RATTLERS

» THE GAME

Tabbed as the 13th seed, the Delaware State women's basketball team (8-20, 3-13 MEAC) will take on No. 4 Florida A&M (16-13, 10-6 MEAC) Monday morning (11 a.m.) in the first round of the MEAC Tournament at the Scope Arena in Norfolk, Va.

» THE OPPONENT

The Rattlers head into postseason action winning five out of their last six games, including back-to-back victories over Morgan State and Bethune-Cookman to complete the regular season. Sitting second in the MEAC in scoring (70.1 ppg), FAMU has three players averaging double figures, led by the conference's leading scorer **Jasmine Grice** (25.4 ppg). In addition, Grice leads the MEAC in steals (113) and the Rattlers in rebounding (6.4 rpg). Also in the backcourt, guard **Taneka Rubin** averages 12.2 points per contest, while guard **Kimberly Sparkman** (10.0 ppg) leads the team in assists (120).

» THE COACH

LeDawn Gibson is in her fourth season with the Florida A&M women's basketball program. Last season, she led the Rattlers to a 15-15 overall record.

» THE SERIES

The Lady Hornets are 19-30 all-time against FAMU. Earlier in the season on Feb. 17, DSU fell 95-79 on the road to the Rattlers, despite guard **Raven Bankston** totaling a game-high 33 points (13-of-25) and a career-high nine rebounds. For FAMU, it shot 44 percent (35-of-80) from the field and 91 percent (19-of-21) from the free throw line with three players scoring in double figures, led by **Jasmine Grice's** 26 points (9-of-24) and five steals.

A WIN WOULD MEAN...

LAST TIME OUT...

DSU wrapped up the regular season with a 74-71 loss in overtime at UMES this past Monday, despite leading by 14 twice in the second half. At game's end, the Hornets shot 47 percent (28-of-60) from the floor, compared to UMES's 35 percent (25-of-72). Guard **Raven Bankston**, who was bothered by a lingering shoulder injury most of the night, led three Hornet players in double figures with a team-high 20 points (9-of-22). On the glass, forward **Tylinn Carter** pulled down a career-high 18 rebounds, which was the most by any Hornet this season. For the Hawks, **Mariah McCoy** led four players in double figures with a game-high 21 points (9-of-14). **Ashleigh Claybrooks**, meanwhile, recorded a double-double with 12 points and a team-high 15 rebounds off the bench.

TOURNAMENT TIME

The Lady Hornets are 21-31 all-time in MEAC Tournament action... DSU's last win in the MEAC Tournament occurred last season with a 55-44 victory over Bethune-Cookman in the opening round, which snapped a five-year drought... Delaware State's lone MEAC Tournament crown occurred in 2007 with a 55-42 win over Morgan State.

BANKSTON KEEPS ON CHUGGING

In her last 10 games, freshman Raven Bankston is averaging 27.0 points per game on 46 percent (105-of-230) shooting, including six games scoring at least 25 points and four games tallying 30 points or more. Her best game during stretch occurred in DSU's recent win at home over Howard with a career-high 38 points (14-of-32), which was the third most in DSU single-game history. Currently, Bankston sits second in the MEAC and 27th in the nation in scoring (21.0 ppg).

MEAC STRUGGLES

Finishing with a 3-13 mark in conference action this season, the Lady Hornets were outscored 71-63 and shot 39 percent from the field, including 28 percent from long distance. On the glass, teams out-rebounded DSU, 720-579, whereas the Hornets struggled to take care of the ball with 279 turnovers, compared to 194 assists.

ROAD WOES

In 15 games away from Memorial Hall, DSU is 2-13 and being outscored, 79-62. Offensively, the Lady Hornets are shooting 39 percent from field, including 24 percent from beyond the arc, while also dishing out 184 assists, compared to 260 by their oppositions. Additionally, opposing squads are

MOVING UP IN THE RECORD BOOKS, MILESTONE WATCH

Guard **Raven Bankston** surpassed Carlene Albury (1985-86) for most points in DSU single-season history with 567... Guard **Jade Washington** now sits sixth all-time on the DSU career assists list with 230... Guard/forward **Deanna Harmon** needs 20 points to become the 16th player in team history to tally 1,000 career points.

AT THIS POINT LAST SEASON...

The Lady Hornets were 9-19 overall and 6-9 in MEAC play, coming off a 59-49 loss at Morgan State.

ALL BY HERSELF

Standing as the lone senior, guard/forward **Deanna Harmon** sits third on the team in scoring (11.8 ppg), second in assists (67) and second in rebounding (6.6 rpg), while leading the squad in steals (52) and free-throw percent (.790). In addition, she is shooting 48 percent (103-of-216), which is third best in the conference, and tallied the second most double-doubles (3) on the team behind **Tierra Hawkins** (8). Against Savannah State (Feb. 10), Harmon not only scored a career-high 24 points (3-of-5), but she went 18-of-19 (.947) from the charity stripe to set a modern-day school record. Adding to her versatility, she was named MEAC Defensive Player of the Week for the first time in her career on Feb. 3, headlined by tallying 19 points (5-of-9), a career-high 14 rebounds and a game-high five steals in the win against Wesley (Jan. 27). Against Morgan State (Feb. 1), she finished with 14 points (5-of-8) and nine rebounds.

"FLOOR" GENERAL WASHINGTON

Despite missing her first start in a DSU against Morgan State (Feb. 24), guard **Jade Washington** leads the team in assists at 4.5 per contest, 120 total. Her highest output of the season occurred in DSU's 79-37 win at home against Wesley (Jan. 27) as she not only finished with a career-high 12, but this total matched a DSU single-game record. Washington also sits second on the team in steals at 1.6 per contest, 44 total. Last season, she led the Lady Hornets in the assist department at 3.5 assists per game, which was good for fourth in the MEAC.

CAN'T SHAKE THE INJURY BUG

Throughout the season, the Lady Hornets have been hit hard on the injury front. Freshman center **Janay Carter** went down with a season-ending knee injury before playing a game, whereas guard **Raine Bankston** suffered the same injury after starting five games. In addition, freshman **Kareena Pitts** (foot) has been inactive since Jan. 29 and is out for the rest of the season.

Earlier in the year, guard **Diamond Williams** (ankle) missed three games before returning to action against NCCU (Jan. 18), while guard **Raven Bankston** suffered a sprained ankle in practice and did not suit up in DSU's loss at Coppin State (Feb. 3). Recently, starting point guard **Jade Washington** (hamstring) missed her first game ever in DSU's 75-64 loss to Morgan State (Feb. 24), but returned the following game against Howard (March 1).

BANKSTON RECORDS SECOND MEAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR, SEVENTH WEEKLY AWARD OVERALL

Freshman sensation **Raven Bankston** was named MEAC Player of the Week for the second week in a row on March 3, third overall, headlined by a 38-point (14-of-32), six-rebound and two-assist performance in DSU's overtime 64-61 win over Howard. Earlier in the week, despite the Lady Hornets falling 65-54 to Morgan State at home, she tallied a team-high 20 points (8-of-19), along with four rebounds, four assists and two blocks. With this honor, Bankston has earned eight conference weekly awards, as she's been named MEAC Rookie of the Week five times throughout her first season in a Hornet uniform.

HAWKINS DONE FOR THE SEASON WITH SHOULDER INJURY

The Hornets took another hit on the injury front with leading scorer (20.7 ppg) and rebounder **Tierra Hawkins** (10.2 rpg) officially ruled out for the rest of the season due to a shoulder injury. Hawkins wraps up her junior campaign as one of eight players in the country averaging 20+ points and 10+ rebounds per game. In her final game, Hawkins recorded her eighth double-double of the season with 11 points (5-of-18) and a game-high 15 rebounds in DSU's 50-47 loss at North Carolina A&T (Jan. 20). Currently,

DAVIS MAKES DEBUT

After missing last season, along with the majority of this season because back-to-back knee injuries, redshirt freshman **Aaliyah Davis** made her first appearance in a Hornet uniform in DSU's win against UMES (Feb. 22). Starring at Cape Henlopen High School (Del.), Davis was a two-time First Team All-South and All-Conference honoree, while also earning First Team All-State recognition as a senior.

SISTER, SISTER

Guard **Raine Bankston's**, twin sister of **Raven Bankston**, season abruptly ended with a knee injury suffered in practice in preparation for DSU's game against George Mason (Dec. 4). In five starts, she averaged 7.6 points, 3.6 assists, 2.8 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game. Coming out of high school, both ranked among the top 20 high school players in Michigan and helped lead John Glenn High School to city and district championships as seniors. In a game during their high school careers, they combined for 75 points.

HORNETS PICKED TO FINISH 10TH IN THE MEAC

The Delaware State Lady Hornets were picked to finish 10th (254 points) in the MEAC Preseason Standings.

Holding down the top spot was defending regular season and conference tournament champions,

Hampton (658), who received 20 first-place votes. Additionally, Hampton's **Alyssa Bennett** was named Co-MEAC Preseason Player of the Year, along with FAMU's **Jasmine Grace**.

Picked to finish second, meanwhile, was North Carolina A&T (599 points), followed by Coppin State (457 points), Florida A&M (429 points), Howard (318 points), Morgan State (314 points), South Carolina State (303 points), Bethune-Cookman (302 points) and UMES (257 points).

Rounding out the rest of the preseason predicted order of finish were Norfolk State (238 points), Savannah State (118 points) and North Carolina Central (80 points).

RETURNERS

Along with **Tierra Hawkins** and **Deanna Harmon**, DSU's floor general last season, point guard **Jade Washington**, returns for the Lady Hornets. Washington was tops on the club with 108 assists to rank fourth in the MEAC (3.5 apg) last season. In addition, she recorded a team-high 54 steals in her first season in a Hornet uniform after coming over from Arizona Western.

Rounding out the rest of the Hornets' returning players are sophomore **N'Kayah Kersey** and junior **Coreenah Redden**.

Appearing in 31 games last season, including 10 starts, Kersey will provide depth at the guard position, while Redden will do the same after playing in 26 games in 2012-13.

FRESH FACES

Delaware State's newcomers include standout twin sisters **Raven** and **Raine Bankston** out of Detroit, Mich. Also, in the backcourt, is the addition of sharpshooter **Diamond Williams** out of Newark, N.J.

Forwards **Tylinn Carter** and **Mi'Queara Lewis**, meanwhile, will look to make solid contributions in their first seasons in a Hornet uniform. Hailing from San Diego, Calif., by way of Serra High School, Carter averaged 14.1 points and 4.1 assists per game to help lead her squad to the Eastern League championship last season.

In the case of Lewis, she averaged 12 points and 10 rebounds per game, to go along with shooting 85 percent from the line. As a senior at Digital Harbor High School (Baltimore, Md.), she led her team to a Division I title.

In addition, walk-on freshman **Kareena Pitts** will compete for playing time down on the block.

TOUGH ROAD AHEAD

The 2013-14 schedule for the Lady Hornets will be a tough one, headlined by five NCAA Tournament teams from last season in Vanderbilt, Albany, No. 8 Maryland, West Virginia and defending regular season and conference tournament MEAC champions, Hampton.

Second Season at DSU | Record: 18-41 (9-23 MEAC)

A new era began on Thursday, May 31, 2012 for the Delaware State University women's basketball team as President **Harry L. Williams** introduced **Tamika L. Louis**, a former championship junior college head coach and Division I assistant coach, as the new head coach.

In her first season, the Lady Hornets finished 10-21 overall, including 6-10 in MEAC action to earn the ninth seed in the conference tournament. Nevertheless, DSU took down the eighth-seeded Bethune-Cookman Wildcats in the opening round, 55-44, to snap a five-year MEAC tournament skid.

Meanwhile, forward **Tierra Hawkins** was able to garner Second Team All-MEAC honors by leading the Lady Hornets in scoring (17.1 ppg) and rebounding (7.4 rpg).

Louis arrived at Delaware State with 14 years of coaching and recruiting experience on the NCAA Division I, Junior College and high school levels. Before accepting the position at DSU, she served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2011-12 season at George Washington University in Washington, D.C.

"As the Lady Hornets' head coach, I will be a servant-leader and hope that my energy, dedication and work ethic will be infectious to the young ladies on the team."

Louis added: "We will establish a winning culture here with an expectation to excel in the classroom and on the court, resulting in MEAC championships. Just as important, we will develop future leaders who, upon graduation, will make an immediate impact in our global society and positively represent DSU."

From 2009-11, Louis was an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for St. John's University, where she was in charge of organizing all recruiting initiatives, game scouting, overseeing player academic progress and of-court mentoring. Additionally, she was responsible for the development of the Red Storm guards, including Second Team All-Big East and Freshman All-American Shennieka Smith.

Prior to her time at SJU, Louis served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Illinois from 2007-09 where she was instrumental in signing the No. 2 and No. 3 ranked players in the 2009 class in the country, according to ESPN Hoop Girl and Blue Star rankings, in All-Americans Destiny Williams and Karisma Penn.

From 2002-05, she was the head women's basketball coach at Mott Community College in Flint, Mich., where she led her squad to a 58-33 overall record during her tenure. The 2004-05 squad boasted a 16-0 conference record and was 27-7 overall en route to a NJCAA Region XII championship and bid to the NJCAA Tournament. For her efforts during this stellar season, Louis was named the Michigan Community College Athletic Association and Region XII Coach of the Year.

Before joining the collegiate coaching ranks, Louis had stints as an assistant and associate basketball coach at Central High School in Fresno, Calif., Rhodes High School in Cleveland, Ohio and Cuyahoga Community College in Cleveland, Ohio.

After playing her freshman year (1993-94) at West Virginia University, Louis transferred to Fresno State, where she was the starting point guard and captain from 1995-98. She earned her Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts Degrees in communications from Fresno State University.
