## Notes

### OVC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Aaron Patrick was chosen as the 2019 Ohio Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Year. Patrick was the 15th OVC Defensive Player of the Year selection from EKU (one player was chosen twice), and the first since Noah Spence in 2015.

### ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

Two Colonels – Graham Ashkettle and Samuel Hayworth – were chosen to the 2019 Academic All-America® Team, as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). The duo were the first EKU football players chosen as Academic All-Americans® since Danny Copeland in 1987. It is only the second time ever two football players from the same OVC team earned Academic All-America® recognition in the same year.

### ALL-AMERICA

Aaron Patrick was chosen to six postseason All-America teams. He was a first team selection by the Associated Press and Walter Camp. He earned second team honors from STATS and the AFCA. Patrick was a third team selection to the HERO Sports and Phil Steele FCS All-America Teams.

### HONORABLE MENTION FOR SOPHOMORE ALL-AMERICA

Redshirt sophomore offensive lineman Tucker Schroeder received honorable mention for the HERO Sports 2019 FCS Sophomore All-America Team.

### ALL-OVC HONORS

Seven Colonels earned all-conference recognition. Running back Daryl McCleskey Jr. and kicker Samuel Hayworth joined defensive lineman Aaron Patrick on the All-OVC first team. Running back Alonzo Booth, offensive guard Tucker Schroeder, offensive tackle Graham Ashkettle and defensive lineman Taquan Evans were second team All-OVC selections.

### NATIONAL DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR FINALIST

Redshirt senior defensive lineman Aaron Patrick was a finalist for the 2019 STATS Buck Buchanan Award, the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) national defensive player of the year award.

### 1,000-YARD RUSHER

Daryl McCleskey Jr. eclipsed the 1,000-yard rushing mark for the season at Southeast Missouri (Nov. 9). The senior was the first Colonel to run for 1,000 or more yards in a season since Dy'Shawn Mobley totaled 1,491 in 2014. McCleskey finished the season with an OVC-best 1,238 rushing yards. No other player in the conference had more than 895 yards.

### ACADEMIC WINNERS

Four players – Alonzo Booth, Graham Ashkettle, Samuel Hayworth and Steven Crowder – were chosen to the 2019 Academic All-District® Team, as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA).

### TOUGH AGAINST THE RUN

Eastern Kentucky limited opponents to 119 rushing yards per game in 2019, second-best in the OVC and 15th in the nation. The Colonels finished the season allowing just 80

yards on the ground to Jacksonville State (Nov. 23), the sixth time EKU allowed 100 rushing yards or less in a game. Over the final six games of the season, Eastern gave up 22 yards on the ground to Murray State (Oct. 19), 40 to Eastern Illinois (Oct. 26), 63 to Austin Peay (Nov. 2), two yards to Tennessee Tech (Nov. 16) and 80 to JSU.

### GETTING TO THE QB

EKU had 11 sacks in the final two games of the season, eight against Tennessee Tech (Nov. 16) and three at Jacksonville State (Nov. 23).

### PROTECTING THE QB

The Colonels struggled to protect the quarterback to start the season, allowing 21 sacks in the first six games. However, over the final six games Eastern gave up only three sacks.

### GROUND COVERAGE

Running backs Daryl McCleskey Jr. and Alonzo Booth ranked highly in national rushing stats. McCleskey was 10th in the nation with 1,238 rushing yards and 25th with an average of 5.79 yards per carry. Booth ranked 16th with 14 rushing touchdowns. As a team, EKU led the OVC and was 20th in the nation with 205.5 rushing yards per game.

### PHIL STEELE ALL-OVC

Ten Colonels earned spots on the Phil Steele 2019 All-Ohio Valley Conference Team. Running back Daryl McCleskey Jr. and kicker Samuel Hayworth joined defensive linemen Aaron Patrick and Taquan Evans on the first team. Running back Alonzo Booth, offensive lineman Graham Ashkettle and kick returner Quentin Pringle were second team selections. Offensive lineman Tucker Schroeder, linebacker Steven Crowder and long snapper Alex Shelton made the third team.

### MCCLESKEY RINGS UP 100 AGAIN

Daryl McCleskey Jr. eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark for the sixth time in 12 games when he ran for 110 yards on 24 carries at Jacksonville State (Nov. 23). The senior also rushed for 100 or more against Indiana State (103), Presbyterian (138), Tennessee State (202), Austin Peay (145) and Tennessee Tech (106).

### PATRICK REACHES 2ND ON SACKS LIST

Aaron Patrick had 10 sacks in 2019. He finished his career with 27.5 career sacks, second-most in EKU history. He finished 1.5 sacks away from tying Greg McKee's school record of 29.0 (1988-91). With two sacks in the season-finale at Jacksonville State (Nov. 23), Patrick passed two players with 27 -- Chad Bratzke (1990-93) and David Wilkins (1988-91).

### SACKS OF HIS OWN

Senior Taquan Evans totaled four sacks over the final two games of the season, raising his season total to eight sacks. That tied for the ninth most in one season in EKU history. He finished second in the OVC and 34th in the nation with 0.67 sacks per game.

### ACADEMIC ALL-STAR

Kicker Samuel Hayworth was one of only 53 players from across the nation chosen to the 22nd annual FCS Athletics Directors Association (FCS ADA) Academic All-Star Team.

### FRESHMAN LEADS OVC

True freshman running back Quentin Pringle led the OVC, and ranked eighth in the nation, in kick return average at 27.1 yards per return.

### 2,000 YARD CLUB

Daryl McCleskey Jr. became the 16th member of Eastern's 2,000-yard career rushing club against Tennessee State (Sept. 28). He came into the game needing 143 yards, but finished with a career-best 202. He capped his career with 2,707 rushing yards, 12th on EKU's all-time rushing list.

### 600 WINS AND COUNTING

Eastern Kentucky's 17-13 win at Austin Peay on Nov. 3, 2018 was the 600th victory in program history. The Colonels are now 609-391-38 in 106 seasons of football. No other OVC program has won more than 567 games (TSU). EKU was the 20th FCS program to win 600 or more games.

### EKU'S RECORD AT RKS

Eastern Kentucky's all-time record in games played at Roy Kidd Stadium is 227-60-1.

### NATIONAL SPECIAL TEAMS POW

Senior kicker Samuel Hayworth was chosen as the STATS FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week on Nov. 25. Hayworth scored a program record 17 kicking points in the Colonels' 29-23 victory at Jacksonville State (Nov. 23). He also tied Eastern's mark of five field goals in a game. After coming up one point short of tying the record earlier this season, Hayworth surpassed Jamie Lovett's record of 16 kicking points in a game, set against Youngstown State in 1983. Lovett also made five field goals in that game. Hayworth's five field goals came from distances of 24, 25, 28, 34 and 50 yards. He also kicked off seven times with three touchbacks. He tied the score with two second quarter field goals and his two in the fourth quarter proved to be the difference in the game. Long snapper Alex Shelton and holder Phillip Richards played an important role on each of the five field goals and the two extra-points.

### OVC SPECIALIST OF THE WEEK

Samuel Hayworth was the unanimous selection for OVC Specialist of the Week on Nov. 24, after his record breaking performance in EKU's win at Jacksonville State (Nov. 23).

### PUTTING THE BRAKES ON TTU

The Colonels held Tennessee Tech (Nov. 16) to 150 yards of offense, including just two rushing yards. TTU came into the game averaging 31 points and 398 yards of offense. Tech was held to a season-low 10 points, and its lone touchdown was set up by an EKU fumble that was returned to the five yard line. The Tennessee Tech passing attack was held more than 100 yards below its average. Only one TTU offensive drive crossed the EKU 30 yard line.

### TURNING YOU OVER

EKU forced five turnovers at Southeast Missouri (Nov. 9), making two interceptions and recovering three fumbles. Eastern leads the OVC in turnover margin (0.60). The Colonels are second in turnovers gained (20) and third in turnovers committed (14).

## Notes

### WE'RE A LITTLE DEFENSIVE

EKU held Eastern Illinois (Oct. 26) to 89 yards of total offense, 40 rushing yards and 49 passing. The Panthers had just eight first downs and averaged only 1.5 yards per offensive play. Of those 89 yards, 69 came on a late touchdown drive. Prior to that drive, EIU had accumulated just two first downs and 20 yards. It was the fewest yards allowed by an EKU defense in more than 16 years.

### SPECIALIST OF THE WEEK

After Eastern's 33-6 victory at Eastern Illinois (Oct. 26), redshirt senior kicker Samuel Hayworth was chosen as the OVC Specialist of the Week. In a driving rain, and on a completely saturated field, Hayworth hit four field goals and three extra-points to account for 15 of Eastern's 33 points.

### HAYWORTH ALMOST BREAKS RECORD

Samuel Hayworth hit four field goals and three extra-points to account for 15 points against Eastern Illinois (Oct. 26). He came up one point shy of tying Jamie Lovett's program record of 16 kicking points in a game, set against Youngstown State in 1983.

### WINNER, WINNER CHICKEN DINNER

With EKU up by seven, Murray State (Oct. 19) drove to the three yard line in the closing minute. On 2nd-and-goal with seven seconds remaining, Frank Sumpter intercepted a pass in the end zone to secure the victory.

### CO-DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After coming up with the game-saving interception at Murray State (Oct. 19), Frank Sumpter was chosen as the OVC Co-Defensive Player of the Week (Oct. 20).

### HALTING THE RACERS

The Colonels held Murray State (Oct. 19) to 22 rushing yards on 19 carries. It was the fewest yards allowed by an EKU team since giving up six yards against Austin Peay on Oct. 5, 2013.

### THREE INTERCEPTIONS

Eastern picked off three passes in its 34-27 win at Murray State (Oct. 19). Daulson Fitzpatrick, Aaron Patrick and Frank Sumpter each had an interception in the game.

### HERE, THERE, EVERYWHERE

Aaron Patrick had three tackles, one sack, one forced fumble and an interception at Murray State (Oct. 19). His third quarter pick was the first of his career.

### 300 YARDS PASSING

Redshirt freshman Parker McKinney threw for 313 yards against Tennessee-Martin (Oct. 5). It was the only 300-yard game by an Eastern QB during the 2019 season.

### HITTING 100 IN THREE STRAIGHT

Running back Daryl McCleskey rushed for 100 yards-plus in three straight games. He had 103 yards on 13 carries at Indiana State (Sept. 14), 138 yards on 12 carries at Presbyterian (Sept. 21) and a career-high 202 yards on 16 carries against Tennessee State (Sept. 28). He is the first Colonel with three straight 100-yard rushing games since Dy'Shawn Mobley had four straight in 2014.

### GETTING OFFENSIVE

Eastern totaled a season-best 525 yards of offense – 379 on the ground and 146 through the air – against Tennessee State (Sept. 28). It was the Colonels' first 500-yard offensive output since rolling up 564 against Morehead State in the 2018 season-opener.

### RUSHING FOR A FIRST DOWN, ALMOST

Eastern Kentucky averaged 9.0 yards per carry on its way to rolling up 379 rushing yards against Tennessee State (Sept. 28). It was the highest single game team rushing average in more than 16 years.

### TWO 100-YARD RUSHERS

Daryl McCleskey Jr. (202) and Alonzo Booth (115) both rushed for 100 or more yards against Tennessee State (Sept. 28). It was the first time since Nov. 1, 2014 EKU had two 100-yard rushers in the same game. On that day, Dy'Shawn Mobley and Jared McClain both finished with 139 yards at Tennessee State.

### TWO PICKS IN ONE GAME

Making his second career start, sophomore safety Joseph Sayles intercepted two passes at Presbyterian (Sept. 21). He returned the first for 20 yards and the second for 34.

### 100 RECEIVING YARDS

Newcomer Keyion Dixon had a season-high 101 yards on six receptions at Presbyterian (Sept. 21). He also caught his first touchdown pass as a Colonel.

### MCKINNEY COMES ON STRONG

Parker McKinney came on to play late in the first quarter at Presbyterian (Sept. 21) and engineered four of EKU's five scoring drives. He finished 14-for-20 for 155 yards and threw two passing touchdowns. He also scored a touchdown on the ground.

### MCCLESKEY FOR 100

Senior Daryl McCleskey Jr. rushed for 103 yards on 13 carries at Indiana State (Sept. 14). He averaged 7.9 yards per carry.

### DEFENSIVE BRIGHT SPOTS

In EKU's loss at Louisville, Josh Hayes intercepted a pass and Steven Crowder finished with 11 tackles, including two for a loss.

### BIG WIN

EKU beat Valparaiso, 53-7. The 46-point margin was the biggest win for the Colonels against a Division I team since beating Tennessee State, 49-0, on Nov. 19, 2005.

### GETTING DEFENSIVE

Eastern Kentucky held Valparaiso (Aug. 29) to 68 rushing yards and 184 yards of total offense.

### NEARLY A 1ST DOWN ON EACH RUN

The Colonels averaged 8.5 yards per carry in churning out 333 rushing yards against Valparaiso (Aug. 29). It was the best single game rushing average since registering 8.5 yards per carry twice during the 2007 season.

### BIG RUN

Alonzo Booth broke loose for an 86-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter of EKU's win over Valparaiso (Aug. 29). It was the longest run from scrimmage by a Colonel since Bobby Washington set the school record with a 99-yard run at Murray State in 2007.

### TOTING THE ROCK

Alonzo Booth racked up 128 yards on just seven carries and scored three touchdowns against Valparaiso (Aug. 29). He averaged 18.3 yards per carry.

### SCOOP AND SCORE

After Steven Crowder forced a fumble on a sack on Valparaiso's second play of the game, Corey Glass picked up the ball and took it 29 yards to the end zone.

### PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

Defensive end Aaron Patrick was chosen as a preseason All-American by *Phil Steele* (first team), *STATS* (second team) and *HERO Sports* (second team).

### PRESEASON TOP-25

The Colonels were back in familiar territory, listed among the top-25 teams in the nation to begin the season. EKU was ranked 24th in the *HERO Sports* Top 25 and 25th in the *Lindy's Sports* Preseason FCS Top 25.

### STATS PRESEASON POLL

Eastern sat just outside the top-25 in the Preseason *STATS* FCS Top 25. The Colonels were 30th. Three 2019 opponents were among the top-25 – Jacksonville State (No. 6), Indiana State (No. 16) and Southeast Missouri (No. 17).

### PICKED THIRD IN THE OVC

In a pair of preseason OVC polls, the Colonels were picked to place third in the league in 2019 in the OVC Media Poll and the OVC Coaches Poll.

### THREE PICKED ALL-OVC BY COACHES

Three Colonels – running back Daryl McCleskey Jr., defensive end Aaron Patrick and defensive back/linebacker Leodis Moore III – were chosen to the Preseason All-OVC Team by league coaches and communications directors.
