CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LANI MASON, DELAWARE

Junior | Outside Hitter | Chester, Va./Matoaca

Mason led Delaware to a 2-0 week, defeating UNCW in back-to-back CAA matches. The junior outside hitter averaged 4.71 kills per set and 3.29 digs per set while swinging .350 throughout the weekend. On Saturday, Mason recorded her fifth double-double of the season, tallying a match-high 16 kills while adding 17 digs in a four-set victory for the Blue Hens. In the weekend finale, she led the match with 17 kills on a .448 hitting percentage and added six digs and a pair of service aces in a straight-set win. Mason leads the Blue Hens with 199 kills and ranks fourth in the CAA with 3.11 kills per set this season.



CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

MIËTTE VELDMAN, JAMES MADISON

Sophomore | Outside Hitter | Daleville, Va./Lord Botetourt

Veldman led James Madison to a split with Elon in a showdown of the top two teams in the CAA standings this weekend. The sophomore tallied 38 kills (4.75 per set) on a .341 hitting percentage while adding 20 digs (2.50 per set) in the weekend series. Veldman recorded a match-high 22 kills, swinging .367 with seven digs and two service aces in the Dukes' five-set victory over the Phoenix. Despite falling in the second matchup, Veldman recorded her fourth double-double of the season, tallying a team-high 16 kills and 13 digs to conclude the weekend. She ranks second in the CAA this season, averaging 3.76 kills per set, and she has recorded double-figure kills in six straight matches.

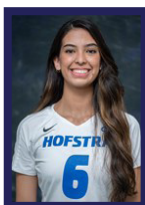


DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

SARAH PIERRE, HOFSTRA

Junior | Middle Blocker | Bloomfield, N.J./Bloomfield HS

Pierre was a force at the net in Hofstra's two straight-set victories over William & Mary, averaging 2.33 blocks per set over the weekend. The junior tallied 14 total blocks, including her third match this season with double-digit blocks. Pierre started the weekend with 11 blocks, becoming the first Hofstra player with three matches of 10+ blocks since 2014. The Junior leads the CAA in blocks per set and ranks ninth in the NCAA with 1.52 blocks per set this season.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

BEATRIZ ALVES, HOFSTRA

Freshman | Setter | São José dos Campos, Brazil/Colégio Campos Salles

It was another solid week for Alves as she facilitated the Pride offense in back-to-back sweeps over William & Mary. Alves totaled 75 assists (12.50 per set), 13 digs (2.17 per set), six kills (1.00 per set), four blocks (0.67 per set) and three service aces (0.50 per set) throughout the two matches. She helped Hofstra to a .325 attack percentage for the week, setting a new season-high for the Pride. Alves opened the weekend with 39 assists, seven digs, four kills, two service aces and two blocks in Saturday's victory. In the following contest, she totaled 33 assists, six digs, two kills, two blocks and a service ace. Alves has 30 or more assists in nine straight matches and has 13 such performances this season.

WEEK 7 IN REVIEW

▪ **Charleston** (11-8, 4-4 CAA) split a pair of five-set matches with Towson, dropping the first of the weekend before bouncing back in the second. Lexi Wierzicki paced the Cougars with 28 kills (2.80 per set). She had team-highs in both contests, recording 15 kills in their setback and 13 in the team's victory. Wierzicki has recorded 10 or more kills in nine of the last 10 matches and has completed the feat on 12 occasions this fall. Bailey Gabi lead Charleston over the weekend with 29 digs (2.90 per set). Gabi had a team-high 15 digs to go along with 11 kills on Saturday en route to her league-leading eighth double-double of the season. Charleston will remain at TD Arena for a pair of conference clashes this weekend. The Cougars are set to host Hofstra on Saturday and Sunday.

▪ **Delaware** (8-9, 3-5 CAA) defeated UNCW twice over the weekend and has won three straight CAA matches. The Blue Hens were paced by Lani Mason, who recorded 33 kills (4.71 per set) on a .350 hitting percentage. Mason tallied 23 digs (3.29 per set) and notched her fifth double-double (16K, 17DG) of the season in the opening match of the weekend. Ezgi Basaranlar recorded 66 assists (9.43 per set) and has had 30 or more assists in four consecutive matches. Katie Turner helped on the backline, recording 28 digs (4.00 per set) and tallying double-digits in both matches. Delaware will look to continue its winning streak as the Blue Hens travel to Boston for a CAA matchup with Northeastern this weekend.

▪ **Elon** (11-7, 6-2 CAA) fell to James Madison in a five-set battle on Saturday before defeating the Dukes in straight-sets on Sunday. In the opening match of the weekend, the Phoenix had three players reach double-digit kills, led by Sydney Love with 15. Leah Daniel added 13 kills while Kellyn Trowse tallied 12. In the finale, Daniel had a team-high 16 kills and Love added 10 to led the Phoenix attack. Love has reached double-figure kills in four straight matches, while Daniel has eclipse double-digits in 16 matches this fall. Haylie Clark continued her stretch of solid play from the setter position, tallying 86 assists (10.75 per set) over the weekend. Clark and Daniel lead the CAA in statistical categories as Clark paces the league in assists per set (9.58), and Daniel tops the conference in kills per set (4.12). Elon will remain at home and host UNCW for a pair of conference matches this weekend.

▪ **Hofstra** (11-8, 5-3 CAA) earned a pair of straight-set victories over William & Mary this past weekend. It marks the first CAA Series sweep for the Pride this fall. Ana Martinovic led the offensive attack, racking up 30 kills (5.00 per set) on a .364 hitting percentage. She led both matches in kills with 13 and 17, respectively. Martinovic had eclipsed double-figure kills in 13 matches this season, including seven of eight conference contests. Beatriz Alves continued her stellar freshman campaign. Alves totaled 75 assists (12.50) in her setter role, facilitating the Hofstra attack. Sarah Pierre made her presence felt at the net, recording 14 blocks (2.33 per set) over the weekend. Pierre leads the CAA in blocks per set (1.56), and her effort has helped Hofstra take over the conference lead in blocks per set (2.54) as a team. The Pride will travel to Charleston for a weekend matchup with the Cougars on Saturday and Sunday.

▪ **James Madison** (10-4, 4-2 CAA) split its weekend series with Elon. The Dukes defeated Elon in five sets before dropping a three-set match to the Phoenix. During the weekend, Miëtte Veldman led James Madison offensively. Veldman recorded a match-high 22 kills on a .367 hitting percentage along with seven digs and two service aces in the Dukes' victory. She followed the performance with a team-high 16 kills and 13 digs in the weekend finale. It was her fourth double-double of the season and marked the sixth consecutive match for Veldman with double-figure kills. Savannah Marshall led the Dukes in digs for both matches, recording 38 total (4.75 per set) to anchor the backline. James Madison returns to Harrisonburg and will welcome William & Mary for back-to-back matches on Saturday and Sunday.

▪ **UNCW** (2-15, 1-5 CAA) dropped a pair of home matches to Delaware over the weekend. Katie Lanz led UNCW with 14 kills on Saturday, and Sarah Blakely held team-high honors with nine on Sunday. Lanz has surpassed double-figure kills in nine matches this season. Quinn Manley finished the weekend with 30 digs over seven sets, including 24 in Saturday's match. It marked the fourth time this season Manley has had 20 or more digs, and she has reached double-digit digs 10 times this fall. The Seahawks will head on the road for a pair of matches against Elon this weekend.

▪ **Northeastern** (8-8, 4-2 CAA) is back in action this weekend after no contests last week. On the offensive end, Evelyn Gonzalez leads the team in kills per set (2.89), while Samantha Shupe paces the squad in assists per set (8.89). Defensively, Northeastern leads the CAA in digs per set (14.88), and Kayla Martin has a team-high 263 digs (4.17 per set). Marika Virthe leads the Huskies with 68 blocks (1.03 per set). Northeastern is second in the CAA standings (4-2) and will get back to conference play this weekend. The Huskies will host Delaware on Saturday and Sunday.

▪ **Towson** (17-3, 5-3 CAA) split a weekend series with Charleston, completing a reverse sweep on Saturday before falling in five sets on Sunday. Fay Bakodimou and Emily Jarome had solid weekends, recording double-digit kills in both matches for the Tigers. Jarome tallied 32 kills (3.20 per set), while Bakodimou finished with 31 (3.10 per set). Jarome had back-to-back double-doubles, leading the team with 17 kills and 14 digs in Towson's victory while tallying 13 kills and 14 digs on Sunday. Jarome has five double-doubles overall this season. Bakodimou chipped in 13 kills and three service aces to opened the weekend and had a team-high 18 kills along with four service aces to conclude the weekend. Bakodimou leads the CAA in service aces per set (0.60) and tops the NCAA with 42 service aces this season. Towson continues to lead the CAA in hitting percentage (.279) and opponent hitting percentage (.125) as well as kills (13.08) and assists (12.12) per set. Towson will enjoy a week away from the court before traveling to William & Mary on October 22 and 23.

▪ **William & Mary** (3-8, 0-6 CAA) fell in back-to-back matches against Hofstra. In the first match of the weekend, five student-athletes recorded seven or more kills for the Tribe. Maddie Meyers had a team-high 11 kills and was the only player in double-figures. In the finale, Julia Brown led the Tribe with 14 kills while Lauren Merrill added 13. Brown paced William & Mary throughout the weekend with 23 kills (3.83 per set). She ranks third in the CAA with 3.18 kills per set this season. Amy Schewm facilitated the Tribe offense well, tallying 71 assists (11.83 per set) between both matches. William & Mary will look to end its six-game skid as they visit James Madison for a pair of matches this weekend.

MILESTONE MONDAY

▪ Elon's Kellyn Trowse reached 500 career digs over the weekend. Trowse recorded 13 digs in two matches against James Madison to bring her career total to 500 digs.
▪ Hofstra's Ana Martinovic tallied her 100th career service ace this past weekend. Martinovic recorded one service ace to bring her season total to 22, and her career mark now sits at 100.
▪ James Madison's Sophia Davis eclipsed 500 career kills during the Dukes' weekend series. Davis tallied 22 kills against the Phoenix to bring her career total to 502 kills. The junior now has more than 500 kills and 250 blocks to her credit.

A CLASS OF HER OWN

▪ William & Mary's Julia Brown was among the top 30 volleyball student-athlete candidates selected for the 2021 Senior CLASS award. The honor highlights seniors that show exemplary excellence in four categories: community, classroom, character and competition. As a top candidate, Brown will be eligible for the finalist ballot that narrows the pool from 30 to 10 candidates for the award's final vote.
