BEARS

» THE GAME

The Delaware State women's basketball team (7-18, 2-11 MEAC) will continue its final three-game home stretch of the season Monday evening against the visiting Morgan State Bears (3-22, 1-11 MEAC).

» THE OPPONENT

After losing 15 consecutive games, the Bears secured their first win since Dec. 18 with an upset 66-61 win at home over in-state rival Coppin State last Wednesday. Offensively, MSU is led by the MEAC's second leading scorer guard **Tracey Carrington** (21.1 ppg), who also leads the team in rebounding (5.4 rpg). The squad's next leading scorer, meanwhile, is guard **Ivy Harrington** (7.0 ppg).

» THE COACH

Donald Beasley is in his ninth season with the Morgan State women's basketball program. Throughout his tenure, Beasley has reached the century mark in wins and has had at least one player receive All-MEAC honors each season.

» THE SERIES

Delaware State is 38-32 all-time against the Bears. Earlier in the season on Feb. 1, the Hornets defeated MSU on the road, 86-66, for their first conference. In that game, DSU shot 53 percent (32-of-61), led by guard **Raven Bankston** dropping a then career-high 35 points (13-of-23).

A WIN WOULD MEAN...

- » The Lady Hornets' second time winning back-to-back games this season.
- » Delaware State's first time sweeping the season series against MSU since the 2011-12 season.
- » DSU's sixth home victory of the season, its third in MEAC play.

LAST TIME OUT...

Delaware State defeated UMES this past Saturday, 79-68, behind a season-best 53 percent (26-of-49) and four players scoring in double figures. Leading the way was freshman sensation **Raven Bankston** dropping a career-high 36 points (12-of-24), including going 9-of-10 (.900) from the free throw line and 3-of-5 (.600) from three-point range. Guard **Jade Washington** tallied a season-high 11 points (5-of-6) and a team-high seven rebounds, whereas fellow starter **Tylinn Carter** totaled 10 points (4-of-8) and five rebounds. Off the bench, guard **N'Kayah Kersey** finished with 13 points (3-of-4), including a 3-for-4 outing from beyond the arc, two assists and two steals.

BANKSTON ROLLING OF LATE

In her last seven games, freshman **Raven Bankston** is averaging 27 points per game on 47 percent shooting, including five games scoring at least 25 points and three games tallying 30 points or more. Her best game during stretch occurred in DSU's recent win at home over UMES with a career-high 36 points (12-of-24). In the Hornets' 86-66 road victory at Morgan State (Feb. 1), Bankston scored 35 points (13-of-23), which followed up a 28-point (13-of-21) effort against Wesley (Jan. 27). As a result, she was named MEAC Player of the Week for the first time ever. In addition, she was named MEAC Rookie of the Week for the sixth time after scoring a game-high 26 points (11-of-28), to go along with five rebounds, three assists and two blocks in DSU's 64-60 loss at home to South Carolina State (Feb. 10). Currently, Bankston sits third in the MEAC in scoring (20.4 ppg).

FAMILIAR FACE

On Monday, a familiar face in former DSU women's basketball head coach **Ed Davis** (2000-12) will be in attendance as an assistant coach with Morgan State. Manning the sidelines for 12 seasons, Davis posted a 178-182 overall record at DSU, including a 121-85 mark in conference action. Davis' years at Delaware State were highlighted by a MEAC Tournament championship and NCAA Tournament berth (2007), a MEAC regular season co-championship (2003-04), five MEAC championship game appearances and the only 20-win seasons (four) in team history.

MEAC STRUGGLES

Currently, Delaware State sits 12th in the MEAC standings with its 1-11 mark. In these 12 games, the Lady Hornets are being outscored 73-61 and shooting 38 percent from the field, including 25 percent from long distance. On the glass, teams are out-rebounding DSU, 525-438, whereas the Hornets have struggled to take care of the ball with 212 turnovers, compared to 148 assists.

CAN'T SHAKE THE INJURY BUG

Throughout the season, the Lady Hornets have been hit hard on the injury front. Before playing a game, center **Janay Carter**, whereas guard **Raine Bankston** also went down with a season-ending knee injury after starting five games.

Later in the year, guard **Diamond Williams** (ankle) missed three games before returning to action against NCCU (Jan. 18), while guard **Raven Bankston** suffered a sprained ankle in practice and did not suit up in DSU's loss at Coppin State (Feb. 3) for the first time this season. On the frontline, freshman **Kareena Pitts** has been inactive the past six games because of a foot injury.

However, redshirt freshman **Aaliyah Davis** played in her first game ever in DSU's win against UMES (Feb. 22), coming off two severe knee injuries.

HAWKINS DONE FOR THE SEASON WITH SHOULDER INJURY

The Hornets took another hit on the injury front with leading scorer (20.7 ppg) and rebounder **Tierra Hawkins** (10.2 rpg) officially ruled out for the rest of the season due to a shoulder injury. In her final game, Hawkins recorded her eighth double-double of the season with 11 points (5-of-18) and a game-high 15 rebounds in DSU's 50-47 loss at North Carolina A&T (Jan. 20). Hawkins wraps up her junior campaign as one of eight players in the country averaging 20+ points and 10+ rebounds per game. In DSU's 86-73 win at home over Wilmington (Nov. 20), she tallied 30 points to eclipse 1,000 career points to become the 15th player in Hornets history to reach this milestone. Currently, she sits eighth on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,280 points. Also, Hawkins was named MEAC Player of the Week twice this season (Nov. 25 and Jan. 6).

COMING UP NEXT...

DSU will face Howard this Saturday (2 p.m.) for its final home game of the season. Earlier in the season, the Lady Hornets fell on the road to the Bison on Jan. 2, 70-64.

ALL BY HERSELF

Standing as the lone senior, guard/forward **Deanna Harmon** sits third (11.7 ppg) in scoring, second (62) in assists and second (6.8 rpg) in rebounding on the team, while leading the squad in steals (49) and free-throw percent (.794). In addition, she is shooting 49 percent (90-of-186), which is third in the conference. So far this season, she has tallied the second most double-doubles (3) on the team behind **Tierra Hawkins** (8). Against Savannah State (Feb. 10), Harmon not only scored a career-high 24 points (3-of-5), but she went 18-of-19 (.947) from the charity stripe to set a modern-day school record. Adding to her versatility, she was named MEAC Defensive Player of the Week for the first time in her career on Feb. 3, headlined by tallying 19 points (5-of-9), a career-high 14 rebounds and a game-high five steals in the win against Wesley (Jan. 27). Against Morgan State (Feb. 1), she finished with 14 points (5-of-8) and nine rebounds.

"FLOOR" GENERAL WASHINGTON

Starting every game this season, guard **Jade Washington** leads the team in assists at 4.6 per contest, 114 total. Her highest output of the season occurred in DSU's 79-37 win at home against Wesley (Jan. 27) as she not only finished with a career-high 12, but this total matched a DSU single-game record. Washington also sits second on the team in steals at 1.6 per contest, 41 total. Last season, she led the Lady Hornets in the assist department at 3.5 assists per game, which was good for fourth in the MEAC.

BANKSTON RECORDS FIFTH MEAC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK HONOR, SIXTH WEEKLY AWARD OVERALL

On Feb. 10, guard **Raven Bankston** was named MEAC Rookie of the Week for the fifth time this season after scoring a game-high 26 points (11-of-28), to go along with five rebounds, three assists and two blocks in DSU's 64-60 loss at home to South Carolina State (Feb. 8). With this honor, not only has Bankston received MEAC Rookie of the Week honors five times, but it marks the sixth time this season she's earned a conference weekly award.

Totaling 63 points, eight rebounds, six assists, three steals and one block in victories over Wesley (Jan. 27) and Morgan State (Feb. 1), Bankston was named MEAC Player of the Week on . On Jan. 13, she was named MEAC Rookie of the Week for the fourth time this season after averaging 21.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.0 steals and 1.5 assists in games against NJIT and Hampton.

Nov. 11 marked Bankston's first MEAC Rookie of the Week honor after totaling 18 points (8-of-12), including a 2-for-3 (.666) output from beyond the arc, five rebounds and a steal in DSU's season opening loss at Old Dominion. Later in the season, she won the award in back-to-back to weeks (Dec. 9, Dec. 16).

BACKCOURT TAKES A HIT, RAINE DONE FOR THE SEASON

Guard **Raine Bankston's**, twin sister of **Raven Bankston**, season abruptly ended with a knee injury suffered in practice in preparation for DSU's game against George Mason (Dec. 4). In five starts, she averaged 7.6 points, 3.6 assists, 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game. Coming out of high school, both ranked among the top 20 high school players in Michigan and helped lead John Glenn High School to city and district championships as seniors. In a game during their high school careers, they combined for 75 points.

HORNETS PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN THE MEAC

The Delaware State Lady Hornets were picked to finish 10th (254 points) in the MEAC Preseason Standings. Holding down the top spot was

defending regular season and conference tournament champions, Hampton (658), who received 20 first-place votes. Additionally, Hampton's **Alyssa Bennett** was named Co-MEAC Preseason Player of the Year, along with FAMU's **Jasmine Grace**.

Picked to finish second, meanwhile, was North Carolina A&T (599 points), followed by Coppin State (457 points), Florida A&M (429 points), Howard (318 points), Morgan State (314 points), South Carolina State (303 points), Bethune-Cookman (302 points) and UMES (257 points).

Rounding out the rest of the preseason predicted order of finish were Norfolk State (238 points), Savannah State (118 points) and North Carolina Central (80 points).

RETURNERS

Along with **Tierra Hawkins** and **Deanna Harmon**, DSU's floor general last season, point guard **Jade Washington**, returns for the Lady Hornets. Washington was tops on the club with 108 assists to rank fourth in the MEAC (3.5 apg) last season. In addition, she recorded a team-high 54 steals in her first season in a Hornet uniform after coming over from Arizona Western.

Rounding out the rest of the Hornets' returning players are sophomore **N'Kayah Kersey** and junior **Coreenah Redden**.

Appearing in 31 games last season, including 10 starts, Kersey will provide depth at the guard position, while Redden will do the same after playing in 26 games in 2012-13.

FRESH FACES

Delaware State's newcomers include standout twin sisters **Raven** and **Raine Bankston** out of Detroit, Mich. Also, in the backcourt, is the addition of sharpshooter **Diamond Williams** out of Newark, N.J.

Forwards **Tylinn Carter** and **Mi'Queara Lewis**, meanwhile, will look to make solid contributions in their first seasons in a Hornet uniform. Hailing from San Diego, Calif., by way of Serra High School, Carter averaged 14.1 points and 4.1 assists per game to help lead her squad to the Eastern League championship last season.

In the case of Lewis, she averaged 12 points and 10 rebounds per game, to go along with shooting 85 percent from the line. As a senior at Digital Harbor High School (Baltimore, Md.), she led her team to a Division I title.

In addition, walk-on freshman **Kareena Pitts** will compete for playing time down on the block.

TOUGH ROAD AHEAD

The 2013-14 schedule for the Lady Hornets will be a tough one, headlined by five NCAA Tournament teams from last season in Vanderbilt, Albany, No. 8 Maryland, West Virginia and defending regular season and conference tournament MEAC champions, Hampton.

Second Season at DSU | Record: 17-39 (8-21 MEAC)

A new era began on Thursday, May 31, 2012 for the Delaware State University women's basketball team as President **Harry L. Williams** introduced **Tamika L. Louis**, a former championship junior college head coach and Division I assistant coach, as the new head coach.

In her first season, the Lady Hornets finished 10-21 overall, including 6-10 in MEAC action to earn the ninth seed in the conference tournament. Nevertheless, DSU took down the eighth-seeded Bethune-Cookman Wildcats in the opening round, 55-44, to snap a five-year MEAC tournament skid.

Meanwhile, forward **Tierra Hawkins** was able to garner Second Team All-MEAC honors by leading the Lady Hornets in scoring (17.1 ppg) and rebounding (7.4 rpg).

Louis arrived at Delaware State with 14 years of coaching and recruiting experience on the NCAA Division I, Junior College and high school levels. Before accepting the position at DSU, she served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2011-12 season at George Washington University in Washington, D.C.

"As the Lady Hornets' head coach, I will be a servant-leader and hope that my energy, dedication and work ethic will be infectious to the young ladies on the team."

Louis added: "We will establish a winning culture here with an expectation to excel in the classroom and on the court, resulting in MEAC championships. Just as important, we will develop future leaders who, upon graduation, will make an immediate impact in our global society and positively represent DSU."

From 2009-11, Louis was an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for St. John's University, where she was in charge of organizing all recruiting initiatives, game scouting, overseeing player academic progress and of-court mentoring. Additionally, she was responsible for the development of the Red Storm guards, including Second Team All-Big East and Freshman All-American Shenniekia Smith.

Prior to her time at SJU, Louis served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Illinois from 2007-09 where she was instrumental in signing the No. 2 and No. 3 ranked players in the 2009 class in the country, according to ESPN Hoop Girl and Blue Star rankings, in All-Americans Destiny Williams and Karisma Penn.

From 2002-05, she was the head women's basketball coach at Mott Community College in Flint, Mich., where she led her squad to a 58-33 overall record during her tenure. The 2004-05 squad boasted a 16-0 conference record and was 27-7 overall en route to a NJCAA Region XII championship and bid to the NJCAA Tournament. For her efforts during this stellar season, Louis was named the Michigan Community College Athletic Association and Region XII Coach of the Year.

Before joining the collegiate coaching ranks, Louis had stints as an assistant and associate basketball coach at Central High School in Fresno, Calif., Rhodes High School in Cleveland, Ohio and Cuyahoga Community College in Cleveland, Ohio.

After playing her freshman year (1993-94) at West Virginia University, Louis transferred to Fresno State, where she was the starting point guard and captain from 1995-98. She earned her Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts Degrees in communications from Fresno State University.
