2015 FAMU Football Season To Be Dedicated To Nelson Townsend

The late **Nelson Townsend**, a dynamic visionary who three times served as Director of Athletics at Florida A&M University, passed away in early January of this year.

FAMU head football coach Alex Wood, who was hired by Townsend in December, stated that the 2015 season would be played in Townsend's honor.

Townsend, a Virginia native, is a member of the National Association

of Collegiate Athletic Directors (NACDA) Hall of Fame, along with the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) and University of Maryland-Eastern Shore Halls of Fame.

In addition to his three tours at FAMU, Townsend served as Athletic Director at Maryland-Eastern Shore, Delaware State and the University of Buffalo, helping UB transition from Division III to Division One.

2015: The struggle continues:Heading into the third week of October, FAMU coaches, players and fans are still mystified at the club's 0-6 start... The Rattlers have been competitive every game before a key miscue or a late surge by the opponents seals the deal....

@ The last three games have seen FAMU seemingly on the verge of getting a win, only to have it slip away in the late going.... FAMU led Tennessee State 14-7 in the third period, before a TSU touchdown and safety late in the quarter shifted the momentum away from FAMU.... Savannah State shocked the Rattlers early, jumping to a 30-7 lead by halftime, but FAMU clawed their way back to 30-20 before a critical fumble inside their own 20 led to SSU's clinching points late in the third.... Saturday against NCCU, FAMU led 24-17 headed into the final period, but misfired on a third down passing play in the red zone, before missing a field goal, opening the door for NCCU to score 10 late points to escape with a win...

@ In the opener at USF, FAMU trailed 3-0 after one period and 13-0 at the half before the Bulls pulled away in the second half.... The next week against Samford, FAMU led 14-10 after the first quarter, but the Bulldogs stormed back with a 31-point second quarter to put the game out of reach.... The South Carolina State game was pure frustration for FAMU, as they were shutout, 36-0, unable to muster any offense, while getting worn down defensively by the Bulldogs patented ground game, which struck for over 400 yards.

State was on hand for the biggest crowd – 30,459 in 2010, and the 2005 battle between FAMU and Norfolk State attracted 26,988 fans....

FAMU's Leading Men:

@ **Defensively**, the Rattlers have been put to the test by opposing defenses far, but the GanGreen Defense has held its own for the most part... Preseason All-MEAC safety Jacques Bryant now tops the tackle charts with 44 stops (28 solos) and an interception... Linebackers Akil Blount (41 tackles, 2.5 for loss, INT for TD) and Kashawn Butler (42 tackles, 3 recovered fumbles, an interception), have been big hitters too, along with sec-

ondary aces Braxton Brown (34 stops) and John Boston (29 stops, a TFL, INT).... Junior Curtis Alexander (28 tackles, 3.0 for loss) is the other member of the Three Hitmen at line-backer....

@ **Offensively**, freshman Devin Bowers still holds the club rushing lead with 144 yards on 15 carries, followed by Devondrick Nealy (111) and Gerald Hearn (89).... QB Carson Royal has passed for 928 yards and a 3 TDs on 81 of 155 passing (4 INTs), while backup Kenny Coleman (306 yards, 1 TD on 28 of 57 passes, 3 INTs) has seen playing time of late.... Sophomore Brandon Norwood tops the team with 32 receptions for 264

yards and one TD, followed by Montavious Williams' 383 yards on 23 grabs.... Both players had nine (9) catches against North Carolina Central (10-10-15)...

@ Special Teams: Nealy is averaging 18.4 yards per punt return, highlighted by his electrifying 84-yard TD runback against Tennessee State (9-26-15)... He is also averaging 20.7 yards on kickoff returns, sharing those duties with Jairockeis Jones (15.6) and Kenyan Foster (13.9).... Junior Colby Blanton is the Rattler kicking game, averaging 41.0 per punt (44 attempts), with two 61-yard kicks, seven (7) kicks over 50 yards, and 13 downed inside the opponent's 20-yard line... He is 11-of-11 on PATS and 4-of-9 on field goals, in this his first collegiate season punting, placekicking and kicking off, where he averages 58.8 yards on his kickoffs...

Year of the Long Play: The Rattlers have despite their struggles, made some big, long plays (40 yards or longer) in the first six games – nearly of them scoring plays (See Page 4 chart):

Nealy Mr. All Purpose:

Devondrick Nealy has made the most of his touches of the pigskin so far this year, leading the Rattlers in all-purpose yards... The senior from nearby Monticello, Florida, who transferred in to FAMU from Iowa State, is averaging 106.0 all purpose yards per game....

Through six games, Nealy has 636 combined yards (111 rushing, 152 receiving, 166 on punt returns and 207 on kickoff returns).... The scintillating speedster brought the huge Bragg Stadium crowd to their feet three weeks ago against Tennessee State (9-26-15), with his 84-yard TD punt return in his first home game in a Rattler uniform... He had a 46-yard return the following week (10-3-15) to set up a score for FAMU against Savannah State.... Saturday against NCCU, Nealy caught a 50-yard pass on a flea flicker play from Kareem Smith in the second quarter..

The MEAC Right Now: Heading into the third week of October, the 2015 MEAC title chase and the Run For Atlanta (champion gets berth in the newly-minted Celebration Bowl) continues with five games on tap being of the league variety....

@ After the first month, the five teams that tied for first in the 2014 standings are either in first or within range of the top spot... Bethune-Cookman (3-0, 5-1) and Morgan State (3-0, 4-2) – are out front, with North Carolina A&T (2-0, 4-1) a half-game back.... Norfolk State (2-1, 2-4) is next followed by South Carolina State and North Carolina Central (both 1-1, 2-3)...

@ This week's action features a pair of 1:00 games, with Bethune-Cookman

traveling to North Carolina A&T, while Hampton (2-2, 3-3) hopes to stay alive in the chase at Morgan State....

Winless Howard (0-2, 0-4) is at South Carolina State, and North Carolina Central is at Savannah State (1-2, 1-4), in the 2:00 games... Delaware State (0-2, 0-4) is at FAMU (0-3, 0-6) for Homecoming at 3:00 p.m., while Norfolk State has a bye weekend....

The Final Five: The Rattlers suffered another bitter setback last week, falling 27-24 to Morgan State, leaving them five game left to build some momentum toward next season....

Although technically, the Rattlers are ineligible for the MEAC title due to the APR penalties from the NCAA, their league games count in the standings, meaning they can have a say on who wins the title.... FAMU continues their final stretch at home this week during Homecoming against Delaware State for Homecoming (3:00 p.m.), before closing their home slate in two weeks against North Carolina A&T (Oct. 31 – 5:00 p.m.).... FAMU closes the season in a familiar vein, on the road, with November travel dates at Hampton (Nov. 7 - 1:00 p.m.); Morgan State (Nov. 14 - 1:00 p.m.); and Bethune-Cookman (Nov. 21 - 2:30 p.m.) in Orlando....

Head Football Coach * Florida A&M University
University of Iowa, 1978 * First Season

At first glance, Florida A&M University head football coach Alex Wood looks more like an erudite college professor than a football coach.

But beyond the personable, mild-mannered, intellectual persona that Wood projects to the public, is a fiercely competitive firebrand, who stresses discipline and accountability from his players both on and off the field.

A native of Massillon, Ohio, Wood was a product of the storied Ohio high school program that was once led by the legendary Paul Brown, who went on to coach the Cleveland Browns and later found the Cincinnati Bengals.

"I wasn't a supremely gifted athlete," Wood recalls. "But I worked hard, worked out hard, lifting weights. I was known as a tough guy, a try hard guy."

Wood, who was a walk-on running back and special teams performer at the University of Iowa, eventually earned a scholarship with the Hawkeyes.

It was in the crucible of his years as a dedicated and determined young athlete, that the idea of

continuing in the game of football was born.

"Many of my coaches in high school and college inspired me during my playing career," Wood recalls. "Denny (Dennis) Green was one of my coaches at Iowa. He was an excellent coach, and he was also the first African American coach I ever had."

"I knew I didn't have the talent for the NFL," Wood said, "but I wanted to get something back for what I had put into the game, so I moved into coaching."

"Coaching keeps me in the game (football). I interact with other coaches, work clinics, growing and learning so I can pass along that knowledge. That in turn, allows me to teach the fundamentals of football, instill discipline, to teach life lessons, and place emphasis on character and perseverance," said Wood.

"Seeing some of those former players years later, some who may not been great athletes, but who have become great men is very rewarding, knowing you helped make a difference, that you touched the lives of young men," he concluded.

Wood, came to Florida A&M from the University of Buffalo, where he was offensive coordinator the last four seasons (2011-14), and interim head coach for the last half of the 2014 season.

During that four-year run, the Bulls averaged 35 points and over 4,000 yards in offense, finding a perfect balance between the run and pass.

His offensive philosophy was no doubt influenced by his various work stops in college, which ranged from championship teams at Miami (Fla.), and tours in FCS at James Madison and Southern (La.), to the professional level, in Minnesota, Cincinnati and Arizona.

Offensively, Rattler fans can expect to see a no huddle, hurry up pro style attack, that will utilize multiple personnel groupings and multiple formations, seeking that critical balance between the run and the pass, while pressuring opposing defenses with a relentless pace.

"We will snap the ball with 17 seconds on the play clock, seeking to average 95 plays or more every game. This will allow us to keep opponents vanilla, and not allow them to substitute much," promises Wood.

Rattler fans got a taste of an up tempo, fastbreak offense during the Gulf Coast Offense days under coach Billy Joe (1994-2004), and the possibilities of a return of those high-flying days has many FAMUans breathless with anticipation headed into 2015.

"The no-huddle is something we've always done, at first late in games, or when things were stagnant, to pump some life back into the offense.

"But now it is a full-time venture, with emphasis on a balanced philosophy. We don't want to be one dimensional, and being able to establish the run allows us to use play action more effectively as well," Wood added.

Defensively, stopping the run, which has been a challenge for the Rattlers in recent years, will be the top priority of Wood's GanGreen Defense.

"On offense, we want to be equally effective in the run game and through the air, while on defense, we want to make teams one dimensional, and stopping the run will be the key to success on that side of the ball."



Wood will employ multiple fronts on defense, with an aggressive, pressure style, that will cover well in the secondary, and seek to confuse the quarterback.

"We will play with pace on defense too, running to the ball like scalded dogs, being sound in our tackling and looking to create takeaways" Wood says.

With Fall training camp just days away, the first-year Rattler coach turned his expectations for the team in 2015, sounding very much like the 37-year coaching veteran he is.

"I expect us to play hard, play smart, play and a complete game with great excitement for four quarters," Wood said of his charges, who were in the final stages of a summer training regime that began in mid May.

The summer work regimen for the players placed equal emphasis on athletic training and academic excellence, and according to Wood, it was the first complete summer session the program has ever had.

"We are coming out of the summer training energized," Wood said. "I'm really looking forward to our seniors providing leadership for us this year, and they should be the most hungry to have a good year."

Rattler fans and opponents can expect Alex Wood to put his mark on the FAMU Football Program, such that it reflects the tenets of hard work, discipline and character that he has espoused over his long and fruitful career.

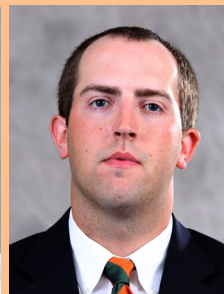
