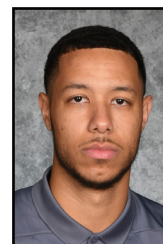

PROMOTING WITHIN: Clifford "Cliff" Reed was named interim head coach on March 27, 2018, the 20th head coach in Maryland Eastern Shore men's basketball history. He spent the last four years on the Hawk sidelines as an assistant, including three as associate head coach. Working under former head coach Bobby Collins, Reed and the Hawks went 49-82 (30-34 MEAC), including an 18-15 campaign in 2014-15 and a MEAC Tournament semifinals berth in 2016-17.

MIX AND MINGLE: The Hawks return active five players from their 2017-18 team, including leading scorer Tyler Jones (12.1). Returning to action are three starters from the 2016-17 squad (Andino, Caldwell, Taylor) who missed last season with injuries. Joining them are seven JUCO and graduate transfers. Heading the newcomers are point guard Bryan Urrutia, whose 8.0 assists per game ranked fifth in the NJCAA, and forward AJ Cheeseman, who posted nearly 14 points and 6.5 rebounds per game at Gordon State (Ga.) College.

ONE LAST RIDE: Graduate student guard Ryan Andino enters his fifth and final year with the Eastern Shore program. The Ft. Lauderdale native burst onto the scene in 2014-15, winning MEAC Rookie of the Year and leading the league in three-point percentage (.421). Andino was a preseason All-MEAC second team selection last year before a season-ending injury. He enters 2018-19 with a career .383 three-point percentage and is 134 points shy of 1,000 for his Hawk career.

MUSCLING HIS WAY IN: Junior forward Tyler Jones played as a walk-on during his freshman season, earning a scholarship at season's end. He built on that reward with a standout sophomore campaign, leading the team in scoring (12.1) and returning Hawks in rebounding (5.0). Jones reached the 20-point plateau six times in conference play, including three straight 21-point efforts to close out the regular season.

ARE WE THERE YET: Eastern Shore once again takes on an imposing nonconference slate leading into its MEAC opener on January 5. After opening the season at Georgetown, the Hawks battled ACC foe North Carolina State. Other marquee matchups include road bouts with North Texas, St. John's, Duquesne, Pittsburgh, and Virginia Tech. The Hawks have four nonconference home games scheduled, including a Nov. 30 showdown against local rival Delaware.

Longwood Lancers

2017-18 Record: 7-26 (3-15, 10th in Big South)**2018-19 Record:** 2-0 (0-0, ACC)**All-Time Series:** Longwood leads 4-0

LAST MEETING (FEB. 4, 2009): The Frankie Allen-coached Hawks dropped a 98-86 decision at Longwood in the team's second matchup of the season. The Lancers dealt Eastern Shore a 61-49 home loss on Nov. 22.

READY TO JOUST: The Lancers are in pursuit of their first winning record since 2008-09. Longwood went 17-14 that season, their only winning season since joining Division I in 2004-05. Through six seasons as a member of the Big South, LU is 23-81 (.221) in conference play and has never finished higher than eighth in the league standings.

THE ONE TO WATCH: Redshirt senior guard Isaiah Walton returns for one final season with the Lancers. The Oberlin, Ohio native led LU in scoring last season with 15.6 PPG, good for ninth in the Big South, shooting .428 from the floor and .840 from the free throw line. Walton has led Longwood in scoring in each of its first two games, notching 20 points against Randolph last Tuesday and pouring in 23 in Friday's road win at Richmond.

RETRIEVING HISTORY: Griff Aldrich enters the first season of his first head coaching gig as a household name in college basketball. Aldrich served two seasons as recruiting coordinator at UMBC, who beat Virginia by 20 points in last season's history 16-over-1 upset in the NCAA Tournament. Before arriving at UMBC, Aldrich was a partner at a law firm and CFO of an investment company, coaching AAU basketball on the side. After deciding to commit to coaching full-time, Aldrich and Retrievers boss Ryan Odom took a program that averaged 24 losses over eight straight losing seasons and produced a pair of 20-win seasons.

Interim Head Coach Cliff Reed

1st Season at Eastern Shore (0-2)

Florida resident took BCU to its first MEAC Regular Season Championship in 2010-11 as the Wildcats finished 21-13 (13-3) that season. The team had a seven-game winning streak to end the regular season and earned a spot in the NIT against Virginia Tech. The accomplishments elevated Reed to being named MEAC Coach of the Year and NABC District 15 Coach of the Year in 2011.

In his early years at BCU, Reed helped the Wildcats to their first win over a power conference foe, when the Wildcats defeated South Florida, 75-68, in 2005. It was in 2005 where Reed and the Wildcats provided BCU with its first winning seasons in 25 years of Division I play. He was named Collegiateinsider.com Coach of the Year in 2005-06.

Before he was the head coach at BCU, Reed served as an assistant coach at his alma mater for four seasons from 1997-2001. Reed began his coaching career at Atlantic High School (Fla.) and was the head coach for three years from 1994-97. He led the team to back-to-back District 8 titles on the Class 4A level.

He played two seasons at Bethune-Cookman from 1989-1991 and was named to the MEAC Second Team his senior year. He set the single-game school record for three-pointers made (seven) and scored over 1,200 points in two seasons with the Wildcats. Reed transferred to BCU from St. Johns River Community College, where he averaged 18 ppg over two seasons. He was also named to the Mid-Florida All-Conference team in 1985.

Reed graduated from Bethune-Cookman with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Physical Education. He would later attain his graduate degree from Concordia University in 2011 with a Masters in Coaching and Athletic Administration.

Clifford Reed, Jr. was named the Interim Head Coach of the men's basketball program on March 27, 2018, becoming the 20th head coach in Maryland Eastern Shore history. Reed had spent the previous four seasons on the Hawks' sidelines as an assistant to former head coach Bobby Collins, including three as associate head coach.

The Ormond Beach, Fla., native came to The Shore with an extensive background in coaching as he has been manning basketball sidelines for over 20 years. His tenure has included coaching stints at three different collegiate institutions. Reed is one of the most respected coaches in the nation and he has experience building championship teams from the ground up.

Prior to joining the Hawks, Reed served as an assistant coach at Savannah State in 2013-14, winning 13 games. He was with Georgia Southern for the year prior and led the Eagles to 14 wins overall, seven of which were in the Southern Conference. Reed helped lead those respective teams to first-round wins in their conference basketball tournaments.

Reed spent over 10 years as the head coach of Bethune-Cookman University, his alma mater, from 2001-11. In 291 games leading the Wildcats, Reed posted a 125-166 record, the last three of which were all winning seasons. He led the Wildcats to consecutive 17-16 years in 2008-09 and 2009-10. The longtime

ASSISTANT COACHES

Assistant Coach

Adrian "Ace" Custis enters his 5th season on the sidelines at Eastern Shore. This year will mark the fifth season for Custis as an assistant at the collegiate level.

Custis joined Eastern Shore after having spent the previous season as an assistant coach at Virginia State.

Custis played professional basketball for 15 seasons. He originally was signed to a free-agent deal by the Dallas Mavericks in 1997, before playing in the domestic Central Basketball Association and United States Basketball League. He then took his talents overseas, playing in Japan, the Philippines, Qatar, Lebanon, Syria, and Indonesia, before retiring in 2012.

Custis was a four-year standout at Virginia Tech, leading the Hokies to the 1995 NIT title and a 1996 NCAA Tournament berth. He was the third player (fourth overall) in VT history to score 1,000 points and bring down 1,000 rebounds. His No. 20 jersey was retired during his senior year in 1997, where it hangs beside those of Bimbo Coles (12), Dell Curry (30), and Allan Bristow (44).

Ace graduated from Virginia Tech in 1997 with a degree in marketing.



Assistant Coach

Raheem Waller begins his 1st season at Eastern Shore.

Waller comes to Eastern Shore after three seasons as head coach at Buford High School (S.C.). He led his team to two playoff appearances and was once named Region Coach of the Year.

At the collegiate level Waller has made stops on the sidelines of seven NCAA Division I and II programs, including MEAC outfits Florida A&M and Savannah State.

Waller played collegiately at South Carolina State, eventually becoming a team captain. He earned all-conference and all-tournament honors while leading the Bulldogs to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances in 1996 and 1998. Waller played professionally in the International Basketball League and United States Basketball League, as well as overseas.

Waller earned his bachelor's degree in industrial technology from South Carolina State in 1999 and Master's in Sport Management from American Public University in 2016.

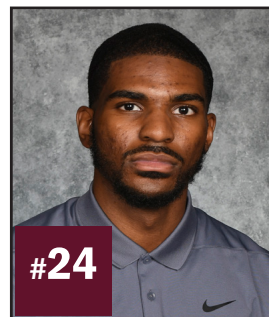
