EIU Hosts UT Martin To Kickoff November

Eastern Illinois vs. UT Martin O'Brien Field (10,000) . Charleston, III November 1, 2025 • 2 pm • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- · Eastern Illinois returns home following back-to-back road games as the Panthers host UT Martin for Family Weekend on the Charleston campus. EIU is looking to snap a three-game losing skid as they lost at home to Gardner-Webb and then suffered tough road losses at Southeast Missouri and Charleston Southern. The Panthers enter the month of November at 3-5 overall, 2-3 in the OVC-Big South. EIU hosts a UT Martin team still in the hunt for the OVC-Big South title at 3-5 overall, 3-1 in the conference. The Skyhawks have won or shared four straight conference titles advancing to the second round of the FCS playoffs last season.
- · Eastern Illinois and UT Martin will battle for time of possession on Saturday as the two schools rank among the nation's leaders in time of possession. The Skyhawks are currently fifth in the FCS in time of possession and first in the OVC-Big South at 33:33 per game. The Panthers have been among the FCS leaders all season and currently rank sixth at 33:17 per game. On the season EIU has had the ball for more than its opponents in six of eight games this year including a 40:17 minute time of possession in the home opening win over Dayton. The Panthers held the ball for 39:48 in another home win over Tennessee State.
- Sophomore corner Isaiah Houi finished with seven solo tackles on Saturday at Charleston Southern while adding two pass break-ups to his season total. Houi now has nine pass break-ups this season which ranks him 21st in the FCS and first in the OVC-Big South. He needs one more pass break-up to crack the EIU single season top ten for pass break-ups. The EIU single season record is 18 set by Russell Dandy in 2023. Last season Houi became a regular in the defensive secondary late in the season finishing the year as the team leader with seven pass break-ups.
- Punter Mason Miller continues to hover around the FCS leaders in punting average as the graduate transfer had three punts at Charleston Southern over the weekend for an average of 53.7 yards per punt with a long of 64 yards. Miller is currently third in the FCS in punting average at 48.2 yards per punt with 15 of his 35 punts traveling 50 or more yards and 14 landing inside the opponents 20-yard line. Miller is chasing the EIU single season punting average record of 44.6 set by Kevin Cook during the 2007 season. He is on pace to become the fourth punter in school history to average 44 yards or better for the season.

- Eastern Illinois defense forced and recovered two fumbles on Saturday at Charleston Southern as the Panthers have at least one fumble recovery in five straight games with multiple recoveries in four of those five contests. On the season EIU has ten fumbles recovered which ranks the Panthers third in the FCS with UT Rio Grand Valley. Tarleton State is the national leader in fumble recoveries with 13 followed by Monmouth with 11. Individually Drake Van Hyfte has two fumble recoveries to lead the Panthers. Those ten fumble recoveries are added to EIU's two interceptions this year ranking the Panthers tied for 30th in turnovers gained with 12.
- •As a defensive unit Eastern Illinois ranks 25th in the FCS in rushing defense as the Panthers are allowing teams to rush for 125.6 yards per game. On Saturday, EIU held Charleston Southern well below that season average as the Buccaneers finished with 61 yards on the ground. Twice this season EIU has held an opponent to less than 35 yards rushing with Dayton rushing for 31 yards in the opener and Tennessee State mustering 30 yards on the ground on October 4. EIU ranks 45th in the FCS in team tackles for loss this year averaging 6.0 per game.
- Tylan Foster finished with double digit tackles on Saturday at Charleston Southern as the transfer linebacker recorded his third double figure tackle game of the season. He made ten tackles at CSU with eight solo stops and one pass break-up. His season high for tackles is 11 against Illinois State. On the season Foster ranks second on the Panthers team with 63 total tackles (8th in the OVC-Big South). He is the team leader with 36 solo tackles which is fourth in the OVC-Big South.
- Fellow linebacker Ja'Wuan Nickson leads the Panthers this season in both total tackles (64) and tackles for loss (6.5). On Saturday at Charleston Southern he was once again among the Panthers leaders for tackles in the game finishing with eight (five solo). Three times this season Nickson has finished a game with double-figure tackles with a season high 12 tackles against both Southeast Missouri and Illinois State.
- Gerliaer Ervin joined the Eastern Illinois sack party for the year as the Panthers defense has recorded nine this year with five different players collecting at least one. Ervin was playing in just his third game this season had the one sack. For the year he has four tackles. Samuel Robles is the team leader in sacks with three followed by Drake Van Hyfte and Trevon Piggee with two sacks each. Alton Jefferson has the final EIU sack. Van Hyfte led the team in sacks two seasons ago with five while Nicholas Oliviera-Chace led the team with six last year.
- Tight end Joe McNab hauled in a 23-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Cole LaCrue on Saturday at Charleston Southern. It was the only catch of the day for McNab who has spent most of his EIU career as a blocking tight end after seeing his first Panthers career action as a reserve offensive lineman in 2022 against nationally ranked UT Martin. He did not catch a pass and was rarely targeted during his first four seasons with the Panthers. This year McNab has five catches for 50 yards and two touchdowns. His first career catch was for a touchdown against Tennessee State.
- Quarterback Cole LaCrue has done most of his damage on the ground this season rushing for 418 yards and a team-high seven touchdowns. On Saturday at Charleston Southern, LaCrue threw his first collegiate touchdown pass connecting with tight end Joe McNab. LaCrue finished the game 10-of-18 for 121 yards. This season the Wisconsin transfer has passed for 490 yards going 44-of-88 with the one touchdown and five interceptions. As a prep player at Broomfield (Colo.) HS he passed for more than 6,000 yards with 56 touchdowns.
- Cooper Willman had two punt returns for 21 yards on Saturday at Charleston Southern as he continues to move up the EIU career punt return yards list. Willman has climbed to fifth in career punt return yards with 364 on 35 total punt returns making his 10.4 yards per return average currently third on EIU's career charts. He enters the week ranked 23rd in the FCS in punt return average at 10.4 yards per return this season.
- •• EIU veteran wide receivers Cooper Willman and DeAirious Smith both have climbed the EIU career receiving list this season. Willman had three catches for 33 yards at Charleston Southern while Smith was held without a reception for the first time in 16 games (Sept. 2023 vs McNeese). Willman's receiving yards moved his EIU career total up to 1,668 yards which places him 15th on the Panthers all time chart. Willman is also closing in on the EIU career Top Ten for receptions. He has 120 and needs seven more to tie Alexander Hollins for 10th. Earlier this season Smith joined Willman on the career 1,000 yard receiving list. He now has 1,153 career receiving yards moving up to 25th on the career list. Currently just EIU and North Dakota State have active 1,000 yard receivers at the FCS level with all of those yards accumulated at the same school.
- Knowledge Davis earned a start at defensive end on Saturday at Charleston Southern and the junior college transfer responded with four tackles (3 solo) and one of the Panthers six tackles for loss in the game. Davis has played in all eight games this season with 15 tackles and three quarterback hurries to his credit.
- Redshirt freshman Kwan Johnson is the lone player to start all eight games this season at his left tackle position as the Panthers have not started the same offensive line combination in more than two straight games. A total of nine different players have made starts on the offensive line this year with Johnson (8), DiSanto (7), Rahfeeq Katumbusi (7), Dante Thompson (7), Alejandro Arellano (3), Johnathan Arellano (2), Panayiotis Mihalopoulos (2), Sandro Malicevic (1) and Carson Fichtel (1) all getting at least one start this season.

Eastern Illinois Returning All-Conference Players

13 - Cooper Willman (1st Team WR / AP)



- Drew Schiller knocked home three more field goals on Saturday at Charleston Southern giving the redshirt freshman ten makes this season in 14 attempts. His miss came from 37 yards in the fourth quarter and then he had a field goal blocked to end the game. He enters the week ranked 49th in field goal percentage in the FCS. Last season he kicked in four games prior to his redshirt making him 13-of-21 in his EIU career. Schiller knocked home his extra point attempt at CSU moving his career total to 26-of-26.
- Cole Silzer made his first career start on Saturday at Charleston Southern as senior Alton Jefferson missed the contest due to injury. Silzer had played in two other games this season and in two during his prior three years in the program taking a redshirt season in 2022 and playing in two contests as a redshirt freshman in 2023. He missed all of last season due to injury.

SEASON LONG NOTES

- Graduate student Brett Galletti has been named a semifinalist for the William V. Campbell Award which is presented to the top academic student in college football. Galletti earned his bachelor's degree in construction management with a 3.97 GPA and is currently enrolled in the MBA program at Eastern Illinois. Galletti opened the season as the starting long snapper, a role he has performed in for the past three years. He was one of 44 FCS players selected as semifinalists and four from the OVC-Big South.
- Eastern Illinois once again has a mixture of players transferring from both the FBS and FCS level into the Panthers program. EIU currently has seven FBS transfers on its roster with program newcomers Cole LaCrue (Wisconsin), Charles Kellom (Akron) and Jack Tremblay (Central Michigan). The Panthers roster features eight FCS transfers with seven of those players new to EIU this year in Tylan Foster (Incarnate Word), Bruce Mitchell (Mississippi Valley State), Jihad McCall (Morehead State), Nick Vecchiarelli (Marist), Dante Thompson (Robert Morris), Jourden Hale-Frater (Tennessee State) and Jefferson McKinnon (Marist).
- Eastern Illinois jumps back into games with the Power Four FBS Conferences over the next several years as last season the Panthers played a pair of Big Ten schools with games at Illinois and Northwestern. This year's schedule dips back into the SEC as the Panthers end the 2025 regular season at Alabama.. Other future FBS games on the EIU schedule include a trip to play at Minnesota in 2026, Illinois in 2027, Kentucky in 2028 and Indiana in 2029.
- Eastern Illinois football has 12 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. This year's graduate players are Tienne Fridge, Brett Galletti, Jesse Garza, Zeke Lewis, Jihad McCall, Mason Miller, Trayvon Moore, Phoenix Porter, DeAirious Smith, Joseph Solomon, Drake Van Hyfte and Cooper Willman.
- Based on a combination of COVID football seasons and redshirt football seasons, Eastern Illinois has seven players that will be competing in their sixth year of collegiate football this season. Moses Alexander, Jihad McCall, Mason Miller, DeAirious Smith, Joseph Solomon, Drake Van Hyfte and Cooper Willman all began their collegiate careers during the 2020 season. Of the seven, Smith (40 games), Van Hyfte (37 games) and Willman (48 games) have spent their entire careers at EIU.
- Eastern Illinois once again has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel and incoming freshmen Cale Kimbro and Barron Sholl. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Kimbro and Sholl's fathers (Jared Kimbro and Scott Sholl) were also offensive linemen in the early 2000's blocking for quarterback Tony Romo and running back J.R. Taylor. Sholl was a multi-time All-OVC center. All three played at EIU for head coach Bob Spoo.
- Eastern Illinois football continues to expand its reach across both the United States and North America. EIU's roster features players from 23 different states spanning from California and Washington on the West Coast to New Jersey and Maryland on East Coast. Dejan Guzina gives the Panthers a player from Canada as EIU has had players on its roster from Canada, Finland, The Netherlands and Australia in recent years.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference merged into a joint conference for the sport of football in 2023 playing its inaugural season with ten members. Gardner-Webb was the league's first champion. Conference realignment once again impacted the FCS as Bryant and Robert Morris exited the league after one season and Western Illinois joined for the 2024 season. The conference rebranded as the OVC-Big South Football Association in 2025 and will play with nine member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Western Illinois from the OVC. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb. The league announced in July 2024 that the partnership would be extended to 2030 (previous deal was to 2026) with the OVC Conference Office overseeing the day-to-day operation of the league. Tennessee Tech has announced that it will depart the conference following the 2025-26 academic year.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 67-53 (16-26 at EIU, 4th year) career record. He was the 2003 Big South-OVC Coach of the Year.

UT MARTIN HEAD COACH JASON SIMPSON

Jason Simpson is currently the longest tenured head coach in the Ohio Valley Conference entering his 20th season with UT Martin. In his debut season of 2006, Simpson earned OVC Coach of the Year honors as he led the Skyhawks to a share of the OVC Championship and the school's first FCS Playoff appearance. More recently, UTM advanced to the second round of the FCS playoffs in 2021 and 2024 winning four straight OVC regular season championships. Simpson has posted a record of 127-97 with an OVC mark of 96-51. In 2019 he became UTM's career leader in coaching wins and currently ranks third in OVC history. Simpson is a 1995 graduate of Southern Mississippi where he played baseball.

SCOUTING UT MARTIN

UT Martin got off to a slow start for the season playing three of their first four contests against FBS teams and the other against a nationally ranked Southern Illinois team. That tough schedule resulted in an 0-4 start to the season. UTM bounced back with a win over Southeast Missouri in the OVC-Big South opener and has since improved to 3-1 in the conference standings. Quarterback Jase Bauer has passed for 1,376 yards and six touchdowns while rushing for another six scores accounting for 12 of the Skyhawks 19 touchdowns this season. John Gentry and Tommy Ansley have split the tailback load with both over 300 yards. On defense Keyshawn Johnson has been a force with 11 tackles for loss and 7.5 sacks this season as part of his 34 tackles. As a pass defense UTM has seven interceptions with 29 pass break-ups.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and UT Martin will be meeting for the 31st time with UT Martin having won six straight in the series and eight of the last nine. With last year's win by UT Martin the all-time series is now tied at 30-30. EIU's last win in the series came in 2018 when the Panthers picked up a 24-21 overtime win at O'Brien Field. In 2023, the game between the two schools also went to overtime with the Skyhawks collecting a 28-27 win when both teams were nationally ranked during the game.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools. EIU's current active streak is 11 games after they were shutout in 2024 season opener at Illinois.
