#### POINTS OF INTEREST

- ▶ East Carolina returns home to Williams Arena at Minges Coliseum on Tuesday, Nov. 29, at face 2016 MEAC tournament champion and NCAA Tournament participant Hampton at 7 p.m. It'll be just the second meeting between the Pirates and first since Dec. 23, 2003. ECU won that game by a final score of 77-53.
- ▶ Hampton represents ECU's third MEAC opponent of the season and fourth HBCU foe. East Carolina has won 14 consecutive games against current members of the MEAC with their last lost coming at Morgan State on Dec. 18, 2006. The Pirates' next opponent, N.C. Central, is also a member of
- ▶ East Carolina will be shooting for its 17th consecutive non-conference home victory Tuesday. The Pirates are 4-0 at home this season against non-conference opponents after going 7-0 inside Williams Arena at Minges Coliseum prior to American Athletic Conference play a year ago.
- ▶ Sophomore Kentrell Barkley was named to the American Athletic Conference Weekly Honor Roll for the second time in his career Monday. Barkley averaged 16.7 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game as East Carolina went 2-1 last week. Barkley recorded 20 points and 11 rebounds against Mercer, his second straight game scoring 20 or more points.
- ▶ ECU is coming a 70-63 victory over Air Force Sunday to claim third-place in the Savannah Invitational. B.J. Tyson, who was named to the all-tournament team, led the Pirates with 18 points and Caleb White added 15.
- ▶ Graduate transfer Andre Washington brought his season blocked shots total 16 over the weekend in Savannah. Washington has more blocks in the first seven games than the Pirates' 2015-16 season leader Michel Nzege had in 29 games, 12.
- ▶ Barkley and Washington have each led ECU in rebounding four times in the last five games. They tied for the team-high with eight each against Charlotte, Florida A&M and Air Force, Washington grabbed a game-high 16 against Stetson, while Barkley hauled in 11 yersus Mercer.
- ▶ White is the only senior in The American to rank among the top-10 in the league in scoring. He ranks 10th with 16.0 points per game. White also finds himself 21st in the NCAA with 3.5 3s per game with a 52.5 3-point shooting percentage, 25th-best in Division I.
- ▶ ECU ranks among the top-four in The American in four defensive categories: scoring defense (4th/61.3), field goal percent defense (2nd/.350), 3-point field goal percent defense (3rd/.298) and blocked shots per game (3rd/5.7).
- ▶ UPCOMING MILESTONES: B.J. Tyson is 18 points shy of becoming the 28th player in school history with 1,000 career points ... Caleb White needs four points to become the seventh player in program history to score 1,300 points.

# TEAM NOTES

#### **LEBO BECOMES ECU'S TOP DI COACH**

- ▶ Seventh-year head coach Jeff Lebo passed Tom Quinn for the most coaching victories in the school's Division I era (since 1965) Nov. 22 with his 103rd victory
- ▶ Lebo recorded his 100th victory at ECU on Veteran's Day as the Pirates defeated Grambling State, 72-57. He became just the third coach in school history to win triple digit games. Three days later he posted his 101st win
- ▶ Lebo's 103 wins ranks second behind Howard Porter, who coached the Pirates to 182 victories during their NAIA membership from 1947-59.

#### PIRATES SWIPING GLASS CLEAN

- ▶ East Carolina has out-rebounded each of its first seven opponents of the season by an average of 10.7 boards per game, 13th largest in the nation.
- ▶ The Pirates' highest rebounding margin of the season to date is 25 (63-38) vs. Stetson.
- ▶ ECU's 63 rebounds against Stetson were the most under coach Jeff Lebo and the most since they grabbed a school- record 71 against USF in 2003.

**KEY PERFORMERS:** Derrick Wiley led East Carolina with 15 points, Erroyl Bing scored 13 with Gabriel Mikluas and Belton Rivers adding 11 points each ... Bing and Mikulas grabbed eight rebounds apiece, while Japhet McNeil led the Pirates with six assists ... Moussa Badiane, the program's all-time leader in blocked shots, rejected three Hampton fiel goal attempts.

**TURNING POINT:** With ECU down four less than seven minutes into the game, senior Erroyl Bing's fast break dunk ignited a 26-10 run over the final 12:13 of the first half to push ECU to a 35-23 halftime lead ... The start of the second half was just a continuation of the end of the first half. A turnaround jumper by senior Derrick Wiley, three-pointers from Japhet McNeil and Bing, and another Bing dunk in transition ballooned the ECU lead to 21 points, 6:06 into the half. The Pirates out scored Hampton 35-11 during a 16-minute stretch, holding Hampton to just three field goals during that stretch and just seven during the entire half. ECU led by as many as 26 during the contest.

Washington scored all 10 of his points after halftime, while Tyson scored 11 of his 15 in the final 20 minutes. Mercer guard Ria'n Holland led all scorers with a career-high 26 points.

**TURNING POINT:** Trailing by nine at halftime, East Carolina rallied to a 66-65 lead on Andre Washington's free throw ... However, Ria'n Holland made a 3-pointer after a Mercer timeout with 20 seconds left to take the lead back for the Bears ... Then Demetre Rivers got a big steal on the next possession ... Jordan Strawberry iced it for Mercer with two free throws.

**KEY PERFORMERS:** Kentrell Barkley dropped in 21 points and grabbed eight rebounds to lead ECU to a decisive 82-62 win over Florida A&M ... Caleb White added 20, making 6-of-10 3s with five rebounds and six assists ... B.J. Tyson poured in 17 points, handed out three assists and collected three steals ... Andre Washington also pulled down eight rebounds and freshman Jeremy Sheppard had six assists as well.

**TURNING POINT:** ECU began the game on a 17-4 run, scoring 12 unanswered after the game was tied at 2-2 ... That run was followed by a 23-4 spurt that put the Pirates ahead by 29, 46-17, with 1:17 remaning in the first half . **PIRATES HIGHLIGHTS:** The win gave ECU Head Coach Jeff Lebo his 103rd win as a Pirate, making him the school's winningest coach in its Division I era ... White became the sixth player in school history to make 200 career 3-pointers ... East Carolina topped 80 points for the first time since Jan. 24, 2016 at Memphis ... ECU won its 16th consecutive non-conference game inside Williams Arena at Minges Coliseum ... The Pirates never trailed for the second straight game.

#### **EARLY DEFENSIVE TRENDS**

- ▶ ECU has held five of its first seven opponents under 63 points, including all four at home. In 14 halves of basketball this season, ECU has held its opponent to less than 30 points eight times.
- ▶ The Pirates have 40 blocks and 42 steals through the first seven games. ECU finished the 2015-16 season with 64 total blocks. Andre Washington is on pace to eclipse that mark by himself.
- ▶ ECU has forced its opponents to shoot under 35 percent from the floor in nine halves this season, including five halves under 30 percent. Stetson was 6-for-37 (.162) in the second half after shooting 8-of-32 (.250) in the first half. N.C. A&T shot just 25.9 percent in the first half and Charlotte made just 29.4 percent of its first half field goal attempts. The Pirates also limited Florida A&M to 29.6 percent shooting. Air Force also shot less than 35 percent in both halves this past Saturday.

#### **AMERICAN WEEKLY HONOR ROLL PIRATES**

- ▶ Kentrell Barkley was named to The American Honor Roll for the first time this season Nov. 28 after averaging 16.7 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists in a 2-1 week for ECU.
- ▶ Andre Washington earned his first American Athletic Conference Weekly Honor Roll on Nov. 21. He scored a career-high 21 points and grabbed a career-best 16 rebounds, while blocking six shots to help ECU defeat Stetson, 73-50, in the first game of the Savannah Invitational. Washington's performance made him the first ECU player to register a 20-point, 15-rebound game since 2006.
- ▶ Senior Caleb White was named to the first American Athletic Conference weekly honor for the 2016-17 season. White scored 22 points in the season opener against Grambling State to earn a place on the conference's weekly honor roll for the sixth time.

  - •The Pirates won their home opener for the 15th straight season.
- •It was the program's 16th straight victory when playing its first game of the season at Minges Coliseum. The last time ECU was 0-1 after playing its initial game at home was 1989.

#### **TYSON & BARKLEY RECEIVE PRESEASON HONORS**

- ▶ Junior B.J. Tyson was named to The American Preseason Second-Team as voted upon by the league's 11 head coaches. Tyson is the fourth-leading returning scorer in the conference after averaging 14.6 points per game last season.
- ▶ Tyson and sophomore teammate Kentrell Barkley were also tabbed all-conference third-team selections by Athlon Sports.
- ▶ The duo was also named to the CollegeSportsMadness.com American Athletic Conference preseason fourth-team.

#### **PIRATES PICKED TO FINISH SEVENTH IN THE AMERICAN**

- ▶ ECU was picked to seventh in The American this season by the league's head coaches. The Pirates garnered 39 points to finish ahead of UCF (37), Tulsa (34), USF (25) and Tulane (11).
- ▶ East Carolina posted a 4-14 record in The American last season to finish tied for ninth.

#### **COACHING STABILITY**

- ▶ Coach Jeff Lebo is in his seventh season as the Pirates' top man, making him the third-longest tenured head coach in program history behind Howard Porter (1947-59) and Tom Quinn (1966-74).
- ▶ Assistant coach Michael Perry is in his 10th season at ECU, making him the second-longest tenured basketball coach, head or assistant, in the program's 85-year history. He joined the coaching staff prior to the 2007-08 season as an assistant coach to Mack McCarthy and was retained for Lebo's staff in 2010
- ▶ Assistant coach Ken Potosnak is in his seventh season at ECU, after coming over from Auburn with Lebo, as is Director of Basketball Operations Kyle Robinson. Mike Netti is in his fourth year as an assistant coach. Potosnak is second only to Perry in terms of years spent as an assistant coach at ECU.

#### WILLIAMS TO SIT OUT 2016-17 SEASON

- ▶ Freshman point guard Shawn Williams must complete a year of academic residency at the ECU before being cleared for competition according a ruling by the NCAA over the summer.
- ▶ A native of Little Rock, Ark., Williams inked his National Letter-of-Intent with the Pirates during the 2015 fall signing period. As a senior at Maumelle High School, he received all-state honors from the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette and Arkansas High School Athletic Associ-

ation. He averaged 23.0 points and 3.6 assists per game, while leading his team to the state 5A championship game.

#### CRAIG & WASHINGTON BRING ADDED SIZE

- ▶ The summer addition of graduate transfer center Andre Washington and junior college transfer Jabari Craig gave the Pirates a much needed boost in size.
- ▶ At 7-foot-1, Andre Washington is the tallest player in school history and one of only two American-born seven-footers to compete at ECU. With his shoes on, Washington is nearly 7-foot-2 at 7-1 3/4.
- ▶ Toronto native Jabari Craig brings a 6-foot-10, 235-lb. frame to the Pirates after spending the previous two seasons in junior college. Although his minutes were limited in JUCO, Craig has the potential to impact the game on both ends of the floor.
- ▶ The Pirates also got bigger up front with the return of 6-foot-10 forward Deng Riak, who played in a mere eight games before sustaining a should injury that cost him the final 24 contests of the year. He received a medical redshirt and has four years of eligibility.

#### MILLENNIAL SCORERS


- ▶ Senior Caleb White enters his final campaign ranked eighth on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,200 points. With a career average of 12.4 ppg, White is on pace to score more than 1,500 points and finish as the Pirates' second all-time leading Division I scorer (since 1965) and fourth overall.
- J > Junior B.J. Tyson will look to become just the fourth Pirate to score more than 1,000 points in his first three seasons since freshman were ruled eligible for competition in 1972. Tyson scored a total of 881 during his first two seasons in Greenville, averaging 13.6 ppg during 65 games played as a freshman and sophomore.

#### DAVIS SIGNS NLI

K.J. Davis, a 6-foot-6 guard at I.C. Norcom High School in Portsmouth, Va., signed a National Letter of Intent to join the Pirates for the 2017-18 season, during the 2016 fall signing period. Davis helped Norcom win its third straight 3A state title earlier this year, scoring 16 points and grabbing 10 rebounds in the championship game, nailing four 3-pointers, to cap a 29-1 campaign. An honor roll student and two-time all-conference player, Davis was named second-team 3A all-state a year ago as well as a first-team 3A All-East region selection. He played on the AAU circuit for Virginia's Team Loaded as well as Boo Williams.

#### HISTORIC ANNIVERSARIES

- ▶ Fifty years ago, Vince Colbert became the first African-American
- to receive a basketball scholarship to East Carolina University in 1966. Colbert averaged more than 14 points per game during his two seasons (1966-68) with the Pirates.
- ▶ The 2016-17 season marks the 45th anniversary of East Carolina's first-ever trip to NCAA Tournament. Head coach Tom Quinn led the Pirates to an upset win over Southern Conference regular season champion Davidson in the SoCon semifi-



▶ It's been 10 years since East Carolina defeated NC State in the Wolfpack's only visit to Greenville, 75-69. Senior Sam Hinnant dropped 30 on the 'Pack as a sea of Purple flooded the court following the final buzzer.



#### THREE-HEADED APPARATUS

▶ ECU returns three of its top four scorers from a year ago: B.J. Tyson (14.6), Caleb White (12.5) and Kentrell Barkley (10.1). The trio was referred to as the "three-headed apparatus," by Matt Norlander of CBSSports.com.

#### RANKED FOES

▶ ECU has four games scheduled against teams ranked in the preseason AP and/or coaches polls. Virginia, whom the Pirates will face in Charlottesville on Dec. 6, is ranked seventh in the coaches poll and eighth in the AP. UConn comes in at No. 16 in the coaches poll and 18th in the AP, while Cincinnati, who ECU will face just once at home on Jan. 15, is No. 25 in the coaches poll, but isn't ranked in the AP.

#### TRIPLE THREATS

- ▶ East Carolina has finished in the top-3 in its conference in 3-point field goals made per game each of the last five seasons, averaging 7.1 or more made 3s each campaign. The Pirates made an average of 7.3 3-pointers per game last year, which was third-best in The American behind Temple (7.7) and Cincinnati (7.6).
- ▶ Caleb White finished ranked sixth in The American in 3-point field goal made per game (2.3).

#### **NEW FACES**

- ▶ ECU added nine new faces to the team in 2016-17 following the loss of five seniors and three transfers. Isaac Fleming and Andre Washington are both Division I transfers, Jabari Craig joined the program from junior college and four freshmen (Elijah Hughes, Jeremy Sheppard, Raquan Wilkins, Shawn Williams) signed NLIs. The Pirates also added a pair of walk-ons (Addison Hill, John Whitley).
- ▶ Billy Hubly is the newest member of the coaching staff, taking over the role of video coordinator. Hubly spent the previous three seasons at Georgia Tech, two as a graduate assistant coach on the floor and the previous as the Yellow Jackets' video coordinator.

#### ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- ▶ The Pirates' 2016-17 roster features 16 players (13 scholarship student-athletes) from seven states and three foreign countries (Australia, Canada and Switzerland).
- ▶ Five Pirates are native North Carolinians, while an additional seven hail from eastern seaboard states (Delaware, Florida, Georgia, New York Virginia)
- ▶ East Carolina has one graduate transfer, three seniors, three juniors, three sophomores, one redshirt freshman and five true freshmen. Junior Isaac Fleming and freshman Shawn Williams will both sit out the 2016-17 season in compliance with the NCAA.
- ▶ Six Pirates stand 6-foot-7 or taller, while 10 are 6-foot-5 or smaller.
- ▶ Five players transferred to ECU from either another NCAA institution or iunior college.

#### **NEARLY 140 DIFFERENT TRIUMPHS FOR LEBO**

- ▶ ECU Head Coach has defeated 136 different opponents during his 18-year head coaching career. This season he will have a chance to bring that number to 140 as he leads ECU against two foes he never faced for the first time: Hampton and Presbyterian. Should ECU face Akron in the Savannah Invitational, the Zips would be a first time opponent for both Lebo and the Pirates.
- ▶ The only other opponent on the schedule that Lebo has yet to gain a victory over is UConn. He will have two opportunities to record his first win over Huskies, first in Hartford on Jan. 22 and then at home on March 1.

# JFFF

**Head Coach** Seventh Year at ECU 19th Overall

North Carolina, 1989



The 2015-16 campaign is Jeff Lebo's seventh season as the head coach of the East Carolina Pirates and no coach in school history has won more games in its Division I era (since 1965) than Lebo. He was hired by ECU in March of 2010 and is the fourth-longest tenrued coach in school history. Lebo received a contract extension which runs 2020 following the 2013-14 campaign after leading the Pirates into the postseason three times during his first four seasons as the helm.

Lebo directed the Pirates to 99 wins during his first six years, the most successful stretch of victories during that time span in the program's Division I history. No coach in the 83-year history of ECU basketball won more games in his first five seasons. Under his supervision, the Pirates recorded their first-ever 20-win season as an NCAA Division I member, received three postseason tournament invitations and claim their first postseason championship.

He directed the Pirates to a pair of winning campiagns and one .500 season in his first four years. During the 13 years prior to his arrival, ECU hadn't won more than 14 games in any given season and posted a .500 record just once. Lebo coached the Pirates to 18 wins in 2011-12, second-most in the program's Division I history, which dates back to 1965.

The Pirates had also gone winless in conference tournament play since 1996 until he led them to a pair of wins at the 2011 Conference USA Championship tournament as ECU defeated UCF in the opening round and then knocked out No. 1 seed UAB in the quarterfinals to earn the program's first trip to semifinals.

East Carolina is 5-6 in conference tournament play under Lebo, including a victory over UCF in the first round of the 2015 American Basketball Championship tournament

Six Pirates earned All-Conference USA accolades under his direction, including the school's first C-USA scoring champion and first-team all-league player, Maurice Kemp in 2013. A year later, Akeem Richmond led all NCAA Division I players in 3-point field goals per game (4.56), made (155) and attempted (392). His 155 3-pointers made is the third-highest single season total in NCAA history.

Lebo's Pirates have set schools records for points, 3-point field goals, assists, blocks and steals during his tenure as well, while also establishing the ECU record for most wins as a Division I member.

Lebo spent the first 12 years of his head coaching career restoring programs at Tennessee Tech. Tennessee-Chattanooga and Auburn and responded by leading each program to at least one 20-win season before departing. He guided Tennessee Tech and Auburn into the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) play, winning five of seven contests - falling on both occasions to teams. which advanced to the NIT Championship Game. Lebo was honored with three consecutive OVC Coach-of-the-Year awards for his unprecedented success at Tennessee Tech. In addition, he was named the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 7 Coach-of-the-Year and the Tennessee Coach-of-the-Year at the conclusion of the 2001-02 season.

Lebo began his coaching career as an assistant at East Tennessee State under Alan LeForce for two seasons from 1990 to 1992 before he joined Eddie Fogler's staff as an assistant coach at Vanderbilt in 1992-93. During his only season in Nashville, Lebo helped coach the Commodores to an SEC Championship, a Sweet 16 appearance and a 28-6 record. He then followed Fogler to South Carolina the next year, where he spent five seasons and played a key role assisting the Gamecocks to their only SEC title in 1997 and a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. In his final three seasons in Columbia, Lebo helped the Gamecocks to an average of 22 wins per year, posting records of 19-12, 24-8 and 23-8

A four-year letterman at North Carolina, Lebo played for legendary coach Dean Smith and was part of a Tar Heel program that posted a 116-25 record during his career, captured a pair of ACC regular season titles and won the 1989 ACC Tournament title. UNC advanced to the Sweet 16 each of his four years and made two Elite Eight appearances. He was a two-time All-ACC Tournament selection and a second-team all-conference pick in 1988.
