### THE MATCH

The Elon University men's soccer team begins postseason play for the Colonial Athletic Association Men's Soccer Championship Tournament as the fourth-seeded Phoenix hosts fifth-seeded William & Mary in a quarterfinal match at 7 p.m. at Rudd Field.

### SERIES HISTORY

The Phoenix and the Tribe will meet on the soccer pitch for the eighth time on Saturday in the series between the two programs. Elon trails William & Mary 2-4-1 all-time and had been winless versus the Tribe since 2013. The Phoenix snapped that streak with its 2-0 victory over William & Mary at Rudd Field on Oct. 12, earlier in the season with Elijah Agu providing both goals in the contest.

### UNCW RECAP

Elon concluded its regular-season on Tuesday, Nov. 1, with a scoreless draw against UNCW. The shutout was the Phoenix's league-leading eighth of the year and the 16th overall for keeper Matthew Jegier, moving him into sole possession of fourth-place on the program's all-time career list. UNCW, who needed a win or a draw in the match to qualify for the tournament, earned the

#### ABOUT ELON

The Phoenix closed the regular-season on a four-match winless streak with its last victory coming on Oct. 15, at Drexel. Since then, Elon has lost three straight versus Delaware, Duke and Hofstra before its draw against UNCW last Tuesday. The four-match winless streak is the longest for the program since Elon began the 2011 season at 0-3-1 in its first four games.

Elon's offense has cooled a bit during the four-match winless streak as the Phoenix has produced only three goals during the frame. Overall, the Phoenix has scored 25 goals on the season with Agu tying for the CAA-lead with 11 on the year which is also eighth in the country. Agu however has been held goal-less in the last three matches and only three other players – Jaiden Fortune, Austin Hill and Tuki Tayali – are having multi-goal seasons outside of Agu.

Defensively, Elon has allowed a CAA-low 14 goals on the year and ended the regular-season leading the league with eight shutouts. The Phoenix also has a league-best 0.88 goals against average and is 17th in the nation in shutout percentage at 0.50. Jegier has played all but nine minutes in goal this season for Elon and is leading or tied for the CAA-lead in GAA (0.82) and clean sheets (seven).

#### THE OPPONENT

The Tribe clinched its spot for the league championships last Saturday, Oct. 29, after a 1-0 victory over Drexel. William & Mary has won three straight and four of its last five since its 2-0 loss to Elon on Oct. 12, including a 4-0 victory versus Big Ten opponent Michigan. William & Mary heads into the tournament as one of the top scoring teams in the league as the Tribe has scored a CAA-best 36 goals. The Tribe also lead the league in total points (106), goals per match (2.00), shots (255) and assists (34). Ryder Bell paces the squad with 22 points on his team-high nine goals along with four assists. Overall, the Tribe has had 13 players contribute at least one point on the year. The Tribe has conceded 21 goals this season with its opponents averaging just under 10 shots per match (9.6). Opponents are shooting just over 45 percent of those attempts on frame. Phil Breno has been the main goalkeeper for the Tribe all season and has a GAA of 1.17 along with a .722 save percentage and six shutouts.

#### THE COACHES

**Elon:** Chris Little is in his third season as the head coach of the Phoenix after helping the Phoenix to a 14-6-1 overall ledger in his second year at the helm of the program. The 2015 NSCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year, Little has produced a 61-37-14 record in his six seasons as a head coach and currently has the highest winning percentage in program history.

**William & Mary:** Chris Morris is in his 25th season overall at William & Mary and the 12th as the program's head men's soccer coach (2004). He has guided the Tribe to the NCAA Tournament three times as head coach, including a berth in the Sweet Sixteen in 2010. Norris has posted winning seasons in six of the past nine seasons.

#### UP NEXT

If the Phoenix wins its quarterfinal matchup, it will travel to Hempstead, N.Y., to take on No. 1 seed and host Hofstra on Nov. 11, in the semifinal round at 7 p.m.

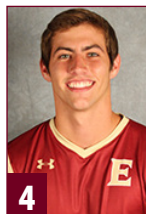

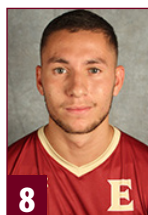

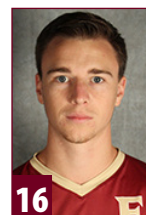

## Quick Hits

## TOURNEY TIME

Elon has made the CAA Tournament each season since entering the league in 2014. Despite qualifying for the tournament the last three years, the Phoenix is still searching for its first victory in the CAA Championships.

Elon has not been any lower than a No. 4 seed in the CAA Tournament in each of its two seasons and was the No. 2 seed a year ago. Saturday's match will be the second CAA Tournament match hosted by Elon as the Phoenix previously hosted Northeastern at Rudd Field in its inaugural year in the CAA in 2014.

## ACADEMICALLY SOUND

For the ninth straight season, Elon was awarded as a National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) Academic Team as announced on Oct 6. The Phoenix produced a team GPA of 3.0 or higher for the ninth year in a row and was one of 315 men's soccer teams that were honored by the NSCAA. Elon was also one of six teams from the Colonial Athletic Association that were recognized.

## JEGIER SELECTED ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

Matthew Jegier was named an Academic All-District selection by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) on Oct. 27. The redshirt sophomore keeper was selected to the first team for District 3 and has a chance to be named Academic All-American later this season.

## BACK FOR MORE

Despite the loss of 10 graduating seniors and only three returning starters, the Phoenix has a number of other key components coming back this season. Four-year players Taylor Adler and Will Smith both saw a great amount of time of the pitch with Adler starting three matches and Smith one in 2015. Sophomores Amir Berkane and Nick Adamczyk also started at least one game last season while junior Elijah Agu and sophomore Billy Beresford were one of nine players total that tallied a goal and/or an assist during the 2015 campaign.

## EXHIBITION SLATE

Elon went unbeaten during its 2016 exhibition schedule with a 2-0-1 record. The Phoenix earned a 1-1 draw versus No. 10 Georgetown in the first-ever meeting of any kind on the soccer pitch between the two programs. Elon went on to earn a 1-0 victory at Campbell before wrapping up the preseason slate with a 4-0 defeat of No. 22 Charlotte.

**ON THIS DAY IN ELON SOCCER****NOVEMBER 5, 1988**

**SALISBURY, N.C. --** Marcus Ford (pictured above) scored a pair of goals in the 86th and 89th minute to help Elon to a 2-1 victory over Catawba in the District 26 playoffs on Saturday, Nov. 5. Ford tallied the first score of the contest with a helper by Scott Graham before clinching the match with his second on an assist by Mike Wessels. The win improved Elon to 13-4-2 on the year while advancing to Area 7 playoffs.

**LOOKING BACK 2015**

The 2015 season was another exceptional year for the Elon University men's soccer program. The Phoenix achieved a number of team and individual accolades while continuing to establish itself as one of the elite programs in the nation. Elon jumped out to its best start in school history with a 7-0 record en route to a 14-6-1 record on the year. The maroon and gold also posted a 6-2 record in its second season in the CAA to clinch a share of the league's regular season championship and earning the No. 2 overall seed for the CAA Tournament. Elon would fall to Delaware via penalty kicks in the semifinals of the conference tournament, but earned its first-ever at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament, its fourth berth to the national tournament in the last five seasons. The Phoenix hosted Winthrop in the opening round and in front of 2,400 fans at Rudd Field - the most highly attended match in the opening round of the NCAAAs - Elon earned its first-ever victory in the national tournament with a 3-0 win and advanced to the second round for the second time in school history.

**NATIONAL ELITE**

Due to its great start and its win at seventh-ranked Wake Forest, Elon achieved its highest national ranking ever as the Phoenix soared as high as No. 8 in the National Soccer Coaches Association of America Top 25 poll on Sept. 22. The maroon and gold was also ranked in a number of the major soccer polls for six consecutive weeks - its longest streak in the national polls in program history. The Phoenix was also ranked highly in the NCAA RPI Report throughout the year and finished 2015 ranked No. 23 in the nation.

**CONFERENCE HONORS**

Elon ended up with eight players receiving 2015 All-CAA accolades with senior defender Nathan Diehl headlining the honorees by being named the league's Defensive Player of the Year. Diehl along with James Brace and Miguel Salazar were first team All-CAA selections while Eduardo Alvarez and Sam McBride were third team selections. Jaiden Fortune and Matthew Jegier received spots on the CAA All-Rookie team while keeper Christopher Shannon was the Phoenix's representative on the league's All-Academic team.

**#FLOODTHERUDD**

A critical part of the Phoenix's success in 2015 was its performance at the home confines of Rudd Field. Elon went 7-1 on its home pitch, its best home record by percentage points at the Division I level. The Phoenix also saw a great number of fans packing the fence during 2015 as Elon averaged a CAA-best 1,155 fans per match. That total was the Phoenix's highest attendance mark over the past decade. Elon concluded its home season with 2,419 fans flooding Rudd Field for the Phoenix's opening-round match versus Winthrop - the most highly attended match of the NCAA opening round.

**ELON IN THE PROS**

After the season, Miguel Salazar became the fourth Phoenix player to receive an invite to the MLS Player Combine and ended up signing a professional contract with expansion San Antonio FC of the USL under former Elon head coach Darren Powell (2005-2013). Fellow senior Sam McBride also joined San Antonio FC along with former Phoenix defender Austin Dunker '14. The Phoenix currently has five players playing soccer at the professional level with the San Antonio FC trio joining Daniel Lovitz '13 and Clint Irwin '11 of Toronto FC in the MLS. Since 2005, Elon has had 12 players drafted or reach the professional ranks of soccer.
