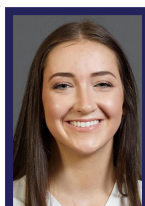


CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LANI MASON, DELAWARE

Junior | Outside Hitter | Chester, Va./Matoaca

Mason led Delaware to a pair of crucial wins over Charleston, averaging 5.13 kills and 2.88 digs per set while hitting .302 over the weekend. On Saturday, the junior outside hitter recorded a match-high 20 kills on a .349 hitting percentage. She added five digs and a service ace in a four-set victory for the Blue Hens. In the weekend finale, Mason posted her sixth double-double of the season, tallying a team-high 21 kills and 18 digs. She rounded out her performance with four blocks and a service ace in Delaware's second straight four-set victory. Mason has recorded double-digit kills in six consecutive matches and has eclipsed double-figures 14 times this fall. She ranks third in the CAA with 3.45 kills per set this season.



CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ERICA STAUNTON, NORTHEASTERN

Junior | Outside Hitter | Orland Park, Ill./Carl Sandburg

Staunton led Northeastern to a weekend sweep of Elon, helping vault the Huskies into a tie atop the conference standings. The junior outside hitter averaged 4.63 kills per set, without an error, while swinging an impressive .464 throughout the weekend. On Saturday Staunton had a career-high 21 kills, hitting .500 in the Huskies' five-set victory over the Phoenix. She added six digs and three blocks in the effort. On Sunday, Staunton tallied a match-high 16 kills on a .424 hitting percentage, adding four digs and three blocks in a straight-set victory to cap off the weekend. Staunton has reached double-figure kills in five of her previous six contests.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

RACHEL HESS, TOWSON

Junior | Libero | Breinigsville, Pa./Allentown Central Catholic

Hess was pivotal to Towson's defensive effort against William & Mary that led to back-to-back wins for the Tigers. The junior libero averaged 5.43 digs per set, helping to hold the Tribe to a combined .112 hitting percentage over the weekend. On Friday, Hess recorded a match-high 23 digs as the Tigers limited William & Mary to .059 hitting for the match. She followed the performance with a team-high 15 digs in the weekend finale. Hess ranks third in the CAA in digs per set (4.24) this season and has recorded double-digit digs in 18 matches this fall.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

JESSICA FRANNEA, NORTHEASTERN

Freshman | Setter | Cypress, Texas/Bridgeland

Franea had an impressive weekend, helping Northeastern to a weekend sweep of Elon. The freshman setter averaged 11.50 assists per set, facilitating the Huskie attack. She began the weekend with a career-high 53 assists in a five-set win while adding four service aces, seven digs and two blocks. Franea concluded the weekend with a 39-assist performance in a straight-set victory, contributing seven digs, two blocks and a service ace as well in the effort.

WEEK 9 IN REVIEW

■ **Charleston** (13-10, 6-6 CAA) dropped back-to-back four-set matches to Delaware. Lexi Wierzbicki and Gabi Bailey paced the Cougars throughout the weekend. Wierzbicki recorded 33 kills (4.13 per set) to lead Charleston, while Bailey had 26 kills (3.25 per set) and 25 digs (3.13 per set). Wierzbicki put up a team-high 10 kills in match one, followed by a career-high 23 kills on a .352 hitting percentage in the weekend finale. Bailey recorded eight kills and nine digs on Saturday and had a career day on Sunday with a career-high 18 kills and seven blocks while equaling a personal best with 16 digs. It marked Bailey's league-leading ninth double-double of the season. Charleston will have Halloween weekend off before returning to action the following weekend. The Cougars will travel to Northeastern when they return to play on November 6 and 7.

■ **Delaware** (11-10, 6-6 CAA) earned a pair of four-set victories over Charleston in a crucial matchup for positioning in the conference standings. Lani Mason and Savannah Seemans were the driving force behind the Blue Hens' big weekend. The duo contributed on both sides of the net as Mason recorded 41 kills (5.13 per set) and Seemans tallied 34 (4.25 per set). Defensively, Seemans had 24 digs (3.00 per set), and Mason recorded 23 (2.99 per set). Mason led the Blue Hens in kills in both matches, recording 20 on Saturday and 21 on Sunday, along with 18 digs for her sixth double-double of the season. Seemans recorded back-to-back double-doubles, contributing 14 kills and 11 digs in match one, followed by 20 kills and 13 digs in the weekend finale. The consecutive double-doubles give Seemans six on the fall as well. Delaware will continue conference play, traveling to Towson for matches on Friday and Sunday.

■ **Elon** (13-9, 8-4 CAA) fell in back-to-back conference matches against Northeastern. The Phoenix dropped a hard-fought, five-set battle on Saturday before falling in straight sets on Sunday. Kellyn Trowse posted double-doubles in both matches, recording her first two on the season. Trowse had 11 kills and 14 digs in match one and followed the performance with 10 kills and 10 digs in the weekend finale. Leah Daniel added 31 kills (3.86 per set), including 23 in the five-set tussle. Haylie Clark recorded 69 assists (8.63 per set), and she has recorded double-figure assists in every match this season. Elon will look to bounce back as the Phoenix travel to Williamsburg to take on William & Mary for a pair of conference matches this weekend.

■ **Hofstra** (11-10, 5-5 CAA) is back in action after a week off. The Pride will host UNCW for a pair of CAA matches this weekend. Hofstra ranks second in the CAA in blocks per set (2.48) and third in digs per set (14.37), thanks to some impressive individual efforts thus far. Sarah Pierre leads the conference in blocks per set (1.46), topping the Pride with 83 total blocks. Chiarra Cucco sits atop the conference averaging 4.71 digs per set, pacing Hofstra with 372 total digs this fall. Ana Martinovic leads the Pride with 228 kills (2.89 per set), while Beatriz Alves tops the team in assists per set (9.29). Alves also leads the team with 30 service aces (0.38 per set).

■ **James Madison** (13-5, 7-3 CAA) split a series with UNCW, dropping the first match in five sets before a straight-set victory to conclude the weekend. Miëtte Veldman led the Dukes with 37 kills (4.63 per set) on a .408 hitting percentage. She was closely followed by Sophia Davis, who recorded 34 kills (4.25 per set) on a .564 hitting percentage. Veldman added 21 digs (2.63 per set) and recorded her fifth double-double (24K, 12DG) in Saturday's contest. Savannah Marshall contributed 39 digs (4.86 per set) from her libero position to lead the Dukes over the weekend. James Madison will gear up for a pivotal conference matchup this weekend. The Dukes will host Northeastern on Saturday and Sunday in a matchup featuring two of the three teams tied for first place in the CAA standings.

■ **UNCW** (3-18, 2-8 CAA) split a pair of home CAA matches against James Madison. The Seahawks knocked off the Dukes in five in the opener on Saturday before the Dukes evened the series with a sweep on Sunday. The win over JMU snapped a modest four-match losing streak in UNCW's series with the Dukes. In their victory, the Seahawks landed four in double-digit kills for the second time this season, led by Brooke Hanshumaker and Kate Lanz with 14 kills apiece. Brianna Haggerty recorded her fourth double-double of the season on Saturday, recording 12 kills along with 18 digs. Sarah Blakely was the lone Seahawk in double-figures for both matches, tying a season-high with 10 kills on Saturday followed by 11 kills to lead the team on Sunday. UNCW will head on the road for Halloween weekend as the Seahawks travel to Hofstra for a pair of CAA matches this weekend.

■ **Northeastern** (11-9, 7-3 CAA) had a pair of important wins, defeating Elon in back-to-back matches. With the victories, the Huskies find themselves in a three-way tie atop the conference standings. Erica Staunton paced the Northeastern attack, recording 37 kills (4.63 per set) without committing an error and hitting an impressive .464 throughout the weekend. Nailah Jenkins added double-figure kills in both matches, totaling 20 (2.50 per set) for the weekend. Jessica Frannea had a terrific weekend holding down the setter position as the freshman recorded 92 assists (11.50 per set). Staunton and Frannea both set career-highs on Saturday as Staunton put up 23 kills and Frannea tallied 53 assists. In the weekend finale, Staunton had a match-high 16 kills while Frannea contributed 39 assists. The Huskies will head on the road for a crucial matchup this weekend. Northeastern faces James Madison on Saturday and Sunday with both teams tied for first place in the conference.

■ **Towson** (19-3, 7-3 CAA) earned a pair of wins over William & Mary, defeating the Tribe in straight-sets on Saturday after a four-set victory on Friday. The victories help the Tigers keep pace in the conference standings, where they find themselves in a tie for first place. Emily Jarome led the Towson attack, recording 24 kills (3.43 per set), with 12 coming in each match. Jarome was the lone Tiger to reach double-figures in both matches and led the team in kills on Sunday. Fay Bakodimou chipped in 22 kills (3.14 per set), leading the team with 14 on Saturday. Defensively, Rachel Hess had an impressive weekend, tallying 38 digs (5.43 per set). She recorded a match-high 23 digs on Saturday followed by a team-high 15 to conclude the weekend. At the net, Nikiya Mitchell played big, totaling 14 blocks (2.33 per set). Mitchell set a career-high with 11 blocks in the Tigers' victory in match one. Towson will host Delaware for pair of matches this weekend. The Tigers and Blue Hens will square off on Friday before a day off and reconvene on Sunday.

■ **William & Mary** (3-12, 0-10 CAA) fell in back-to-back contests against Towson. It was a four-set defeat for the Tribe on Friday, followed by a setback in three sets on Saturday. Julia Brown led William & Mary with 23 kills (3.29 per set) and nine blocks (1.29 per set). Brown recorded 14 kills and hit .542 with four blocks in the series finale despite the setback. Ana Porter led the team with 28 digs (4.00 per set), recording double-figures in both contests. Porter has reached double-digit dig totals in 12 matches this fall. The Tribe will stay at home to host Elon for matches on Saturday and Sunday.

MILESTONE MONDAY

■ Caroline Dozier of James Madison surpassed 1,000 career assists this past weekend. The junior recorded 83 assists, bringing her career total to 1,045. She leads the Dukes with 605 assists this fall and ranks third in the conference averaging 9.45 assists per set.

■ Lani Mason of Delaware eclipsed 500 career kills in her action this weekend. The junior led the Blue Hens with 41 kills, increasing her career total to 530. She has a team-high 269 kills this season, ranking third in the CAA with 3.45 kills per set.
