**SERIES/LAST MEETING:** The Tigers and Golden Rams will meet on the gridiron for the 20th all-time meeting. Edward Waters has a 10-9 series advantage, however Albany State dominated their last meeting, a 30-0 homecoming win last season.

**AT LONG LAST:** Edward Waters was finally able to put four solid quarters of football together in their 49-20 home win last Sunday against Morehouse. The Tigers showed a dominant display, especially through the air posting 309 passing yards and four receiving TD's. David Johnson went 12-14 passing for 211 yards and 3 TDs. Tyler King led the Tiger ground attack with a season best nine carries for 96 yards and 3 TDs, including a 53 yard rushing TD. Defensively, EWU held Morehouse to 222 yards of total offense and gained another turnover with a Widmyer Garcon 4th quarter INT.

**MOVIN' ON UP:** EWU has been on a steady climb up the SIAC rankings in some key statistics. The Tigers are fourth in the conference in scoring defense, allowing just 13.4 points per game and second in total offense, posting 359.2 ypg. EWU is also third in the league in passing efficiency, at 144.4, and continue to lead the conference in interceptions with six.

**THE CHAMPS ARE HERE:** The 2021 SIAC champion Golden Rams have continued to show why they are the class of the conference on their quest to repeat. ASU's "Dirty Blue" defense is second in scoring defense in the SIAC, allowing just 7.2 ppg, third in total offense, averaging 358.6 ypg, and third in total defense, allowing 312.0 ypg. ASU also leads the conference in rushing averaging 197.4 ypg.

**STARS CONTINUE TO SHINE:** Preseason SIAC Offensive Player of the Year in junior QB Dionte Bonneau has had a solid season so far. He ranks fifth in the conference in passing, going 53-102 for 785 yards, five TDs, and three INTs. RB Marcuis Fulks is fourth in the league in rushing, with 355 yards on 69 attempts, averaging 71.0 yards per game and five rushing TDs. Defensively, LB Stephen Pierre is third in the conference in tackles, with 47 and 1.5 sacks. Sophomore DL Josh Hill is seventh in the conference in tackles for loss with five, and junior LB Malik Barnes has four TFLs for the Golden Rams as well.

**LEADER OF THE NEW SCHOOL:** Head Coach Gabe Giardina is in his sixth season in charge at ASU and has led the Golden Rams to a resurgence in dominance. Coach "G" is 34-15 during his six seasons, including last season's SIAC Championship and trip to the NCAA Division II National Tournament.

**SEASON #72 OF EWC FOOTBALL:** 2022 marks the 72nd year of football as a varsity sport at Edward Waters College and the 22st year since the rebirth of the program in 2001 after a 34-year hiatus.

**YEAR #2:** Edward Waters received the go-ahead from the NCAA to advance to year #2 of their transition from NAIA to NCAA Division II. Year 2 will see all sixteen varsity sports be fully eligible for SIAC championships.

**11 STARTERS AND 38 LETTERMAN RETURN:** The Tigers return 11 starters from the 2021 team that finished 4-7, their best record since the 2018 campaign.

**CHASING SUCCESS:** Edward Waters is looking to notch its first +.500 season since the 2004 season when the Purple & Orange went 8-3.

## FIRST SEASON AT EWU (1-3) TENNESSEE STATE '00

Toriano Morgan was announced as the 15th head coach in the storied history of Edward Waters College Football on April 15, 2021.

Morgan brings over 17 years of coaching experience to his new role at Edward Waters, spread amongst high school and collegiate institutions. Under his purview, Morgan has coached 35 all-conference players and has been a part of sending 13 players to play in the National Football League. Morgan has been a perennial winner at every stop in his coaching career, bringing with him a streak of seven consecutive seasons with at least seven wins or more.

A native of Fort Lauderdale, Morgan returns to his home state after spending two seasons as Assistant Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator/Quarterbacks Coach at Virginia State University. In his first season at VSU in 2019, Morgan was an instrumental figure in the Trojans' 8-2 overall record and 6-1 mark in the CIAA, en route to a second place finish in the CIAA's Northern Division. Morgan's offense was ranked 4<sup>th</sup> in the CIAA in scoring, averaging 31.4 points per game, third in the league in total offense with a 382.2 yards per game average, and second in rushing yards with 228.4 yards per game.

Prior to joining the staff at Virginia State University, Morgan was a highly decorated Head Coach at Dillard High School in Fort Lauderdale, where he restored the perennial prep power to prominence, guiding them to a regional playoff appearance in his first season. Morgan compiled a 9-3 record which was his Alma Mater's best record in 15 years. Morgan was selected as the Head Coach of the Broward County Athletic Association All-Star Game and the Head Coach for the Public vs Private All-Star Game. Morgan was also selected as a finalist for the Tournament of Champions Coach of the Year.

Morgan served as the Associate Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator at Virginia Union University for four seasons, from 2014-2017. Morgan is credited with directing a prolific offense at Virginia Union, which averaged over 400 yards and 34 pts per game during his stint. In 2014, the team finished 1<sup>st</sup> in total offense and 3<sup>rd</sup> in scoring offense in the CIAA, Morgan improved the Panthers' passing average from 69.9ypg in 2013 to 409.3ypg in 2014, which help propel the Panthers to a seven win season (7-3). Quarterback Kenny Graham finished 1<sup>st</sup> nationally in yards per completion averaging and 4<sup>th</sup> nationally in passing efficiency.

2015 was another record breaking season for Morgan and the Panther's Offense Averaging 36 points per game and 439 yards per game, both 1<sup>st</sup> in the CIAA. The Panthers became the first CIAA program to amass over 2,000 yards rushing and 2,000 yards passing in the same season. Offsetting that production with 22 Rushing TDS and 22 Passing TDs and an NCAA Playoff appearance for the first time in 25 years. Quarterback Shaheem Dowdy was awarded the Willie Lanier Award which goes to the best College Football Player (Non-FCS) in the Commonwealth of Virginia. This was the first time this award had ever been awarded to a Div-2 player.

2016 Morgan's Offense produced William Stanback who finished 1<sup>st</sup> in the CIAA in rushing with 1,299 yards, while being selected First Team All-CIAA.

Morgan's Offense at VUU produced 11 All-CIAA Players and 4 All-Americans. Under Morgan's direction the offense set six program records during his tenure.

Morgan's offensive success over the past half a decade has awarded some national exposure. On two occasions, Morgan was selected as the Assistant Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator for the HBCU Spirit of America Bowl All-Star Game, A nationally televised game for HBCU student athletes to be evaluated for the NFL Draft.

Morgan began his career as a coach in 2002 as a graduate assistant at his Alma Mater, Tennessee State University, earning both a Bachelor's (Criminal Justice, 2000) and Master's (Administration and Leadership, 2002) degrees.

Morgan was also a standout player at TSU, where he was a three year letterwinner for the Big Blue Tigers. He was a pivotal part of back-to-back Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Championship teams in 1998 and 1999. Morgan led TSU to a #1 national ranking, becoming the first HBCU to be ranked #1 and also helped lead TSU to two consecutive FCS playoff appearances. In his final season in 2000, Morgan was also voted team captain.

Morgan is married to his wife Adeline and has a son, Zaiden.
