# OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK JULIA BROWN, WILLIAM & MARY Graduate | Middle Blocker | Geneva, Ill./Geneva

In her final weekend at Kaplan Arena, Brown led William & Mary to a split with Elon, averaging 3.88 kills per set on a scorching .529 hitting percentage. The graduate student posted 10 kills on a .474 hitting percentage in a setback on Saturday. However, in the weekend finale, Brown recorded a career-high 21 kills, hitting .563, and added five blocks with a service ace to lead the Tribe to a five-set victory. Brown ranks fourth in the CAA in hitting percentage (.338) and kills per (3.25) set this season.



#### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK SAVANNAH MARSHALL, JAMES MADISON Senior | Libero | Virginia Beach, Va./Floyd E. Kellam

Marshall anchored James Madison's back row in a pair of straight-set victories over Northeastern. The victories helped James Madison clinch a CAA tournament berth and stay in a tie for first place in the conference standings. Marshall averaged 4.33 digs per set and chipped in 2.33 assists per set from her libero position. On Saturday, the senior recorded a match-high 10 digs to help limit Northeastern to a .038 hitting percentage. She added six assists and two service aces in the effort. On Sunday, Marshall led James Madison with 16 digs while adding eight assists and two service aces to cap off the weekend.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK BEATRIZ ALVES, HOFSTRA

Freshman | Setter | São José dos Campos, Brazil/Colégio Campos Salles

Alves continued her stellar freshman campaign with another strong week, helping Hofstra to back-to-back wins over UNCW. Alves averaged 11.38 assists per set, facilitating the Pride attack while adding 1.38 digs and 1.25 kills per set over the weekend. On Saturday, she recorded 45 assists, seven digs, four kills, two service aces and a pair of blocks to help the Pride win in four sets. In the weekend finale, Alves tallied 46 assists, six kills, four digs, two blocks and a service ace as Hofstra earned a four-set victory. Alves ranks second in the CAA with 9.48 assists per set this season and has recorded 40 or more assists in eight matches this fall.

- Charleston (13-10, 6-6 CAA) had a break in its schedule and will return to action this week. The Cougars lead the CAA in digs per set (14.78) this season as five individuals are averaging 2.00 or more digs per set. Sammy Campion paces the squad with 4.84 digs per set. Lexi Wierzbicki leads the Charleston attack with 271 kills (2.95 per set), while Emma Appleman has a team-high 482 assists (6.10 per set). Claire Campbell is the team's top blocker, with 97 total (1.05 per set) on the year. Bailey Gabi leads the CAA with nine double-doubles and is averaging 2.85 kills and 2.43 digs per set this fall. Off its break, Charleston will travel to Northeastern for a pair of matches this weekend, resuming conference play.
- Delaware (11-12, 6-8 CAA) suffered a pair of setbacks, falling in back-to-back matches to Towson. The Blue Hens fell in four sets on Friday before a five-set battle on Sunday. Lauryn Richardson led Delaware offensively, with 28 kills (3.11 per set) on a .359 hitting percentage. Richardson led Delaware in kills, both matches, with 14 kills on Friday and 14 Sunday. She added four blocks and three digs in Friday's effort. Delaware leads the CAA in service aces per set (2.08), ranking fifth in the nation. Savannah Seemans sits second in the conference (0.47), while Ezgi Basaranlar (0.44) is third. Delaware will take a break from conference play and host UMBC for a matchup on Thursday.
- Elon (14-10, 9-5 CAA) split its weekend series with William & Mary, winning the first contest in three sets before falling in five on Sunday. Leah Daniel paced the Phoenix with 28 kills (3.50 per set), followed by Sydney Love with 23 (2.88 per set). Daniel had a team-high 12 kills in the Elon victory, while Love added eight. On Sunday, Daniel recorded a team-high 16 kills, and Love posted a career-high 15. Haylie Clark contributed 33 assists and 11 digs for her fifth double-double of the season despite the setback. Elon will wrap up its regular season, hosting Hofstra for contests on Friday and Saturday.
- Hofstra (13-10, 7-5 CAA) got back on track defeating UNCW in a pair of four-set matches. Freshman Beatriz Alves facilitated the Hofstra attack, recording 91 assists (11.38 per set). Ana Martinovic was the main beneficiary, leading the Pride with 31 kills (3.88 per set). Defensively, Chiara Cucco tallied 35 digs (4.38 per set), and Sarah Pierre totaled 11 blocks (1.38 per set). On Saturday, Martinovic recorded her eighth doubledouble of the season, with 14 kills and 12 digs. Zyare Abdul-Rahim added 14 kills as well, while Alves tallied 45 assists. On Sunday, Martinovic had a season-high 17 kills, and Florencia Wolkowyski added 14, while Alves recorded 46 assists. Cucco led both matches in digs with 15 and 20, respectively. Hofstra will continue play, heading to Elon this weekend.
- James Madison (15-5, 9-3 CAA) won a pair of pivotal matchups against Northeastern to keep pace atop the conference standings. Miëtte Veldman paced the team with 30 kills (5.00 per set), while Caroline Dozier tallied 67 assists (11.17 per set) in back-to-back straight-set victories. Dozier's performance put her atop the CAA rankings in assists per set (9.60) for the fall. Savannah Marshall anchored the Dukes' backline, recording 26 digs (4.33 per set). On Saturday, Veldman wreaked havoc, with a match-high 18 kills. In the following match, Sophia Davis led the contest with 16 kills on a .545 hitting percentage, while Veldman added 12 kills. Dozier picked up her fifth double-double of the season with 36 assists and 10 digs. Chloe Wilmoth added nine kills in each match and hit .432 for the weekend. For the second consecutive weekend, James Madison will face an opponent it is tied with for first place in the CAA standings. The Dukes will host Towson for matches on Saturday and Sunday in a key series for postseason positioning.

- UNCW (3-20, 2-10 CAA) fell in back-to-back four-set contests against Hofstra. Katie Lanz led UNCW's attack in the first match, recording 10 kills on a .409 hitting percentage. Sarah Blakely added nine kills in the effort. In the weekend finale, Brianna Haggerty led UNCW with 10 kills and added 10 digs for her team-leading sixth double-double of the season. Kirsten Badowski contributed nine kills to rank second on the team. Jadyn Berry posted a team-high 27 digs (3.38 per set) over the weekend, leading the Seahawks in both matches. UNCW will play its final two home contests this fall when they host William & Mary on Saturday and Sunday.
- **Northeastern** (11-11, 7-5 CAA) suffered a pair of conference setbacks, falling to James Madison in consecutive matches. On Saturday, Northeastern was limited to a .038 team hitting percentage. Erica Staunton and Defne Arliel each had eight kills to lead Northeastern. On Sunday, Rafaella Lepenioti recorded a team-high 12 kills and posted a .407 hitting percentage, the best during her freshman campaign. Staunton reached doublefigures as well, tallying 10 kills in the contest. Northeastern returns to Boston for two final home matches this fall. The Huskies will host Charleston for a pair of contests this weekend.
- Towson (21-3, 9-3 CAA) defeated Delaware in back-to-back matches, besting the Blue Hens in four-set on Friday before a five-set victory on Sunday. Emily Jarome led the way for Towson, recording her sixth and seventh double-doubles of the season. For the weekend, Jarome averaged 3.44 kills per set on a .324 hitting percentage along with 2.89 digs per set. On Friday, she had a math-high 15 kills and added 11 digs, five blocks and three service aces. In the weekend finale, Jarome led the match with 16 kills while recording a season-high 15 digs and two service aces. Rachel Hess continued her work in the back row, recording 38 digs (4.22 per set) over the weekend. Hess tallied 16 digs on Friday, followed by 20 on Sunday. She has recorded double-digit digs in 20 matches this fall. Towson faces James Madison for a pair of contests this weekend in a matchup of the top two teams in the CAA standings.
- William & Mary (4-13, 1-11 CAA) fell to Elon in straight sets before ending its 11-game skid with a five-set victory over the Phoenix. Julia Brown continued to be at the forefront for William & Mary. Brown recorded 31 kills (3.88 per set) on a .529 attacking percentage. In the defeat, Brown recorded 10 kills while Lauren Merrill posted a match-high 14. Brown willed the Tribe to victory on Sunday, recording a career-high 21 kills along with five blocks. Maddie Meyers helped the cause, contributing 14 kills, while Merrill and Kaitlyn Ferguson tallied nine. William & Mary will end its season with four matches on the road, starting with a pair of matches at UNCW this weekend.

• Lydia Wiers of Towson surpassed 500 career kills over the weekend. The junior recorded 12 kills against Delaware to push her career total to 507. Wiers ranks third on Towson with 178 kills this fall, and she leads the CAA with a .373 hitting percentage.
