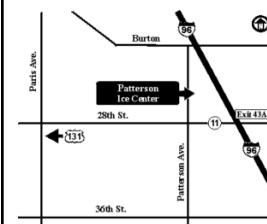

PAUL LOWDEN

Paul Lowden enters his eighth season as the Head Coach of the Davenport University Panthers Hockey Team. The Panthers compete in the American Collegiate Hockey Association (ACHA) at the Division II level. Last season, Lowden collected his 200th win as Head Coach of Davenport and after leading his team to back-to-back ACHA D2 National Championships, has an overall record of 238-56-13

Paul grew up on the east side of Toronto, Ontario (Canada) where he played his minor and junior hockey. He played his college hockey from 1983-1987 for the Ferris State University's NCAA DI Hockey Program.

He currently holds the career record at Ferris State University for goals scored (101) and total points (208) and was inducted into the Ferris State University Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. He continued his athletic career by playing professional hockey in Germany from 1987-1992.

Paul also serves as Davenport University's Athletic Director. Lowden started the athletic program in 2002 with two programs (Hockey and Women's Basketball). The university currently has 20 varsity programs and 4 non-varsity programs.

Lowden was selected as the first head coach of the ACHA DII Select Team which travelled to Europe for nine days from December 26th, 2007 to January 4th, 2008. The Select Team went 5-0 against Teams from Switzerland, Austria, Germany and the Czech Republic.

Paul resides in Ada, MI with his wife Lisa and their three children (daughters Kristyn, Kaitlyn and son Kyle).



PHIL SWEENEY

Phil enters his 6th season as a Panthers Assistant Coach. He also serves as the Men's and Women's Golf coach at Davenport University. Sweeney's main role for the hockey team is to work closely with the forwards and the special teams units. He has been an integral part of the success as he has helped DU strive for the top of Division II hockey. Phil is currently working on his degree here at Davenport and lives in Kentwood, MI



JAMIE BRADFORD

Jamie brings a wealth of experience to the Davenport coaching staff. He has been with Robby Glantz Power Skating for 10 years and as Head Instructor he has developed many skaters throughout the U.S. and Canada. Jamie will continue to bring the same skills and experience this year to ensure that the Panthers are the best skaters and most conditioned team in the ACHA.



JOE MESSINA

Coach Messina is in his 6th season as the Goaltending Coach for Davenport University Men's Ice Hockey Team. Messina was recruited to attend the State University of New York at Brockport to play men's NCAA Division III Ice Hockey. Messina excelled and received a varsity letter four years consecutively at SUNY Brockport from 1998 - 2002. Messina is the Head Instructor for Bandits Goalie School which has been developing goaltenders since 1999. Joe also works with numerous pro, college and amateur goalies in the Grand Rapids Area.

2009-2010 SEASON PREVIEW

The 2009-10 Davenport Panthers will look much different than the championship team from last season. Heading into this season the Panthers will have 15 new players. DU will also be led by an entirely new staff of captains as well. **Jeremy Barber** will take over for Jeremy Bultema as the 4th captain in Davenport history. Barber will be joined by Senior Adam Thomas and Junior Jared Mailloux as the assistant captains.

Defensive Coach **Jamie Bradford** will have a lot of talent back on the blue line. Barber and Mailloux will lead a very strong defensive unit for the Panthers. The DU defense will also feature returners

Jon Stolarz, Kenny Jacobs, Brandon Davis, Jeff Slusser and Kevin Brojek. Joining the team this season will be three very talented players in **CJ Pobur, Jonathon Frank, and Adam Gillikin.** This group of players will be look-

ing to continue where the defense left off last season at nationals when the Panthers suffocated the competition by only allowing six goals at the ACHA National Tournament. This is a very talented group of players that can not only play solid defense in the Panthers zone, but can also contribute on offense as well.

Davenport has been well known over the years for having a lot of fire power up front and this season should be no different. DU will be led up front by All-American **Adam Thomas.** Adam will be joined by **Brit Ouellette** who is entering his third year in a Panther uniform. **Chad Rutzel** will be entering his final year at DU and will again be looked upon to lead the Panthers whenever they are short handed during the season. **Ben Dykstra** will look to improve on a very impressive rookie season as will **Mitch Kane** and **Jordan Phillips** who each will look to step up in their second campaign.

Joining the forwards are a crowd of talented players that have combined eight years of college hockey experience in the NCAA and ACHA. **Shaun McWhorter** leads the new class of very talented transfers as he comes to DU from Western Michigan. **Phil Tesoriero** will add a physical, intense style of play to the lineup as he joins the team from Minnesota Crookston. **Zach Fowler** and **Aaron Warsen,**

both from Adrian College, will add depth up front, while **Clay Mattson** comes to the team from Lindenwood University and the Panthers also scored a very talented freshman class to go along with the returners and transfers. **Jesse Carter, Marc Thompson, Patrick Gallagher, Paul Ziemke, and Josh Andres** all join DU after very successful seasons playing junior hockey. The forwards will be looked upon to light up the lamp on opponents and drive them crazy with a relentless fore-check. The most impressive part of the forwards contribution last season was in the defensive zone where the players really bought into the coaches systems and shut teams down.

The goalies at Davenport have some big shoes to fill and look up to the task. **Scotty Knight** will be back for the Panthers and looks to provide leadership for Coach Lowden and the Panthers. Scott will be joined in net by transfer **Jacob Schira** (Minnesota Crookston) and former Grand Rapids Owls star **Anthony Petrak.** Davenport has always had stellar goaltending since the start of the program and this season should be the same. The Panthers goalies always have a good support in front of them, but are always called upon to make big saves in big situations due to the fact the Panthers play the hardest schedule in the nation.

Davenport has built its program on facing the best teams the ACHA has to offer whether it be D1 or D2 and this season is no different. Highlighting the year will be a trip to Arizona in mid-January to face last year's ACHA D1 Champions Lindenwood University. DU will play a total of 14 games against ACHA Division I opponents and also will continue its play in the toughest league in the nation: the GMHL. The conference has produced the last six ACHA D2 National Champions and with games scheduled against Grand Valley, Miami (OH), Michigan, Michigan State, Ohio State and Ferris State, there really is no off-night for the Panthers.

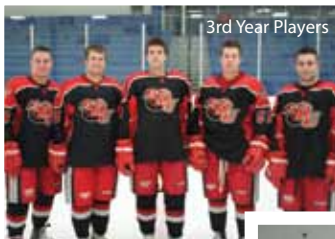

2008-2009 SEASON IN REVIEW

Record Breaking Start – After winning their final nine games of 2007-2008, the defending ACHA D2 champions won their first 18 games last season before finally dropping their first game on November 22 to Liberty University. All Together, Davenport won 27 straight games which is an ACHA record for D2 and ultimately, the Panthers posted a 37 game unbeaten streak against fellow D2 teams.

Ring and Banner Ceremony – Davenport played its annual cross-town clash on October 3 against rival Grand Valley State but the 2008-2009 festivities were even bigger than normal. The Panthers welcomed back the entire National Championship team from the prior year as they handed out rings and raised the ACHA D2 National Championship banner.

Sweep of State's D1 Teams – Over Thanksgiving weekend, the Panthers played against Eastern Michigan, Western Michigan and UM Dearborn in the annual East/West Classic on the campus of UM Dearborn. The three teams proved no match for the Panthers as DU won by a combined total of 24-6 which was highlighted by a 10-2 victory over the host Wolves in the final game of the weekend.

Inaugural GMHL All-Star Team Chosen – For the first time in the ACHA's history, the conferences came together to compete against each other in an All-Star type format. The GMHL announced their first ever all-star team and Davenport University landed four players on the inaugural team that competed from April 3-5 in Philadelphia, PA. Chris Joswiak, Jeremy Barber, Bobby Collar and Kevin Brojek led the GMHL team to an undefeated mark in the tournament.

Good Luck Duck Remains in Grand Rapids – The annual Davenport/Oakland series proved to have little luster for 2008-2009 as the Panthers closed out the season series on February 14 with a 4-2 win in Rochester. The two teams met for a third time as the DU seniors got their last skate on home ice at Patterson Ice Center.

Two-Time Four Peat – Since Davenport entered the GMHL, the Panthers have dominated and last season was no different as they won their fourth straight regular season crown and fourth straight conference tournament title. The Panthers claimed the tournament title on home ice with a 5-1 win over Grand Valley to also give DU a sweep of each game this season from the Lakers.

Pool D and National Semifinal Dominance at Nationals – In a tough pool draw at the National Tournament, Davenport cruised to wins over Miami of Ohio (7-1), Colorado (5-1), and William Patterson (5-1) in route to their fourth straight appearance in the D2 semifinals where they defeated Colorado State (6-2).

Back to Back National Champions! – In a game played in downtown Grand Rapids at Van Andel Arena, the Panthers claimed their second consecutive National Championship with a 5-1 win against Florida Gulf Coast. The Panthers finished the national tournament by outscoring their opponents by a margin of 28-6.

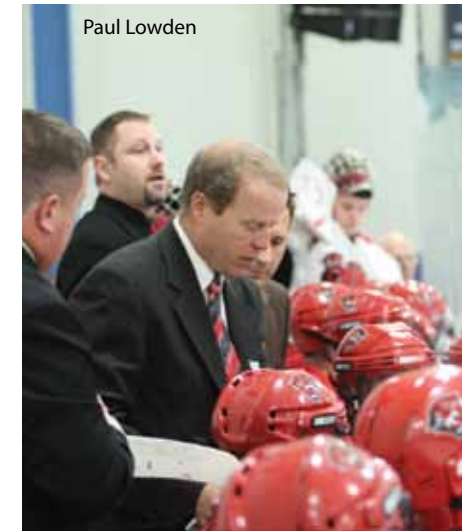

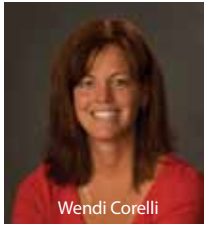
