EAGLES UPDATE

The Eagles put together their best shooting effort of the season against Concordia Chicago at home on Saturday but had trouble adjusting to a second-half press from the Cougars and fell 84-79 to drop to 1-7 on the year and 1-5 in the NACC.

The Eagles shot above 40 percent for the second time this year and finished just above their previous best of 49.0 percent to finish at 49.2. The Eagles led by as much as 14 in the second half but CUC's full court trap helped push the Eagles' turnover total to 24.

The Eagles led for nearly 27 minutes behind a huge game from Trevon Ampe and solid ball movement from everyone on offense. Ampe scored six points more than his previous career best to finish with 21 while the team finished with a season high 19 assists. Dylan Heemstra and Adam Freitag each finished with five helpers on the day.

The Eagles had a 20-8 run to give them a 41-29 lead in the closing minutes of the first half. Arik Anderson's bucket with 12 minutes left in the game gave the home team a 61-47 lead before the Cougars settled into a groove defensively.

Concordia Chicago would implement the press and forced 12 Eagles turnovers over the final 12 minutes of the game. They managed an 18-2 run to go up 77-73 with just under four minutes to go but the Eagles would tie things at 77 and again at 79 before a fast break layup and three free throws in the final moments gave the Cougars the win.

Ampe finished 10-of-14 from the floor and had nine rebounds while Emilio Lopez had a season-high 16 points.

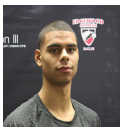
TEAM NOTES

* - The Eagles averaged only 5.3 three-pointers per game over the first four contests of the season but have at least eight in every game since for an average of 9.5 per game.

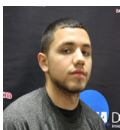
* - The Eagles were especially efficient on offense on Saturday, finishing with a season-high 19 assists. Their previous best this season was 13 against MSOE on Dec. 1. The Eagles had 19 or more helpers on four occasions last year.

* - The Eagles have seen a huge improvement from beyond the arc so far this season. They shot just 21.7 percent from deep in the month of November but are shooting 32.6 percent so far in December.

* - Junior forward **Trevon Ampe** (Madison, Wis./La Follette) was lights out on Saturday, going 10-of-14 from the floor to finish with a career high 21 points. He leads the NACC by a wide margin in FG percentage (75.0), as the next-highest player sits at 66.1 percent (Rockford's Michael Murray).



* - Senior guard **Emilio Lopez** (Milwaukee, Wis./Wisconsin Lutheran) scored a season high 16 points on 7-of-13 shooting on Saturday to help lead the Eagles. He has finished in double figures in four of the last five games.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

The UW-Stevens Point Pointers are ranked 19th in the country but fell to 4-4 on the year after a loss to No. 5 St. Thomas last weekend. The Pointers have played four ranked opponents this year. Forward Sean McGann leads the team in both scoring (14.6) and rebounds (5.4).

Carroll's 83-78 win over Loras on Saturday pushed its record to a perfect 7-0. They are also 4-0 in the MWC, with their latest being a 109-103 win over Grinnell College. Kyle Keranen leads four Pioneers in double figures with 15.1 per game. Bryan Nagy leads in rebounding with 10.0 per game.

Top-ranked Augustana College was 3-0 last week to retain No. 1 status. The Vikings wrapped up last week with an 83-50 win over Lewis and Clark. All but one of their wins this year have been by at least 20 points, with the exception being a 70-67 win over No. 20 Washington University. They overcame an eight-point deficit in St. Louis to remain undefeated. Ben Ryan and Hunter Hill lead the Vikings in scoring by averaging 13.9 apiece, while Tayvian Johnson sits close behind at 9.9.
