- **Merritt Beeker:** Collected his first career victory on the mound in game two of the doubleheader with George Washington (Feb. 18) ... Fired across 1.1 scoreless innings and struck out three ... Turned in 0.2 scoreless frames at Duke (Feb. 28).
- **Joey Berini:** Has started six games at shortstop ... Tallied two hits and a run scored in East Carolina's 23-5 triumph over George Washington (Feb. 19) ... Added another hit and run scored at Campbell (Feb. 21) ... Rapped out an RBI double in the 6-5 home victory over then No. 12 North Carolina (Feb. 24).

Quick Things To Note Entering 2023

- ▶ East Carolina finished the 2022 campaign with 46 wins - its most since a 47-victory campaign in 2019. ECU posted a 20-4 record in league play, outpacing second-place UCF by six games.
- ▶ The Pirates hosted an NCAA Regional for the fourth-straight season, joining Stanford as the only team to do so.
- ▶ East Carolina is the only team in the nation to have won 40 games the last four seasons, host four-straight NCAA Regionals and play in three-straight NCAA Super Regionals.
- ▶ ECU earned the No. 8 national seed, its highest since it was No. 7 in 2001 and hosted a regional in Wilson, N.C.
- ▶ The Pirates finished at No. 8 in the final 2022 NCAA RPI ranking.
- ▶ East Carolina ranked 14th nationally in total attendance and 18th in average attendance in 2022.
- ▶ Ninth-year head coach Cliff Godwin was tabbed the AAC Coach of the Year for the fourth time in his career.
- ▶ ECU returns the American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Year and Third-Team All-American RHP Carter Spivey as well as freshman All-America selection and AAC Baseball Championship Most Outstanding Player outfielder Jacob Jenkins-Cowart and the 2022 squad's leader in batting average outfielder Lane Hoover.
- ▶ The Pirates welcome back six All-AAC honorees to this year's squad: Lane Hoover (First Team), Carter Spivey (First Team), Cam Clonch (Second Team), Alec Makarewicz (Second Team), Garrett Saylor (Second Team) and Jacob Starling (Second Team).
- ▶ ECU finished among the top 40 nationally in 12 statistical categories in 2022, ECU was third among NCAA Division I squads in both fielding percentage and sacrifice flies.

ECU leads the all-time series with Indiana 2-1 while the Pirates are 1-1 against Georgetown. East Carolina and Long Beach State have never met on the diamond.

Mustache March

With the dawn of a new month, the East Carolina baseball team (players, coaching staff and support staff) will once again participate in Mustache March to raise money and awareness for ALS Research and the Jim "Catfish" Hunter Chapter. This year, the Pirates will team up with the Pitt Community College and Clemson baseball programs to help fight and strikeout ALS with a goal of raising \$10,000. As most of Pirate Nation is aware, the baseball program has been greatly affected by ALS as former head coach and ECU Hall of Fame member Keith LeClair was diagnosed with the disease while coaching in 2001. The Pirates continue to follow the mission, vision and characteristics that made Coach LeClair such a tremendous leader, father, friend and coach. Current PCC Head Coach Tommy Eason coached under LeClair from 1998-2005, Clemson Head Coach Erik Bakich and Assistant Head Coach Nick Schnabel both played for LeClair and were teammates of ECU skipper Cliff Godwin from 1999-2000. Starting Wednesday, March 1 and running through the end of the month, the Pirates will grow mustaches to continue raising money for ALS research. Over the last four years, the team has raised over \$48,000. With the additional support from ECU Dowdy Student Stores, the sum has eclipsed \$71,000 in total donations.

Pirates Selected As AAC Preseason Favorites

After doubling as both the regular season and tournament champion in the American Athletic Conference a season ago, East Carolina topped the 2023 Preseason Coaches' Poll. The three-time defending AAC regular season champion Pirates have been picked first in the preseason poll five-straight times and six overall since joining the league. ECU received 49 points and seven first-place votes while Houston was second with 39 points and UCF third with 38. South Florida was awarded the only other first-place vote. Reigning American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Year Carter Spivey was named the 2023 Preseason Pitcher of the Year, joining the likes of Evan Kruczynski (2017), Jake Kuchmaner (2020) and Carson Whisenhunt (2022). Both Spivey and Jacob Jenkins-Cowart garnered unanimous selection to the All-AAC Preseason Team.

Up Next

East Carolina will play a pair of midweek games on the road, traveling to Kannapolis March 7 for a contest against Queens University at Atrium Health Park before taking on Elon the next day.

Distinguished Double

By winning both the regular season and conference tournament in 2022, ECU became the first team in league history to win both the outright/solo regular season title and conference tournament crown. Houston pulled off the double in 2017, but the Cougars had to share the regular season championship with UCF and were the No. 2 seed in the league tourney.

Listed Among The Nation's Elite

D1Baseball recently released its Top 100 baseball programs, identifying clubs in the best shape right now with an eye toward the next five to 10 years. ECU was tabbed No. 22 and is the highest ranked side in the AAC as well as one of six North Carolina institutions in the top 50 (North Carolina/14, NC State/16, Duke/33, Wake Forest/41 and Campbell/46). Houston represents the next highest American Conference team at No. 51 while future league member Florida Atlantic is 52nd.

Sleepers, Awake

D1Baseball asked every program in the country who they thought would be this year's "sleeper team" to reach the 2023 Men's College World Series. Of 229 responses, East Carolina led the way with 22 votes while Campbell was second with 17 and Wake Forest third at 14. The Pirates have participated in 32 NCAA Regionals - the most of any team in the nation without a trip to Omaha and the College World Series.

RPI Examination

ECU owns the second-best average RPI in the nation since 2018, finishing 12th in 2018, seventh in 2019, 13th in 2021 and eighth in 2022. The Pirates' average mark of 10.0 is behind only Stanford (5.8).

Academic Success

Since Cliff Godwin returned to East Carolina, his teams have excelled in the classroom by registering a 3.05 or higher grade point average in 15 of 16 semesters, including a team-best 3.69 in the Spring of 2021, which bested the previous mark of 3.61 (Spring 2020). Under Godwin, a two-time Academic All-America selection, his teams have combined to have nearly 400 players on the ECU Director of Athletics Honor Roll (3.0 or higher), while over 100 Pirates have earned inclusion on The American All-Academic Team maintaining a minimum 3.00 GPA. Following the 2022 season, the Pirates earned their seventh-straight AAC Team Academic and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Excellence Awards (2016-22). Five players have earned CoSIDA Academic All-America honors since 2016 (Travis Watkins/2016 first team, Charlie Yorgen/2016 third team, Jake Agnos/2019 first team, Alec Burleson/2019 third team and 2020 first team, Matt Bridges/2021 third team). Burleson became the third player in program history to be named a two-time Academic All-America selection joining Godwin and Sam Narron.

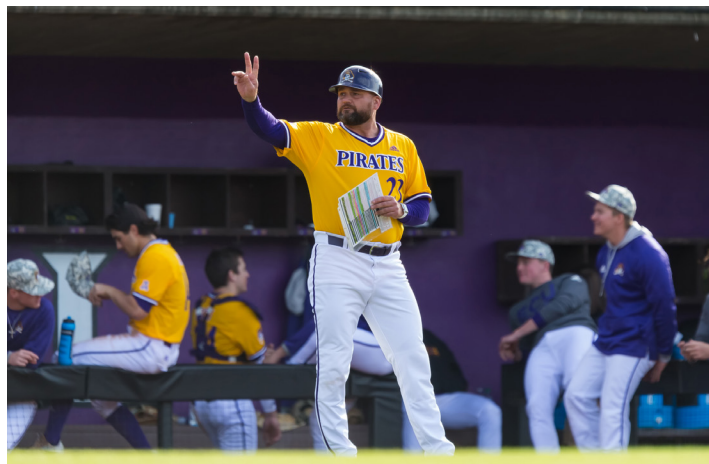

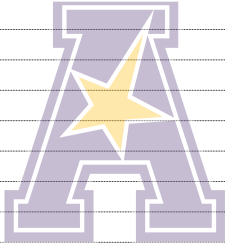

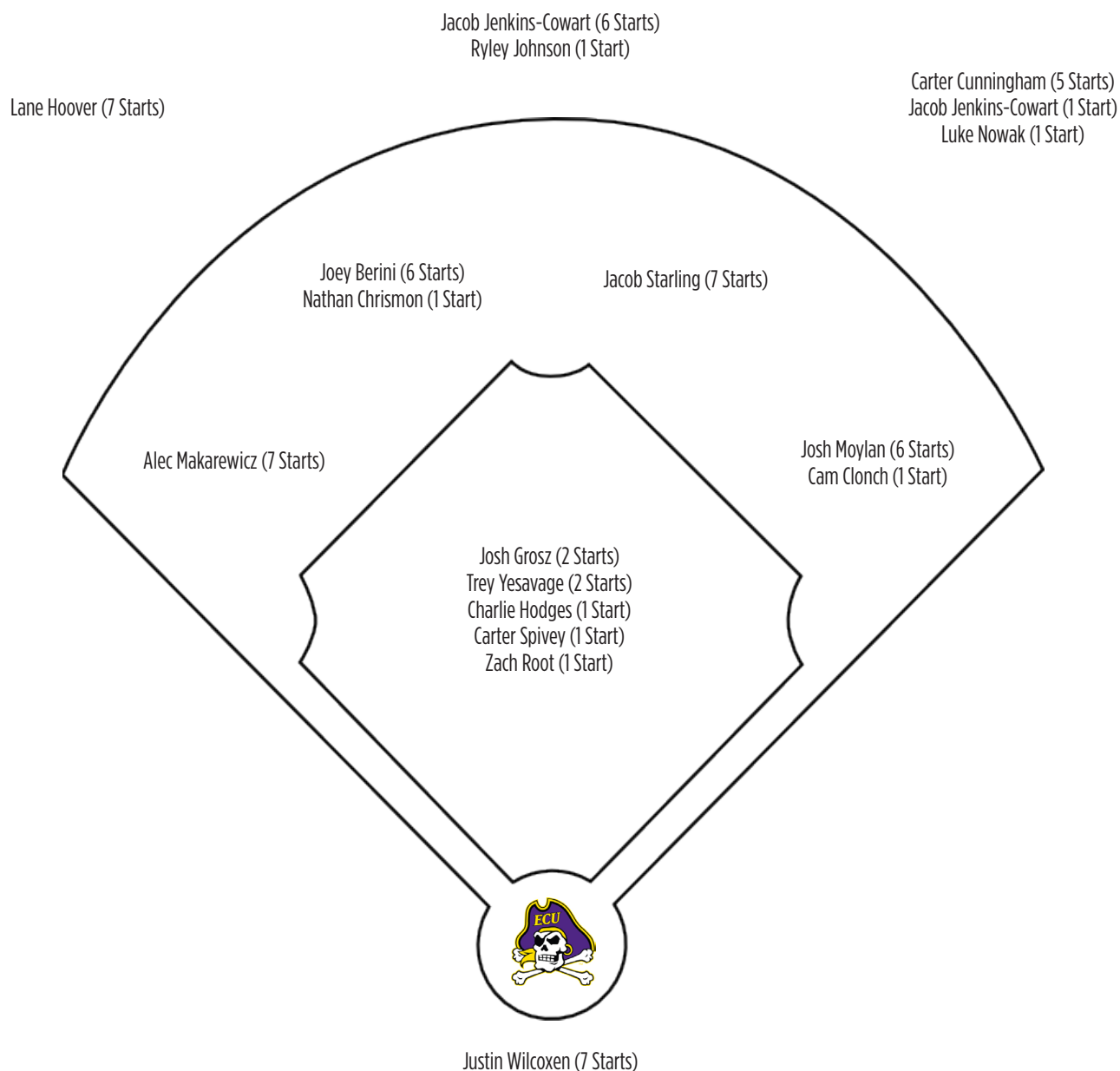
