**HIGHLANDERS**

#### » THE GAME

The Delaware State women's basketball team (3-9, 0-2 MEAC) will look to get back on track Tuesday evening (5:30 p.m.) when it takes on the NJIT Highlanders (4-14), beginning a three-game homestand.

#### » THE OPPONENT

NJIT heads into Tuesday's contest coming off a 1-3 mark during a four-game home stretch. On the road, the Highlanders are just 1-8 this season with their lone victory occurring at LIU Brooklyn on Nov. 20.

As a team, NJIT is averaging 56 points per game with guard **Shakia Robinson** (10.9 ppg) as their leading scorer. Down low, forward **Uju Nwankwo** leads the squad in rebounding (9.4 rpg) and blocks (28), while averaging 8.9 points per contest.

#### » THE COACH

**Steve Lampher** is in his second season with the Highlanders. Last year, he led NJIT to a 16-15 overall record, including a 6-2 mark in the program's final season as members of the Great West Conference.

#### » THE SERIES

The Lady Hornets are 1-2 all-time against NJIT. Last season, DSU fell 55-42 on the road to the Highlanders, behind Uju Nwankwo's 19-point and 10-rebound performance. The lone win for DSU occurred on Nov. 24, 2011 at home in overtime, 82-74.

**A WIN WOULD MEAN...**

- » The Lady Hornets would snap a season-long six-game losing streak.
- » DSU's second victory over NJIT in team history.
- » Delaware State's third home victory of the season, snapping a two-game slide.
- » The Hornets would be 4-9 overall for the first time since 2010-11.

**LAST TIME OUT...**

The Lady Hornets fell 70-64 on the road to MEAC foe Howard last Tuesday, despite double-double performances by forward Tierra Hawkins and guard/forward Deanna Harmon.

When the final buzzer sounded, DSU shot 41 percent (25-of-60) from the floor, whereas HU finished the game at 35 percent (24-of-69). On the glass, Delaware State out-rebound the Bison, 50-37, but the difference turned out to be the turnovers with the Lady Hornets committing 27, compared to Howard's 15.

Individually, Hawkins led all scorers with 26 points (10-of-18) and totaled a career-high 16 rebounds for her sixth double-double of the season, whereas Harmon (5-of-7) and guard Raven Bankston (6-of-21) both poured in 15 points and dished out three assists. Harmon also pulled down a career-high 12 rebounds and collected a game-high five steals.

Howard, on the other hand, had three players score in double figures, led by guard Te'Shya Heslip's 22-point (8-of-13) and seven-assist performance. Along with scoring 15 points (6-of-15), Shavonne Duckett tallied 11 rebounds, while Cheyenne

Brown finished with 10 points (3-of-12), six rebounds and a game-high two blocks.

**HAWKINS NAMED MEAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK FOR THE SECOND TIME**

Monday, junior **Tierra Hawkins** was named MEAC Player of the Week for the second time this season, which also marks the second time in her stellar career she's received this honor.

Despite DSU's 70-64 loss at MEAC foe Howard this past Tuesday, Hawkins totaled a game-high 26 points (10-of-18) and a career-high 16 rebounds for her sixth double-double of the season.

She also went a perfect 6-for-6 from the free throw, and added two assists, one steal and one block while playing all 40 minutes against HU.

**HOME COOKIN' ON THE MENU**

The Lady Hornets' contest against NJIT will begin a stretch of three straight home games. In four games at Memorial Hall, Delaware State is 2-2 and averaging 77 points per game on 39 percent shooting, while forcing 24 turnovers and 11 steals per contest on the defensive end.

**BOTH ENDS SLIPPING**

In the first six games this season, the Lady Hornets scored at least 65 points and averaged 77 points per contest on 42 percent shooting. Also, during this stretch, Delaware State forced 23 turnovers per game, including 11 steals, and averaged 23 points off those miscues.

However, the Lady Hornets have seen both their offensive and defensive production decline of late.

In the last five games, DSU is averaging 51.4 points per game on shooting 33 percent shooting from the field, including 14 percent from three-point range. Additionally, opponents are forcing 22 turnovers per game, including nine steals, while DSU is giving up 80 points on 45 percent shooting from the floor.

## MOVING UP THE CAREER LIST, MILESTONE WATCH

After scoring 26 points in back-to-back games, forward **Tierra Hawkins** now sits ninth (1,194) all-time on DSU's scoring list.

Senior **Deanna Harmon**, meanwhile, only needs seven assists to move into third (232) all-time on DSU's assist list.

The Lady Hornets were 2-10 overall and 0-2 in the MEAC, coming off a 76-54 loss to Central Connecticut.

## HAWKINS DOESN'T MISS A BEAT

After missing two games (Maryland and West Virginia) due to a shoulder injury, junior **Tierra Hawkins** has averaged 21 points and 14 rebounds in three games since her return, including scoring 26 points back-to-back games.

So far in 2013-14, the Clinton, Md. native, leads the Lady Hornets in scoring (22.4 ppg), which is second in the MEAC and 13th in the nation. Additionally, Hawkins leads the Lady Hornets in rebounds (10.7 rpg), which is good for second in the MEAC.

In DSU's 86-73 win at home over Wilmington (Nov. 20), Hawkins tied what was then a career-high 30 points and matched a career-high in rebounds (15). Also, in this game, she tallied 1,000 career points to become the 15th player in team history to reach this milestone.

On Nov. 25, she was named MEAC Player of the Week for the first time in her stellar career as a Hornet. In games against Wilmington and Albany, Hawkins averaged 29.5 points, shooting 66-percent from the field (25-of-38), with 10.0 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 2.0 steals.

**ALL BY HERSELF**

Standing as the lone senior, guard/forward **Deanna Harmon** is averaging 11.6 points, 7.3 rebounds and a team-leading 2.3 steals per contest. In addition, her team leading 56 percent (48-of-86) is tops in the conference. From the line, the Owings Mills, Md. native, is shooting 80 percent (43-of-54).

**"FLOOR" GENERAL WASHINGTON**

Starting every game this season, guard **Jade Washington** leads the team in assists at 4.0 per contest, 48 total. Her highest output of the season occurred in DSU's 90-83 overtime win at home against George Mason (Dec. 4) as she finished with a career-high eight.

Washington is also sits second on the team in steals at 1.7 per contest, 20 total.

Last season, she led the Lady Hornets in the assist department at 3.5 assists per game, which was good for fourth in the MEAC.

**BANKSTON LOOKING TO SHAKE SLUMP**

Despite sitting second (18.5 ppg) on the team and fourth in the MEAC in scoring, guard Raven Bankston has struggled of late.

In her last six games, Bankston is averaging 18 points per game on just 32 percent (41-of-130), including 14 percent (4-of-29) from long distance and 69 percent (20-of-29) from the free throw line. Assist wise, she has totaled eight (1.3 apg), compared to 22 turnovers. Defensively, she has four steals and one block.

**BANKSTON TALLIES THIRD MEAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK HONOR**

On Dec. 16, in what was for the second straight week and for the third time this season, guard **Raven Bankston** was named MEAC Rookie of the Week, after her 22-point and six-rebound performance at No. 8 Maryland.

With this feat, she is the first Hornet to garner this award three times in a season since forward **Tierra Hawkins** did it during the 2011-12 season, as she went on to win MEAC Rookie of the Year.

The previous week, in DSU's thrilling 90-83 overtime victory at home over George Mason, Bankston was one of four players to score in double figures as she poured in 18 points (6-of-15).

Earlier, despite the Lady Hornets' 80-75 loss at home to Coppin State (Dec. 7), the Detroit, Mich. native, scored a team-high 21 points (7-of-21), including a 5-for-6 (.833) output from the charity stripe.

Earlier in the season on Nov. 11, Bankston earned the award, after totaling 18 points (8-of-12),

including 2-for-3 (.666) beyond the arc, five rebounds and a steal in DSU's season opening loss at Old Dominion.

### BACKCOURT TAKES A HIT, RAINE DONE FOR THE SEASON

Guard **Raine Bankston's**, twin sister of **Raven Bankston**, season abruptly ended with a knee injury suffered in practice in preparation for DSU's game against George Mason (Dec.4). In five starts, she averaged 7.6 points, 3.6 assists (second most on the team), 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game.

Coming out of high school, both ranked among the top 20 high school players in Michigan and helped lead John Glenn High School to city and district championships as seniors.

In a game during their high school careers, they combined for 75 points.

### HORNETS PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN THE MEAC

The Delaware State Lady Hornets were picked to finish 10th (254 points) in the MEAC Preseason Standings.

Holding down the top spot was defending regular season and conference tournament champions, Hampton (658), who received 20 first-place votes. Additionally, Hampton's **Alyssa Bennett** was named Co-MEAC Preseason Player of the Year, along with FAMU's **Jasmine Grace**.

Picked to finish second, meanwhile, was North Carolina A&T (599 points), followed by Coppin State (457 points), Florida A&M (429 points), Howard (318 points), Morgan State (314 points), South Carolina State (303 points), Bethune-Cookman (302 points) and UMES (257 points).

Rounding out the rest of the preseason predicted order of finish were Norfolk State (238 points), Savannah State (118 points) and North Carolina Central (80 points).

### RETURNERS

Along with **Tierra Hawkins** and **Deanna Harmon**, DSU's floor general last season, point guard **Jade Washington**, returns for the Lady Hornets. Washington was tops on the club with 108 assists to rank fourth in the MEAC (3.5 apg) last season. In addition, she recorded a team-high 54 steals in her first season in a Hornet uniform after coming over from Arizona Western.

Rounding out the rest of the Hornets' returning players are sophomore **N'Kayah Kersey** and junior **Coreenah Redden**.

Appearing in 31 games last season, including 10 starts, Kersey will provide depth at the guard position, while Redden will do the same after playing in 26 games in 2012-13.

### FRESH FACES

Delaware State's newcomers include standout twin sisters **Raven** and **Raine Bankston** out of Detroit, Mich.

Also, in the backcourt, is the addition of sharpshooter **Diamond Williams** out of Newark, N.J.

Forwards **Tylinn Carter** and **Mi'Queara Lewis**, meanwhile, will look to make solid contributions in their first seasons in a Hornet uniform.

Hailing from San Diego, Calif., by way of Serra High School, Carter averaged 14.1 points and 4.1 assists per game to help lead her squad to the Eastern League championship last season.

In the case of Lewis, she averaged 12 points and 10 rebounds per game, to go along with shooting 85 percent from the line. As a senior at Digital Harbor High School (Baltimore, Md.), she led her team to a Division I title.

In addition, walk-on freshman **Kareena Pitts** will compete for playing time down on the block.

### TOUGH ROAD AHEAD

The 2013-14 schedule for the Lady Hornets will be a tough one, headlined by five NCAA Tournament teams from last season in Vanderbilt, Albany, No. 8 Maryland, West Virginia and defending regular season and conference tournament MEAC champions, Hampton.

## Second Season at DSU | Record: 13-30 (6-12 MEAC)

A new era began on Thursday, May 31, 2012 for the Delaware State University women's basketball team as President **Harry L. Williams** introduced **Tamika L. Louis**, a former championship junior college head coach and Division I assistant coach, as the new head coach.

In her first season, the Lady Hornets finished 10-21 overall, including 6-10 in MEAC action to earn the ninth seed in the conference tournament. Nevertheless, DSU took down the eighth-seeded Bethune-Cookman Wildcats in the opening round, 55-44, to snap a five-year MEAC tournament skid.

Meanwhile, forward **Tierra Hawkins** was able to garner Second Team All-MEAC honors by leading the Lady Hornets in scoring (17.1 ppg) and rebounding (7.4 rpg).

Louis arrived at Delaware State with 14 years of coaching and recruiting experience on the NCAA Division I, Junior College and high school levels. Before accepting the position at DSU, she served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2011-12 season at George Washington University in Washington, D.C.

"As the Lady Hornets' head coach, I will be a servant-leader and hope that my energy, dedication and work ethic will be infectious to the young ladies on the team."

Louis added: "We will establish a winning culture here with an expectation to excel in the classroom and on the court, resulting in MEAC championships. Just as important, we will develop future leaders who, upon graduation, will make an immediate impact in our global society and positively represent DSU."

From 2009-11, Louis was an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for St. John's University, where she was in charge of organizing all recruiting initiatives, game scouting, overseeing player academic progress and of-court mentoring. Additionally, she was responsible for the development of the Red Storm guards, including Second Team All-Big East and Freshman All-American Shenniekia Smith.

Prior to her time at SJU, Louis served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Illinois from 2007-09 where she was instrumental in signing the No. 2 and No. 3 ranked players in the 2009 class in the country, according to ESPN Hoop Girl and Blue Star rankings, in All-Americans Destiny Williams and Karisma Penn.

From 2002-05, she was the head women's basketball coach at Mott Community College in Flint, Mich., where she led her squad to a 58-33 overall record during her tenure. The 2004-05 squad boasted a 16-0 conference record and was 27-7 overall en route to a NJCAA Region XII championship and bid to the NJCAA Tournament. For her efforts during this stellar season, Louis was named the Michigan Community College Athletic Association and Region XII Coach of the Year.

Before joining the collegiate coaching ranks, Louis had stints as an assistant and associate basketball coach at Central High School in Fresno, Calif., Rhodes High School in Cleveland, Ohio and Cuyahoga Community College in Cleveland, Ohio.

After playing her freshman year (1993-94) at West Virginia University, Louis transferred to Fresno State, where she was the starting point guard and captain from 1995-98. She earned her Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts Degrees in communications from Fresno State University.
