POSTSEASON AWARDS

Player of the Year

Joe DeRoche-Duffin • Sr. • OF • UConn

DeRoche-Duffin emerged as the most prolific power hitter in The American in his senior year as he finished the 2016 season with a league-leading 17 home runs with 55 RBIs. He had 62 hits, including 32 that went for extra bases, and finished second in the conference with a .549 slugging percentage. DeRoche-Duffin became the first UConn player to be named as a conference player of the year since 2011, when George Springer was the Big East's top honor. He finished the season one home run shy of The American's single-season record of 18.

Pitcher of the Year

Anthony Kay • Jr. • LHP • UConn

Kay became the second straight UConn player to be named as The American's Pitcher of the Year after Carson Cross took last year's honor. Kay finished the season with a 9-2 record, a 2.65 earned-run average and 111 strikeouts in 119.0 innings. He was particularly effective in conference games as he went 5-0 with a 1.85 ERA in eight starts against league opponents.

Rookie Position Player of the Year

Joe Davis • Fr. • 1B • Houston

Davis was chosen as The American's Rookie Position Player of the Year as he led the conference with 58 RBIs, was third in batting (.331) and was second in home runs (13) as a true freshman. Davis also finished as the conference leader with 138 total bases in 2016.

Rookie Pitcher of the Year

Tim Cate • Fr. • LHP • UConn

Cate was tabbed as The American Rookie Pitcher of the Year as he went 5-1 with a 2.73 earned-run average in 13 starts for the Huskies. He struck out 101 batters in 82.1 innings, an average of 11.04 per nine innings, which ranks as the best mark in the conference.

Coach of the Year

Jim Penders • UConn

Penders was named American Athletic Conference Coach of the Year for the first time, and earned his fourth conference coach of the year accolade, after he led the Huskies to a third-place finish as UConn went 14-9 in The American. UConn went on to win the conference tournament title and advance to the NCAA Championship.

Introductions

The American Athletic Conference is in its third season as a baseball-playing entity in 2016. The conference features eight members who play eight three-game conference series. Each team faces six teams once and one team twice during the course of conference play.

Big Three

Three American Athletic Conference teams were selected to the 2016 NCAA Championship. UConn won The American's automatic bid to the tournament, while Tulane and East Carolina were chosen as at-large selections.

Lucky Seven

Under its current, eight-team configuration, The American has had seven NCAA tournament teams in the last two seasons. The conference sent four teams to the 2015 NCAA regionals (East Carolina, Houston, USF, Tulane) and three to the 2016 tournament.

Back In Business

UConn made its first NCAA tournament appearance since the 2013 season, when the Huskies won the Big East's automatic bid.

Pedigree

Current members of the American Athletic Conference have made a combined nine appearances in the College World Series. UConn leads the conference with five appearances, while Houston and Tulane have made two appearances each. Houston was the national runner-up in 1967. The last team among The American's current membership to reach the CWS was Tulane, which advanced to Omaha in 2005.

Houston and Louisville both advanced to the Super Regional round in the 2014 NCAA Championship, while East Carolina will play in the 2016 Super Regionals.

The American has one CWS appearances to its credit. Louisville advanced to Omaha in 2014, when the Cardinals competed in the conference.

The Sum Of Its Parts

The eight American Athletic Conference members have made a combined 108 appearances in the NCAA Championship, including this season's three bids. East Carolina has made 28 appearances, followed by Tulane (21), Houston (19), UConn (19) USF (11), and Cincinnati and Memphis (five each).

When It Counts

American Athletic Conference teams have combined to go 18-17 in the NCAA tournament in its first three seasons. The American was 9-5 in the 2014 tournament, 3-8 in 2015 and is 6-4 in 2016.

Superstars

East Carolina is making its fourth appearance in the NCAA Super Regionals. The Pirates are looking for their first College World Series appearance.

On The Other Hand

East Carolina won the NAIA national championship in 1961.

Back On Top

Tulane won the American Athletic Conference regular-season title as the Green Wave finished percentage points ahead of second-place East Carolina. It was Tulane's first conference title for Tulane since the 2005 Conference USA crown.

Jake From Plate Farm

Tulane catcher Jake Rogers has thrown out 27 of the 43 runners who have attempted stolen bases against him. Rogers did not allow a runner to steal during the American Athletic Conference Championship as opponents were 0-for-4 against him.

The Kay Zone

UConn southpaw Anthony Kay — the 2016 American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Year — has won his last seven decisions of the 2016 season. Kay's last loss was March 25 against Columbia.

Youth Revolution

East Carolina outfielder Dwanya Williams-Sutton became the first freshman to lead the American Athletic Conference in batting (.359) and is second in the conference in slugging (.563).

Regular Occurrence

UConn made its fourth NCAA regional appearance in the last seven years.

Not Getting Any Younger

Cincinnati, which had the youngest roster in Division I baseball last year, has three seniors, two juniors, 12 sophomores and 14 freshmen on its squad this season. The Bearcats, who were picked to finish eighth in The American's preseason coaches poll, ended up fourth in the final standings.

Not A Bad Start

In its brief history, the American Athletic Conference has already made its mark at the highest level of intercollegiate athletics.

- Teams from The American have won two CFP/BCS New Year's Six games in the league's first three years. Houston defeated Florida State in the 2015 Chick-Fil-A Peach Bowl and finished No. 8 in the final national polls. UCF defeated Baylor in the 2013 Fiesta Bowl to finish the year No. 10 nationally.
- UConn has won four NCAA basketball titles since the formation of The American. The Huskies won the 2014 men's title and captured women's championships in 2014, 2015 and 2016.
- The American was one of six finalists — and the only college sports entity — for the 2016 Sports Business Awards League of the Year honor, along with Major League Baseball, Major League Soccer, NASCAR, the National Basketball Association and the PGA Tour.
- The American has produced NCAA individual champions in swimming and diving and golf, as well as the 2015 U.S. Amateur champion in men's golf. The league produced the two winners of the 2016 Sullivan Award as the nation's top amateur athlete.

UConn starter Anthony Kay picked up his second win of the tournament, while shortstop Bryan Daniello went 3-for-4 to lead the Huskies to their first American Athletic Conference Championship title with a 7-2 victory against Houston in the final.

Kay was named as the tournament's Most Outstanding Player after he worked six innings and struck out five, allowing six hits and two runs in a start that was interrupted by a one-hour, three-minute lightning delay. Kay was the winning pitcher in the Huskies' tournament-opening win against Memphis.

Daniello finished the championship with a tournament-record 13 hits and hit .619 in the Huskies' five games (13-for-21) to join Kay on the All-Tournament Team.

Bobby Melley went 3-for-5 with three RBIs for UConn, while Jack Sundberg, Tyler Gnesda and John Toppa had two hits each. Patrick Ruotolo worked the last three innings for UConn to get his 11th save of the year. UConn's All-Tournament selections included Kay, Daniello, Melley, Toppa and second-baseman Aaron Hill.

Houston was led by Campbell and Connor Hollis, who had two hits each. The Cougars placed four players on the All-Tournament Team – designated hitter Joe Davis, outfielders Zac Taylor and Connor Wong, and pitcher Nick Hernandez.

Tulane catcher Jake Rogers and Memphis second-baseman Brandon Grudzielanek were also named to the All-Tournament Team.
