OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK LEXI WIERZBICKI, CHARLESTON

Junior | Outside Hitter | Easley, S.C./Pickens HS

Wierzbicki led Charleston to a weekend sweep of Hofstra with 32 kills (4.57 per set) on a .394 hitting percentage. In a straight-set victory on Saturday, Wierzbicki recorded a teamhigh 13 kills on a blistering .545 hitting percentage while adding four digs and a pair of blocks. In the weekend finale, the junior outside hitter tallied a career-high 19 kills, hitting .318 for the match. She added five blocks and four digs to round out her performance. Wierzbicki paces the Cougars with 238 kills (2.83 per set) this season, and she has recorded double-digit kills in 11 of her previous 12 matches.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK ANNIE SMITH, JAMES MADISON

Freshman | Middle Blocker | Jupiter, Fla./The King's Academy

Smith had the best weekend of her young career, helping James Madison limit William & Mary to a combined -0.086 hitting percentage in their weekend series. The freshman middle blocker led the Dukes with 14 blocks (2.33 per set) in back-to-back straight-set victories. On Saturday, Smith recorded a career-best nine blocks to lead the match, as JMU held the Tribe to -0.094 hitting for the contest. She came back Sunday with five blocks and added five kills to help the Dukes earn the weekend sweep. Smith ranks second on the Dukes with 1.21 blocks per set this season and has a total of 41 blocks during her freshman campaign.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK SYDNEY LOVE, ELON

Freshman | Outside Hitter | Chesapeake, Va./Hickory

Love continued the great start to her collegiate career, helping Elon to a 2-0 weekend against UNCW. She tallied 12 kills (3.00 per set) without an error and hit a red-hot .600 over six sets. Love started the weekend with six kills, swinging .500 with a pair of blocks and one dig in a straight-set win for the Phoenix. She followed the performance hitting .750 and tallying six kills, two digs and a block as Elon defeated UNCW in three sets. On the season, Love ranks second on the Phoenix with 165 kills (2.54 per set), and she has surpassed double-figures on eight occasions this fall.

- Charleston (13-8, 6-4 CAA) defeated Hofstra in a pair of CAA contests to improve to 6-4 in conference play this fall. Lexi Wierzbicki paced the Cougars attack, recording 32 kills (4.57 per set) on a .394 hitting percentage. In match one, Wierzbicki posted a team-high 13 kills, swinging .545. Gabi Bailey chipped in 10 kills and three service aces as Charleston won in straight sets. On Sunday, Wierzbicki led the way again, tallying a career-high 19 kills, while adding five blocks and four digs. Anna Smith found double-figures, recording 10 kills to aid the four-set victory, and Bailey contributed three service aces for the second match in a row. The Cougars improved to 9-2 this season when Bailey records at least two service aces. She ranks third in the conference and leads the team with 34 this fall. Charleston heads on the road after four matches at TD Arena. The Cougars will face Delaware for a pair of conference matches this weekend.
- **Delaware** (9-10, 4-6 CAA) split its weekend series with Northeastern, defeating the Huskies in straight sets on Saturday before falling in three sets on Sunday. Lani Mason paced the Delaware attack, recording 29 kills (4.83 per set), while Savannah Seemans pitched in a solid weekend with 20 kills (3.33 per set) and 18 digs (3.00 per set). In the Blue Hen victory, Mason had a match-high 15 kills on a .407 hitting percentage along with seven digs. Seemans added nine kills and eight digs while swinging .318. In their setback, Mason led the match with 14 kills, adding five digs, while Seemans recorded her fourth double-double of the fall with 11 kills and 10 digs. Delaware will turn the page as the Blue Hens host Charleston on Saturday and Sunday.
- Elon (13-7, 8-2 CAA) improved to 8-2 in conference play with a pair of straight-set victories over UNCW. Over the weekend, the Phoenix hit .384 as a team while holding UNCW to a 0.011 team attacking percentage. On Saturday, five players recorded at least five kills, led by Leah Daniel with a match-high 10. Daniel paced the match on Sunday as well with 12 kills, giving her 22 kills (3.67 per set) on a .455 hitting percentage for the weekend. Sydney Love recorded six kills in each match (3.00 per set) while hitting .600 throughout the weekend's competition, providing a boost for the Phoenix. Elon ranks second in the CAA in hitting percentage (.252), kills per set (12.69) and assists per set (11.61) this season, while a pair of individuals lead the league in statistical categories. Daniel paces the conference in kills per set (4.09), and Haylie Clark sits atop the ranks in assists per set (9.67). Elon continues CAA play traveling to Northeastern for matches on Saturday and Sunday.
- Hofstra (11-10, 5-5 CAA) dropped a pair of CAA matchups on the same weekend for the first time this season. The Pride fell to Charleston in three sets on Saturday and battled for four sets on Sunday. Ana Martinovic contributed 19 kills (2.71 per set) and 24 digs (3.43 per set) over the weekend, while Beatriz Alves recorded 60 assists (8.57 per set) and 21 digs (3.00 per set). Martinovic led the Pride with 13 kills on Saturday, adding seven digs. Athina Dimitriadis paced Hofstra on Sunday with 10 kills, and Alves recorded her sixth double-double of the season with 32 assists and 13 digs. Hofstra will have the week off before looking to end October on a high note. The Pride will host UNCW for a pair of contests over Halloween weekend.
- James Madison (12-4, 6-2 CAA) earned a pair of straight-set victories over William & Mary. The Dukes' defense stymied the Tribe's attack, holding them to a -0.086 combined hitting percentage over the weekend. Miëtte Veldman recorded 23 kills (3.83 per set) on a .391 hitting percentage to led the attack, while Annie Smith tallied a team-high 14 blocks (2.33 per set) to anchor the defense. Sophia Davis contributed on both ends, recording 14 kills (2.33 per set) and 11 blocks (1.83 per set) while swinging .321. Thanks to the blocking numbers from Davis and Smith, James Madison moved atop the CAA ranks in blocks per set (2.64), while Davis ranks second in the league (1.31) individually. The Dukes hit the road, heading to UNCW for a pair of matches this weekend.

- UNCW (2-17, 1-7 CAA) fell in back-to-back three-set matches to Elon, which sits atop the CAA standings. It was a balanced attack for the Seahawks as six players had three or more kills on Saturday, and four did the same on Sunday. Jadyn Berry pitched a valiant effort defensively, recording 30 digs (5.00 per set) between both games. Berry tied a seasonhigh with 21 digs, which led the match, in Saturday's contest. The Seahawks will return to Wilmington as conference play continues. UNCW welcomes James Madison to Hanover Hall for matches on Saturday and Sunday.
- Northeastern (9-9, 5-3 CAA) split a pair of matches against Delaware, falling in three sets before bouncing back for a straight-set victory. Erica Staunton and Nailiah Jenkins led the way for the Huskies over the weekend. Staunton paced Northeastern with 20 kills (3.33 per set), while Jenkins added 17 kills (2.83 per set) and a team-high 10 blocks (1.67 per set). Staunton had a team-high 13 kills and added four blocks despite the setback on Saturday. Jenkins paced Northeastern with 10 kills on a .500 hitting percentage and seven blocks in the Huskies' victory. Northeastern will have a key matchup with Elon this weekend as the Huskies welcome the Phoenix to Boston for a pair of contests.
- Towson (17-3, 5-3 CAA) enjoyed a weekend off in the heart of its conference schedule. The Tigers lead the CAA in hitting percentage (.279) and opponent hitting percentage (.125), ranking 11th and fourth, respectively, in the NCAA in each category. Additionally, Towson leads the conference in kills per set (13.08) and assists per set (12.12). Fay Bakodimou leads a balanced Tigers' attack with 200 kills (2.86 per set). Bakodimou also ranks third in the NCAA with 42 service aces and leads the CAA in service aces per set (0.60). Lydia Wiers paces the conference in hitting percentage (.378) and ranks fifth in blocks per set (1.10) to lead Towson. Rachel Hess has a team-high 301 digs and is third in the conference with 4.12 digs per set. Towson will return to action this weekend, visiting William & Mary for matches Friday and Saturday.
- William & Mary (3-10, 0-8 CAA) dropped a pair of three-set matches to James Madison over the weekend. Julia Brown and Anne Louise Seekford both averaged north of 2.00 kills per set. Brown paced the Tribe in both matches, recording 10 kills in Saturday's contest, followed by seven on Sunday. With Saturday's performance, Brown has reached double-figure kills in nine matches this season. She ranks fourth in the conference with 3.14 kills per set. Seekford chipped in 13 kills throughout the weekend and ranked second on the team in both matches. William & Mary will return home to host Towson for a pair of matches this weekend.

MILESTONE MONDAY

• Erica Staunton of Northeastern eclipsed 500 career kills this past weekend. Staunton led the Huskies with 20 kills to bring her career total to 515. The junior has 106 kills to average 2.52 kills per set this fall.

HALF & HALF

- We have eclipsed the halfway point in the CAA volleyball schedule this fall. Only four weeks remain in conference play.
- Elon is off its best conference start in program history. The Phoenix sit at 8-2 atop the CAA standings. Elon has never finished a season better than fifth in the final CAA standings.
- Of the 20 conference series thus far, 11 teams have swept their respective series, and nine have resulted in splits.
- Towson holds the top marks in four, team statistical categories: hitting percentage (.279), opponent hitting percentage (.125), kills per set (13.08), and assists per set (12.12).
- Four CAA teams are ranked in the top 100 of the NCAA RPI: James Madison (51), Elon (82), Towson (88), Charleston (97).
- More than half of the league's teams (5) have cracked doubledigit win totals, while five have yet to surpass double-digits in
