## **OUICK NOTES**

- In the first at bat of his collegiate career, freshman Tait Nunnally hit a 2-run home run over the wall in right field at No. 15 Auburn (Feb. 16).
- Junior newcomer Boone Shevey hit two home runs in game two of the series against Oakland (Feb. 24). He hit one in the seventh and then another when he came to bat in the ninth.
- Jack Waters has made two relief appearances. He hasn't allowed a run in three and two-thirds innings. The redshirt sophomore right-hander has four strikeouts and just one walk.
- The Colonels, down 5-3 in the ninth at No. 6 Vanderbilt, brought the go-ahead run to the plate.
- Rese Brown was huge out of the bullpen at No. 6 Vanderbilt (Feb. 21). He came on in the bottom of the first and surrendered just one run on two hits over four and one-third innings and retired the final nine batters he faced.
- The Colonels won 67 games over the last two seasons, the winningest two-year period for the program since 1989 and 1990.
- The two wins over No. 15 FGCU in 2023 were EKU's eighth and ninth victories against a top-30 team since the start of the 2016 season.
- Three Colonels were recognized as top MLB Draft prospects in the ASUN by D1Baseball.com. Luke Reed (RHP) was the 14th ranked prospect in the ASUN for the 2024 Draft. Chase Alderman (RHP) was the fourth ranked prospect for the 2025 Draft. Silas Shaffer (C) was the 12th ranked prospect in the conference for the 2025 draft.
- Bradley Stewart (LHP) was ranked second on the D1Baseball Impact Freshmen list for the ASUN.
- The Colonels have had players taken in each of the last two MLB Drafts and a total of nine players picked in the last nine drafts.
- EKU was fourth in the NCAA in 2023 with 57 double plays turned.
- The 2023 Colonels broke the program record for walks drawn in a season, finishing with 331. The previous mark of 300 was set during the 1981 season.
- EKU was second in the ASUN, and 22nd in the country, with 331 walks drawn last season.

#### STEWART TAKES THE MOUND

Freshman Bradley Stewart, who was drafted by the Tigers last summer made his collegiate debut at No. 15 Auburn (Feb. 18). He struck out two of the three batters he faced and did not allow a hit or a run. Stewart missed most of his junior and senior seasons at Cooper City High School due to an injury.

Three Colonels were recognized as top MLB Draft prospects in the ASUN Conference by D1Base-ball.com. Luke Reed, a right-handed pitcher, was the 14th ranked prospect in the ASUN for the 2024 Draft. Chase Alderman, a right-handed pitcher, was the fourth ranked prospect for the 2025 Draft. Silas Shaffer, a catcher, was the 12th ranked prospect in the conference for the 2025 draft.

#### **TOP FRESHMEN IN ASUN**

Bradley Stewart, a left-handed pitcher, was



ranked second on the D1Baseball Impact Freshmen list for the ASUN.

#### **COLONELS PICKED 7TH IN ASUN**

EKU was picked to place seventh in the 12-team Atlantic Sun Conference this season. The Colonels earned 77 points, 12 more than Central Arkansas and seven fewer than sixth place Austin Peay.

#### TWO PICKED IN 2023 MLB DRAFT

Catcher Will King was drafted by the Atlanta Braves and incoming left-handed pitcher Bradley Stewart was chosen by the Detroit Tigers in the 2023 MLB Draft. The Colonels have had players taken in each of the last two Major League Baseball Drafts and a total of nine players picked in the last nine drafts. Stewart, who signed with EKU in the spring, was the 500th overall pick and the sixth selection of the 17th round. King was the 609th pick overall and the 25th selection in the 20th round.

#### **LOTS OF WINS THE LAST 2 SEASONS**

The Colonels combined to win 67 games in 2022 (38) and 2023 (29). It's the winningest two-year period for the program since the 1989 (39) and 1990 (42) teams combined for 81 wins.

#### SIX ALL-AMERICANS IN SEVEN YEARS

EKU has produced six All-Americans in the past seven years — Ben Fisher (2017), Alex Holderbach (2018), Aaron Ochsenbein (2019), Daniel Harris IV (2020), A.J. Lewis (2020) and Will Brian (2022).

#### **GETTING TWO**

EKU was fourth in the NCAA last season with 57 double plays turned. The Colonels were third with 0.97 double plays per game.

#### **NEW WALKS RECORD**

The 2023 Colonels broke the program record for walks drawn in a season, finishing with 331. The previous mark of 300 was set during the 1981 season.

#### **BOMBS AWAY**

EKU was third in the ASUN and 53rd in the nation with 87 home runs.

#### **WALK RANKINGS**

EKU was second in the ASUN, and 22nd in the nation, with 331 walks drawn.

#### THROW 'EM OUT

In 2023, Hayden Duffield tied for first among all ASUN catchers (minimum 15 stolen bases attempted against), throwing out 41.2 percent of the runners who attempted to steal.

#### **CLANCY'S CLEAR & PRESENT DANGER**

In his final 14 trips to the mound in 2023, Joe Clancy was 5-0 with a 0.95 ERA, having allowed two runs in 19 innings. He held foes to a .115 average and struck out 23 during that time.

#### **SEVEN STRAIGHT WITH 10+**

EKU scored 10 or more runs in seven straight games from April 30 through May 9. It was the third longest streak in program history. The 2004 team did it nine straight games and the 1985 team scored 10 or more in eight consecutive games.

#### **FAULKNER FINISHES STRONG**

Reliever Gavin Faulkner made eight straight appearances without allowing a run to end the 2023 season. He struck out 11 and allowed six hits in eight and one-third innings in that time. For the season, Faulkner only allowed runs in one of his 12 appearances. He had a 1.64 ERA and 14 Ks in 11 innings.

#### THIRD STRAIGHT OUALITY START

Isaac Milburn made his third straight Friday night quality start on May 5 at Queens. He pitched a complete game (7 inning), 1-hit, shutout on 75 pitches. He struck out six, held Queens to a .045 batting average and allowed just four base runners — one hit, one walk, one hit batter and one batter who reached on an error. He retired the final seven batters.

#### WALK-OFF WIN VS. NO. 1

Miguel Larreal's walk-off single beat first place Lipscomb 11-10 (April 30). Larreal lifted a ball down the left field line that landed fair by just a few feet. Santiago Peralta scored from second for the win.

#### **WALKING AWAY WITH A SWEEP**

In a 3-game sweep of North Alabama, EKU drew 32 walks and posted a .452 on-base percentage.

#### **WALK THIS WAY**

Miguel Larreal drew four walks in EKU's 5-3 win at North Alabama (April 22). As a team, the Colonels walked 12 times, including seven in a 5-run seventh.

#### **BEATING NO. 15 FGCU**

EKU began its series against No. 15 FGCU with a 17-6 run-rule win in the opener. The Colonels scored four runs in the ninth inning of game two to complete a comeback from a 7-4 deficit and clinch the series.

# CHRIS PROTHRO Head Coach

Chris Prothro was chosen as Eastern Kentucky University's head coach on Sept. 30, 2020.

It didn't take

long for Prothro to turn the Colonels into champions. In 2022, EKU went 38-20 overall and claimed a share of the ASUN Conference West Division Championship with a 20-10 league mark. The 38 wins were the most in a season since the 1990 squad won 42. It was the program's first conference title since 2012. The Colonels were picked to finish eighth in the ASUN Preseason Poll, but tied for the best overall conference record in the league.

EKU followed the championship campaign with 29 more wins in 2023, making it the winningest two-year period for the program since 1989 and 1990.

Two players earned considerable national attention during the 2022 season. Kendal Ewell was a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes Award, given each year to the top amateur baseball player in the country. He also earned multiple national player of the week honors. Will Brian was chosen as an All-American by three organizations, was also a finalist for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award and was picked in the 10th round of the MLB Draft by the New York Yankees. Brian was ranked by D1Baseball.com as the No. 6 reliever in the nation and Ewell was rated as the 34th-best outfielder.

Ewell and Brian joined catcher Will King on the 2022 ASUN All-Conference Team. King also earned a spot on the ASUN All-Tournament team after leading the Colonels to the semifinals.

Accolades poured in after the 2023 season for the Colonels as well. Shortstop Logan Thomason, who helped the team finish fourth in the nation in double plays turned, was selected as the ASUN Defensive Player of the Year. He and King earned all-conference recognition. Chase Alderman was chosen to the ASUN All-Freshman Team. King was on the Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year Award watch list for the second straight season and was chosen to the ABCA Rawlings Midwest All-Region Team.

The pipeline to the pros continued as well. King was picked by the Atlanta Braves in the 2023 MLB Draft. In addition, incoming freshman left-handed pitcher Bradley Stewart, who signed with EKU in the spring, was drafted in the 17th round by the Detroit Tigers.

The drafting of an incoming player speaks to the success Prothro and his staff have fostered on the recruiting trail. EKU's 2023 recruiting class was recognized by Collegiate Baseball News and ranked higher than

such programs as South Florida, Wake Forest, Missouri, Nebraska, Kansas State, Middle Tennessee, Washington, South Alabama and Georgia Southern among others.

EKU won 17 more games in 2022 than the season before. Brian broke EKU's single season individual saves record. As a team, the Colonels set a new record for fielding percentage (97.5 percent) and total saves (19). The 2023 Colonels set a new program record for walks drawn in a season, surpassing a mark that had stood for 42 years.

The success in 2022 had EKU mentioned among the nation's best to start the 2023 season. The Colonels were ranked 46th in Collegiate Basebal's Fabulous 50 Division I Pre-Season Poll. It is the first time the program has received a pre-season ranking from the publication. EKU was the highest ranked ASUN team and was ranked higher than such programs as South Carolina (47), Alabama (49) and BYU (50). Others who did not crack the preseason top-50 include Washington, Arizona State, Notre Dame, Southern California, Coastal Carolina, Iowa, Illinois and Indiana.

In his first season, Prothro led the Colonels to victories over No. 15 Georgia Tech and No. 7 Louisville in 2021. EKU also got the tying run to second base in the ninth inning at No. 2 Vanderbilt before falling by two. Four players earned postseason honors, the pitching staff led the league in strikeouts and defensively the team set what was then a new program record with a 972 fielding percentage.

Prior to taking the head coaching position at EKU, Prothro helped South Alabama capture two conference championships, make two NCAA Regional appearances and compile a 152-104 record in five seasons as an assistant coach.

As the recruiting coordinator at South Alabama, Prothro led the efforts that resulted in the 2018 recruiting class being ranked 25th in the nation. The 2016, 2017, 2019 and 2020 classes also garnered recognition by national collegiate baseball publications.

Prothro joined the Jaguars staff in July of 2015. As the program's hitting instructor, USA ranked first or second in every major statistical category in the Sun Belt in 2017 as well as placing among the national leaders in runs scored per game, walks and home runs. He instructed two first team All-Sun Belt selections in three consecutive seasons, 2016-18. Prothro coached five players who were drafted over a three-year span, including the No. 10 overall pick in 2018.

With Prothro on the staff, South Alabama captured the 2016 Sun Belt Conference regular season title and the 2017 Sun Belt Tournament Championship. The Jaguars won two games in the Tallahassee Regional

in 2016 before falling to top-seeded Florida State. USA beat No. 2 seed Mississippi State in the first round of the Hattiesburg Regional in 2017 and finished that season ranked 26th nationally.

From the summer of 2007 to 2015, Prothro served in a variety of roles at Nicholls State University.
