OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LANI MASON, DELAWARE

Junior | Outside Hitter | Chester, Va./Matoaca

Mason dominated as the Blue Hens defeated William & Mary in a pair of straight-set matches to conclude the regular season. The junior outside hitter averaged 4.67 kills per set on a .478 hitting percentage along with 1.17 service aces per set and 3.33 digs per set over the weekend. In match one, Mason finished with a match-high 19 kills and 11 digs to record her eighth double-double this season. She hit .452 for the match and added a pair of service aces in the effort. In the weekend finale, Mason contributed nine kills on a season-high .533 hitting percentage while recording nine digs and five service aces.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

RACHEL HESS, TOWSON

Junior | Libero | Breiningsville, Pa./Allentown Central Catholic

Hess spearheaded the defensive effort that limited Northeastern to a combined .118 hitting percentage in a pair of wins, securing Towson the CAA regular season title. The junior libero racked up 35 digs (5.00 per set) and posted a .938 reception percentage throughout the weekend. In Sunday's top-seed clinching sweep, Hess finished with a match-high 23 digs, averaging 7.67 per set. The performance came after pacing Towson with 14 digs and adding six assists on Saturday.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

BEATRIZ ALVES, HOFSTRA

Freshman | Setter | São José dos Campos, Brazil/Colégio Campos Salles

Alves concluded her first regular season with a strong effort in a weekend split with James Madison. The freshman setter racked up 81 assists (13.50 per set) and 14 digs (2.33 per set) in the weekend's competition. In Sunday's regular season finale, Alves tallied 42 assists, 10 digs and two blocks as the Pride won in straight sets. It marked her seventh double-double this season. She also contributed 39 assists, four digs and two kills despite a setback in the first match of the weekend.

WEEK 12 IN REVIEW

■ **Charleston** (16-11, 9-7 CAA) ended the regular season with back-to-back wins over UNCW. In the first match, the Cougars fell behind two sets to one before coming back to win in five. On Sunday, Charleston defeated the Seahawks in straight sets to conclude the weekend. Gabi Bailey led Charleston, recording back-to-back double-doubles. In Saturday's match, Bailey recorded 13 kills and 13 digs, followed by a match-high 11 kills with 10 digs in Sunday's finale. She leads the CAA with 11 double-doubles this season. Lexi Wierzbicki provided the second of the one-two punch. Wierzbicki totaled 24 kills (3.00 per set), and recorded double-figure kills in both contests to help the Cougars. Charleston is seeded third in the CAA tournament and faces sixth-seeded Hofstra on Thursday.

■ **Delaware** (14-12, 8-8 CAA) earned a pair of straight-set victories over William & Mary to finish the regular season. Lani Mason paced the Blue Hens, recording 28 kills (4.67 per set) on a .478 hitting percentage, with 20 digs (3.33 per set) and seven service aces (1.17 per set). On Saturday, Mason tallied match-highs with 19 kills and 11 digs while hitting .452. It marked her eighth double-double of the season. In Sunday's contest, Mason tallied nine kills, hitting .533 with five service aces and nine digs. Savannah Seemans added seven kills on Saturday and nine Sunday to rank second on Delaware with 16 kills (2.67 per set) throughout the week. The fourth-seeded Blue Hens will take on fifth-seeded Northeastern on Thursday in the CAA tournament.

■ **Elon** (16-10, 11-5 CAA) enjoyed a week off prior to the CAA tournament. The Phoenix won its final two regular-season matches of the year. Leah Daniel paces the Elon attack with 369 kills, averaging 4.01 kills per set. Haylie Clark facilitates the offense from her setter position, averaging 9.43 assists per set. Sydney Love has been impressive in her first collegiate season, ranking second on Elon in kills (217) and kills per set (2.49). Defensively, Elon is led by Jordan Gower and Jenn Krzeminski. Gower paces the team with 4.02 digs per set, while Krzeminski leads the Phoenix with 110 blocks (1.21 per set). After a program-best 11-5 finish in CAA play, Elon is seeded second in the CAA tournament and awaits the winner of No. 3 Charleston and No. 6 Hofstra on Friday.

■ **Hofstra** (14-13, 8-8 CAA) ended the regular season with a weekend split against James Madison. After falling in straight sets on Saturday, the Pride returned the favor dropping the Dukes in three sets on Sunday. Beatriz Alves had an impressive week facilitating the Pride attack. She recorded 81 assists (13.50 per set) with 14 digs (2.33 per set). On Saturday, Alves tallied 39 assists as Athina Dimitriadis (13k) and Florencia Wolkowyski (11k) reached double-digit kills. In the Pride's victory, Alves recorded her seventh double-double this season with 42 assists and 10 digs. On Sunday, four Hofstra players reached double figures attacking, led by Wolkowyski with 13 kills. Dimitriadis added 11 kills, while Ana Martinovic and Zyare Abdul-Rahim each chipped in 10. Hofstra is seeded sixth in the CAA tournament and faces third-seeded Charleston in the quarterfinals on Thursday.

■ **James Madison** (17-7, 11-5 CAA) finished the season with a weekend split at Hofstra. Miëtte Veldman paced JMU with 27 kills (4.50 per set) and added 13 digs (2.17 per set). Sophia Davis added 20 kills (3.33 per set) and nine blocks (1.50 per set). Caroline Dozier recorded 58 assists (9.67 per set) and 17 digs (2.83 per set). Davis had 10 kills in each match, while Veldman led JMU in both contests, with 14 and 13 kills, respectively. On Sunday, Dozier recorded her eighth double-double this season with 31 assists and 10 digs despite the setback. James Madison finishes the regular season with a 17-7 record overall and an 11-5 mark in conference play.

■ **UNCW** (4-23, 3-13 CAA) dropped its final two contests this season to Charleston. Katie Lanz had an impressive weekend, recording 27 kills (3.38 per set). Lanz led UNCW in kills in both matches, including a season-best 19 kills in Saturday's five-set defeat. Jaydyn Barry gave it her all from the libero position, tallying 45 digs (5.63 per set) between both matches. On Saturday, Barry recorded a career-high 30 digs in the effort. The Seahawks conclude the year with a 4-23 record, going 3-13 in conference play.

■ **Northeastern** (12-14, 8-8 CAA) ended the regular season with back-to-back losses against Towson. The Huskies fell in four sets on Saturday, followed by a straight-set defeat on Sunday. Erica Staunton paced Northeastern's attack in both matches, totaling 32 kills (4.57) over the weekend. Kalya Martin led the Huskie defense with 32 digs (4.57 per set). Martin recorded double-digit digs in both contests with 17 and 15, respectively. On Saturday, Staunton had a match-high 20 kills and hit .333, while Rafaella Lepenioti tallied her second double-double of the season with 10 kills and 12 digs. On Sunday, Staunton was the only player to reach double-digit kills, leading the match with 12. Northeastern is seeded fifth in the CAA tournament and will face fourth-seeded Delaware in the quarterfinals on Thursday.

■ **Towson** (24-4, 12-4 CAA) defeated Northeastern in back-to-back matches to claim the CAA regular-season title and secure the top seed in the conference tournament. Fay Bakodimou and Emily Jarome led the Towson attack. Bakodimou tallied 27 kills (3.85 per set), and Jarome totaled 23 (3.29 per set) with 23 digs. Rachel Hess was a staple defensively for the Tigers, recording 35 digs (5.00 per set). Hess had a match-high 23 digs in Sunday's contest and added 12 on Saturday. In match one, Bakodimou recorded 16 kills to lead the team, while Jarome added 15 with 14 digs for her eighth double-double this season. Nikiya Mitchell was the third Tiger with double-figure kills, recording 11. In the weekend finale, Bakodimou had nine kills along with Lydia Wiers, and Jarome contributed eight. The Tigers await the winner of No. 4 Delaware and No. 5 Northeastern in the CAA tournament after earning the top seed and a first-round bye.

■ **William & Mary** (5-16, 2-14 CAA) fell in its final two contests of the year to Delaware in straight sets. Julia Brown led the Tribe with 20 kills (3.33 per set). On Saturday, Brown recorded a team-high 13 kills, while Amy Schewm tallied her fifth double-double (22a, 10d) during her freshman season. In the weekend finale, Lauren Merrill paced William & Mary with 11 kills hitting .320 for the match. The Tribe finished the year with a 5-16 record and a 2-14 mark in conference play.

MILESTONE MONDAY

■ Emily Jarome of Towson eclipsed 1,000 career kills over the weekend. The senior outside hitter recorded 27 kills to increase her career total to 1,014. She ranks second on the team with 269 total kills this fall and leads Towson averaging 2.77 kills per set.

■ Towson's Lydia Wiers surpassed 250 career blocks this weekend. The junior middle blocker tallied nine blocks to push her career total to 258. She leads Towson with 113 blocks this season and ranks fifth in the CAA in blocks per set (1.10). Wiers now has over 500 career kills and 250 career blocks in her collegiate career.

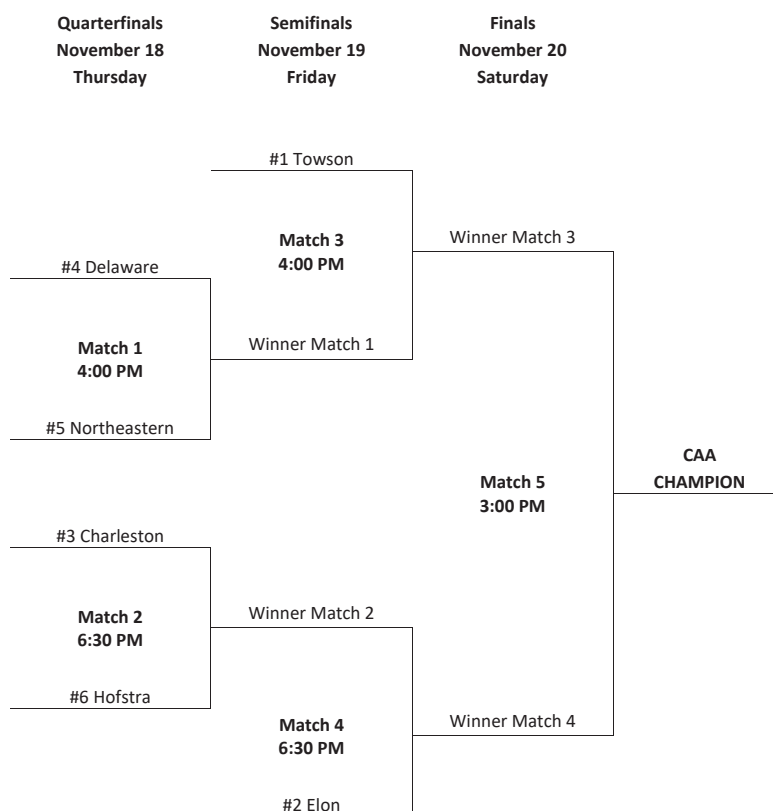

TOURNAMENT SEEDING

Seeding for the championship will be based on a double round-robin in-season competition. Per Conference COVID policy for the 2021-22 academic year, if a Conference match cannot be rescheduled and / or played the match would be considered a forfeit (loss) for the cancelling team, and a victory (win) for the opposing team. The set score would be reflected as 3-0 for each match not played. Per NCAA policy, the game would not count in the team's overall record.

In the event of a tie for position, the tie will be broken in the following manner:

1. Two teams tied:

- Head-to-head conference competition.
- Percentage of sets won between the tied teams in head-to-head competition.
- Percentage of matches then sets won against the highest ranking team in the final conference standing, in which the tied teams played this opponent an equal number of times.
- If a tie still exists, then use the procedure in 1.c for the 2nd highest ranking team in the final conference standing, and so on throughout the rest of the conference.
- Calculation of (+/- points) among the tied teams in head-to-head competition.
- If a tie still exists, a coin flip conducted by the Commissioner will be used.

2. Three or more teams tied:

- Head to head competition as determined by the combined record of matches among the tied teams involved, even if the number of matches played against each other is unequal. Compare until an advantage is gained using the procedures set forth above.*
- Percentage of sets won amongst the tied teams against each other.*
- Calculation of +/- points between the tied teams against each other.*

* At any point after the above calculations, the number of tied teams drops to two, tie-breaking procedure number 1 is employed.
