OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

HAYLIE CLARK, ELON

Senior | Setter | Saint Cloud, Fla./Harmony

Clark facilitated the Phoenix attack as Elon split its weekend series with Towson. The senior setter tallied 81 assists (10.13 per set) along with eight kills (1.00 per set) on a .438 hitting percentage and four service aces against the Tigers. Clark recorded 37 assists, three service aces, three blocks and eight digs to help Elon snap Towson's 24-game home winning streak on Saturday. In Sunday's finale, she totaled 44 assists, eight kills and six digs despite the Phoenix falling in the match. Clark leads the CAA with 9.41 assists per set this season, and she surpassed 1,500 career assists with her performance over the weekend.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

QUINN MANLEY, UNCW

Freshman | Libero | Lexington, S.C./River Bluff

Manley was stout on the backline for the Seahawks, helping hold Northeastern to a .148 team hitting percentage en route to a weekend split. The freshman libero averaged 5.22 digs per set, racking up 47 total digs over the two matches. Manley tied a season-best 20 digs in a four-set victory on Saturday before tallying a career-high 27 digs in the Seahawks' setback Friday. Manley has recorded double-digit digs in seven consecutive matches and has eclipsed double-figures in nine contests this season.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

ANNA SMITH, CHARLESTON

Freshman | Outside Hitter | Mendon, Mich./Mendon HS

Smith averaged 4.00 kills per set and hit .317 while leading the Cougars to a weekend sweep of William & Mary. The freshman outside hitter opened the weekend with a match-high nine kills, along with four digs and two blocks in a straight-sets victory over the Tribe. In the weekend finale, Smith exploded for a match-high 19 kills in just her fourth start of the season. She also added three service aces and two blocks while hitting .375 in the contest. Smith has recorded nine or more kills in the previous four matches, including double-figures in three of the past four.

WEEK 6 IN REVIEW

▪ **Charleston** (10-7, 3-3 CAA) defeated William & Mary in a pair of conference matches over the weekend. The Cougars bested the Tribe in straight sets on Saturday before a four-set victory on Sunday. Charleston's sweep on Saturday marked the Cougars' first three-set victory this season. The Cougars posted a .282 team hitting percentage while holding William & Mary to just .156 swinging. Freshman Anna Smith led the charge offensively, averaging 4.00 kills per set on a .317 hitting percentage. She had a season-high 19 kills in the finale on Sunday. Lexi Wierzbicki also had a strong weekend attacking. Wierzbicki recorded 24 kills (3.57 per set), swinging at a .327 clip. Charleston returns home after four matches away from TD Arena. The Cougars host Towson for two matches this weekend.

▪ **Delaware** (6-9, 1-5 CAA) earned its first CAA win of the season and snapped an eight-game skid defeating Hofstra in straight sets on Sunday. The victory came after a four-set defeat to the Pride on Saturday. Lauryn Richardson tallied a team-high 23 kills (3.29 per set) on a blistering .475 hitting percentage. She recorded double-figure kills in back-to-back matches, including a match-high 13 in the Blue Hens' victory. Ezgi Basaranlar had a solid all-around effort and facilitated the offense well, averaging 10.43 assists per set. Basaranlar added eight kills, four service aces, 12 digs, and seven blocks from her setter position. Delaware will head on the road, visiting UNCW for matches on Saturday and Sunday.

▪ **Elon** (10-6, 5-1 CAA) split a pair of four-set matches with Towson over the weekend. The Phoenix extended its best conference start in program history to 5-0 with a win in the opening match the weekend but picked up its first conference loss on Sunday. Elon's win Saturday ended Towson's 24-match home winning streak at SECU Arena. Haylie Clark captained the offense, recording 81 assists (10.13 per set). Clark added 14 digs, eight kills and four service aces to round out her performance. She leads the CAA, averaging 9.41 assists per set this season. Leah Daniel and Sydney Love were the major beneficiaries of Clark's passing. Both recorded double-digit kills in back-to-back matches. Daniel tallied 30 kills (3.75 per set), and Love registered 22 (2.75 per set). Elon will have another challenge this weekend as the Phoenix host James Madison for a pair of matches between the top two teams in the CAA.

▪ **Hofstra** (9-8, 3-3 CAA) continued the trend of splitting its CAA series by going 1-1 with Delaware over the weekend. The Pride defeated Delaware in four sets on Saturday but fell to the Blue Hens in straight sets on Sunday. It marks the third consecutive series split to begin their CAA slate, and they are the only team to split all of their conference series to begin the fall. Beatriz Alves recorded 69 assists (9.86 per set) for the Pride and has tallied 30 or more assists in seven straight matches. Florencia Wolkowyski paced Hofstra in kills over the weekend, tallying 19 (2.71 per set). Wolkowyski has seven games with 10 or more kills thus far in her freshman campaign. Chiara Cucco extended her double-figure dig streak to all 17 matches this fall after 13 in each contest this weekend. Hofstra will return to Hempstead to play host to William & Mary on Saturday and Sunday.

▪ **James Madison** (9-3, 3-1 CAA) had a brief break in its schedule and will return to play this week. The Dukes sit second in the CAA rankings after a 3-1 start to conference play. James Madison ranks second in the conference in opponent hitting percentage (.176) and blocks per set (2.49). Sophia Davis is largely responsible for the Dukes' blocking effort, leading the conference with 1.36 blocks per set. Savannah Marshall anchors the backline, averaging a team-high 3.62 digs per set. Miëtte Veldman leads the James Madison attack, ranking second in the CAA with 3.52 kills per set. Caroline Dozier facilitates the Dukes' offense, leading the team in assists (390) and assists per set. She ranks third in the conference with 9.29 assists per set. James Madison returns to action, hosting Elon for a pair of important CAA matches this weekend.

▪ **UNCW** (2-13, 1-3 CAA) went 1-1 on the weekend after splitting a home series with visiting Northeastern. UNCW earned a 3-1 win in the opener that snapped an 11-match losing streak as well as a brief three-match skid to the Huskies. Brianna Haggerty posted a pair of double-doubles on the weekend, giving her four for the season. Haggerty led the Seahawks with 26 kills (2.89 per set), including a match-high 14 in UNCW's victory. Freshman libero Quinn Manley continued her stellar play, totaling 47 digs on the weekend, including a career-high 27 in Sunday's five-set loss. Graduate transfer Sarah Blakely made her UNCW debut and posted 10 kills on Sunday. UNCW will remain in Wilmington and host Delaware for matches Saturday and Sunday.

▪ **Northeastern** (8-8, 4-2 CAA) split its weekend matches with UNCW, losing in four sets on Saturday before edging the Seahawks in five sets Sunday. Erica Staunton led the Huskies with double-figure kills in back-to-back matches. Staunton recorded 11 kills on Saturday before a season-high 17 kills in the Northeastern victory. Nailah Jenkins added 20 kills and six service aces for the Huskies over the weekend. Fourteen of Jenkins kills came in the weekend finale, helping Northeastern split the weekend's contests. Freshman Sahitya Krishnamurthy made an impact with 29 digs (4.14 per set), including a season-best 26 on Sunday. Northeastern will enjoy a week off before returning to action on October 16 and 17 against Delaware.

▪ **Towson** (16-2, 4-2 CAA) split a weekend series with Elon, dropping the first match on Saturday and bouncing back with a win Sunday. Irbe Lazda had a team-high 21 kills (2.62 per set) and notched double-figures for the first time in her career with 13 kills in Towson's victory. Lydia Wiers had 19 kills (2.38 per set), including a team-high 14 in the weekend finale. Wiers ranks first in the CAA with a .384 hitting percentage this fall. As a team, Towson leads the conference in hitting percentage (.293), opponent hitting percentage (.123), kills per set (13.38), assists per set (12.46) and blocks per set (2.55). Towson travels to Charleston for a rematch of the spring's CAA Tournament semifinals. The Tigers will square off with the Cougars on Saturday and Sunday.

▪ **William & Mary** (3-6, 0-4 CAA) dropped a pair of matches to Charleston, first falling in straight sets on Saturday before a four-set defeat Sunday. The Tribe utilized a balanced offensive attack. Four student-athletes recorded 10 or more kills over the weekend. Julia Brown led the way with 18 kills (2.57 per set) and paced William & Mary in both matches. Right behind her was Maddie Meyers, who tallied 17 kills (2.43 per set). Brown ranks third in the CAA in kills per set (3.06) and hitting percentage (.353), while Meyers has eight or more kills in all five matches she's appeared in this fall. William & Mary will look to get back on track as the Tribe visits Hofstra for a pair of matches this weekend.

FLIP A COIN

- There have been 12 CAA conference series so far this fall. Of those 12, six have resulted in splits, while six have been sweeps.
- Eight of nine CAA teams have split at least one of their conference series.
- Hofstra is the only team to split its first three conference series.
- Elon has swept two of its first three CAA opponents and is the only team to sweep multiple series this fall.

MILESTONE MONDAY

- Elon's Haylie Clark eclipsed 1,500 career assists over the weekend. The senior from Saint Cloud, Fla., recorded 81 assists in two matches against Towson to bring her career total to 1,519. Clark has 527 assists this season and leads the CAA with a mark of 9.41 assists per set.
