Delaware State Head Coach Eric Skeeters (Coppin State, '97): 6-29 at DSU and career (second season); 0-0 vs. Virginia Tech

VT Head Coach Mike Young (Emory & Henry, '86): 4-0 at Virginia Tech (1st season); 303-244 career (18th season); 0-0 vs. DSU

THE GAME

Delaware State begins a three-game road swing with a visit to unbeaten Virginia Tech. The Hornets (0-4) are trying to bounce back from a 92-84 home loss to LIU Brooklyn on Monday. The point total marked a season-high for DSU this season. **John Crosby** (sr.) led the Hornets with a career-high 32 points, hitting 10-of-16 shots from the field and 10-of-13 at the free throw line, while **L.J. Stansbury** (so.) also recorded personal bests with 18 points (8-15 FGs) and eight rebounds in the contest. **Ameer Bennett** (jr.) also reached double-figures in the game with 14 points. Bennett also pulled down a team-high nine rebounds in the game. Crosby's LIU performance raised his team-best scoring average to 20.0 points per game. Stansbury and Bennett are tied for second on the team in scoring at 12.3 points per game. Bennett's also the Hornets' top rebounder at 7.3 per game, while **Pinky Wiley** (jr.) has a team high 15 assists.

Virginia Tech (4-0) is coming off a 79-53 victory over Lehigh last Saturday (Nov. 16). Landers Nolley II led the Hokies with a game-high 27 points on 10-of-19 shooting from the field, including seven-of-12 on three-point shots. P.J. Home added 14 points (6-8 FG), while Hunter Cattoor came off the bench to contribute 11 points (three 3 pt. FG). Nolley is Virginia Tech's scoring leader at 22.8 points per game. He also has a team-high 15 three-point field goals. Nahiem Alleyne is second on the Hokies with a 10.8 point per game average. Tyrece Radford is Va. Tech's top rebounder at 6.8 per game.

HORNETS vs. Hokies / ACC

This will be the second meeting between the Hornets and Hokies. Virginia Tech won the first contest 68-53 on Dec. 31, 1994 in Blacksburg, Va. Delaware State is 1-25 all-time vs. current members of the Atlantic Coast Conference, with the lone victory over an ACC team was against Wake Forest (72-65) on Nov. 28, 2014.

WILEY NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-MEAC THIRD TEAM

Delaware State's **Pinky Wiley** has been named to the 2019-20 Preseason All-MEAC Third Team in voting by league head coaches and sports information representatives. As a sophomore in 2018-19, Wiley was third on the Hornets in scoring at 9.5 points per game, including 10.8 in MEAC contests. He was No. 1 in the MEAC in steals (2.1 pg) and fourth in assists (4.4 pg), while ranking second on the Hornets with 53 three-point field goals a year ago.

Bethune-Cookman University senior forward Cletrell Pope was named the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Men's

Basketball Preseason Player of the Year, the conference announced today. North Carolina Central was tabbed as the preseason favorite to win the MEAC this season.

Joining Pope on the Preseason All-MEAC First Team are Howard's Charles Williams, South Carolina State's Damani Applewhite, Coppin State's Dejuan Clayton and Pope's teammate Malik Maitland. Williams received All-MEAC First Team honors last season.

North Carolina Central captured its third straight MEAC Tournament championship last season under head coach LeVelle Moton. Moton and the Eagles finished 10-6 in MEAC play and 18-16 overall in making their third straight NCAA appearance, and they return four players and two starters from last year's squad.

Bethune-Cookman was picked second, followed by defending regular-season champion Norfolk State.

Rounding out the rest of the preseason poll are North Carolina A&T State, South Carolina State, Howard Coppin State, Morgan State, Florida A&M, Delaware State and Maryland Eastern Shore.

HORNETS IN THE MEAC

Despite its recent woes, Delaware State has enjoyed a fair amount of success in league play since the 2000-01 season. The Hornets own a 175-145 mark vs. MEAC competition during the span (.549). DSU has reached double figures in MEAC wins 10 times since 2000-01 season. Delaware State claimed three consecutive MEAC regular season titles from 2004-07. During that span, the Hornets were 46-8 in league games. Delaware State captured its only MEAC Tournament title and NCAA Tournament berth in 2005. The Hornets have competed in six MEAC Tournament championship games, the last in 2015.

Hornet 2019-20 Honors

Pinky Wiley (Preseason All-MEAC Third Team)

INJURY REPORT

Delaware State will start 2019-20 without two key performers from last season. Forward **D'Marco Baucum** (so.) is out indefinitely due to a knee injury suffered during preseason practice. Baucum joined the team in Jan. 19 and competed in the final 17 games during the 2018-19 season, including 14 starts. He averaged 8.2 points and 4.1 rebounds per game in 2018-19, ranking fourth on the Hornets in scoring and fourth in rebounding. In addition, he led the team with a .829 free throw percentage last season. Baucum scored in double figures in seven contests, including a career-high 15 points (5-8 FG; 2-3 3FG; 3-3 FTA) at Florida A&M. Also, **Fahim Jenetto** (so.) is out indefinitely due to an eye injury. Jenetto averaged 7.0 points and 3.3 rebounds, while shooting .400 from three-point range as a freshman in 2018-19 but missed the final 18 games due to a knee injury.

TRANSFER LEADS DSU SCORERS

For the second season in a row, a senior transfer is emerging as Delaware State's top scorer in the early going. Through four games, guard **John Crosby** tops the Hornets with a 20.0 point per game average, highlighted by a career-best 32 points vs. LIU in DSU's last outing on Monday. DELAWARE STATE 2019-20 MEN'S BASKETBALL — HEAD COACH ERIC SKEETERS



Skeeters is in his second season as head coach of the Hornets. Among the highlights of his first season at the helm was the team's first MEAC Tournament victory since 2015 with an upset of No. 6 seed Savannah State. The Hornets were eliminated from the 2019 MEAC Tournament by eventual champion North Carolina Central in the quarterfinals.

The 2018-19 Hornets also posted impressive road wins at Delaware and Coppin State in Skeeters' first season

An assistant coach with the team that pulled off the biggest upset in the history of the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament and Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference alum was announced as the 13th head coach of the Hornets on July 25, 2018 by DSU Director of Athletics Scott Gines.

A Baltimore, Md., native, Skeeters previously served an assistant at Maryland-Baltimore County (UMBC). This is his first head coach position.

Prior to joining the Hornets, Skeeters served two seasons as an assistant under head coach Ryan Odom at UMBC from 2016-to-2018.

Last March, the Retrievers shocked the college basketball world and ruined millions of brackets with a historic 74-54 win over top-ranked Virginia, the first-ever win by a No. 16 seed against a No. 1 seed in 136 all-time NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament matchups.

UMBC's 2017-18 season was also highlighted by the second America East Tournament championship in team history and a school-record 25 wins (25-11).

"Eric Skeeters stood out among an outstanding group of candidates for head coach of the Delaware State men's basketball team," said Gines. "He's a 21-year Division I assistant who has contributed to successful programs in highly competitive conferences, including the MEAC. During his career, Skeeters has played a key role in helping to rebuild programs, while serving on staffs that engineered two of the biggest upsets in NCAA Tournament history."

According to Gines, Skeeters has the experience and leadership attributes the DSU men's basketball program needs at this time, besides being a good fit for the school.

"Eric will resonate with our current players, community, and alumni. They will love his energy, drive, and devotion. He is well positioned to lead our men's basketball team," said the new Delaware State AD.

From 2013 to 2016, Skeeters was an assistant coach at George Mason University in Fairfax, Va., and the previous four years he was a member of the University of South Florida coaching staff. While at South Florida, he helped lead the Bulls to their first NCAA Tournament bid in 20 years. USF made the most of its 2012 Big Dance appearance, defeating California and Temple before falling to Ohio in the round of 32.

Skeeters' coaching career also includes a six-year stint at Towson University (Md.), in addition to assistant positions at Virginia Tech, Youngstown State, and his alma mater, Coppin State, also a member of the MEAC.

He was a young assistant coach for the 1996-97 Coppin State team that pulled a post-season upset of the University of South Carolina, marking the second victory by a No. 15 seed over a No. 2 in NCAA Tournament history.

"Delaware State University is a unique opportunity and I look forward to putting together a staff and team that will enable us to create something special," said Skeeters. "As a MEAC grad, my goal from day one will be to recruit, coach and develop champions on the court, in the classroom and in the community."

Skeeters added, "My journey around the game of basketball has taught me to surround yourself with great people that you believe in. My meetings with Director of Athletics Dr. Scott Gines, DSU President Dr. Wilma Mishoe and the committee made a huge impact in the decision process. I would like to personally thank Dr. Mishoe & Dr. Gines for this opportunity because I was thoroughly impressed with their vision for DSU, the athletics department and our program."

Skeeters was awarded a bachelor's in management science from Coppin State in 1997. He and wife Marie have two sons, Evan and Miles.
