• **Quick Notes**

▶ Saturday's game matches the top two teams in the Ohio Valley Conference. The winner will have the inside track to the automatic bid to the FCS playoffs. EKU has won a league-best 21 OVC titles with the last coming in 2011.

▶ The EKU defense has forced 27 turnovers in 2014, which is tied for first nationally (FCS) with North Carolina A&T. Eastern turned four Tennessee State turnovers into 25 points in last weekend's victory.

▶ Junior RB **Dy'Shawn Mobley** was added to the Walter Payton Award watch list (FCS most outstanding player) on Tuesday. Mobley ranks ninth nationally in rushing (1,061 yards) and 13th in rushing yards per game (117.9). Mobley has reached the 100-yard plateau in six of the last seven games, including 139 yards and three touchdowns last weekend against Tennessee State.

▶ Senior QB **Jared McClain** piled up a personal-high 139 yards rushing on Nov. 1 at Tennessee State. McClain has 475 rushing yards this season, second most on the team. He has scored at least one rushing touchdown in seven games.

▶ Senior DB **Brandon Stanley** is tied for the league lead with four interceptions. Stanley has notched an interception in three of the last five games. The safety also ranks first on the team with 77 tackles and has averaged 12 tackles per game over the last four contests.

▶ Jacksonville State leads the league in rushing offense (284.2 yards per game) and rushing defense (110.0 ypg). The Colonels rank second in both of those categories – 249.6 yards per game on offense and 142.8 yards allowed on defense.

**• A Colonel Win Would ...**

... Give the Colonels their ninth win, their most in seven years under head coach **Dean Hood**.

... Mark Eastern's first win over a top-five FCS team since downing No. 2 Jacksonville State on Nov. 6, 2010.

... Make EKU's all-time record 582-359-38.

**• On This Date in EKU History ...**

Eastern scored the final 20 points in a 20-10 win at Southeast Missouri on Nov. 8, 1997.

WR **Bobby Washington** caught a touchdown pass and RB **Derick Logan** ran for a fourth quarter score in the win. The Colonels went on to win the 1997 OVC title and advance to the Division I-AA playoffs.

**• Best Start Since 1990**

Eastern Kentucky's 6-0 start was the team's best since going 10-0 to begin the 1990 campaign.

**• Kickers Beware**

Eastern Kentucky has blocked seven kicks this year which ranks second nationally. The Colonels have blocked four field goal attempts and three punts. Last week, WR **Devin Borders** blocked a punt which led to an EKU field goal. Borders leads all FCS players with five blocked kicks.

**• Superb Defense Inside the 20-Yard Line**

EKU's red zone defense ranks seventh nationally as the opposition has scored touchdowns just 18 times on 35 trips (51.4 percent) inside the 20-yard line.

**• Quick Strike Offense**

Of Eastern's 49 scoring drives, 30 have taken less than two minutes off the game clock.

**• EKU vs. Ranked FCS Teams**

In seven years under head coach **Dean Hood**, the Colonels are 7-10 against ranked FCS teams. Last year, the Colonels were 1-2 against ranked teams highlighted by a 44-0 win over No. 23 Tennessee State.

**• Road Warriors!**

Thanks to a 56-42 win at Tennessee State on Nov. 1, Eastern Kentucky notched its fifth road win of the season. The Colonels had not won five road games since 1990.

**• Among the Best in the OVC**

Since Jacksonville State joined the league in 2003, no team has a better winning percentage in OVC games than EKU.

**• Another Homecoming Victory**

Thanks to a 33-21 win over Southeast Missouri on Oct. 25, the Colonels have now won eight straight Homecoming games and are 11-4 in those games since 2000.

**• A Very Rare Occurrence**

When DB **Stanley Absanon** blocked a 32-yard field goal attempt and returned the ball 75 yards for a touchdown at Tennessee Tech on Oct. 25, it was the first time the Colonels returned a blocked field goal for a score since the 1982 Division I-AA championship game.

**• Just a Blip on the Radar**

The Colonels turned the ball over seven times in their only loss of the season on Oct. 18 at Tennessee Tech. EKU hadn't turned the ball over that many times since a 2004 loss to Western Kentucky (seven).

**• OVC Specialist of the Week**

Senior PK **Andrew Lloyd** was named OVC Specialist of the Week after making both field goal attempts, including the game-winner in overtime, against Eastern Illinois on Oct. 11. Lloyd connected from 29-yards out in overtime to give the Colonels the victory. Lloyd is 11-of-14 on field goal attempts this season and has made 17 of his last 20 attempts dating back to last fall.

**• It's Been Some Time**

Eastern's 36-33 win over Eastern Illinois on Oct. 11 was the team's first overtime win since defeating Austin Peay on Sept. 27, 2008.

### • Block That Kick!

Sophomore WR **Devin Borders** has blocked two punts and three field goal attempts this season. His blocked field goal in the fourth quarter against Eastern Illinois on Oct. 11 was a key play in ECU's comeback win. Borders led the nation in blocked kicks one year ago (five).

### • ECU Athletics Hall of Fame – Class of 2014

The Eastern Kentucky University Athletics Hall of Fame 2014 induction class features seven distinguished individuals as well as the 1940 undefeated football team. The class was enshrined at the ECU Center for the Arts on Oct. 11.

Two football players are a part of the 2014 induction class: OL **James Hand** (1991-95) and QB **Bill Hughes** (1975-79).

Hand was a two-time All-American at offensive guard for the Colonels in 1994 and 1995. Hughes led Eastern to its first national title in 1979.

### • ECU in OVC Openers

The Colonels are now 47-20 all-time in OVC openers following a 49-24 win at UT Martin on Sept. 20. ECU is 4-3 in OVC openers under head coach **Dean Hood**.

### • OVC Offensive Player of the Week

Junior RB **Dy'Shawn Mobley** was named OVC Offensive Player of the Week following his performance in the win against Morehead State on Sept. 13. Mobley only tallied six carries against the Eagles, but amassed a hefty 123 yards on the ground (20.5 yards per carry).

### • Welcome to the Club!

WR **Joel Brown**, WR **Jeff Glover** and RB **Dy'Shawn Mobley** each scored their first touchdown wearing an ECU jersey in the 55-13 win over Morehead State on Sept. 13.

### • Stepping Up Against the FBS

For the first time since 1985, Eastern Kentucky was able to pull off a victory over an FBS opponent as the Colonels earned a 17-10 win over Miami (Ohio) on Sept. 6. Junior WR **Jeff Glover** provided the winning score with a 43-yard touchdown pass to fellow WR **Deno Montgomery** with 4:43 remaining.

**• Colonel News & Notes**

**• Breaking Into the National Top-25 Polls**  
Thanks to the 17-10 upset over Miami (Ohio), Eastern Kentucky earned a spot in the Sept. 8th FCS coaches poll at No. 25. This was the first time Eastern Kentucky landed a spot in an FCS top-25 poll since Sept. 9, 2013.

**• Absanon Earns National Accolades**  
Junior DB **Stanley Absanon** was named The Sports Network's national FCS Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 8 following his performance in the win at Miami (Ohio). He became the first ECU player to notch two interceptions in the same game in almost two years in the 17-10 victory. Absanon returned his first interception 55 yards for a touchdown to tie the game at 10 in the third quarter. He then sealed the game by making an interception at midfield with a minute remaining. Absanon totaled six tackles and three pass break-ups.

**• New Faces on Defense**  
There are plenty of new faces on ECU's defense this year. Only four projected starters were in the starting line-up in last year's opener against Robert Morris. Senior DB **Brandon Stanley** is the team's active leader in career tackles with 231 stops. Senior LB **Tyrelle Johnson** ranks second with 110 tackles.

**• On The Road Again ...**  
This was the eighth time in the past nine seasons that the Colonels have opened their schedule on the road. Eastern's 29-10 win at Robert Morris on Aug. 28 gave the squad a season opening victory on the road for the first time since 1992.

**• Offensive Outburst**  
The Colonels piled up 407 yards rushing in the win at Robert Morris on Aug. 28, marking the first time ECU has reached the 400-yard plateau since 2001 against Glenville State. Eastern Kentucky's 624 yards of total offense rank second most in seven years under head coach **Dean Hood** (666 yards vs. Murray State in 2012).

**• OVC Specialist of the Week**  
Senior PK **Andrew Lloyd** was named OVC Specialist of the Week on Aug. 31 after converting all three field goal attempts at Robert Morris (34, 25 and 25 yards). All seven of Lloyd's kick-offs were downed for touchbacks as well.

**• Quarterback Battle**  
Heading into the opener, senior **Jared McClain** and sophomore **Bennie Coney** were in competition for the starting quarterback spot. McClain ranked third in the OVC in to-

tal offense last year (162.4 ypg) while Coney is a transfer from Cincinnati.

**• Preseason National Rankings**  
The Colonels received votes in the preseason Sports Network and FCS Coaches poll, but did not make the top-25 cut. Three OVC teams were in the initial rankings – Jacksonville State (No. 6), Tennessee State (No. 15) and Eastern Illinois (No. 16).

**• OVC Predictions**  
Eastern Kentucky was picked fourth in the preseason OVC poll behind Jacksonville State, defending league champion Eastern Illinois and Tennessee State. The Colonels, winners of a record 21 OVC titles, tallied 82 points in the poll. Since **Dean Hood** took over as ECU's head coach in 2008, the Colonels have won two OVC championships and 38 league games. Both of those numbers rank second among the nine OVC football teams.

**• OVC Freshman of the Year**  
Sophomore WR **Devin Borders** earned the 2013 OVC Freshman of the Year award after finishing with team highs in receptions (34), receiving yards (509) and touchdown catches (six). Borders also led the nation with five blocked kicks one year ago.

**• Jude Equals ECU Single-Game Record**  
Sophomore RB **JJ Jude** tied an ECU single-game record last year by scoring four rushing touchdowns in the win over Morehead State on Sept. 21. Jude carried the ball 33 times for a then OVC season-high 195 yards in that game. See page five of game notes for complete record list. Jude was named OVC Newcomer of the Week and The Sports Network's FCS Co-Freshman of the Week for his efforts.

**• Veteran Offensive Line**  
All five projected starters on the offensive line entering 2014 started at least two games in the trenches last year. Senior C **Dustin Crane** and junior LT **Brett Eyckmans** started every game in 2013.

**• Lengel Granted Sixth Year of Eligibility**  
TE **Matt Lengel** was granted a sixth year of eligibility by the NCAA. Lengel has only played a handful of downs each the last two years due to suffering major injuries early in the season.

The expectations for the Eastern Kentucky University football team always seem to be high and head coach Dean Hood has delivered Ohio Valley Conference championships twice in his six years as head coach (2011, 2008).

The Eastern football program has produced eight All-Americans, one OVC Defensive Player of the Year, one OVC Freshman of the Year and 24 first team all-conference performers in Hood's six years on the EKU sidelines. This past fall, wide receiver Devin Borders became just the second Colonel to win the OVC Freshman of the Year accolades since the award was started in 2004.

Hood, 50, spent seven seasons working at Wake Forest University before taking over the EKU program in January 2008. Under Hood's direction, the Wake Forest defense was known for creating turnovers and scoring touchdowns. The Demon Deacons forced 186 turnovers from 2001-07, more than two per game. In 2007, Wake Forest led the Atlantic Coast Conference with 35 turnovers forced on its way to going 9-4 and capturing the Meineke Car Care Bowl.

From 1994-98, Hood spent five seasons as an assistant coach at Eastern Kentucky under College Football Hall of Fame coach Roy Kidd. He served all five years as the secondary coach and the last two seasons as the defensive coordinator. In Hood's first stint at EKU, the Colonels captured two Ohio Valley Conference titles and advanced to the NCAA Division I FCS playoffs three times.

At Wake Forest, Hood and the rest of the Demon Deacons broke every program record imaginable in 2006 and set many other milestones. WFU won the ACC title for the first time since 1970 by shattering the program record with 11 victories. The Demon Deacons earned a berth in a BCS bowl game, taking on Louisville in the FedEx Orange Bowl.

Much of the credit for Wake Forest's 2006 league championship fell to the defense. The Demon Deacons allowed just 15.4 ppg to rank second in the ACC and 21st nationally. Against the run, Wake yielded just 105.8 yards per game to rank 21st nationally, the third lowest total in Wake Forest history. Against the pass, the Demon Deacons recorded 22 interceptions, second most in the nation.

Hood's defenders earned All-ACC mention 14 times. That list includes four NFL draft picks – Calvin Pace, Montique Sharpe, Eric King and Josh Gattis.

Hood entered the collegiate coaching ranks as an assistant at Fairmont (W.Va.) State College, where he worked with the defensive backs during the 1987 and 1988 seasons. The 1988 team won the WVIAC championship and led the nation with 31 interceptions. Hood then spent the 1989 campaign at Colgate University.

From 1990-93, Hood coached at Glenville (W.Va.) State College, the last three of which he served as defensive coordinator and assistant head coach. In 1993, Glenville finished 10-3 and advanced to the NAIA Division I championship game. Also that year, Hood's defense led the nation in scoring defense (9.2 ppg), passing defense (118.0 ypg), and total defense (223.0 ypg).

Hood moved to Ohio University for two years (1999-2000) where he was in charge of the defensive backs. That unit recorded 17 interceptions in 1999, the most in more than a decade. The following year, Ohio ranked 20th nationally in scoring defense (18.9 points per game) as the Bobcat defense was one of only five units in Division I-A that did not allow more than 30 points in a game throughout the entire season.

This is Hood's first head coaching position and he is just the third EKU head football coach in the last 50 years.

Hood graduated from Ohio Wesleyan in 1986 with a degree in biology. He went on to earn a master's in physical education from West Virginia University in 1989.

Hood is married to the former Crystal Ramsey of Richmond, Ky. The couple has four children – two sons, Trey and Daven, and two daughters, Jada and Cordia.
