Delaware State Head Coach Eric Skeeters (Coppin State, '97): 6-24 at DSU and career (first season); 2-14 in MEAC regular season; 0-2 vs. NC Central; 1-0 MEAC Tournament

THE GAME

Eleventh-seeded Delaware State (6-24; 2-14 MEAC) takes on No. 3 North Carolina Central in a MEAC Tournament quarterfinal round contest. A win would give the Hornets their first tournament semifinal round appearance since 2015. DSU reached the quarterfinals with a 71-67 opening round win over No. 6 Savannah State on Monday. **Kevin Larkin** led four Delaware State double-figure scorers with a game-high 19 points on 7-of-11 shooting from the field. He also led the Hornets with nine rebounds. **Saleik Edwards** added 17 points, highlighted by five three-point field goals, while **D'Marco** tallied 12 points and seven boards. **Jonathan Mitchell** came off the bench to contribute 10 points. Larkin, a 2018-19 All-MEAC Third Team selection, is tops on the Hornets and fourth in the MEAC in scoring at 16.0 points per game, and is second in the league in rebounding at 9.0 per game. In addition, he is tied for second in the conference with 11 "double-doubles" this season. On Dec. 3, 2018 vs. Cairn, Larkin scored a career-high 40 points, the top single-game total in the MEAC this season. He also had 11 rebounds, six assists and four steals to lead the Hornets to a 102-66 victory in that contest. Larkin has reached double-figures in scoring in 21 of the 25 games in which he has competed, topping the 20-point mark five times. Edwards is second on the Hornets and 13 in the MEAC in scoring at 10.4 points per game. He's also the team leader with 66 three-point field goals to rank seventh in the league at 2.3 per game. **Pinky Wiley** is DSU's third-leading scorer at 9.6 points per game and is number one in the MEAC's in steals at 2.1 per game. He also ranks fourth in the MEAC at 4.4 assists per contest.

North Carolina Central (15-15; 10-6 MEAC), the defending MEAC tournament champs, won six of its last eight games regular season game to finish third in the final conference standings. The Eagles are led by 2018-19 All-MEAC First Team selection Raasean Davis, who ranks sixth in the league in scoring at 14.8 points per game and is third in the league in rebounding at 8.9 per contest. He's also the MEAC's top shooter with a .648 percentage. Randy Miller is second on the team and 3th in the MEAC in scoring at 13.3 ppg. NC Central is second in the league in scoring defense, 67.4 points per game.

HORNETS vs. Eagles Series (NCCU leads 24-16; DSU leads 2-1 in MEAC Tournament)

This will be the third meeting between the Hornets and Eagles this season and fourth MEAC Tournament contest between the teams. North Carolina Central swept the regular season series, winning 71-70 on Jan. 14 at Delaware State and 87-52 on Feb. 11 on its home court in Durham, N.C. In the Jan. 14 contest, the Eagles scored the winning basket on a length of the court driving lay-up by Jordan Perkins with 1.6 seconds left to play. In the second regular season meeting, NCCU used an 18-0 first half run to take control of the game. North Carolina Central has won the last four meetings to open up a 24-16 lead in the series.

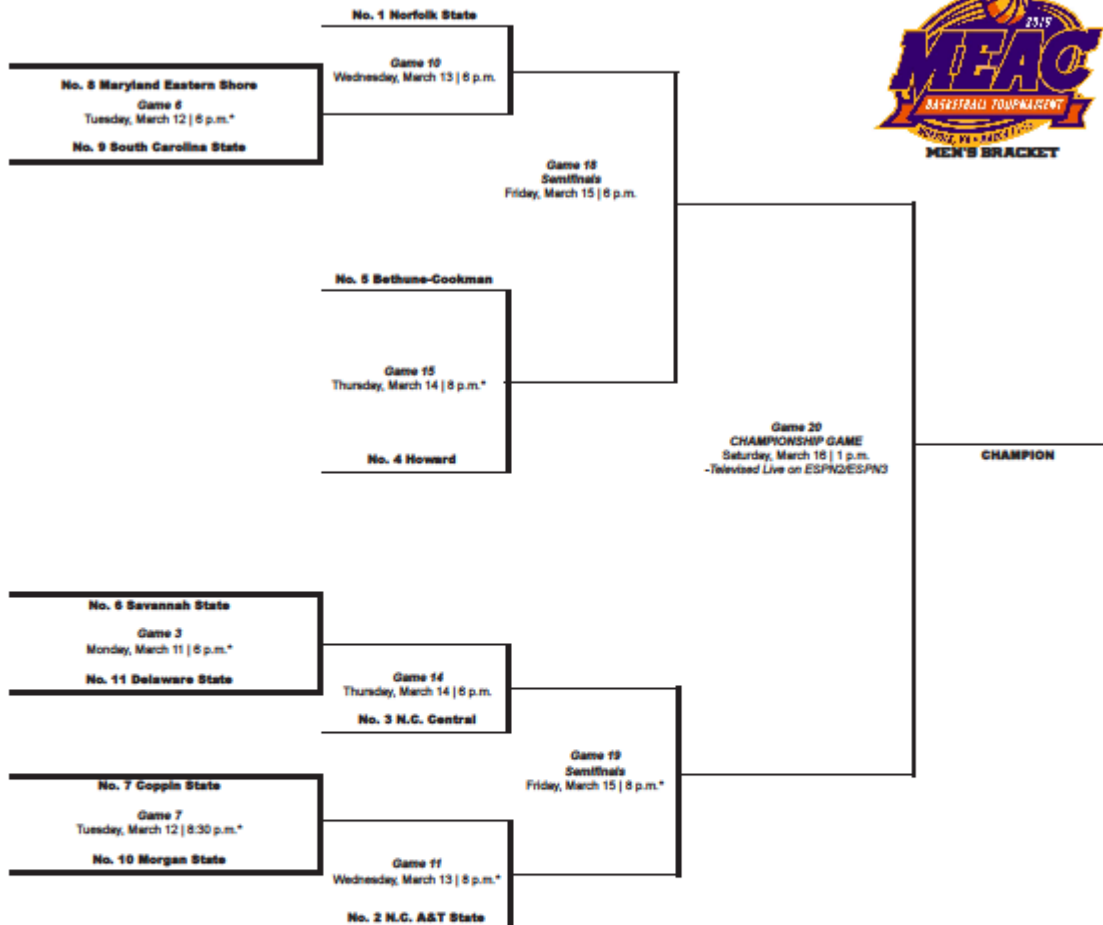

DSU's LARKIN NAMED TO ALL-MEAC THIRD TEAM

Delaware State swingman **Kevin Larkin** (gr.) has been named to the 2018-19 All-MEAC Men's Basketball Third Team in voting by league head coaches and media relations representatives announced. Larkin was tops on the Hornets and fourth in the MEAC in scoring at 15.9 points per game, and was second in the league in rebounding at 9.0 per game during the 2018-19 regular season. In addition, he is tied for second in the conference with 11 "double-doubles" this season.

On Dec. 3, 2018 vs. Cairn, Larkin scored a career-high 40 points, the top single-game total in the MEAC this season. He also had 11 rebounds, six assists and four steals to lead the Hornets to a 102-66 victory in that contest.



Larkin reached double-figures in scoring in 20 of the 24 games in which he competed, topping the 20-point mark five times.

His season was also highlighted by the game-winning basket with 3.4 seconds left to play in the Hornets' 73-71 victory at Delaware on Dec. 19.

A native of Georgetown, Del., and product of Sussex Tech High School, Larkin attended Cheyney University (Pa.) and Niagara (N.Y.) before returning to the First State to attend DSU and compete for the Hornets this season.

Howard University sophomore was selected as the 2018-19 MEAC Player-of-the-Year. Florida A&M freshman MJ Randolph is the voters' choice for league Rookie-of-the-Year, while Bethune-Cookman junior was chosen as the top defensive player.

Norfolk State's Rob Jones is the MEAC Coach-of-the-Year after leading the Spartans to the 2018-19 regular season league championship with a 15-1 record.

HORNETS IN THE MEAC

Despite its recent woes, Delaware State has enjoyed a fair amount of success in league play since the 2000-01 season. The Hornets own a 175-145 mark vs. MEAC competition during the span (.549). DSU has reached double figures in MEAC wins 10 times since 2000-01 season. Delaware State claimed three consecutive MEAC regular season titles from 2004-07. During that span, the Hornets were 46-8 in league games. Delaware State captured its only MEAC Tournament title and NCAA Tournament berth in 2005. The Hornets have competed in six MEAC Tournament championship games, the last in 2015.

HORNETS' MEAC TOURNAMENT RECAP

No. 11 Delaware State 71 No. 6 Savannah State 67

Mar. 11, 2019 - Opening Round

Delaware State played like anything but the lowest seed in the 2019 MEAC Men's Basketball Tournament, turning in its grittiest performance of the season to defeat No. 6 Savannah State 71-67 in an opening round game at the Scope Arena.

The Hornets snapped a four-game MEAC Tournament losing streak and averaged a 76-73 regular season loss to Savannah State to advance to the tournament quarterfinals against No. 3 seed and defending champ North Carolina Central.

Delaware State led by as many as 17 in the second half and held off a late Savannah State rally to reach the tournament's round of eight for the first time since 2015.

Kevin Larkin led four double-figure scorers for the Hornets with a game-high 19 points on seven-of-11 shooting from the field, including two three-pointers on four attempts. Larkin also led the Hornets with nine rebounds in the contest.

Fellow senior Saleik Edwards (sr.) added 17 points for the Hornets, highlighted by five three-point field goals (5-12).

D'Marco Baucum (fr.) contributed 12 points and seven rebounds, while Jonathan Mitchell (sr.) came off the bench add 10, five rebounds and three steals for the Hornets.

Each team struggled with first half shooting, but Delaware State managed to hold a 31-25 lead at the break. The Hornets shot 25.6% percent in the half (10-for-39), while Savannah State hit just seven of its 32 attempts in the first 20 minutes (21.9%), including four-of-20 on three-point attempts (20.0%).

Delaware State used an early second half spurt to open up the biggest lead of the game. Larkin capped off a 15-1 rally with a three-pointer to stretch the Hornets' lead to 48-31 at the 13:25 mark of the second half.

DSU was six-for-10 from the field, including three three-pointers, while Savannah State missed each of its eight shots and committed two turnovers during the Hornet rally.

After the Tigers pulled to within 61-55 on a three-pointer by Romani Hansen, the Hornets ran off the next five points, and opened up a 66-55 lead on a basket and free throw by Baucum with 3:22 left to play.

Delaware State missed five free throws over the next three minutes, allowing Savannah State to claw back into the contest. The Tigers pulled to within 69-67 on a lay-up by Zach Sellers off a DSU turnover with 15 seconds left, but Mitchell knocked down two at the line with eight ticks remaining to seal the win for the Hornets.

DELAWARE STATE 2018-19 MEN'S BASKETBALL — HEAD COACH ERIC SKEETERS



Skeeters, an assistant coach with the team that pulled off the biggest upset in the history of the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament and Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference alum was announced as the 13th head coach of the Hornets on July 25, 2018 by DSU Director of Athletics Scott Gines.

A Baltimore, Md., native, Skeeters most recently served as an assistant at Maryland-Baltimore County (UMBC). This is his first head coach position.

Prior to joining the Hornets, Skeeters served two seasons as an assistant under head coach Ryan Odom at UMBC from 2016-to-2018.

Last March, the Retrievers shocked the college basketball world and ruined millions of brackets with a historic 74-54 win over top-ranked Virginia, the first-ever win by a No. 16 seed against a No. 1 seed in 136 all-time NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament match-ups.

UMBC's 2017-18 season was also highlighted by the second America East Tournament championship in team history and a school-record 25 wins (25-11).

"Eric Skeeters stood out among an outstanding group of candidates for head coach of the Delaware State men's basketball team," said Gines. "He's a 21-year Division I assistant who has contributed to successful programs in highly competitive conferences, including the MEAC. During his career, Skeeters has played a key role in helping to rebuild programs, while serving on staffs that engineered two of the biggest upsets in NCAA Tournament history."

According to Gines, Skeeters has the experience and leadership attributes the DSU men's basketball program needs at this time, besides being a good fit for the school.

"Eric will resonate with our current players, community, and alumni. They will love his energy, drive, and devotion. He is well positioned to lead our men's basketball team," said the new Delaware State AD.

From 2013 to 2016, Skeeters was an assistant coach at George Mason University in Fairfax, Va., and the previous four years he was a member of the University of South Florida coaching staff. While at South Florida, he helped lead the Bulls to their first NCAA Tournament bid in 20 years. USF made the most of its 2012 Big Dance appearance, defeating California and Temple before falling to Ohio in the round of 32.

Skeeters' coaching career also includes a six-year stint at Towson University (Md.), in addition to assistant positions at Virginia Tech, Youngstown State, and his alma mater, Coppin State, also a member of the MEAC.

He was a young assistant coach for the 1996-97 Coppin State team that pulled a post-season upset of the University of South Carolina, marking the second victory by a No. 15 seed over a No. 2 in NCAA Tournament history.

"Delaware State University is a unique opportunity and I look forward to putting together a staff and team that will enable us to create something special," said Skeeters. "As a MEAC grad, my goal from day one will be to recruit, coach and develop champions on the court, in the classroom and in the community."

Skeeters added, "My journey around the game of basketball has taught me to surround yourself with great people that you believe in. My meetings with Director of Athletics Dr. Scott Gines, DSU President Dr. Wilma Mishoe and the committee made a huge impact in the decision process. I would like to personally thank Dr. Mishoe & Dr. Gines for this opportunity because I was thoroughly impressed with their vision for DSU, the athletics department and our program."

Skeeters was awarded a bachelor's in management science from Coppin State in 1997. He and wife Marie have two sons, Evan and Miles.
