.3 points and 9.9 rebounds per game. Two other DSU players are also averaging double figures on the season. Bankston sits at 18.6 points per game while Deanna Harmon is averaging 11.3 points.

Last Year Against DSU: Last year Rachel Gordon posted her fourth double-double of the season with 17 points and 13 rebounds to lead the NSU to a 61-51 victory over Delaware State on Feb. 9, 2013 at Joseph Echols Hall. The Spartans snapped a three-game losing streak with the win against the Lady Hornets.

Delaware State shot 34.6 percent (18-of-52) on the night. Tasia Bristow was the only player to score in double-figures for the Lady Hornets as she led all scorers with 24 points. Tierra Hawkins posted nine points and nine rebounds.

The Spartans finished the game shooting 44.2 percent (23-of-52) from the field. Aside from Gordon, Recca Trice, Aivah Parham and Batavia Owens also scored in double figures tallying 12 points each.

In the second meeting, Aivah Parham tallied 15 points and eight rebounds, but it was not

enough as the Spartans fell to Delaware State, 58-48, on Feb. 23 at Memorial Hall.

DSU shot 34.0 percent (18-of-53) on the afternoon. Bristow was the only Lady Hornet to score in double-figures and she led all scorers with 25 points and 10 rebounds. Hawkins added nine points and three rebounds, respectively.

The Spartans finished the game shooting 32.8 percent (19-of-58) from the field. Parham led NSU with 15 points and eight rebounds. Two other Spartans finished the game scoring in double-figures including Gordon, who posted her sixth double-double of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds. Trice added 10 points, eight rebounds and five assists, respectively.

NSU outrebounded Delaware State 43-39 while Delaware State outscored the Spartans off turnovers, 24-8.

Scoring Leaders: Rae Corbo leads NSU in scoring, averaging 13.7 points per game followed by Rachel Gordon, who is averaging 11.5 points per game. Ebony Brown rounds out the top-three scoring leaders for NSU, averaging 10.4 points per game.

Moving Up the Charts: Rachel Gordon is in sixth place all-time in career rebounding at NSU with 895 rebounds. Gordon needs 11 more boards to tie Ann Theus for fifth place all-time.

Rachel on the Boards: Rachel Gordon had 19 rebounds in NSU's loss to Texas-Pan American on Nov. 29. It was the fifth highest total by an NSU player and a Division I record as well. It was the most rebounds in a game by a Spartan player since Stephanie Palmer had 26 against Johnson C. Smith on Dec. 7, 1989.

Cracking the Top 10: Rae Corbo ranks 12th all-time in career free throws made at NSU with 223. Corbo needs to make only one more to tie Michelle Sessoms for 11th all-time. She only needs four more to tie Charlette Fayton for 10th all-time.

NCAA, MEAC Leaderboard: Rachel Gordon currently ranks No. 7 in the nation in rebounds per game and Rae Corbo is No. 78 in free throw percentage.

As a team, NSU currently ranks in the top 5 in 12 different categories in the MEAC, while NSU players rank in the top 5 in seven different categories, including Rachel Gordon, who leads the league in rebounds, averaging 12.4 rebounds per game.

Stingy Defense: NSU gave up 40 points against Virginia University-Lynchburg on Dec. 20. It tied for the fewest points NSU had given up in a game in the Division I era. The last time the Spartans gave up 40 points or less was against Bethune-Cookman last season on March 2.

NSU Wins Big: The Spartans posted their largest win in more than eight years with their 116-40 victory over Virginia University-Lynchburg on Dec. 20. The 76-point margin was the largest for NSU since they defeated St. Paul's by 83 points on Jan. 16, 1996. The win also set a Division I record for the Spartans and ranks fifth all-time in NSU's record book for the largest winning margin.

NSU also set a Division I record with 116 total points. It was the most NSU had scored in a game since Feb. 17, 1996 against Elizabeth City State when NSU had 117.

The Spartans shot a Division I best 63.2 percent (48-of-76) on the afternoon and were 7-of-16 from 3-point range. NSU also finished the night shooting 72.2 percent (13-of-18) from the free throw line.

Powell Named MEAC Rookie of the Week: Freshman forward Logan Powell of the Norfolk State women's basketball team was named the MEAC Rookie of the Week on Dec. 23, the conference office announced.

A native of Lebanon, Ky., Powell posted 13.5 points on 10-of-16 shooting with 6.0 rebounds in a pair of non-conference games.

She totaled 13 points and four rebounds in NSU's loss against East Carolina at home on Dec. 17, and followed that up with a career-high 14 points and eight boards with two assists and a steal in a 116-40 victory over Virginia University-Lynchburg on Dec. 20.

NSU Players Earn MEAC Defensive Player of the Week Honors: Spartan players won four of the first five MEAC Defensive Player of the Week honors to start the season. Quineshia Leonard earned the award in the first week of the year on Nov. 11, while Rachel Gordon took home the honor on Nov. 18 and in back-to-back weeks on Dec. 2 and 9.

Clark Inks 2 in Early Signing Period: Norfolk State women's basketball head coach Debra Clark announced that high school products Kayla Roberts and Shayla Tanner have signed national letters of intent to join the Spartans for the 2014-15 season.

Roberts is a 6-foot power forward from Norland High School in Miami, Fla. She averaged 7.3 points, 9.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game as a junior last season. Roberts earned 2012 All-Dade County honorable mention and earned a spot on the 2013 preseason All-Dade third team.

A native of Raleigh, N.C., Tanner is a 6-foot-1 center out of East Wake High School, the same school that produced current Spartan Jazamine Gray. Tanner averaged 8.0 points and 9.0 rebounds last season. She was also named to the Neuse River Conference all-academic team for three years.
