PIRATES HOST UAB TO WRAP UP REGULAR SEASON

► East Carolina is set to wrap up its regular season slate this weekend when the Pirates play host to AAC foe UAB at Max R. Joyner Family Stadium. First pitch for Friday's game will be at 5 p.m. and the game will be streamed on ecupirates.com while Saturday and Sunday's games will start at 2 p.m. and noon respectively on ESPN+ with Patrick Johnson (play-by-play) calling both contests and Brittany Hoyt (analyst) calling Saturday while Courtney Layton (analyst) will call Sunday's game. The Pirates enter their final series of the 2024 season on a five-game winning streak and are winners of six of their last seven games after sweeping their third conference foe in Memphis last weekend. Logan Sutton earned a spot on the AAC Honor Roll after slashing numbers of .444/.643/1.000 with five RBI and five runs scored.

► Prior to the start of Sunday's game, the Pirates will honor their four seniors in Addy Bullis, Jayci Chamberlain, Payton Hudson and Taylor Woodring. Bullis enters the weekend with 294 career strikeouts (181 at ECU) and has pitched 322.1 innings in the Purple and Gold for a 3.32 ERA. Woodring has had a career year as a senior, batting .337 with 17 RBI and five home runs and was named AAC Player of the Week on Apr. 8.

► Emma Jackson headlines the Pirates' offense, batting .406 (2nd in AAC) and tallying 71 hits (1st in AAC/t-8th in NCAA) along with 23 doubles (1st in AAC/1st in NCAA) and 47 RBI (t-1st in AAC). Jackson was named the 14th best outfielder in the country by Softball America for the month of April and is only four doubles away from breaking the single-season doubles program record of 26 set by Kate Manuse in 2004. Morgan Johnson completes the one-two punch at the plate for ECU with a .387 batting average (6th in AAC), 47 RBI (t-1st in AAC) and a team-high 13 home runs (t-3rd in AAC). Johnson was recently tabbed the seventh-best first baseman for the month of May by Softball America. Taylor Apple leads ECU in the circle with a 2.59 ERA and 103 strikeouts (5TH in AAC) to go along with nine complete games while Addy Bullis sports a 2.64 ERA with 54 strikeouts.

► UAB enters the series on a five-game skid after getting swept at home by Charlotte last weekend and dropping two of three to Wichita State in the weekend prior. Bella Wiggins leads the Blazers at the plate with a .340 batting average while Lindsey Smith is the main power threat in the lineup with seven home runs on the season. Leigha Kirby headlines the Blazers' pitching staff with a 3.16 ERA and 71 strikeouts in 128.1 innings of action. ECU leads the all-time series with UAB 22-21 as the team's last met on March 9, 2014 with the Pirates winning 7-1 at home.

► The Pirates return 12 positional players from last season's team that went 27-28, led by Anna Sawyer, Jayci Chamberlain and Logan Sutton while retaining the majority of their pitching staff, headlined by Addy Bullis and Jordan Hatch. ECU added 12 new faces to the 2024 roster, including transfers Morgan Johnson, Hailey Massaro, Annie Kate Dalton, Makenzie Mason, Mary-Kathryn Scott, Samantha Turnage and Emma Jackson. The team also welcomes in five freshmen, including three who were in Extra Innings Softball Top 100 in Taylor Apple, Kaleigh Ayscue and Devin Long.

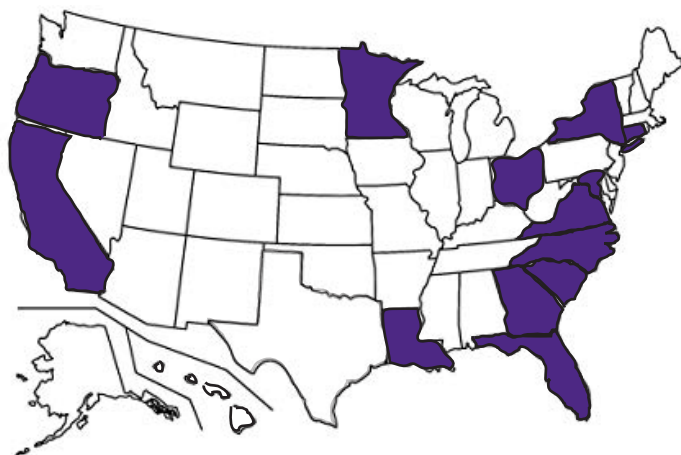

HEAD COACH SHANE WINKLER (THIRD SEASON, BUTLER '04)



Shane Winkler enters his third season as the head softball coach at East Carolina University after being tabbed as the Pirates' head coach in May 2021 following a successful three-year stint as head coach at George Washington University.

Winkler is the program's first male head coach and its fifth coach overall. In his first season at the helm, the Pirates compiled an overall record of 20-36 and outfielder Taudrea Sinnie was named to the 2022 All-American Athletic Conference Second Team

while pitcher Jordan Hatch received AAC All-Rookie Team accolades.

The Pirates showed improvement in Winkler's second season as the team won its most games since 2014 with a 27-28 overall record. For the second straight season, ECU had a player make an all-conference team and all-rookie team as Taylor Edwards was named to the 2023 All-American Athletic Conference Second Team and utility Mackenzie Kila earned AAC All-Rookie Team honors. Edwards was also tabbed to the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-Mideast Region Third Team, becoming the first Pirate to be named to an NFCA All-Region Team since 2014.

During his three years at GW, Winkler compiled a 91-43 record and captured the school's first two Atlantic 10 championships, sharing the title in 2019 before claiming the first outright championship this past season. The Colonials won both the regular season and tournament titles in 2021 to advance to the NCAA Championship for the first time and made their second overall postseason appearance.

GW participated in the National Invitational Softball Championship (NISC) Liberty Regional after claiming a share of the 2019 league title.

Winkler became the first Atlantic 10 Coach-of-the-Year in program history this past year after leading the Colonials to a 23-1 conference record in addition to a sweep of championship banners. GW was 38-8 in A-10 play during his tenure.

Under his tutelage, 12 student-athletes earned all-conference accolades highlighted by Jenna Cone, who earned A-10 Player-of-the-Year honors in 2019 and 2021, and Sierra Lange, who made history as the first Colonial to be named the conference's Pitcher-of-the-Year in 2021.

In addition, 11 players received all-region accolades, including a school-record seven this past year.

Winkler's teams set program records for runs per game (7.0), home runs (64), ERA (1.97) and fielding percentage (.977) in 2021, leading the A-10 in eight offensive and five pitching categories.

During his initial campaign at GW in 2019, the Colonials won a team-record 44 games and ranked third in the country with a .341 batting average, piling up 582 hits over 64 games, 89 more than the previous mark. GW ended the season among the national leaders in doubles per game (1.68, eighth), triples per game (0.31, 21st), on-base percentage (.405, 15th), scoring (6.02, 20th) and slugging percentage (.502, 22nd).

Before taking over the program at GW, Winkler spent a decade (2009-18) leading the softball program at Charleston Southern University. He totaled a program-record 261 wins with the Buccaneers and guided them to their first NCAA Tournament berth in 2014.

Winkler made his mark at Charleston Southern with three 30-win seasons and two Big South Championship final appearances highlighted by their breakthrough victory in 2014.

CSU ranked in the top 10 nationally in home runs in 2017 and was one of just two teams in the country, along with national champion Florida State, to rank in the top 30 in both home runs and steals in 2018.

Winkler's Buccaneers produced 35 All-Big South Conference honorees and 10 all-academic selections. The program also produced its first Big South Scholar Athlete-of-the-Year and had a recipient of the Christenberry Award for top academic student-athletes in the conference each of his final two seasons. He has amassed 372 career victories during his 14 seasons as a head coach.

Prior to his tenure at Charleston Southern, Winkler served three seasons (2006-08) as an assistant coach at Marshall where he was responsible for the outfielders and the offense. The Thundering Herd broke the program home run record twice on his watch and consistently ranked among the top offenses in Conference USA led by a four-time All-American catcher. During his three seasons, the Thundering Herd had a combined record of 91-78.

Winkler's first collegiate job came as co-head coach at Danville Area Community College (Ill.) for the 2005 season in which the Jaguars produced their first winning campaign in 12 years. He got his start coaching softball while in college working with a summer program in his hometown of Kentland, Ind.

Winkler has also been active with National Pro Fastpitch, where he served a summer season as the head coach of the Chicago Bandits in 2014. He tutored numerous Olympians and NCAA champions, including former All-America pitcher Jennie Finch, during his time on the pro circuit, which also encompassed stints as an assistant coach with the Bandits (2009) and the Akron Racers (2007).

On the baseball field, Winkler was an outfielder who played collegiately at Illinois Central College, Purdue and Butler. He earned his associate's degree in general education from Illinois Central in 2002 before earning a bachelor's degree in communication studies from Butler in 2004.

Winkler moved on to play professionally with the Florence Freedom (2004) and Washington Wild Things (2006) of the Frontier League, and the Amarillo Dillas (2006) of the United Baseball League.

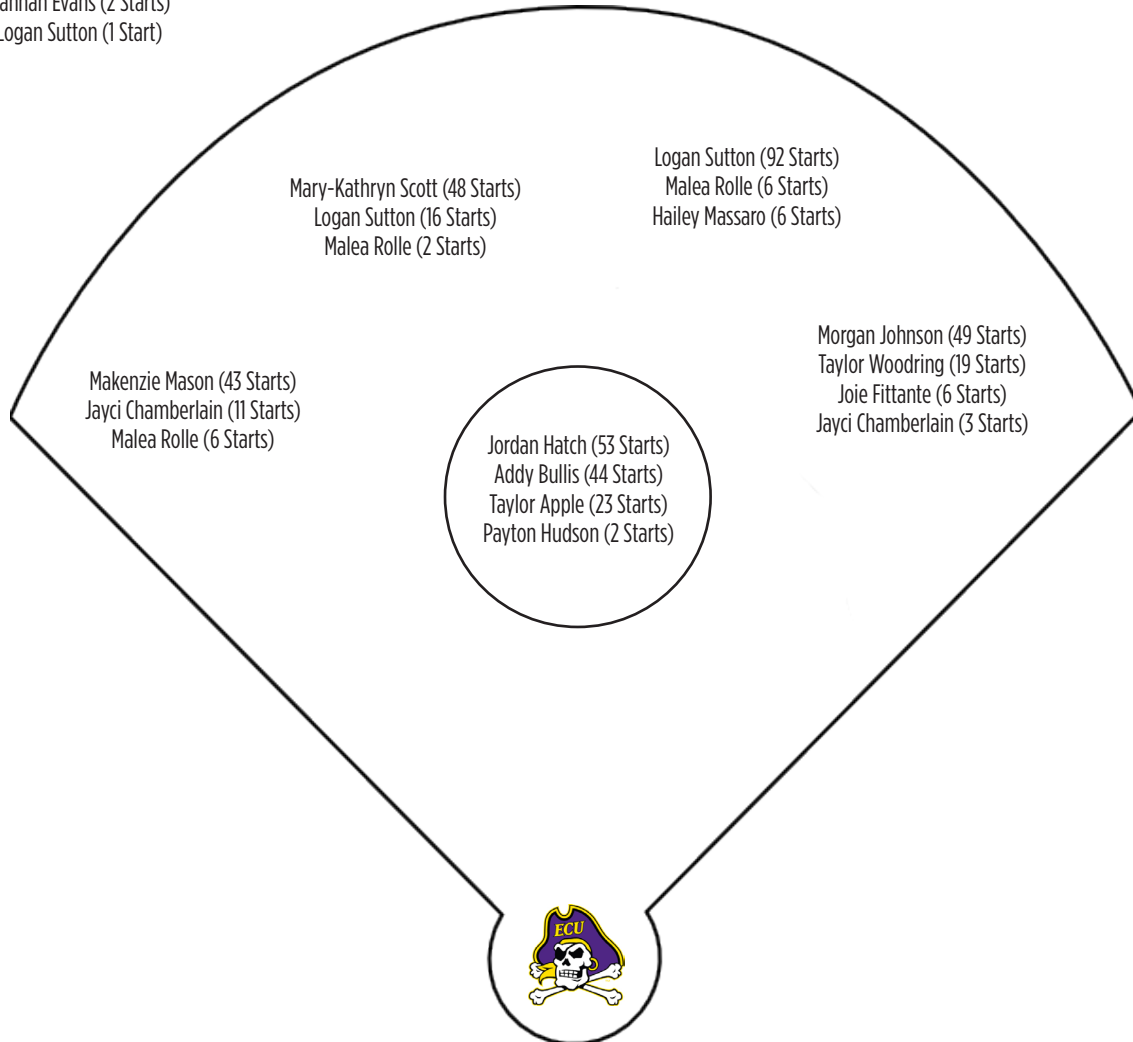
