## QUICK NOTES

- Jan Weisberg, who won more than 500 games and captivated the baseball world with a College World Series run as the head coach at Birmingham Southern, was chosen as the new head coach at ECU in May 2025.
- Redshirt freshman Dylan Littlefield has hit a home run in four straight games. In those four games, Littlefield hit .412 with 10 RBIs, five runs scored and one double. He struck out just one time in 17 at bats and had a 1.176 slugging percentage.
- Jacob Price turned in ECU's first quality start of the season. The redshirt junior right-hander pitched 6 2/3 innings against Dayton (Feb. 21), allowing three runs on seven hits. He did not walk a batter and struck out two.
- Dylan Littlefield, David Alvarez and Khaleel Pratt hit their first home runs of the season against Northern Kentucky.
- Jack Bell has made two appearances as the finisher for the Colonels. In 2 1/3 innings he has not allowed a hit, walk or run and has struck out three.
- Dylan Littlefield hit .417 with two runs and five RBIs in the first series of the season, at Alabama State.
- Newcomer Jacob Price pitched four innings and did not allow an earned run in his ECU de-but, against Alabama State (Feb. 14).
- Dylan Littlefield finished 3-for-5 with two runs and three RBIs in ECU's 14-7 series finale victory at Alabama State (Feb. 14).
- The Colonels return 18 players from last season and lost 28 players off last year's roster. Three of the nine starters (including DH) return — Julius Searce (LF), Jay Douglas (CF) and Silas Shaffer (DH).
- Griffin Howell and Jack Bell combined to pitch the final two innings of ECU's 14-7 win at Alabama State (Feb. 14) without allowing a hit or a run.
- Bradley Gagen, in his second season at ECU, started the season-opener at Alabama State (Feb. 13) and allowed just one run on two hits and struck out seven in four innings.

### NEW HEAD COACH

Jan Weisberg, who won more than 500 games and captivated the baseball world with a College World Series run as the head coach at Birmingham Southern, was chosen as the new head coach at EKU in May 2025.

Weisberg served as the head coach at NCAA Division II Valdosta State in 2025, leading his team to 30-plus wins for the 12th time in the last 16 years.

In 17 years as Birmingham Southern's head coach, Weisberg compiled a record of 544-209-1 (.722). He led the program to 14 conference titles, nine NCAA Regional appearances, three trips to the NCAA Super Regionals and two College World Series (2019, 2024) appearances. BSC was the fourth-winningest baseball team in Division III during the 2010s.

### MOST MAGICAL BASEBALL STORY OF THE 2020s

After Birmingham Southern College made the announcement in March of 2024 that it would shut down after 168 years of operation, Jan Weisberg's team made national headlines with a magical run to the NCAA Division III College World Series. BSC, the No. 7 seed, lost in the national semifinals.

### COACHING ASSIGNMENTS

### SERIES HISTORY

### ALWAYS BE CLOSING

Jack Bell, a senior who spent the last two seasons at NCAA Division II Mississippi College, has made two appearances as the finisher for the Colonels. In 2 1/3 innings he has not allowed a hit, walk or run and has struck out three. He earned his first save of the season against Northern Kentucky (Feb. 17).

### THREE'S ACROSS THE BOARD

Pedro Moreno finished with three hits, three runs and three RBIs in the win over Northern Kentucky (Feb. 17). He was 3-for-4 with two walks.

### STATISTICAL ODDITY

EKU allowed 11 runs against Northern Kentucky (Feb. 17), but only one was an earned team run. Cooper Pumphrey started and allowed one earned run. Anthony Scarpino allowed one earned run in his one inning of relief, but it was an unearned run for the team. Combined, Clay Cartledge (4) and Gavin Faulkner (5) allowed nine runs, but they were all unearned.

### HITTING EARLY

In 17 years as the Panthers' head coach, Weisberg compiled a record of 544-209-1 (.722). He led the program to 14 conference titles, nine NCAA Regional appearances, three trips to the NCAA Super Regionals and two College World Series (2019, 2024) appearances. BSC was the fourth-winningest baseball team in Division III during the 2010s.

"Throughout the process, I was looking for a head coach who had been successful at every level," said Vice President and Director of Athletics Kyle Moats. "I thought it was important to have someone who was respected throughout the baseball community. Jan's reputation as a coach, mentor, father and husband are undeniable. He is a coach who will not take short cuts, expects the best every day from his staff and players, and welcomes the challenging landscape of college athletics."

Weisberg was chosen as the Alabama Coach of the Year four times, he produced five Academic All-America selections, three NCAA Gold Glove winners, 15 All-America honorees, one National Pitcher and one National Player of the Year, and has coached four MLB Draft picks. In 19 seasons as a head coach, Weisberg has compiled a record of 595-253-1 for a winning percentage of .701.

"This is a very exciting opportunity for me and my family to join Eastern Kentucky University and the Colonels Athletics family," Weisberg said. "I want to thank President David McFaddin and Kyle Moats for this tremendous opportunity, and for the trust in me to guide the young men in the ECU baseball program."

Weisberg's ties to central Kentucky include two seasons as a player at the University of Kentucky (1991-92), 13 seasons on the Wildcats' coaching staff (1993-2005) and one year as the head coach at Transylvania University

(2006).

As a player at UK, Weisberg helped the Wildcats to what was then a school record 41 victories and an NCAA Regional berth in 1991. In 1992, he finished with the fifth-most RBIs in a single season in program history.

Weisberg spent the 1993 and 1994 seasons as a graduate assistant at Kentucky. He served as a full time assistant from 1994 through the 2005 season. In 1999 Weisberg added recruiting coordinator duties and engineered three top-25 rated recruiting classes. He also coordinated the team offense, instructed hitters, catchers and infielders, and coached third base.

As the head coach at Transylvania in 2006, Weisberg guided the Pioneers to a runner-up finish in the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference, the highest finish in program history up to that time. He also led Transy to its first-ever HCAC Tournament appearance. Seven of his players earned all-conference honors that year.

In 2025, Weisberg's Valdosta State squad finished the season 30-22 overall and 22-10 in the Gulf South Conference (GSC). The Blazers finished second in the league standings, missing a share of the conference title by just ½ game. Under Weisberg's guidance, Orlando Pena earned GSC Player of the Year and First Team All-GSC honors. He and teammate Ryan Brown were also a second team National Collegiate Baseball Writer's Association (NCBWA) All-South Region picks.

"Jan understands the value of relationships," Moats said. "In our discussions, we both emphasized the importance of getting our baseball alumni reengaged with our program. He is very well connected in central Kentucky and throughout the Commonwealth. Jan is well aware of our successful history and is anxious to get us back to those winning ways. I could not be happier and more excited for ECU to have Jan and Alyssa leading our baseball program."

Weisberg earned a bachelor's of arts degree in economics from Kentucky in 1993.

"You will get a lot of passion from me as we move forward to create sustained success as a program," said Weisberg. "EKU is a beautiful place and there is great tradition in this program. We will work tirelessly to create a high-expectation, high-achievement culture that will lead to great successes on and off the field that the ECU alumni, student-body, athletics department, and university can be proud of. I look forward to joining with our players and staff to help elevate the Colonel brand through a successful baseball program that aspires to greatness on and off the field."
