@ECUVB Opens 2016 Campaign At Bucknell Invitational

East Carolina begins its fourth season under the direction of head coach Julie Torbett this weekend when the Pirates head north to Lewisburg, Pa. for the Bucknell Invitational. ECU will take on Canisius, Fairleigh Dickinson and the host Bison during the two-day event. The tournament kicks off a 10-match non-conference schedule for ECU during which it will also travel to face Savannah State, North Carolina A&T, South Carolina State, Navy, Campbell and Georgia State. East Carolina began the 2015 campaign winning five of its first six matches, ending non-conference action with a 7-4 mark. During Torbett's tenure, the Pirates have fared well in such matches, winning 26 of 40 outside of league play. ECU also looks to win a non-conference tournament for the fourth-straight season.

Season Outlook

Head Coach Julie Torbett enters her fourth season in charge of the East Carolina volleyball program with arguably her most talented roster to date. Bolstered by the additions of junior transfer outside hitter Lael Ceriani from UT Martin and former ECU women's basketball standout I'Tiana Taylor, as well as the return of three of its top four hitters from the 2015 campaign, the Pirates look to produce their first winning record since 2006 and challenge for a spot in the top half of the American Athletic Conference. East Carolina will play 10 matches at Minges Coliseum this season while participating in non-conference tournaments at Bucknell, Campbell and Georgia State. ECU finished the 2015 campaign with a 12-19 record, including a 5-15 mark in American Athletic Conference play.

Top Returners

- Senior Middle Hitter **Ashley McRae**: Started all 31 matches and played in all 119 sets ... Led the team with a .300 hitting percentage ... Enters her senior season as the program's career hitting percentage leader at .309 ... Tallied double-digit kills in 11 matches, including a career-high 19 in a five-set victory at UCF ... Ranked eighth among American Athletic Conference players in hitting percentage ... Named to the AAC Weekly Honor Roll (Nov. 9).
- Junior Outside Hitter **Ashton Mares**: Started all 31 matches and played in all but one set ... Paced the squad in kills (374), kills per set (3.17), and aces (26) while ranking second in aces per set (0.22), digs (302) and digs per set (2.56) ... Tallied double-digit kills in 21 of 31 matches with a career-high 24 in a 3-2 win over UConn ... Notched a team-best 14 double-doubles ... Ranked eighth among league players in kills per set and points per set (3.56) ... Named to the AAC Weekly Honor Roll (Oct. 12).
- Senior setter **Sabrina Gonzalez**: Started 30 of 31 matches while playing in all 119 sets ... Topped the team in assists (1,028) and assists per set (8.64) while placing third in both digs (279) and digs per set (2.34) ... Collected a team second-best 13 double-doubles of which nine occurred in conference play ... Ranked fifth in the AAC in assists per set ... Racked up a career-high 57 assists in matches against Charleston Southern and Tulane ... Named to the AAC Weekly Honor Roll (Sept. 14).
- Junior middle hitter **Natalie Montini**: Played in all 31 matches while making 15 starts over 114 sets played ... One of four players to eclipse the 200-kill plateau (245) and averaged 2.15 kills per set ... Tallied double-digit kills in 10 matches, including a career-best 15 in a five-set victory over Presbyterian.

Newcomers to Watch

- Senior outside hitter **I'Tiana Taylor**: A four-year standout for the East Carolina women's basketball team who is completing her collegiate eligibility with the volleyball program ... Earned a pair of American Athletic Conference Second Team selections her junior and senior seasons and was named the AAC Newcomer of the Year at the conclusion of the 2014-15 campaign ... Averaged a double-double with 14.1 points and 10 rebounds per game as a senior and became just the fourth player in program history to average double-digit rebounds in a season ... One of three finalists for the 2014 WBCA Junior/Community College Player-of-the-Year Award during her sophomore season at Weatherford College ... Chosen to the 2014 WBCA Junior/Community College Coaches' All-America Team.
- Junior outside hitter **Lael Ceriani**: Top offensive producer for the Skyhawks in 2015 as a sophomore as she paced UT Martin in kills, kills per set, points and points per set while ranking among the squad's leaders in hitting percentage ... Produced 329 kills (2.63 per set) and 353.0 points (2.82 per set) in 2015. She also tallied 171 kills (2.76 per set) and hit .201 in Ohio Valley Conference matches ... Racked up 17 kills, seven blocks, seven digs and a .235 hitting percentage in UT Martin's five-set victory at Ole Miss.

About East Carolina

East Carolina University is a 108-year old public university nationally recognized for preparing teachers and primary care physicians as well as for its cultural and performing arts programs. It enrolls more than 28,000 undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students and is North Carolina's leading producer of initially licensed teachers and primary care physicians. Among the colleges and schools, East Carolina operates the Brody School of Medicine, School of Dental Medicine, College of Engineering and Technology, and a growing undergraduate Honors College. Julie Torbett, who played an integral role in the success of a nationally-prominent Penn State program as a student-athlete and followed with more than 350 wins in a 20-year coaching career, begins her fourth season as head volleyball coach at East Carolina University in 2016.

In her third season in Greenville, Torbett continued to put the program on solid footing. The Pirates won six of their first eight contests and captured the East Carolina Invitational for the second-straight campaign with three-set victories over Hampton and William and Mary. Torbett also helped mentor four different players who earned spots on the American Athletic Conference Weekly Honor Roll.

In terms of individual development, senior libero Erika Figueroa set the program single-season record for digs with 618 while producing a new single-match mark of 37 digs in a five-set win over UConn Nov. 25. She also left ECU in sole possession of third place on the career chart with 1,391. Figueroa was also named the AAC Defensive Player of the Week Sept. 28 as well as the East Carolina Student-Athlete of the Month for September.

The 2014 season marked East Carolina's inaugural year in the American Athletic Conference and Torbett guided the Pirates to a 15-16 overall record including a 6-14 ledger in league action. Under her tutelage, ECU volleyball collected 15 wins in a single season and six conference victories for the first time since 2007.

Torbett's squad was competitive throughout the season as they opened the year sweeping three matches in the East Carolina Invitational en route to becoming co-champions of the tournament along with UNCW. During the 2014 campaign the Pirates reached several milestones as a team and individually. A defensively strong team, ECU tallied 98 digs in the match against Memphis on October 26, which comes in third in the single-game record book.

A former defensive specialist at Penn State, Torbett used her knowledge and experience to set the tone for the Pirate defense. She coached junior defensive specialist Erika Figueroa into the starting libero position and, on November 16, Figueroa tied the then school record with 34 digs at UConn. With Torbett's help, Figueroa finished the season with three 30-plus dig efforts while averaging 3.74 digs per set to lead ECU and rank ninth in the American Athletic Conference.

Torbett put together a respectable first season with the program, leading ECU to 13 victories for the first time in five years - more than six times the win total from the previous season. She piloted her squad to three Conference USA victories for the first time since 2008 and paced the Pirates to their first five-match winning streak in five years. Under her tutelage, East Carolina captured its first road tournament title since 2005 after three consecutive 3-0 victories at the Elon Phoenix Classic.

Torbett's Pirates garnered a Conference USA Player of the Week in Shelby Beasley for the first time in five years and Nicole Willis was named to the All-Conference USA Second Team, marking the first all-conference ECU volleyball honoree since 2007.

Torbett came to ECU after a two-year stint at Winthrop where she guided the Eagles to a 20-8 Big South Conference record and a 34-24 overall mark. In her first year, Torbett's team tied for the Big South regular season championship, the first for Winthrop since 2007, and earned a No. 2 seed in the conference tournament. In her two years with the Eagles, Torbett's squads made an appearance in the Big South Conference Tournament and she coached six all-conference selections - including 2011 Big South Player-of-the-Year Becca Toor.

Prior to her time in Rock Hill, Torbett was in charge of the UNC Asheville women's volleyball program and she led the Bulldogs to 304 wins in 17 seasons from 1994-2011. Torbett guided UNCA to a pair of Big South regular season championships, a No. 10 ranking in the South Region, and was named Big South Conference Coach-of-the-Year on two occasions (2002 and 2009). In addition, she served as the department's senior woman administrator for 13 years.

In more than 20 years as a head coach at the Division I level, Torbett accumulated 338 career wins to become the winningest coach in Big South volleyball history. Additionally, she has coached and mentored numerous NCAA All-America selections, NCAA statistical leaders, and more than 40 all-conference honorees.

The former Penn State middle back and defensive specialist under legendary head coach Russ Rose helped the Nittany Lions to four Atlantic 10 championships, four NCAA Regional appearances and a perfect 31-0 conference record before earning her degree in exercise and sport science in 1990.

Torbett holds her student-athletes to a higher standard in the classroom as she has coached 18 Academic All-Big South selections and several of her teams have garnered the AVCA (American Volleyball Coaches Association) Academic Team Award which is presented to programs with a cumulative GPA of 3.3 or higher.

In addition to an emphasis on academics, community service also plays a large role for Torbett as she and her teams have participated in various community outreach programs. Throughout her career, Torbett's squads actively visit local elementary schools, retirement communities, and volunteer in an abundance of fundraising events. In 2011, the Eagles volleyball team helped raise more than \$800 for the American Cancer Society.

Torbett is married to Kelvin Thomas and has three sons Nathanael, Colby and Tristan as well as two stepchildren Kianna and Niko.

> East Carolina holds an 18-21 record in season openers dating back to a 3-2 victory over UNC Greensboro in the program's first-ever match. The Pirates are 2-1 in Torbett's three seasons, including a 3-0 road sweep of Savannah State to kick off the 2015 campaign.

> Friday's season opener against Canisius marks the first-ever meeting between the programs. ECU has also never faced Bucknell but won its only tilt with Fairleigh Dickinson in a two-set sweep during the 1981 campaign.

> Below is a numerical breakdown of what is coming back for the Pirates this season:

> ECU racked up 1,928 digs as a team in 2015, averaging 16.20 per set. That total represents the most in a single season for the program since 2007.

> East Carolina allowed the fewest blocks per set of any team in the AAC (1.73 against) in 2015. League champion SMU was second, surrendering 1.92 per set

> The Pirates look to capture their fourth non-conference tournament title of Torbett's tenure this season, having won at least one such event every year since 2013.

> ECU swept a home conference weekend for the first time as a member of the American Athletic Conference last season with a 3-0 triumph over then first place Houston and a five-set win over Tulane.

> Head Coach Julie Torbett, in her fourth season with East Carolina, sits just 22 wins away from her 400 for her career. She left Winthrop after the 2012 campaign as the winningest coach in Big South Conference history. In terms of the AAC, Torbett owns the second-most career victories among the league's current head coaches. Her 338 wins trail only Houston head coach Kaddie Platt's 559.

> Then sophomore Ashton Mares ended the 2015 campaign tallying 65 kills in her final four matches, averaging 3.82 kills per set. She notched a career-high 24 kills in the Pirates' five-set win over UConn - one of three times she reached the 20-kill plateau.

> Mares and then junior Sabrina Gonzalez ranked in the top 10 among AAC players with 14 and 13 double-doubles respectively in 2015.

> Senior middle hitter Ashley McRae is the program's current career leader in hitting percentage as she has compiled a .309 mark in three seasons. Her .360 hitting percentage as a sophomore stands as the second highest in a single season in school history.

> The final stretch of the 2015 campaign served as a breakout of sorts for then freshman Haley Bidgood. The lefty setter, who can also play on the right side, collected her first career double-double to the tune of 11 kills and 22 assists in the Pirates' five-set loss to Memphis before notching another double-double with 10 kills and 16 assists in ECU's 3-2 home win over UConn.

> Torbett has a few new faces on this season's coaching staff, hiring Russ Friedland and Nick Polite as assistant coaches while welcoming Ladislav Lelkes as a volunteer assistant. Friedland spent the last three years at UNLV where he helped the Rebels to a 58-34 record and a trio of winning campaigns. Polite arrives in Greenville from Valparaiso where he helped guide the Crusaders to 77 victories - an average of nearly 26 per season - as well as a 30-14 mark in Horizon League play and a pair of appearances in the Horizon League Tournament championship match.

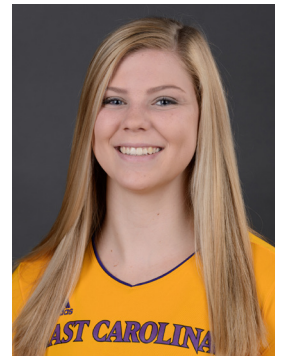

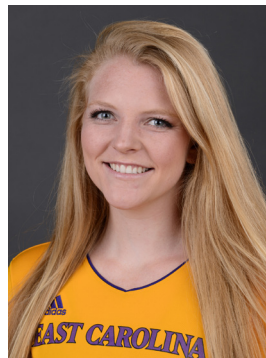
