LEFTOVERS FROM COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON

- The Phoenix opened the home portion of its CAA schedule with a 76-68 victory versus College of Charleston on Friday night, Jan. 11, in the first CAA women's game at Schar Center.
- Lexi Mercer tied her career-high with 19 points to lead the Phoenix while Emily Maupin added 18 for the maroon and gold.
- Mercer was 4-of-6 from downtown, setting a new career-high for made three-pointers in a game.
- The win was the 10th straight overall for the Phoenix against the Cougars while improving the maroon and gold to 2-1 in league play.

PHOENIX FASTBREAKS

- Elon is currently second in the CAA in scoring at 69.4 points per game. The Phoenix is also third overall in the league in field-goal percentage (.415).
- While Elon has allowed opponents to score 71.3

points per contest against them, the Phoenix is only allowing 65.5 points per game versus non power-five opponents. Versus those opponents, Elon is putting up 72.2 points per game.

- Elon currently has four active players averaging seven points or more with three of the four in their first or second year of collegiate basketball. Maupin leads the team with 12.6 points per game followed by Mercer, the lone active upperclassman for the Phoenix, at 11.8.

- Since entering the starting lineup for the first time this season versus Northeastern on Jan. 4, Saadia Munford is averaging 10.0 points per game while also averaging 4.7 boards per contest and 5.7 assists per game, which is currently tied for third in the CAA.

- Maupin leads the Phoenix in rebounding at 6.6 boards per contest and is eighth overall in the CAA. Ariel Colón is currently second at 5.4 boards per contest and is also third in the CAA in double-doubles with three this season.

- Elon has made the most of its chances at the free throw line this season, ranking 37th in the nation in free throws made at 215 and 41st in free throw attempts with 308.

SCOUTING UNCW (8-5, 1-1 CAA)

- UNCW sits at 8-5 on the season and is 1-1 in the CAA after its most recent game setback at William & Mary in which the Seahawks fell to the Tribe, 70-64, on Friday. Prior to that game, UNCW had won three straight and opened league play with a 71-49 win at home over College of Charleston on Jan. 4.

MORE HEADLINES

- The Seahawks are averaging 65.1 points per game and is allowing opponents to score 62.5 points per contest.

- UNCW is also one of the better teams in the league in playing the passing lanes, leading the CAA in steals per game a 9.9.

- Redshirt senior guard Shrita Parker leads the Seahawks at 18.8 points per game, which is third in the CAA. She also leads the team in assists with 47.

- Gigi Smith is second on the team at 13.8 points per game while Lacey Suggs is third at just under ten points per game at 9.2.

- Sophomore forward Paige Powell is the team's top rebounder at 6.5 boards per game.

- Karen Barefoot is in her second season at the helm of the UNCW women's basketball program. Barefoot was the head coach at Elon from 2008-11 and added another familiar Elon face to her coaching staff this season in assistant coach Ali Ford.

- Ford lettered for the Phoenix from 2009-13, finishing as the program's career leader in three-pointers (338) and second in scoring with 2,020 points.

HOME SWEET NEW HOME

-The 2018-19 season marks the first for Elon inside Schar Center. The university's new convocation center seats 5,100.

YOUTH IS SERVED

- The Phoenix features one of the youngest rosters in the nation. Elon's average age is 18.77.

- Elon had the sixth-youngest roster in the country in 2017-18, and it gets younger in 2018-19 with no seniors, two juniors, five sophomores, one redshirt freshman and five true freshmen. In all, 84.6 percent of Elon's roster is first- or second-year players.

- Last year, Elon's roster consisted of nine freshmen and sophomores (75 percent) to go with three seniors on the 12-person team.

WE'RE BEST AT HOME

-Going back to Feb. 3, 2017, Elon had won 18 consecutive home games. It was the longest home winning streak in Elon history, topping the 17-game streak under Kay Yow from Jan. 12, 1974 to March 6, 1975.

-Elon posted a perfect 13-0 season at home in 2017-18, the team's final season in Alumni Gym. It marked the second perfect home slate in program history, matching the 7-0 under Kay Yow back in 1974.

-Over the last two seasons, Elon is a combined 24-2 at home. In all, Elon is 76-20 at home under Charlotte Smith.

-Last time Elon lost at home came Jan. 20, 2017 to James Madison by the score of 76-70. Elon has not lost at home by double digits since Jan. 15, 2015, against James Madison (68-51).

THE NEWCOMERS

-Elon brought in five newcomers for 2018-19 in Brie Perpignan, Kayla Liles, Micaela Ryan, Duru Tasman and Tyja Traore.

-With the five players coming from Virginia, Maryland, Georgia, New York and Turkey, this marks the first time since the 2015 signing class the state of North Carolina is not represented. It's just the second signing class of eight for Smith that does not have a North Carolina representative.

LEFTOVERS FROM 2017-18

-Elon has back-to-back seasons of 20-plus wins for the first time as a Division I program, having won 27 games in 2016-17 and 25 in 2017-18. The two seasons are the second and third 20-win seasons in Elon's D-I history with the other coming in 2010-11.

-From Jan. 28 to March 10, 2018, Elon won a D-I program record 13 games in a row, topping the previous best of nine in a row during the 2016-17 season.

-On the national scene, Elon finished the season 11th in the country in field goal percentage defense, allowing opponents to just 35.1 percent from the floor. It also finished 27th in the nation with 42.0 rebounds per game.

-Elon visited the free throw line the 14th-most times in the country, shooting 705 free throws. That helped its +13.8 scoring margin rank No. 23 in the nation.

FAST FACTS ABOUT OUR HEAD COACH

-Charlotte Smith was inducted as one of 10 new members of the North Carolina Sports Hall of Fame on May 15, 2015.

-A standout at the University of North Carolina, Smith was a four-year starter under Sylvia Hatchell from 1991-95. She hit the game-winning three-pointer in the 1994 national championship game while also pulling down 23 rebounds.

-Was an All-American at UNC after the 1994-95 season.

-Her No. 23 jersey was retired by UNC on Feb. 24, 1996.

-Played two seasons in the American Basketball League and two seasons in Italy before playing eight seasons in the WNBA with the Charlotte Sting (1999-04), Washington Mystics (2005) and Indiana Fever (2006).

-In 2014, Smith competed in the 2014 Dancing with the Little Pink Stars, a fundraiser for local charity Little Pink Houses of Hope, as one of seven local celebrities. Smith and her partner, Anthony Amatucci, earned the even't Best Choreography award as the two were voted the best performance of the night by the judges.

-Back in 2002, Smith was in the full-length film "Juwanna Mann."

-Family basketball ties include former NC State greats David Thompson (uncle) and Dereck Whittenburg (cousin), New Orleans Pelicans' head coach Alvin Gentry (cousin) and Clemson senior guard Gabe DeVoe (nephew).

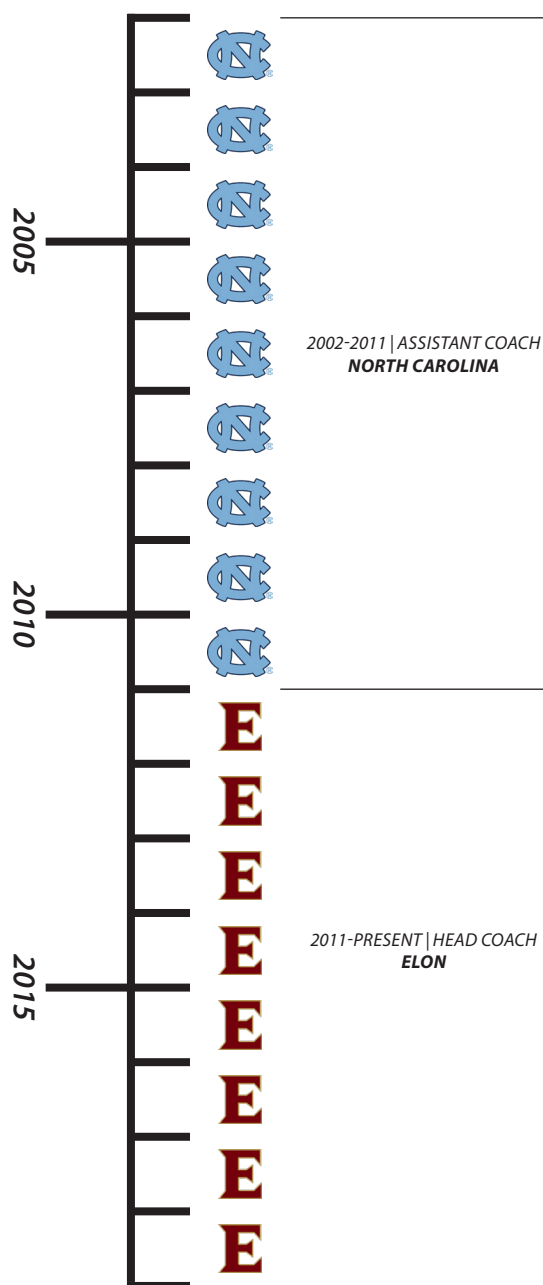
