Panthers Open October Back At O'Brien Field

Eastern Illinois vs. Tennessee State O'Brien Field (10,000) • Charleston, Ill. October 4, 2025 • 2 pm • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois moved to .500 (2-2) on the season and 1-0 in the OVC-Big South as the Panthers went on the road for their first win in Macomb since 1990 with a 31-23 victory at Western Illinois. EIU plays the next two weeks at home hosting Tennessee State this week before welcoming Gardner-Webb to town next Saturday, Oct. 11 for homecoming. Tennessee State will be going on the road for the first time this season as the Tigers are 1-3 on the year, 0-1 in the OVC-Big South after a conference opening loss to Tennessee Tech.
- Jacarre Fleming was named the STATS Perform FCS National Freshman of the Week on Monday following his performance in the road win at Western Illinois. Fleming rushed for 111 yards on nine carries (12.3 ypc avg.) including two touchdown runs of 55 and 30 yards. He finished the game with 177 all-purpose yards with one reception for five yards and three kick returns for 61 yards. Two weeks ago Connor Wolf was an honorable mention selection for the national freshman award with EIU's last winner coming in 2023 when MJ Flowers was the FCS National Freshman of the Week after his big rushing day against McNeese State.
- Jacarre Fleming also added OVC-Big South Freshman of the Week honors on Monday after his 111 yard rushing performance at Western Illinois. Fleming now has 134 yards this season on 14 carries for a 9.6 yards per carry average. He is the third different EIU player to rush for more than 100 yards in a game this season joining Cole LaCrue (193 vs Dayton) and Charles Kellom (133 vs. Dayton). The last time EIU had three or more players rush for 100 yards in a season was in 2022. EIU also had it happen three straight years from 2013-15 with the 2015 season featuring four different 100-yard rushers.
- Corner Isaiah Houi continues to turn away passes from receivers as the sophomore was credited with two pass break-ups on Saturday at Western Illinois to go along with five tackles. Through four games this season Houi now has seven pass break-ups which ranks him fourth in the FCS in passes defended. Last season as a freshman that really only played full-time on defense the second part of the season, Houi led the Panthers with five pass break-ups. Houi needs three more pass break-ups this season to join the EIU single season Top 10 with the school record of 18 set by Russell Dandy just two years ago in 2023.
- Eastern Illinois picked up its second turnover of the season on Saturday when Samuel Robles had a strip sack in the second quarter that Drake Van Hyfte recovered. EIU would convert that turnover into a second quarter touchdown at Western Illinois. It was the second fumble recovery this year for EIU's defense. EIU's last defensive interception was October 5 last year by NiJhay Burt against Southeast Missouri.

- For the second time this season Ja'Wuan Nickson and Tylan Foster both finished a game with double figure tackles. Nickson and Foster both tied for the team lead with ten tackles with both players currently tied for the season team lead with 32 stops (tied for 8th in the OVC-Big South). Nickson added one tackle for loss in the win at Western Illinois and has 2.5 TFL this season. Foster is tied for the EIU team lead in tackles for loss with 3.5. Nickson and Foster both reached double figure tackles in the Panthers Sept. 13 game with Illinois State.
- EIU added five tackles for loss to its team total on Saturday at Western Illinois with four different players picking up a solo tackle for loss and two players Saipeti Maiava Jr and Jesse Garza combining for the other. On the year EIU is averaging 6.0 tackles for loss per game which ranks 43rd in the FCS. Tylan Foster and Drake Van Hyfte are currently tied for the team lead with 3.5 tackles for loss each. Seven different players this year have multiple tackles for loss for the season with 13 total players recording at least a half tackle for loss.
- Samuel Robles and Trevon Piggee each got to the Western Illinois quarterback on Saturday afternoon for sacks with Robles sack resulting in a forced fumble. On the year Robles and Drake Van Hyfte are tied for the team lead with two sacks each. Piggee and Alton Jefferson each have one sack to round out the Panthers team total. Last season EIU had 14 total sacks for the year with Nicholas Oliveira-Chace the leader with six.
- Safety Saipeti Maiava Jr was active once again on Saturday as the junior college transfer was third on the team with seven tackles including six solo stops. Maiava is third overall on EIU's team this season with 31 tackles (11th OVC-Big South) with his 20 solo tackles leading the Panthers. He currently ranks 23rd in the FCS in solo tackles. He made a season high 11 tackles in the second game of the year at Indiana State.
- Eastern Illinois defense limited Western Illinois to just 33 percent on third down conversions (5-of-15) on Saturday in Macomb. That landed right on the Panthers season number for third down defense as the 33 percent for the season ranks EIU 24th in the FCS. Last season EIU allowed opponents to convert at 46.7 percent on third down which ranked 112th in the FCS.
- Running back Charles Kellom churned out 74 yards on 10 carries (7.4 ypc) on Saturday at Western Illinois including his third rushing touchdown of the season midway through the second quarter. Kellom opened his EIU career with 133 yards against Dayton for his second career 100 yard rushing game (one at Akron). The junior currently has 315 yards rushing this season which places him 42nd in the FCS and third in the OVC-Big South.
- CJ Nelson hauled in one pass for 20 yards on Saturday at Western Illinois as the Panthers had just four completions during the road win. Nelson was coming off a big day against Illinois State where the redshirt junior had seven catches for 192 yards and two touchdowns. The 192 yards are the most in the OVC-Big South this season and second most in the FCS this year. He is currently averaging 23 yards per reception which is seventh in the FCS. Nelson has two career 100-yard receiving games to his credit.
- DeAirious Smith hauled in one pass for 33 yards on Saturday at Western Illinois, one of four pass completions EIU had in the game. He became the 36th player in program history to join the 1,000 yard receiving club in the second game of the season at Indiana State. Smith now has 68 receptions for 1,078 yards which ranks 31st on the EIU career list. His 15.85 yards per reception career average ranks him ninth all-time at EIU.
- Cooper Willman had three punt returns for 50 yards on Saturday at Western Illinois as the graduate student is now averaging 10.1 yards per punt return this season, good for 21st best in the FCS. For his career Willman is averaging 9.96 yards per punt return which ranks him fourth on the EIU career list. At WIU he moved into the EIU career top ten for career punt return yards with 279 (passing Charles Owens). Willman was held without a catch at Western Illinois ending his streak of 15 consecutive games with at least one pass reception.
- Mason Miller continues to be a weapon for Eastern Illinois special teams averaging 47.0 yards per punt on Saturday at Western Illinois with two punts downed inside the 20-yard line. He did have one punt blocked, the time since the 2023 season at Robert Morris that EIU had a punt blocked. On the season Miller has a season average of 48.0 which ranks fourth in the FCS. Last season he was an NAIA All-America leading that level in punting at 45.3. EIU's single season punting average record is 44.6 set by Kevin Cook in 2007.
- Kicker Drew Schiller is now 3-for-3 on field goal attempts this season after knocking home a 20-yard kick in the fourth quarter on Saturday at Western Illinois. Schiller also converted all four extra point attempts and is 12-of-12 on PATs this season. Last year he kicked in the opening four games of the year going 3-of-7 with a standout special teams game against Indiana State which won him OVC-Big South Freshman of the Week. He was 7-for-7 on extra points in those four games giving him 19 consecutive extra points made in his EIU career.
- Eastern Illinois completed just four passes on ten attempts on Saturday in the 31-23 win at Western Illinois. It was the fewest pass completions for the Panthers in a game since the end of the 2022 season when EIU completed just three passes in a loss to Southeast Missouri on Nov. 19, 2022. The Panthers had four games during the 2022 season where they completed seven or fewer passes. The ten passing attempts in the game were the fewest by an EIU team since the 2022 season as well when EIU went 6-of-9 for 48 yards through the air against Northwestern State. The Panthers did churn out 340 yards on the ground that afternoon for the win. The previous week EIU won its OVC opener on the road at Murray State also completing just six passes in the win.

Eastern Illinois Returning All-Conference Players

13 - Cooper Willman (1st Team WR / AP)



- On a roster filled with returning players, junior college and four year transfers; a couple of true freshmen have found their way into playing time early in the 2025 season. Linebacker Brock VanDeveer has played in all four games starting on the Panthers special teams unit with three tackles to his credit. Wide receiver Carlyun Neal has played on offense and special teams in three games. He has caught three passes for 47 yards and has three kickoff returns. The latest freshman to play was defensive lineman Tyler Fortis at Western Illinois with no statistics recorded.
- Eastern Illinois offense snapped a six game streak in which the Panthers had failed to score in the opening quarter when Connor Wolf plowed in from the 1-yard line with 5:52 to play in the first on Saturday at Western Illinois. In 2024 EIU scored in the opening quarter in four out of twelve games. This season EIU has been outscored 51-34 in the opening half with 27 of those 34 points coming in the second quarter. EIU's most productive offensive quarter has been the fourth with 51 points this year.
- Graduate student Brett Galletti has been named a semifinalist for the William V. Campbell Award which is presented to the top academic student in college football. Galletti earned his bachelor's degree in construction management with a 3.97 GPA and is currently enrolled in the MBA program at Eastern Illinois. Galletti opened the season as the starting long snapper, a role he has performed in for the past three years. He was one of 44 FCS players selected as semifinalists and four from the OVC-Big South.
- Eastern Illinois will be close to home for a large portion of the season before ending the year on November 22 at Alabama. The Panthers play five of their first six games in the state of Illinois with the lone trip out of state just across the border, 45 miles, to Terre Haute, Indiana. The Panthers play four of their first six contests at O'Brien Field with the other road game at Western Illinois to open OVC play. EIU then travels to Southeast Missouri in mid-October before a flight to Charleston Southern to wrap up October.

SEASON LONG NOTES

- Eastern Illinois once again has a mixture of players transferring from both the FBS and FCS level into the Panthers program. EIU currently has seven FBS transfers on its roster with program newcomers Cole LaCrue (Wisconsin), Charles Kellom (Akron) and Jack Tremblay (Central Michigan). The Panthers roster features eight FCS transfers with seven of those players new to EIU this year in Tylan Foster (Incarnate Word), Bruce Mitchell (Mississippi Valley State), Jihad McCall (Morehead State), Nick Vecchiarelli (Marist), Dante Thompson (Robert Morris), Jourden Hale-Frater (Tennessee State) and Jefferson McKinnon (Marist).
- Eastern Illinois jumps back into games with the Power Four FBS Conferences over the next several years as last season the Panthers played a pair of Big Ten schools with games at Illinois and Northwestern. This year's schedule dips back into the SEC as the Panthers end the 2025 regular season at Alabama.. Other future FBS games on the EIU schedule include a trip to play at Minnesota in 2026, Illinois in 2027, Kentucky in 2028 and Indiana in 2029.
- Eastern Illinois football has 12 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. This year's graduate players are Tienne Fridge, Brett Galletti, Jesse Garza, Zeke Lewis, Jihad McCall, Mason Miller, Trayvon Moore, Phoenix Porter, DeAirious Smith, Joseph Solomon, Drake Van Hyfte and Cooper Willman.
- Based on a combination of COVID football seasons and redshirt football seasons, Eastern Illinois has seven players that will be competing in their sixth year of collegiate football this season. Moses Alexander, Jihad McCall, Mason Miller, DeAirious Smith, Joseph Solomon, Drake Van Hyfte and Cooper Willman all began their collegiate careers during the 2020 season. Of the seven, Smith (40 games), Van Hyfte (37 games) and Willman (48 games) have spent their entire careers at EIU.
- Eastern Illinois once again has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel and incoming freshmen Cale Kimbro and Barron Sholl. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Kimbro and Sholl's fathers (Jared Kimbro and Scott Sholl) were also offensive linemen in the early 2000's blocking for quarterback Tony Romo and running back J.R. Taylor. Sholl was a multi-time All-OVC center. All three played at EIU for head coach Bob Spoo.
- Eastern Illinois football continues to expand its reach across both the United States and North America. EIU's roster features players from 23 different states spanning from California and Washington on the West Coast to New Jersey and Maryland on East Coast. Dejan Guzina gives the Panthers a player from Canada as EIU has had players on its roster from Canada, Finland, The Netherlands and Australia in recent years.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference merged into a joint conference for the sport of football in 2023 playing its inaugural season with ten members. Gardner-Webb was the league's first champion. Conference realignment once again impacted the FCS as Bryant and Robert Morris exited the league after one season and Western Illinois joined for the 2024 season. The conference rebranded as the OVC-Big South Football Association in 2025 and will play with nine member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Western Illinois from the OVC. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb. The league announced in July 2024 that the partnership would be extended to 2030 (previous deal was to 2026) with the OVC Conference Office overseeing the day-to-day operation of the league. Tennessee Tech has announced that it will depart the conference following the 2025-26 academic year.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 66-50 (15-23 at EIU, 4th year) career record. He was the 2003 Big South-OVC Coach of the Year.

TENNESSEE STATE HEAD COACH REGGIE BARLOW

Former NFL wide receiver Reggie Barlow enters his first season as the head coach at Tennessee State and is off to a 1-3 start this season. Barlow coached the last two seasons in the XFL/UFL with the DC Defenders taking the team to the league championship game in 2023. He has previous college head coaching stops at Alabama State and Virginia State winning three SWAC East Division titles at ASU and taking VSU to the NCAA Division II playoffs one time. He has a collegiate coaching record of 84-61. Barlow played college football at Alabama State before an eight-year NFL career with stops in Jacksonville, Tampa Bay and Oakland.

SCOUTING TENNESSEE STATE

Tennessee State enters the weekend at 1-3 overall, 0-1 in the OVC-Big South following a loss to Tennessee Tech. The Tigers are under the direction of a new coaching staff rebuilding on last year's FCS playoff team. Dynamic running back Kendric Rhymes leads the TSU offense in both rushing and receiving this season. Rhymes has 359 yards rushing with three touchdowns with a team high 15 receptions and one score. TSU has used two quarterbacks during the season with Jonathan Palmer and Byron McNair. The Tigers once again have an active defense with Kaiki Baker (29 tackles / 4.5 TFL) and James Stewart (23 tackles / 4 TFL) leading the charge.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Tennessee State will be meeting for the 29th time as EIU hosts Tennessee State at O'Brien Field. EIU holds a 16-12 all-time lead in the series winning four of the last five games since the Spring 2021 COVID season. EIU's win came during the 2023 season at home. The Tigers had won in their previous two trips to Charleston in 2021 and 2018. Prior to the Spring 2021 TSU win to start the Tigers current streak in the series, EIU had won eight out of the previous ten games dating back to 2010.

SERIES DID YOU KNOW FACTS...

- 1.) Of the 28 meetings between Eastern Illinois and Tennessee State, two of those have occurred in the FCS playoffs with EIU beating TSU in 2013 (51-10) and TSU edging EIU 20-19 in 1982 in what later would be a game forfeited by the Tigers due to use of an ineligible player. TSU is one of three teams EIU has faced multiple times in the FCS playoffs with EIU playing both Northern lowa and Southern Illinois three times.
- 2.) Eastern Illinois has had a its fair share of players reach the NFL with notable quarterbacks Tony Romo and Jimmy Garoppolo. Tennessee State has produced multiple NFL players through the years including Hall of Fame inductees Richard Dent and Claude Humphrey. In terms of the College Football Hall of Fame, EIU has two inductees in former coach Darrell Mudra along with quarterback Tony Romo. TSU is represented by former head coach John Merritt.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools. EIU's current active streak is 11 games after they were shutout in 2024 season opener at Illinois.
