Delaware State Head Coach Eric Skeeters (Coppin State, '97): 3-8 at DSU and career (first season)

Weber State Head Coach Randy Rahe (Buena Vista, '82): 253-143 at WSU and career (13th year); 0-0 vs. DSU

THE GAME

Delaware State plays its next-to-last non-MEAC game of the season, visiting Weber State of the Big Sky Conference. The Hornets are coming off a 73-71 victory at First State rival Delaware on Wednesday. Kevin Larkin (sr.) scored the winning points on a follow-up basket with 3.4 seconds left to play. The winning shot capped off a stellar performance for Larkin, who led DSU with 22 points and a career-high 13 rebounds. He currently leads the Hornets in scoring at 15.6 points per game and is rebounding at 9.0 per contest. The Georgetown, Del., native and Sussex Tech (Del.) High School product, transferred to Delaware State for his final season after competing for two seasons at Niagara (N.Y.).

The win at Delaware was DSU's first against a Division I opponent this season and snapped a 27-game road losing streak, dating back to 2016-17 campaign.

Saleik Edwards (sr.) added 18 points in the Delaware contest, highlighted by four three-point field goals. Edwards, the Hornets' second-leading scorer at 13.1 ppg, has 15 three-pointers in the last four games. Jonathan Mitchell (sr.) is DSU's third leading scorer (8.6 ppg) and second best rebounder (5.4 pg).

The Hornets tied their season-high with 13 three-pointers vs. Delaware (13-for-27), while forcing the Hens into six-of-30 shooting from long distance in the game.

Weber State is looking to snap a three-game losing streak. The Wildcats are coming off a 75-63 home loss to Utah Valley last Saturday (Dec. 15). WSU trailed 41-23 at the break and could get no closer than 10 points in the second half. Jerrick Harding, a junior guard, is the team's top scorer at 19.4 points per game. Junior guard Cody John averages 16.7 points, while senior forward / center Zach Braxton contributes 10.4 points and a team-high 7.9 rebounds per game.

HORNETS vs. WILDCATS / BIG SKY

This will be the first meeting between the Hornets and Wildcats. Delaware State is 1-2 all-time vs. current members of the Big Sky Conference. DSU's last contest against a Big Sky opponent was a 91-66 loss at Montana State on Nov. 26, 2016. The Hornets defeated North Arizona 58-53 in the 2006 post-season National Invitation Tournament for their lone win against a Big Sky team.

HORNETS HAVE MUCH TO PROVE IN 2018-19 MEAC RACE

Delaware State is not given much chance in the 2018-19 Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) regular season race. The Hornets have been picked to finish 10th in the 10-team conference race. Delaware State was last in the 2017-18 MEAC standings with a 2-14 league record.

Bethune-Cookman was tabbed as the preseason favorite to win the MEAC this season. The Wildcats captured a share of the MEAC Championship last season under then first-year head coach Ryan Ridder. BCU was 12-4 in MEAC play and 18-14 overall last season. The Cats return nine players and four starters from last year's squad. Back-to-back MEAC Tournament Champion North Carolina Central was picked second followed by Norfolk State.

Rounding out the rest of the preseason poll are Howard, North Carolina A&T State, Morgan State, Florida A&M, Savannah State, Coppin State, South Carolina State, Maryland Eastern Shore and Delaware State.

DSU is also left out of the 2018-19 MEAC preseason honors. No Hornet is listed on any of the Preseason All-MEAC teams, as determined by league head coaches and sports information representatives.

HORNETS IN THE MEAC

Despite its recent woes, Delaware State has enjoyed a fair amount of success in league play since the 2000-01 season. The Hornets own a 173-131 mark vs. MEAC competition during the span (.569). DSU has reached double figures in MEAC wins 10 times since 2000-01 season. Delaware State claimed three consecutive MEAC regular season titles from 2004-07. During that span, the Hornets were 46-8 in league games. Delaware State captured its only MEAC Tournament title and NCAA Tournament berth in 2005. The Hornets have competed in six MEAC Tournament championship games, the last in 2015.

Hornet 2018-19 Honors

EDWARDS LEADS HORNETS' THREE-POINT ATTACK

Delaware State has emerged as one of the MEAC's top three-point shooting teams this season. The Hornets are second on the league in threes at 9.0 per game, trailing only Savannah State at 13.0. DSU tied its season-high with 13 three-pointers in its 73-71 victory over Delaware on Wednesday. The Hornets are sixth among MEAC teams with a .315 three-point shooting percentage.

Saleik Edwards (sr.) is the Hornets' top three-point shooting threat. Edwards is third in the MEAC at 3.1 threes per game (34 total), while **Faheem Jenneto** (fr.) ranks fifth in the league with a .412 three-point shooting percentage.

Edwards had a career-best six three-pointers in the season opener at East Carolina on Nov. 6. and knocked down five threes vs. Jacksonville State in the Hornets' last outing on Dec. 8. Through 10 games this season, he has already exceeded his three-point total for the entire 2017-18 campaign. Edwards is 30-for-88 from beyond the arch this season. He had 18 three-pointers for the entire 2017-18 campaign.

Delaware State has knocked down at least six three-pointers in each game this season. The Hornets have reached double-figures in threes in four games.

NO PLACE LIKE THE FIRST STATE FOR HORNET SENIOR



Delaware State is thankful for Kevin Larkin's decision to return to the First State for his final collegiate season. His latest performance that has Hornet fans smiling came in Wednesday's 73-71 win at Delaware. Larkin scored the winning points on a follow-up basket with 3.4 seconds left to play to cap off a 22-point, 13-rebound effort (each a team high) in the contest. On Dec. 3, all Larkin did was score a career-best 40 points, grab 11 rebounds, record six assists and four steals in DSU's 102-66 victory over Cairn. The 40 points were the most by a Hornet since Amere May matched the total vs. Coppin State on Mar. 5, 2015, and is tied for 11th among all NCAA Div. I players this season.

Despite an injury-plagued start, Larkin is hoping to make the most of his one season at Delaware State. Following an All-State career at Sussex Tech High School in Georgetown, Del., he began his college career at Cheyney (Pa.) before transferring to Niagara.

Larkin has played in just seven of the Hornets' 11 games this season. He missed the first three games, and four overall, due to injuries.

His 15.6 point per-game and 9.0 rebound per-game averages are tops on the Hornets and would rank among the MEAC leaders if not for the missed games. Conference statistical leaders must play in at least 75% of their teams' contests to appear in the rankings. Larkin has played in 63.6% of the Hornets' games this season (7 of 11).

DELAWARE STATE 2018-19 MEN'S BASKETBALL — HEAD COACH ERIC SKEETERS



Skeeters, an assistant coach with the team that pulled off the biggest upset in the history of the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament and Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference alum was announced as the 13th head coach of the Hornets on July 25, 2018 by DSU Director of Athletics Scott Gines.

A Baltimore, Md., native, Skeeters most recently served as an assistant at Maryland-Baltimore County (UMBC). This is his first head coach position.

Prior to joining the Hornets, Skeeters served two seasons as an assistant under head coach Ryan Odom at UMBC from 2016-to-2018.

Last March, the Retrievers shocked the college basketball world and ruined millions of brackets with a historic 74-54 win over top-ranked Virginia, the first-ever win by a No. 16 seed against a No. 1 seed in 136 all-time NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament match-ups.

UMBC's 2017-18 season was also highlighted by the second America East Tournament championship in team history and a school-record 25 wins (25-11).

"Eric Skeeters stood out among an outstanding group of candidates for head coach of the Delaware State men's basketball team," said Gines. "He's a 21-year Division I assistant who has contributed to successful programs in highly competitive conferences, including the MEAC. During his career, Skeeters has played a key role in helping to rebuild programs, while serving on staffs that engineered two of the biggest upsets in NCAA Tournament history."

According to Gines, Skeeters has the experience and leadership attributes the DSU men's basketball program needs at this time, besides being a good fit for the school.

"Eric will resonate with our current players, community, and alumni. They will love his energy, drive, and devotion. He is well positioned to lead our men's basketball team," said the new Delaware State AD.

From 2013 to 2016, Skeeters was an assistant coach at George Mason University in Fairfax, Va., and the previous four years he was a member of the University of South Florida coaching staff. While at South Florida, he helped lead the Bulls to their first NCAA Tournament bid in 20 years. USF made the most of its 2012 Big Dance appearance, defeating California and Temple before falling to Ohio in the round of 32.

Skeeters' coaching career also includes a six-year stint at Towson University (Md.), in addition to assistant positions at Virginia Tech, Youngstown State, and his alma mater, Coppin State, also a member of the MEAC.

He was a young assistant coach for the 1996-97 Coppin State team that pulled a post-season upset of the University of South Carolina, marking the second victory by a No. 15 seed over a No. 2 in NCAA Tournament history.

"Delaware State University is a unique opportunity and I look forward to putting together a staff and team that will enable us to create something special," said Skeeters. "As a MEAC grad, my goal from day one will be to recruit, coach and develop champions on the court, in the classroom and in the community."

Skeeters added, "My journey around the game of basketball has taught me to surround yourself with great people that you believe in. My meetings with Director of Athletics Dr. Scott Gines, DSU President Dr. Wilma Mishoe and the committee made a huge impact in the decision process. I would like to personally thank Dr. Mishoe & Dr. Gines for this opportunity because I was thoroughly impressed with their vision for DSU, the athletics department and our program."

Skeeters was awarded a bachelor's in management science from Coppin State in 1997. He and wife Marie have two sons, Evan and Miles.
