HEAD COACH MIKE KENNEDY



Winning baseball continues to be the tradition for Mike Kennedy and the Elon University Phoenix as the skipper begins his 21st season as head coach.

His previous 20 Elon teams have collected 17 winning records and 15 campaigns of 30 or more victories, all while consistently playing against many of the country's finest programs.

His 2006 squad set a school record with 45 victories while the 2008 team captured the program's first NCAA Division I league tournament title. Kennedy's program won four Southern Conference regular-season crowns as well as two league tournament titles.

With each victory tallied, Kennedy adds to his record for the most wins by an Elon baseball coach that he set in 2003. In his 20 seasons, Kennedy has guided the Phoenix to 654 victories. In the last 18 seasons, Elon has had 27 victories over opponents ranked in the top-25.

Prior to the start of the 2009 season, Kennedy was selected to serve as the pitching coach for USA Baseball's National Team (Collegiate) during the summer. With USA Baseball, Kennedy was reunited with his mentor Rick Jones, a former head coach at both Elon and Tulane. Under Kennedy's guidance, Team USA's pitching staff recorded a 2.16 ERA in the squad's 24 games that summer. In 212.2 innings, the staff surrendered 51 earned runs on just 118 hits. The pitchers also fanned 282 hitters and held opponents to a .164 batting average. Under Kennedy, Team USA threw the first-ever no-hitter against international competition. The squad captured the 2009 World Baseball Challenge title.

In the 18 seasons (1997, 2000-16) that Elon players have been eligible for postseason honors, Kennedy has coached 42 first-team all-conference honorees, 43 second-teamers, two third-team picks, 28 conference all-tournament selections, 13 all-region players, three all-region tournament picks, 25 all-state honorees, three league players of the year, two league pitchers of the year, two league freshmen of the year, three freshman All-Americans and two academic All-Americans. In his full tenure at Elon, 52 players have gone on to play pro baseball.

A native of Fayetteville, N.C., Kennedy was a two-time honorable mention All-American catcher for Elon from 1988-1990. He experienced 102 victories during his career, as Elon posted a .756 winning percentage his last two years. The career .311 hitter batted .321 with seven homers and 36 RBI during Elon's 1990 NAIA District 26 championship season. He also collected 15 doubles that year and was named first-team All-South Atlantic Conference, first-team all-district and honorable mention All-American. He earned all-conference, all-district, all-area and honorable mention All-American honors during the 1989 season, hitting .289 with 32 RBI as Elon finished 36-9. For his career, Kennedy appeared in 115 games, batting .311 with 26 doubles, 13 home runs and 78 RBI.

Kennedy signed with the Oakland Athletics organization as a ninth-round selection in the 1990 amateur draft, making stops in Scottsdale, Ariz., Medford, Ore. and Modesto, Calif.

In its 114 baseball seasons, Elon has gone 66-47 (with one unknown result) in season openers. Under Mike Kennedy, the maroon and gold has gone 13-8 in its first game of the season.

HOME OPENERS

Under skipper Mike Kennedy, Elon has posted a record of 15-6 in home openers following a 10-5 win over Longwood to open the 2017 campaign.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

Head coach Mike Kennedy announced prior to the 2017 season that five players will serve as team captains this year. Seniors **Jordan Barrett**, **Danny Crowe** and **Will Nance** will be joined by sophomore **Ryne Ogren** and red-shirt freshman **Cam Devanney** as the Phoenix captains in 2017.

NEARING (AND PASSING) 100

Two Phoenix players have passed the 100-hit mark for their Elon careers this season. Sophomore **Ryne Ogren** reached the 100-hit mark with a double in game one at William & Mary. He now has 120 hits. Senior **Kyle Jackson** notched his 100th hit in an Elon uniform against High Point and now has 111 hits. Jackson is in his second year with the team.

On the mound, senior **Jordan Barrett** (in his second season in the maroon and gold) picked up the 100th strikeout of his Elon career by striking out the first batter he faced in game two against James Madison. He's now at 135 career Ks. Senior **Nick Beaulac** (in his third year with the team) posted his 100th career strikeout against #20 Wake Forest. He now has 103 for his Elon career.

STRONG ARMED

Senior outfielder **Kyle Jackson** leads the Phoenix with five outfield assists in 2017. That gives the senior 10 in his two seasons in the maroon and gold.

POUNDING OUT THE HITS

In Elon's 8-1 win in the series finale at Towson on April 16, the Phoenix recorded a season-high 19 hits. It was the most for the program since a 23-hit outing against Penn State on Feb. 13, 2015.

LATE INNING STREAK COMES TO AN END

Prior to an April 14 loss to Towson in which the Tigers scored three ninth-inning runs to earn the win, Elon had won 50 consecutive games when leading after eight innings. The last such loss came on March 14, 2015 when East Carolina scored four runs in the ninth to defeat Elon by an 11-8 score.

CAA, NATIONAL RECOGNITION FOR BRNOVICH

Following a 15-strikeout performance in a win at William & Mary, freshman **Kyle Brnovich** was honored as the co-CAA Rookie of the Week and as one of Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week on April 10. It was the second straight week that Brnovich garnered league accolades.

15 KS

In a win over William & Mary, freshman **Kyle Brnovich** struck out 15 hitters in 8.1 innings of work. It marked the most Ks by an Elon pitcher since Steven Hensley fanned 16 against Davidson on March 30, 2007.

SCORELESS STREAK

Kyle Brnovich posted a stretch of 20.2 scoreless innings earlier this season. Brnovich gave up one run in the sixth inning of his March 19 start against VMI and did not allow another run until the start of the fifth inning of his April 9 start at William & Mary.

JACKSON, BRNOVICH HONORED

The Elon duo of outfielder **Kyle Jackson** and pitcher **Kyle Brnovich** nearly made it a clean sweep of the weekly CAA baseball awards on April 3. Jackson was selected as the CAA's player of the week, while Brnovich was named the co-pitcher of the week and rookie of the week. Jackson also was one of Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week.

Jackson led the Phoenix to a 4-0 week after batting .467 (7-for-15) with two doubles, four home runs, six runs scored and 14 RBI. He went deep twice and drove in a season-best five runs in Tuesday's win over High Point. On the week, Jackson slugged 1.400 and had a .579 on-base percentage. He also

NOTEWORTHY

stole one base and recorded two outfield assists. Brnovich threw a complete-game, two-hit shutout as Elon blanked James Madison, 3-0, on Sunday to complete a three-game series sweep. It was the first career complete game for the righty who carried a no-hitter into the seventh. Brnovich struck out six, his fifth straight game with at least six strikeouts.

KEEPING DOWN THE DUKES

In Elon's three-game conference sweep of James Madison, the Phoenix allowed just three runs. It marked the fewest runs allowed by an Elon team in a league series since surrendering just two runs to Presbyterian in 1992.

HOMER HAPPY

In Elon's 14-8 win over High Point on March 28, the Phoenix connected for five home runs. Elon got two homers apiece from Kyle Jackson and Cam Devanney and another from Shawn Blake. It was the most homers in a game for Elon since the maroon and gold also belted five in a 14-3 win at College of Charleston on April 23, 2010.

SATTERFIELD EARNS ROW ACCOLADES

Infielder Joe Satterfield was selected as the CAA Rookie of the Week on March 27 after helping the Phoenix get off to a 2-1 start in CAA play as he hit .438 (7-for-16) with two home runs, a double, eight runs scored and three RBIs in four games. He extended his hitting streak to seven-games, including four multi-hit outings. He scored at least one run in all four games and crossed the plate multiple times in three outings. Satterfield went 2-for-3 and scored twice from the leadoff spot in Sunday's conference victory over Northeastern, including a solo homer in the seventh inning that snapped a 0-0 tie.

LEAGUE OPENERS

In the 19 seasons in which Elon has been a member of a conference under head coach Mike Kennedy, the maroon and

gold has gone 14-5 in league openers. The Phoenix is 1-2 in CAA openers. Elon also went 10-1 in SoCon openers, 2-2 in Big South openers and 1-0 in South Atlantic openers under Kennedy.

WELHAF'S HOME SCORELESS STREAK SNAPPED

Junior Robbie Welhaf began the season by not allowing a run to score in his first 17.1 innings at Latham Park. Welhaf opened the season with a nine-inning, no-hit shutout of Longwood before not allowing a run over 8.0 innings in a victory over UMass. Georgia Southern scored the first runs at Latham Park off of Welhaf as the Eagles plated a pair of runs in with one out in the first inning.

HOME SHUTOUT STREAK SNAPPED

On Feb. 28, Elon suffered a 1-0 setback in 10 innings to Liberty at Latham Park. It was a notable feat as the Phoenix had not been shutout at home since a 9-0 loss to Towson on April 14, 2012. Elon had played 133 games at Latham Park in between the two shutouts.

CAA HONORS BARRETT

After striking out 16 hitters in 8.1 innings and going 1-0 on the week, Elon senior lefty Jordan Barrett was named the CAA Pitcher of the Week on Feb. 28. Barrett began his week by taking a no-hitter into the sixth inning in a 13-strikeout performance in a win over Radford. He then fanned three in 1.1 innings out of the bullpen at #12 Clemson.

PITCHER'S DUELS IN TIGER TOWN

In a three-game series at #12 Clemson, the Phoenix went toe-to-toe with the Tigers as two of the three games were low-scoring affairs. In the opener, the two were scoreless until the last of the 13th inning when Clemson pushed across a two-out run. The 1-0 game was the first for Elon since a 1-0 win over Georgia Southern on March 14, 2014. Sunday's finale was a 3-0 game that featured a combined 11 hits.

In the Friday game with the Tigers, Elon starter Ryan Conroy tossed 8.2 shutout innings, scattering six hits and not issuing a walk.

BARRETT MOWS 'EM DOWN

In 7.0 innings in a win over Radford, senior lefty Jordan Barrett struck out a career-best 13 hitters. At one point, Barrett fanned five consecutive hitters. The 13 Ks were the most by an Elon pitcher since Spencer Medick struck out 13 in 9.1 innings against UNCG on April 29, 2012.

WELHAF TOSSES NO-NO, EARNS NATIONAL HONOR

Junior righty Robbie Welhaf threw the first no-hitter of the 2017 NCAA baseball season, and the first for Elon at the Division I level, when he blanked Longwood 7-0 on Feb. 18. Welhaf walked one and hit one batter, but faced just one over the minimum and fanned a career-high eight hitters in what was just his third career start.

The performance earned Welhaf a spot on Collegiate Baseball's Players of the Week list, National Pitcher of the Week honors from the NCBWA and Perfect Game and CAA Pitcher of the Week.

QUICK FEET

After stealing just 37 bases over the course of the 2016 season, the Phoenix showed off some speed during its opening weekend against Longwood. The maroon and gold was successful on 10 of its 13 steal attempts against the Lancers.

On the year, Elon now has stolen 33 bases in 43 tries.

YOUNG OPENING DAY STARTER

For just the third time during Elon's NCAA Division I tenure, a sophomore made the opening day start. Ryan Conroy earned the nod against Longwood this year. The other two sophomores to make opening day starts were Jimmy Reyes (2009) and Scott Light (2000).

I CHOOSE ELON

Freshman right-handed pitcher **George Kirby** had a chance to begin a professional career out of high school after being a 32nd round selection of the New York Mets in the 2016 MLB Draft, but elected to come to Elon. Kirby is the fourth player since the 2010 draft to choose to join the Phoenix instead of turning pro. The others were pitcher David Whitehead (36th round in 2010), pitcher Tyler Manez (32nd round in 2012) and infielder Nick Zammarelli (28th round in 2013).

TOUGH SLATE

Elon's 2017 schedule features 14 games against teams that participated in NCAA Tournament action a year ago. Of the Phoenix's 14 non-conference opponents, seven were selected to finish in the top three of their league (or division). Among them were league (or division) preseason favorites in East Carolina (1st AAC), UNCG (1st SoCon), High Point (1st Big South) and North Carolina (1st ACC Coastal Division).

LONGEST GAMES

Of the 13 longest games in the 100-plus year history of Elon baseball, seven have been played since 2009. The longest game ever for the maroon and gold was a 20-inning affair in the 2011 Southern Conference Tournament in Charleston, S.C. Elon dropped that game 10-7 to Western Carolina.

LATHAM PARK



Walter C. Latham Park, Elon's baseball facility, was dedicated on Saturday, April 28, 2001, in honor of Walter C. Latham, an Elon alumnus. The dedication was followed by Elon's doubleheader against Radford University. The Phoenix swept the two games that day by scores of 10-2 and 7-6.

Latham Park underwent renovations in the summer of 2010 which replaced the playing surface with a FieldTurf infield and new natural sod in the outfield. A new drainage and irrigation system was also installed. Prior to the 2015 season, a padded outfield wall was added.

Latham (1909-2000) came to Elon in 1928 with a dream to accomplish what those before him had not. He wanted to play college ball and earn a college degree. Elon offered him that opportunity. He became the first-ever four-sport letterman at Elon and a member of the Elon Sports Hall of Fame. Latham excelled in the classroom as well. Twice he was forced to suspend his studies in order to help support his family in Bath, N.C. Each time he returned and, in 1934, he earned his degree. Latham was a coach and educator for nearly 50 years in North Carolina.

The playing field is known as Newsome Field and was dedicated on April 29, 1978 in honor of Wilburn E. "Webb" Newsome who played football and baseball and boxed at Elon. Newsome was inducted into the Elon Hall of Fame in 1975.

Featuring a FieldTurf infield surface and a natural grass outfield, state-of-the-art drainage, batting cages, a modernized press box and major league-style dugouts, Latham Park has quickly gained a reputation as being one of the finest small university baseball facilities in not only the CAA, but also the country. Measuring 325 feet down the left field line (which also features a 12-foot high wall), 385 feet to center field and 326 feet down the right field line, the spacious confines of Latham Park have played host to some of the most memorable games and individual performances in the history of Elon baseball.

In 2005, Latham Park was adorned with lights to allow the Phoenix to play night games on campus that the community could enjoy. The first game under the new lights was played on April 9, 2005 against eventual Southern Conference Tournament champion Furman. Elon won that game by a 21-10 score.
